GAMEDAY STORYLINES

- ▶ Head coach **Lon Kruger** has used five different starting lineups throughout the first 11 games of the 2016-17 season. In Oklahoma's past two games, Kruger has started freshman **Jordan Shepherd** at point guard. Shepherd entered his first start (Dec. 17 vs. Memphis) averaging just 2.7 points and 8.8 minutes in his first nine games and had seen just one minute of action in the previous contest, but responded to the shake-up by scoring a career-high 18 points in his first career start. The freshman followed up his debut with a team-high 13 points against Auburn on Dec. 21.
- ▶ Ranked No. 4 in both the AP and Coaches polls, Baylor is OU's highest-rated opponent to date this season and the second team to face the Sooners while ranked in the AP Top 25. Oklahoma is 14-5 at home against AP Top 25 teams in the Kruger era, including 4-4 against top 10 teams and 1-2 versus teams in the top five. OU has won 12 of its last 14 home games against AP Top 25 opponents.
- ▶ Sophomore guard **Rashard Odomes** has scored in double figures seven times this season and ranks third on the team with 10.1 points per game. Odomes has seen one of the largest role increases for Oklahoma this season. After averaging 1.9 points (35 total points) in just 6.1 minutes per game in 2015-16, he has already tripled his total points output with 111 on the season in 24.2 minutes per contest.
- ▶ Oklahoma boasts a 35-10 (.778) home record during Big 12 play in the Lon Kruger era and has won 19 of its past 21 home conference games.

GAME OVERVIEW

For the first time in Big 12 Conference history, Oklahoma (6-5) begins conference play in December when it hosts No. 4/4 Baylor (12-0) at Lloyd Noble Center on Friday, Dec. 30. OU is 4-1 in Big 12 openers under Kruger and has opened conference play with a win in the past four seasons. The Sooners will face each team in the loaded Big 12 twice in a league that has sent seven of its 10 members to the NCAA Tournament in the past three-straight seasons. The Sooners' first five Big 12 games are all against teams with one or fewer losses. Those five teams (Baylor, TCU, Kansas State, Kansas, Texas Tech) combine for a record of 56-4. The Big 12 opener tips off at 6 p.m. CT and air on the Sooner Radio Network (KRXO 107.7 FM "The Franchise" in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** announcing. The game will be televised nationally on ESPN2 with **Doug Sherman** and **Fran Fraschilla** calling the action.

- ▶ Buddy Hield led all scorers with 23 points including 13 points in the game's final eight minutes. Ryan Spangler collected a double-double with 15 points and 13 rebounds.
- ▶ Dante Buford, Khadeem Lattin and Jordan Woodard each scored 6 points.

- ▶ Oklahoma (6-5) fell to Auburn (9-2), 74-70, at Mohegan Sun Arena in Uncasville, Conn., as part of the Birthday of Basketball. The Sooners fell victim to a 17-point deficit (45-28) with 16:41 left in the contest, but rallied to end the game within four. OU outscored the Tigers 48-38 in the second half.
- For the first time in four seasons, the Oklahoma lineup was without senior guard Jordan Woodard, who sat out due to a high leg injury. Woodard had started in 115 consecutive games for the Sooners – the second-longest starting streak among active NCAA Division I players (Valparaiso's Alec Peters leads the country with 116).
- ▶ Oklahoma forced 23 Auburn turnovers the most committed by the Tigers this season and the most by an OU opponent this year. The 23 miscues were the most by a Sooner opponent since Weber State committed 23 on Dec. 22, 2014.
- ▶ OU's 17 offensive boards marked a season high for the squad. The previous best of 16 came against Oral Roberts on Dec. 7.
- ▶ The freshmen trio of Kristian Doolittle (seven points) Matt Freeman (eight points) and Jordan Shepherd (13 points) combined for 28 points on the night.

NEXT UP: TCU

- ▶ Oklahoma opens 2017 with its first Big 12 road contest of the season. The Sooners head to Fort Worth to face 11-1 TCU on Tuesday, Jan. 3 at 8 p.m. CT on ESPNU.
- ▶ The Sooners own an 18-2 record over the Horned Frogs and have won six consecutive games over TCU. OU is 8-1 alltime against TCU in Fort Worth, with the only loss coming in 2013.
- ▶ Since TCU joined the Big 12 in 2012, the Sooners have gone 7-1 against the Frogs.

WATCHING WOODARD

▶ Senior guard **Jordan Woodard** has started in 115 of the Sooners' past 116 contests. Woodard sat out OU's Dec. 21 game against Auburn due to a high leg injury, ending a consecutive starts streak that was second in the nation among current NCAA Division I players.

- ▶ A 2015-16 All-Big 12 honorable mention selection, Woodard was the team's second-leading scorer last season with averages of 13.0 points (10th in Big 12), 3.4 assists (9th), 3.0 rebounds and 1.6 steals (5th) in 29.8 minutes. The Big 12 coaches voted Woodard a preseason All-Big 12 Honorable Mention selection ahead of the 2016-17 season.
- ▶ Woodard has seen remarkable development from season to season particularly from behind the 3-point arc. After shooting 17-for-67 (.254) from 3-point range in 2014-15, Woodard sunk 80 treys on 176 attempts (.455) his junior year to finish second in the Big 12 in 3-point shooting.
- ▶ With three-plus seasons of experience in the Sooner starting lineup under his belt, Woodard has already made a dent in the OU record book. Sitting on 1,324 points at OU, Woodard recently became just the 21st Sooner to score over 1,300 points in a career. He surpassed both Blake Griffin (1,278) and Cameron Clark (1,284) in OU's all-time scoring rankings, moving up to No. 21 on the list. He also ranks in the top 10 of four statistical categories in the OU record book (free throws, free throw percentage, assists, steals).
- ▶ With 410 made foul shots and a career free throw percentage of .807, Woodard is just the seventh Sooner to ever sink 400 career free throws. No Sooner has ever finished his collegiate career with over 400 made free throws at a rate of over .800.
- ▶ Coming off of a 28-point performance against Wichita State, Woodard scored 22 points in his most recent outing against Memphis. Woodard's last two games are the first time in his career he has scored 20-plus points in consecutive games and represents his largest point total (50) in a two-game stretch.

- ▶ Junior forward **Khadeem Lattin** has already proven himself as one of the top shot blockers in Oklahoma program history. After 82 career games for the Sooners, Lattin ranks fifth in the OU record book in career blocks with 129.
- 5. Khadeem Lattin129 ▶ Owning a 7-foot-2 wingspan, Lattin averaged a Big 12-best 2.1 blocks per game in 2015-16, including 2.7 rejections in conference play. His efforts did not go unnoticed throughout the league, as he was voted to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team by conference
- ▶ His 77 total blocks in 2015-16 ranked 17th in the nation and fifth among players at Power Five schools. The forward registered at least six blocks on five occasions, including a career-best eight blocked shots vs. Texas Tech on Jan. 26.
- Lattin is off to another solid start on the defensive end in 2016-17, registering 21 blocks in 11 games. His 1.9 blocks per game ranks fourth in the Big 12. He's also tallied 21 steals this season, compared to his total of 32 in 36 games last season. Lattin is one of two Big 12 players ranked in the conference's top 10 for both blocks and steals. He has tallied multiple steals and multiple blocks in five of his last seven games.
- ▶ On the offensive end, Lattin has seen much improved production. After averaging 5.6 points on .557 shooting in 2015-16, Lattin boasts a 2016-17 average of 9.1 points on a .500 field goal percentage.

Lon Kruger has made his mark in college basketball as one of – if not the best - program rebuilders. Want proof? Look no further than what he's done with Oklahoma.

▶ In the two seasons before his hiring, the Sooners went 27-36 (.429) - capped by a 10th-place finish in the Big 12 in 2010-11. Since being brought on in 2011, Kruger has led the program to a 117-62 (.654) record, including a 102-46 (.689) mark over the past five seasons.

- ▶ Kruger's OU teams keep improving and have surpassed their win total from each subsequent season, with the 2015-16 squad finishing with a 29-8 record and making a trip to the Final Four, Before his arrival at OU, the Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.
- ▶ In five full seasons at Oklahoma, Kruger has produced four NCAA Tournament appearances, three top-three finishes in the Big 12, a national player of the year in Buddy Hield and a trip to the 2016 Final Four. Oklahoma was ranked in the top 10 of the AP Top 25 poll for every week of the 2015-16 season and made its first appearance as the poll's No. 1 team for the first time in more than 25 years.
- ▶ With 111 wins in his first five seasons at OU, Kruger owns the second most victories in the first five seasons of coaching the Sooners. Only Billy Tubbs accumulated more wins (115) in his first five years at OU. Kruger is the first coach in OU history to win six NCAA tournament games within his first five seasons.
- ▶ Boasting 596 career victories, Kruger ranks 10th in Division 1 wins among active coaches and 35th overall in NCAA Division I history.

PLAYER HIGHS IN THE LON KRUGER ERA

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

It's known as the house Alvan Adams built and Wayman Tisdale filled. It's also where Billy Tubbs resurrected Oklahoma basketball, where Blake Griffin flew high and where Buddy Hield became Buddy Buckets. Now, Lon Kruger is continuing the remarkable run of Sooner success inside the Lloyd Noble Center.

- ▶ Oklahoma has gone 58-8 (.879) at Lloyd Noble Center in the past five years, including 32-3 (.914) in the last three seasons. Overall, the Sooners are 69-13 (.842) at the LNC in the Kruger era.
- ▶ The Sooners have won 437 of their last 504 encounters at Lloyd Noble Center, good for a remarkable .869 winning percentage. Included in the stretch was a school-record 51-game winning streak (ended in 1990-91). The Sooners also recorded a Big 12 Conference-record 37-game home court winning streak (ended in 2003).
- ▶ OU is 13-6 at home against AP Top 25 opponents in the Kruger era and has won 12 of the last 14 such contests.
- ▶ Oklahoma has won 126 of its last 132 non-conference games at LNC, including 60 of its last 63. The Sooners are 34-3 in Norman against non-conference opponents under Kruger.
- ▶ Overall, the Sooners own a 532-94 (.850) record in the LNC since the building opened in 1975.
- ▶ Student interest in OU basketball has continued to grow through Kruger's tenure. Student attendance has increased by more than 100 percent from Kruger's first season (2011-12). This year, OU student season tickets sold out in less than 24 hours the fastest rate in the OU era.

IT'S NOT WHERE YOU START...

For the first time since 2013, the Sooners will started the season unranked in both the AP and Coaches preseason polls. Oklahoma was also voted sixth in the Big 12 Conference's preseason poll – it's lowest preseason projection since 2012. Despite the preseason rankings. OU looks to continue an upward trend of surpassing expectations under Kruger.

▶ Oklahoma has finished as well or better than predicted in four of the five seasons under Kruger. In the only exception (2015-16), the Sooners were picked to finish second in the Big 12. While OU ended the 2015-16 regular season with the third best record in the Big 12, the Sooners advanced to the 2016 Final Four – the deepest

- ▶ The Sooners have also finished the past three seasons with a better ranking in the final AP and Coaches Polls compared to where each poll had pegged them at the start of the year.
- ▶ Prior to the 2016 AP preseason poll, the Sooners had received a Top-25 ranking for 36 consecutive weeks. Oklahoma has been ranked in the top 25 in 44 of the past 54 AP polls.

SOONER TIP-INS

▶ SWITCHING IT UP: After five games of using the same starting lineup, head coach Lon Kruger swapped Kristian Doolittle for Matt Freeman at the forward position. It was the first time since February of 2013 that Kruger has adjusted a starting lineup during the season. Dante Buford received the start at the forward position in OU's next two games (Dec. 7 vs. Oral Roberts and Dec. 10 vs. Wichita State) before reutrning to Doolittle. The Sooners have used five different lineups this season - the second-most starting lineup combinations during his six seasons at Oklahoma. Kruger sent out six different lineups during the 2012-13 campaign.

▶ **GETTING TO THE LINE:** After shooting 95-of-147 (.646) from the free throw line in the first six games of the season, Oklahomas has shot 87-of-110 (.791) in its last five outings. Jordan Woodard (.818) and Khadeem Lattin (.800) both rank in the Big 12's top five in free throw percentage.

▶ FROM DEEP: Coming off of a prolific season of 3-point shooting in 2015-16 that included hitting a program-record 382-of-906 (.422) shots from behind the arc, the Sooners are off to another hot start from deep. Oklahoma ranks 22nd nationally and third in the Big 12 in 3-point field goal percentage (.410), sinking an average of 7.7 treys per game. OU has been paced by Jordan Woodard (26 made 3-pointers) and Christian James (21 made 3-pointers). James is second in the Big 12 by shooting his 3-point attempts at a 55.6 percent clip while Woodard is second in the conference in 3-point makes with 2.6 per game.

▶ BULLDOGS BACK TOGETHER: Oklahoma's starting lineup in the first five games included freshman forward Kristian Doolittle, the first freshman to start for the Sooners since Jordan Woodard in the 2013-14 season. Doolittle finished his debut with five points and three rebounds in 19 minutes. Doolittle and Woodard played together for one season at Edmond Memorial High School (Edmond, Okla.), winning the Oklahoma 6A title. The duo is the first pair of former high school teammates to start in a game for the Sooners since Blake and Taylor Griffin (Oklahoma Christian School in Edmond, Okla.) in 2008-09.

KRUGER'S SOONER TURNAROUND

- ▶ Kruger has been leaving his trademark rebuilding stamp on college basketball programs throughout his career. He is the only Division I coach to ever take five different schools to the NCAA Tournament. In 2015 he became the first coach since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985 to take four programs to the Sweet 16 or beyond.
- ▶ After inheriting a program that went 27-36 (.429) in the two seasons prior to his arrival, Kruger has coached the Sooners to a 117-62 (.654) record in six seasons. Over the last four full campaigns, OU posted a 96-41 (.701) mark and advanced to the NCAA Tournament each season, capped by a trip to the 2016 Final Four in Houston. The Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.
- ▶ With a career college coaching record of 596-366 (.620), Kruger owns the 10th most wins among active Division I coaches. He owns a 20-17 record in NCAA Tournament games and has compiled 16 20-plus-win seasons, including nine in the last 10 years. His collegiate teams have made postseason appearances in 21 of the last 26 years.
- ▶ Under Kruger, Sooner players have earned First-Team All-Big 12 selections on three occasions and racked up 14 Academic All-Big 12 honors. Buddy Hield, who played four seasons for Kruger (2012-16), was named the winner of the 2016 Wooden Award, Naismith Trophy and the Oscar Robertson Trophy as the national player of the year (first consensus player of the year for OU since Blake Griffin in 2009).
- ▶ Three Sooners have been drafted into the NBA during Kruger's tenure. Buddy Hield was selected as the sixth overall pick in the 2016 NBA Draft while Isaiah Cousins (2016) and Romero Osby (2013) were chosen in the second round of their respected drafts.
