CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 78-17 record during the 2016-17 campaign. Ten losses were by single digits, including three in overtime.

Big 12 teams boast a .821 winning percentage this season - the best record of any conference in the nation.

Every Big 12 team has a winning percentage of .556 or better - the only conference nationally that can boast that feat.

The 17 combined losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 24 (Big East).

The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.

The Big 12 as a whole has won 114 of its last 142 and 127 of its last 158 non-conference contests overall.

Big 12 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among active conferences with a .609 mark.

For the first time in Big 12 history, the league beat two top five non-conference opponents on the same day. Kansas topped No. 1 Duke and Baylor defeated No. 4 Oregon on November 15.

BAYLOR (9-0, 0-0)

- Baylor is one of six remaining unbeaten teams in Division I and has started 9-0 for the first time since 2011-12, tying for the fourth-best start in the history of the program. The Bears are 19-1 in December contests since 2013.
- Junior forward Jonathan Motley recorded his second career double-double with 20 points and 10 rebounds versus Southern. He scored the first seven points of the game and has 37 points while shooting 57.1 percent in his last two outings.
- Junior forward Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. has 20 blocked shots in the past four contests, including two games versus top 10 opponents. He leads the Big 12 with 39 rejections - 14 more than the next closest player.



IOWA STATE (6-3, 0-0)

- Iowa State has committed fewer turnovers than its opponent in all nine games this season. The Cyclones have had single-digit miscues three times and have not had more than 11 turnovers in a contest since the first game of the year.
- Senior guard Matt Thomas led ISU with 14 points at Iowa. He connected on two shots from 3-point range and moved into a tie (Fred Hoiberg) for fifth place with 183 field goals made from beyond the arc.
- Senior guard Monté Morris has moved into 21st on the all-time ISU scoring list with 1,261 points. He is the sixth player in Big 12 history to reach 600 career assists (606), with his total ranking third on the school career chart.



KANSAS (9-1, 0-0)

- Kansas won its 750th game inside Allen Fieldhouse with the victory over Nebraska, improving its record to 750-109 (.873) at the venue. The Jayhawks are 212-9 (.959) in the building under head coach Bill Self, who is in his 14th season.
- KU shot 59.6 percent versus the Cornhuskers, the fifth straight outing it has shot over 50 percent. The Jayhawks rank third nationally in field goal percentage (.528) and place sixth in 3-point field goal percentage (.431).
- Senior guard Frank Mason has led Kansas in scoring in eight of 10 contests this year, including each of past three games. He has 12 assists with no turnovers in his last two outings, with 25 assists and just three miscues in the past four games.



KANSAS STATE (9-1, 0-0)

- The Wildcats have started 9-1 for the first time under head coach Bruce Weber and the first season since the 2011-12 campaign. Kansas State has scored 70 points or more in eight of its first 10 outings.
- Senior forward Wesley Iwundu needs one more start to become the seventh player in school history to record 100 starts. He has scored in double digits six times this year and grabbed five or more rebounds seven times.
- Sophomore guard Barry Brown has posted double-figure scoring totals nine times in 2016-17, the most of any Wildcat player. He leads the 'Cats in scoring (13.2 ppg), steals (2.3) and minutes played (29.8 mpg).



OKLAHOMA (6-3, 0-0)

- Senior guard Jordan Woodard tied his career high with 28 points to go along with seven rebounds versus Wichita State. It was his 12th career game with 20 points or more and moved him into 21st on the all-time OU scoring list (1,302 points).
- Junior forward Khadeem Lattin has tallied multiple steals and multiple blocks in five of his last six games. He has 129 career rejections, three blocks away from moving into fourth on the Sooner all-time blocked shots list.
- Oklahoma will welcome Memphis to the Lloyd Noble Center for just the second time in eight series meetings on Saturday. OU has won 126 of its last 131 non-conference games in the venue, including 60 of the last 62.



OKLAHOMA STATE (8-2, 0-0)

- Oklahoma State is 5-0 at home this year and has scored at least 101 points in each of those contests. The Cowboys are connecting at a .495 clip from the field in Gallagher-Iba Arena, outscoring their opponents by a +29.2 margin.
- Senior guard Phil Forte has made 38-of-39 (.974) from the free throw line, including 16 in a row, to boast the best percentage in the nation. He has also increased his total career 3-pointers to 265, which ranks third in school history.
- OSU forced Arkansas-Pine Bluff into a season-high 31 turnovers, the first time since 2012 that the Cowboys have forced at least 30 miscues. Oklahoma State has forced no fewer than 15 turnovers by every opponent this season.



TCU (9-1, 0-0)

- Junior Kenrich Williams has recorded a double-double in three of the last four outings, including all four with at least 10 boards. He has also gone three straight games without a turnover and has zero miscues in six of eight contests this year.
- Junior forward Vladimir Brodziansky has scored in double figures in three straight outings and matched his career high with five blocked shots versus Wofford. He has totaled 12 rejections over the past three contests.
- Freshman guard Jaylen Fisher has scored in double digits in five straight contests and all but two games this season. He has shot 40 percent or better from the floor in six of nine outings.



TEXAS (5-4, 0-0)

- Sophomore Tevin Mack averaged 18.0 points and 4.5 rebounds in two games last week, connecting on 11-of-22 (.455) shots from the floor. He has reached double figures in scoring in eight of nine outings this year and 13 times in his career.
- The Longhorns have shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line in three straight contests and six times in 2016-17. UT has had double-figure free throw totals in seven of nine games.
- UT has two of its next three non-conference games at home. The Longhorns are 210-30 (.875) at the Erwin Center over the past 15 seasons (since 2002-03), including 19-4 (.826) at home in the Shaka Smart era.



TEXAS TECH (9-1, 0-0)

- Junior guard Keenan Evans notched the second-best scoring total of his career with 23 points against Nicholls State. He has recorded double-digit points in a career-long five straight outings and has eight such efforts overall in 2016-17.
- Tech has won 27 straight non-conference home games dating back to the 2013-14 season, with 22 coming by double figures. The Red Raiders are shooting 53.7 percent at home this year, including over 50 percent each of the past three outings.
- Junior forward Justin Gray posted his first career double-double in the win over Nicholls State with 18 points and 11 boards. He has scored in double figures in four of his last five contests, shooting over 57 percent in each of those games.



WEST VIRGINIA (8-1, 0-0)

- Bob Huggins needs one victory to become the eighth Division I head coach in history to reach the 800-win plateau. His current victory total ranks third among active coaches and he boasts 27 seasons with 20 wins or more to his credit.
- Junior guard Daxter Miles Jr. had a game-high 20 points versus VMI, the first Mountaineer to eclipse the 20-point mark this year. He is shooting 60 percent from 3-point range overall in 2016-17 and has made 7-of-10 in the last two games.
- West Virginia forced 22 turnovers against VMI, the seventh time in nine outings this season that its opponent has had at least 20 miscues. The Mountaineers lead the nation in turnover margin (+14.9) and turnovers forced (26.0 pg).
