GAMEDAY STORYLINES

- ▶ Oklahoma has won 126 of its last 131 non-conference games at Lloyd Noble Center, including 60 of its last 62. The Sooners are 34-2 at LNC and 62-17 overall against non-conference opponents under Kruger. Since the start of the 2013 season, OU has gone 23-1 at the LNC in out-of-conference play and has won 16 straight non-conference games in Norman
- ▶ The Sooners suffered their third loss of the season on Saturday, to Wichita State, 73-70, and now looks to continue its trend of bouncing back. Since 2013, the Sooners are 24-5 in games after a loss, including 2-0 in such scenarios this season
- ▶ 0U has benefited from a dramatic increase in scoring from starting guards **Christian James** and **Rashard Odomes**. After averaging 2.9 points per game in 2015-16, James is the second leading scorer for the Sooners through nine games, scoring 12.3 points per game on .453 shooting from the field and a Big 12-leading .548 from 3-point range. James is the only returning Big 12 player to average less than 3.0 points in 2015-16 and over 12.0 points in 2016-17. Tallying just 35 total points in 2015-16 (1.9 per game), Odomes has already doubled his total points output with 90 on the season (averaging 10.0 per game).
- ▶ Coming off of a career-high-tying 28 points against Wichita State, senior guard **Jordan Woodard** ranks third in scoring among Big 12 players with 17.1 points per game. His last game marked the 12th 20-point game of his career, which ranks second among active Big 12 players. The senior flirted with a triple-double in last season's game against Memphis, tallying 15 points, nine rebounds and seven assists.

The Sooners opened the 2015-16 season with an 80-78 win over the Tigers at FedEx Forum, marking Oklahoma's first ever visit over Memphis. Both teams enter Saturday looking to bounce back from a loss. The Sooners fell to Wichita State, 76-73, at the All-College Classic in Oklahoma City while the Tigers suffered an 82-79 home loss to Monmouth. The matchup will tip off at 11:30 a.m. CT and air on the Sooner Radio Network (KRXO 107.7 FM "The Franchise" in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** announcing. The game will be televised nationally on CBS with **Rich Waltz** and **Jim Spanarkel** calling the action. The Sooners have not hosted a CBS game at Lloyd Noble Center since Jan. 22, 2005 vs. Texas.

- ▶ Oklahoma claimed its first-ever victory over Memphis, 84-78, in the 2015-16 season opener.
- ▶ The Sooners outshot the Tigers 42.6 percent (29-68) to 34.6 percent (27-78) from the floor. From long distance, OU shot 42.3 percent (11-26) compared to Memphis' 23.1 percent (6-26).
- ▶ Buddy Hield scored a game-high 30 points (one shy of his career high), while adding eight rebounds, three assists, three steals and two blocked shots.
- ▶ Jordan Woodard scored in double figures with 15 points (5-11 FG, 2-3 3FG), including a crucial 3-pointer with 38 seconds left in regulation to give Oklahoma an 80-76 lead. He added nine rebounds and a team-high seven assists.
- ▶ The two teams tied in total rebounds (48) on the evening. The Tigers were 18 of 31 from the free throw line compared to 15 of 20 for the Sooners.
- ▶ The game featured 10 lead changes and six ties
- ▶ Leading the Tigers was Dedric Lawson with 22 points, a game-high 15 rebounds and three blocked shots. Avery Woodson (12), Markel Crawford (12) and Trahson Burrell (10) also scored in double figures for the Tigers.

- ▶ Oklahoma (6-3) fell to Wichita State (9-2) in the 79th All-College Classic, 76-73. The non-conference meeting took place at Chesapeake Energy Arena in Oklahoma City. The Sooners now own a 4-1 record at "The Peake" under head coach Lon Kruger.
- ▶ Senior guard Jordan Woodard scored a career-high-tying 28 points with seven rebounds, four assists and two steals. Woodard's 28 points are the most by a Sooner this season and represent the 12th 20-plus point performance in his career. Woodard went a perfect 10-for-10 from the free throw line, marking just the second time in his career he has shot perfect from the charity stripe on a minimum of 10 attempts. He previously shot 10-for-10 against Kansas on Jan. 8, 2014.
- ▶ Sophomore guard Christian James scored 15 points with six rebounds in his fourth-consecutive game of double-digit scoring. Sophomore guard Rashard Odomes added 10 points in his sixth double-digit performance of the season.
- ▶ The Sooners surrendered a season-low 10 turnovers against a Shocker team that entered the game forcing 16.3 a game.
- ▶ 0U led the Shockers, 39-37, going into halftime. The Sooners have led at the halftime break in eight of their nine games this season.

- ▶ The Sooners celebrate the 125th anniversary of basketball by facing Auburn in the Birthday of Basketball in Uncasville, Conn., on Dec. 21 at 7:30 p.m. CT on CBS Sports Network. Dec. 21, 1891 is the date James Naismith first introduced the game of basketball to a class of young men at the YMCA International Training School in Springfield, Mass.
- ▶ The Sooners are 1-1 all-time against Auburn, with both meetings occurring at neutral sites. Oklahoma and Auburn last met on the hardwood in the opening round of the 1988 NCAA Tournament. The Sooners defeated the Tigers, 107-87, on their road to the 1988 Final Four before falling to Kansas in the national title game.

- 13.0 points (10th in Big 12), 3.4 assists (9th), 3.0 rebounds and 1.6 steals (5th) in 29.8 minutes. The Big 12 coaches voted Woodard a preseason All-Big 12 Honorable Mention selection ahead of the 2016-17 season.
- ▶ With three-plus seasons of experience in the Sooner starting lineup under his belt, Woodard has already made a dent in the OU record book. With a career-high-tying 28 points in his most recent outing, Woodard brought his career scoring total to 1,302 points, becoming just the 21st Sooner to score over 1.300 points in a

- ▶ Junior forward **Khadeem Lattin** has already proven himself as one of the top shot blockers in Oklahoma program history. After 80 career games for the Sooners, Lattin ranks fifth in the OU record book in career blocks with 129.
- Owning a 7-foot-2 wingspan, Lattin averaged a Big 12-best 2.1 blocks per game in 2015-16, including 2.7 rejections in conference play. His efforts did not go unnoticed throughout the league, as he was voted to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team by conference
- ▶ His 77 total blocks in 2015-16 ranked 17th in the nation and fifth among players at Power Five schools. The forward registered at least six blocks on five occasions, including a career-best eight blocked shots vs. Texas Tech on Jan. 26.
- Lattin is off to another solid start on the defensive end in 2016-17, registering 21 blocks in nine games. His 2.1 blocks per game ranks third in the Big 12. He's also tallied 17 steals this season, compared to his total of 32 in 36 games last season. Lattin is the only Big 12 player ranked in the conference's top 10 for both blocks and steals. He has tallied multiple steals and multiple blocks in five of his last six games.
- ▶ On the offensive end, Lattin has seen much improved production. After averaging 5.6 points on .557 shooting in 2015-16, Lattin boasts a 2016-17 average of 10.0 points on a .545 field goal percentage.

- ▶ Kruger's OU teams keep improving and have surpassed their win total from each subsequent season, with the 2015-16 squad finishing with a 29-8 record and making a trip to the Final Four. Before his arrival at OU, the Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.
- ▶ In five full seasons at Oklahoma, Kruger has produced four NCAA Tournament appearances, three top-three finishes in the Big 12, a national player of the year in Buddy Hield and a trip to the 2016 Final Four. Oklahoma was ranked in the top 10 of the AP Top 25 poll for every week of the 2015-16 season and made its first appearance as the poll's No. 1 team for the first time in more than 25 years.
- ▶ With 111 wins in his first five seasons at OU, Kruger owns the second most victories in the first five seasons of coaching the Sooners. Only Billy Tubbs accumulated more wins (115) in his first five years at OU. Kruger is the first coach in OU history to win six NCAA tournament games within his first five seasons.
- ▶ Boasting 596 career victories, Kruger ranks 10th in Division 1 wins among active coaches and 35th overall in NCAA Division I history.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

It's known as the house Alvan Adams built and Wayman Tisdale filled. It's also where Billy Tubbs resurrected Oklahoma basketball, where Blake Griffin flew high and where Buddy Hield became Buddy Buckets. Now, Lon Kruger is continuing the remarkable run of Sooner success inside the Lloyd Noble Center.

- ▶ Oklahoma has gone 58-7 (.892) at Lloyd Noble Center in the past five years, including 32-2 (.941) in the last three seasons. Overall, the Sooners are 69-12 (.852) at the LNC in the Kruger era.
- ▶ The Sooners have won 437 of their last 503 encounters at Lloyd Noble Center, good for a remarkable .869 winning percentage. Included in the stretch was a school-record 51-game winning streak (ended in 1990-91). The Sooners also recorded a Big 12 Conference-record 37-game home court winning streak (ended in 2003).
- ▶ OU is 13-6 at home against AP Top 25 opponents in the Kruger era and has won 12 of the last 14 such contests.
- ▶ Oklahoma has won 126 of its last 131 non-conference games at LNC, including 60 of its last 62. The Sooners are 34-2 in Norman against non-conference opponents under Kruger.
- ▶ Overall, the Sooners own a 532-93 (.850) record in the LNC since the building opened in 1975.
- ▶ Student interest in OU basketball has continued to grow through Kruger's tenure. Student attendance has increased by more than 100 percent from Kruger's first season (2011–12). This year, OU student season tickets sold out in less than 24 hours the fastest rate in the OU era.

PLAYER HIGHS IN THE LON KRUGER ERA

IT'S NOT WHERE YOU START...

For the first time since 2013, the Sooners will start the season unranked in both the AP and Coaches preseason polls. Oklahoma was also voted sixth in the Big 12 Conference's preseason poll – it's lowest preseason projection since 2012. Despite the preseason rankings. OU looks to continue an upward trend of surpassing expectations under Kruger.

- ▶ Oklahoma has finished as well or better than predicted in four of the five seasons under Kruger. In the only exception (2015-16), the Sooners were picked to finish second in the Big 12. While OU ended the 2015-16 regular season with the third best record in the Big 12, the Sooners advanced to the 2016 Final Four the deepest NCAA Tournament run by a Big 12 team that season.
- ▶ The Sooners have also finished the past three seasons with a better ranking in the final AP and Coaches Polls compared to where each poll had pegged them

▶ Prior to the 2016 AP preseason poll, the Sooners had received a Top-25 ranking for 36 consecutive weeks. Oklahoma has been ranked in the top 25 in 44 of the past 53

- ▶ DECEMBER AWAITS: After going 5-1 in November, the Sooners are in the heart of a challenging December schedule. Already having faced No. 17/17 Wisconsin (Dec. 3), Oral Roberts (Dec. 7) and Wichita State (Dec. 10), the Sooners close out the month against competitive programs Memphis (Dec. 17), Auburn (Dec. 21) and No. 4/5 Baylor (Dec. 30). Over the past decade, OU's six December opponents combine to boast 30 NCAA Tournament appearances, 14 trips to the Sweet 16 and four Final Fours.
- ▶ **GETTING TO THE LINE:** After shooting 95-of-147 (.646) from the free throw line in the first six games of the season, Oklahomas has shot 56-of-67 (.836) in its last three outings. Jordan Woodard (.837), Kristian Doolittle (.821) and Khadeem Lattin (.789) all rank in the Big 12's top five in free throw percentage.
- ▶ FROM DEEP...Coming off of a prolific season of 3-point shooting in 2015-16 that included hitting a program-record 382-of-906 (.422) shots from behind the arc, the Sooners are off to another hot start from deep. Oklahoma ranks 28th nationally and fourth in the Big 12 in 3-point field goal percentage (.402), sinking an average of 7.6 treys per game. OU has been paced by **Jordan Woodard** (22 made 3-pointers) and **Christian James** (17 made 3-pointers). James currently leads the Big 12 by shooting his 3-point attempts at a 54.8 percent clip.
- ▶ ...AND FROM DOWN LOW: The Sooners are looking for increased production in the paint. After just one game of scoring over 50 points in the paint in 2015-16, Oklahoma has already had two games of 52 points in the paint this year. The Sooners are averaging 32.8 points in the paint per game (averaged 28.2 in 2015-16).
- ➤ SWITCHING IT UP: After five games of using the same starting lineup, head coach Lon Kruger swapped Kristian Doolittle for Matt Freeman at the forward position. It was the first time since February of 2013 that Kruger has adjusted a starting lineup during the season. Dante Buford received the start at the forward position in OU's two most recent games (Dec. 7 vs. Oral Roberts and Dec. 10 vs. Wichita State).
- ▶ **TRANSITIONING:** The Sooners are outscoring their opponents in transition by over a 2-to-1 rate. Oklahoma is averaging 7.5 fast-break points per game while limiting their opponents to 3.1 points in fast break. The Sooners have held the opposition to two or fewer fast break points in five of their nine games this season.
- ▶ BULLDOGS BACK TOGETHER: Oklahoma's starting lineup in the first five games included freshman forward Kristian Doolittle, the first freshman to start for the Sooners since Jordan Woodard in the 2013-14 season. Doolittle finished his debut with five points and three rebounds in 19 minutes. Doolittle and Woodard played together for one season at Edmond Memorial High School (Edmond, Okla.), winning the Oklahoma 6A title. The duo is the first pair of former high school teammates to start in a game for the Sooners since Blake and Taylor Griffin (Oklahoma Christian School in Edmond, Okla.) in 2008-09.
- ▶ LATTIN NAMED TO OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE: Sooner forward Khadeem Lattin was recently named to the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee. One of two student-athletes on the 16-person committee, Lattin will serve as a non-voting member in a two-year term that begins immediately. The Men's Basketball Oversight Committee ensures that appropriate oversight of men's basketball is maintained, enhances the development and public perception of the sport and make recommendations related to regular-season and postseason men's basketball. The committee is tasked with prioritizing enhancement of the student-athlete educational experience (academically and athletically), and in doing so, promote student-athletes' personal growth and leadership development.

KRUGER'S SOONER TURNAROUND

- ▶ Kruger has been leaving his trademark rebuilding stamp on college basketball programs throughout his career. He is the only Division I coach to ever take five different schools to the NCAA Tournament. In 2015 he became the first coach since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985 to take four programs to the Sweet 16 or beyond.
- ▶ After inheriting a program that went 27-36 (.429) in the two seasons prior to his arrival, Kruger has coached the Sooners to a 117-60 (.661) record in six seasons. Over the last four full campaigns, OU posted a 96-41 (.701) mark and advanced to the NCAA Tournament each season, capped by a trip to the 2016 Final Four in Houston. The Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.
- ▶ With a career college coaching record of 596-364 (.621), Kruger owns the 10th most wins among active Division I coaches. He owns a 20-17 record in NCAA Tournament games and has compiled 16 20-plus-win seasons, including nine in the last 10 years. His collegiate teams have made postseason appearances in 21 of the last 26 years.
- ▶ Under Kruger, Sooner players have earned First-Team All-Big 12 selections on three occasions and racked up 14 Academic All-Big 12 honors, Buddy Hield, who played four seasons for Kruger (2012-16). was named the winner of the 2016 Wooden Award, Naismith Trophy and the Oscar Robertson Trophy as the national player of the year (first consensus player of the year for OU since Blake Griffin in 2009).
- ▶ Three Sooners have been drafted into the NBA during Kruger's tenure. Buddy Hield was selected as the sixth overall pick in the 2016 NBA Draft while Isaiah Cousins (2016) and Romero Osby (2013) were chosen in the second round of their respected drafts.
