CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 87-19 record during the 2016-17 campaign. Twelve losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.
- Eight of the 10 teams in the Big 12 are ranked or receiving votes in the national top 25 polls this week.
- Big 12 teams boast a .821 winning percentage this season - the best record of any conference in the nation.
- Four of the five losses suffered by the five Big 12 teams with only one loss were by four points or less. Average margin of defeat is 5.2 points.
- The 19 combined losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 25 (Big East).
- The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.
- The Big 12 as a whole has won 123 of its last 153 and 136 of its last 169 non-conference contests overall.
- For the first time in Big 12 history, the league beat two top five non-conference opponents on the same day. Kansas topped No. 1 Duke and Baylor defeated No. 4 Oregon on November 15.

BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

Champions for Life is featuring two outstanding women. **BAYLOR (11-0, 0-0)**

- Baylor is one of six remaining unbeaten teams in Division I and its 11-0 start is the fourth-best in program history. The Bears have won 42 consecutive non-conference home games, the second-best active streak in the nation (Duke).
- Junior forward Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. has recorded multiple blocked shots in 10 of 11 outings this year, including 27 in his past six contests. He has also scored in double digits in four straight games and seven times in his career.
- Junior guard Al Freeman is shooting 69.6 percent from the field and 62.5 percent from 3-point range over the last three outings. He has scored in double figures in five straight games - the longest double-digit streak of his career.

**IOWA STATE (7-3, 0-0)**

- Senior guard Naz Mitrou-Long finished with a career-high 37 points on 14-of-18 shooting in the win over Drake. He converted 8-of-12 from 3-point range and now ranks fifth in school history with 186 field goals from beyond the arc.
- Iowa State committed a season-low five turnovers against Drake. The Cyclones have had fewer turnovers than their opponent in all 10 games this season and have not had more than 11 miscues in a contest since the first game of the year.
- Senior guard Monté Morris has moved into 20th on the all-time ISU scoring list with 1,281 points. He has 34 assists over his last six games and has also missed just one free throw (11-of-12, .917) during that span.

**KANSAS (10-1, 0-0)**

- Kansas has scored 89 points or more in six straight games, the longest such streak since posting six straight outings with 91 points or more from January 4-18, 1990. The Jayhawks have had four or more double figure scorers in nine of 11 contests.
- KU has won 10 consecutive games, the 15th time under head coach Bill Self that the Jayhawks have won 10 in a row or more. Kansas has won seven in a row at Sprint Center and is 34-6 (.850) all-time in the venue.
- Senior guard Frank Mason has scored 18 points or more in 10 of 11 games this season. He has dished out 32 assists against just six turnovers in his past five outings and has five or more assists nine times in 2016-17.

**KANSAS STATE (10-1, 0-0)**

- Senior forward D.J. Johnson posted his third career double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds in 23 minutes at Colorado State. He has shot 50 percent or better in seven of the past eight games and has 10 or more boards in three of the last four.
- The Wildcats are 6-0 this season when scoring 80 points or more and 25-2 under head coach Bruce Weber when eclipsing the mark. K-State is 10-1 for the first time since posting the same record to begin the 2011-12 campaign.
- Sophomore guard Kamau Stokes has at least five assists in six games this season, including four in a row. He has two turnovers or less in six outings and has 25 assists with just eight miscues in the past four contests.

**OKLAHOMA (6-4, 0-0)**

- Senior guard Jordan Woodard has led the Sooners in scoring six times this season. He has totaled 50 points over the past two games and has reached the 20-point plateau in consecutive outings for the first time in his career.
- Coach Lon Kruger has utilized four different starting lineups this season after using just one for the entire season a year ago. Freshman Jordan Shepherd made his first career start versus Memphis and responded with a career-high 18 points.
- Junior forward Khadeem Lattin has tallied multiple steals in six of his last seven contests. He also has 129 career blocked shots, three rejections away from moving into fourth on the Sooner all-time blocks list.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (9-2, 0-0)**

- OSU is just the second non-conference team to beat Wichita State at home since 2008. The Cowboys ended a 42-game non-league home win streak for WSU and were the first team in 116 home matchups to score over 80 points in regulation.
- Oklahoma State connected on 14 field goals from 3-point range versus the Shockers, tied for the fourth-most in school history. The Cowboys have made 26 shots from beyond the arc in the last two outings.
- Junior Jeffrey Carroll has scored in double digits in 10 of 11 contests in 2016-17, including 20 points or more four times. Prior to this season he had never eclipsed the 20-point plateau and had 18 career double-figure scoring efforts.

**TCU (10-1, 0-0)**

- The 10-1 start by TCU matches the second-best in program history. It marks the seventh time the Horned Frogs have opened a season with a record of 10-1 or better, with the 13-0 beginning by the 2014-15 squad the best in school history.
- Senior forward Chris Washburn had season-best totals of 15 points and nine rebounds in just 11 minutes versus Texas Southern. The scoring total was his most since February 2, 2016 and more than in his previous six games combined.
- In his last four games, junior Kenrich Williams is averaging 11.25 rebounds and has not registered a single turnover. He is shooting 50 percent from the floor during that span with three double digit scoring outputs.

**TEXAS (5-5, 0-0)**

- Sophomore Tevin Mack led all five starters in double figures with 20 points and 12 rebounds against Arkansas. He is averaging 18.7 points over the past three outings and has scored in double digits in all but one game this season.
- Freshman guard Andrew Jones matched his career high with 17 points while setting a new career best with seven assists versus the Razorbacks. It was his first outing with 10 points or more in the past seven games.
- The Longhorns have outrebounded three of their last four foes after having held an edge on the boards in only two outings prior to the current stretch. Two UT players (Mack, Jarrett Allen) have recorded double-digit rebounding efforts this year.

**TEXAS TECH (10-1, 0-0)**

- The win at Richmond snapped a streak of seven straight non-conference road losses dating back to the 2011-12 campaign. The Red Raiders have started 10-1 overall for the second consecutive season.
- Junior forward Zach Smith has increased his career blocked shots total to 110, moving into second place on the Tech all-time list for rejections. He has scored in double figures in six of his last eight outings.
- Texas Tech has shot 50 percent or better in four consecutive games and in eight of 11 contests this season. The Red Raiders have also outrebounded all but one opponent, including the last two by a combined +41 margin.

**WEST VIRGINIA (9-1, 0-0)**

- With the win over UMKC, Bob Huggins became just the 10th coach in NCAA Division I history to win 800 career games. His current victory total ranks third among active coaches and he boasts 27 seasons with 20 wins or more to his credit.
- Seven different players scored in double figures versus UMKC, led by senior forward Nathan Adrian with 13 points. He returned to the double-digit scoring column for the eighth time after posting a combined four points in the prior two outings.
- WVU forced 27 turnovers against the Kangaroos, the eighth time in 10 contests this season that its opponent has had at least 20 miscues. The Mountaineers lead the nation in turnover margin (+15.4) and turnovers forced (26.1 pg).

Postseason Awards

The Big 12 presents the only official all-conference awards at the end of the regular season. Major award winners are chosen, along with the All-Big 12 teams.
