CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- The Big 12 will open conference play in December for the first time in league history when five teams tip off the league slate on Friday.
- Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 97-21 record during the 2016-17 campaign. Fourteen losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.
- Every team in the Big 12 has been ranked or received votes in the top 25 polls this season - including six squads this week alone.
- Big 12 teams boast a .822 winning percentage this season - the best record of any conference in the nation.
- Four of the five losses suffered by the five Big 12 teams with only one loss were by four points or less. Average margin of defeat is 5.2 points.
- The 21 combined losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 28 (Big East).
- The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.
- The Big 12 as a whole has won 133 of its last 165 and 146 of its last 181 non-conference contests overall.

BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

This week, two outstanding athletes are featured - one closing the chapter on his collegiate career and one who has just begun hers. For Oklahoma's Dylan Blankenbaker, choosing OU for his cross country career was the easy part. Balancing academics and cross country made him not only a stronger student, but a better person for life after college. Dora Gallo's soccer career with Kansas State may have just started, but the freshman midfielder has big plans for her time at school. Her goal is to walk across the stage at graduation and have not only her family members be proud, but use her success to inspire others. **BAYLOR (12-0, 0-0)**

- ✪ Baylor is one of six remaining unbeaten teams in Division I and its 12-0 start is tied for the third-best in program history. The Bears have won 43 consecutive non-conference home games, the second-best active streak in the nation (Duke).
- ✪ Junior forward Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. has recorded multiple blocked shots in 11 of 12 outings this year, including 30 in his past seven contests. He is already tied for 10th on the BU single-season blocks chart.
- ✪ Junior forward Johnathan Motley has scored in double digits in four of his last five games. He has grabbed at least six rebounds in every outing this season and has shot 50 percent or better from the field six times.

**IOWA STATE (8-3, 0-0)**

- ✪ Senior guard Matt Thomas finished with a career-high 23 points on a career-best nine field goals in the win over Mississippi Valley State. He is now tied for fifth in school history for career 3-point field goals made with 188 (Georges Niang).
- ✪ Senior guard Naz Mitrou-Long is 14-of-21 (.667) from beyond the arc over his last two contests. He is third in ISU history for 3-pointers (192) and has shot 50 percent or better from 3-point territory five times this year.
- ✪ Iowa State shot 57.1 percent overall versus MVSU, its second-best mark of the season and fourth time over 50 percent. The Cyclones have made at least eight 3-pointers in nine of 11 games in 2016-17.

**KANSAS (11-1, 0-0)**

- ✪ Freshman Josh Jackson led all scorers with 21 points at UNLV, while grabbing nine rebounds. He has scored in double figures in every game except the opener and has shot 56 percent or better in three of his last four outings.
- ✪ The Jayhawks held UNLV to 34.5 percent shooting – the second-lowest clip of the season by a KU opponent. Kansas has held seven foes below 40 percent from the field and has shot 50 percent or higher eight times.
- ✪ Senior guard Frank Mason has scored 18 points or more in 10 of 12 games this season. He has dished out 40 assists against just nine turnovers in his past six outings and has five or more assists 10 times in 2016-17.

**KANSAS STATE (11-1, 0-0)**

- ✪ Sophomore guard Kamau Stokes finished with a game-high 18 points in the win over Gardner-Webb. He has scored in double figures in two straight outings and three of his last four contests, with 29 assists in the past five games.
- ✪ The Wildcats' six-game winning streak is their longest since winning 10 straight games from Nov. 24, 2013 to January 7, 2014. K-State is 11-1 for the first time since posting the same record to begin the 2011-12 campaign.
- ✪ Senior forward D.J. Johnson was a perfect 8-of-8 from the field against Gardner-Webb and has shot 50 percent or better in eight of his past nine games. He is shooting 84.2 percent over the last two contests, with 17 rebounds.

**OKLAHOMA (6-5, 0-0)**

- ✪ Senior guard Jordan Woodard, who has led the Sooners in scoring six times this season, did not play versus Auburn due to a high leg injury. It ended a string of 115 consecutive games started – the second-longest active streak in the nation.
- ✪ After averaging 8.8 minutes and scoring a total of 24 points in the first nine games, freshman Jordan Shepherd has combined for 31 points in his last two outings. He is shooting 45.5 percent over the two contests, making all eight free throw attempts.
- ✪ Head coach Lon Kruger has used five different lineup combinations so far this year, the second-highest total during his six seasons at Oklahoma (6 in 2012-13). The Sooners used just one starting lineup during the entire 2015-16 campaign.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (10-2, 0-0)**

- ✪ Senior guard Phil Forte led OSU with 19 points versus Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. He made 5-of-10 shots from 3-point range, the most since his sophomore season, to move within 28 field goals from beyond the arc of the school career record.
- ✪ Junior Mitchell Solomon piled up nine offensive boards – just one off the school record – and a career-high 14 total rebounds against the Islanders. The 14 boards are tied for the fourth-most by an OSU player off the bench and most since 2010.
- ✪ The Cowboys have forced every opponent to commit at least 15 turnovers and have at least seven steals in every game. The last time Oklahoma State reached 10 wins faster than 12 games in was 2013-14, when it started the year 10-1.

**TCU (11-1, 0-0)**

- ✪ The 11-1 start by TCU matches the second-best in program history (1930-31) and only the 2014-15 squad (13-0) posted a better record to open a campaign. The Horned Frogs are 9-0 at home this year, averaging 82.7 points.
- ✪ Freshman guard Desmond Bane had a game-high 18 points to go along with seven rebounds versus Bradley. He has six double-digit scoring efforts this year and has shot 50 percent or better in four straight contests.
- ✪ Junior guard Kenrich Williams has grabbed at least six rebounds in all but one outing in 2016-17, including 10 or more six times. The six double-figure rebounding games are the most by any Big 12 player this season.

**TEXAS (6-6, 0-0)**

- ✪ Freshman forward Jarrett Allen recorded his fourth double-double of the year with 17 points and 10 boards against Kent State. He has scored in double digits seven times this season and shot 50 percent or better in six straight outings.
- ✪ Sophomore guard Kerwin Roach Jr. added 13 points in a career-high 32 minutes played versus the Flames. He has scored in double figures in two of his last three contests and is shooting 45.8 percent during the three-game span.
- ✪ Texas reached double digits in steals (10) for the second straight contest (11 vs. UAB) and third time this season. The Longhorns have forced their foes into double-figure turnovers in all but one game in 2016-17.

**TEXAS TECH (11-1, 0-0)**

- ✪ Senior forward Anthony Livingston led Tech in scoring for the third time this year with 19 points versus Longwood, adding a season-best six assists against just one turnover. He has had one turnover or less in all but one game in 2016-17.
- ✪ Texas Tech has shot 50 percent or better in five consecutive games and in nine of 12 contests this season. The Red Raiders have also outrebounded all but one opponent, including the last three by a combined +65 margin.
- ✪ The win at Richmond snapped a streak of seven straight non-conference road losses dating back to the 2011-12 campaign. The Red Raiders have won 28 straight non-conference home games, including 23 by 10-plus points.

**WEST VIRGINIA (11-1, 0-0)**

- ✪ Senior guard Tarik Phillip came off the bench to lead WVU with 16 points in 19 minutes in the win over Northern Kentucky. It was his second straight double digit scoring output after having two the entire season prior to that point.
- ✪ WVU forced 25 turnovers against the Highlanders, the 10th time in 12 games this season that its opponent has had at least 20 miscues. The Mountaineers lead the nation in turnover margin (+15.8) and turnovers forced (26.3 pg).
- ✪ With the win over UMKC, Bob Huggins became just the 10th coach in NCAA Division I history to win 800 career games. His current victory total ranks third among active coaches and he boasts 27 seasons with 20 wins or more to his credit.
