# **GAMEDAY STORYLINES**

- ▶ Head coach **Lon Kruger** has used five different starting lineups throughout the first 12 games of the 2016-17 season. In Oklahoma's past three games, Kruger has started freshman **Jordan Shepherd** at point guard. Shepherd entered his first start (Dec. 17 vs. Memphis) averaging just 2.7 points and 8.8 minutes in his first nine games and had seen just one minute of action in the previous contest, but responded to the shake-up by scoring a career-high 18 points in his first career start. The freshman followed up his debut with a team-high 13 points against Auburn on Dec. 21. Shepherd is averaging 11.0 points per game since joining the starting lineup.
- ▶ Sophomore guard **Rashard Odomes** has scored in double figures seven times this season and ranks third on the team with 9.7 points per game. Odomes has seen one of the largest role increases for Oklahoma this season. After averaging 1.9 points (35 total points) in just 6.1 minutes per game in 2015–16, he has already tripled his total points output with 116 on the season in 23.7 minutes per contest. Odomes saw action in only six Big 12 contests last season, totaling 16 minutes. He surpassed last season's Big 12 minute total in just one game this season, playing 18 minutes in OU's conference opener against Baylor.
- ▶ The young Sooners will look for continued production from its underclassmen. Freshmen and sophomores scored 72 percent of OU's points in the conference opener against Baylor while seven underclassmen saw at least 13 minutes of action in the contest. Seven of OU's top nine scorers are in their first two seasons of elligibility.

# **GAME OVERVIEW**

Oklahoma (6-6, 0-1 Big 12) welcomes in the new year by hitting the road for the first time during Big 12 play. The Sooners head south to Fort Worth, Texas, where TCU (11-2, 0-1 Big 12) is off to a hot start under first year head coach Jamie Dixon. The matchup with the Horned Frogs (receiving votes in both AP and Coaches polls) is the second game in a loaded five-game stretch to open Big 12 play. OU's first five opponents (No. 2/4 Baylor, TCU, Kansas State, No. 3/3 Kansas and Texas Tech) combine for a record of 59-6. The Big 12 road opener tips off at 8 p.m. CT and air on the Sooner Radio Network (KRXO 107.7 FM "The Franchise" in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** announcing. The game will be televised nationally on ESPNU with **Mitch Holthus** and **Bryndon Manzer** calling the action.

- ▶ The Sooners concluded the 2015-16 regular season with a 75-67 road win over TCU in Fort Worth.
- ▶ OU shot exactly 50.0 percent from both the field (23-46) and from beyond the 3-point arc (11-22). Oklahoma's defense held TCU to 43.1 percent shooting from the floor and 28.6 percent from downtown.
- ▶ Four Sooners Buddy Hield (21), Jordan Woodard (13), Ryan Spangler (11) and Isaiah Cousins (10) finished in double-figure scoring against the Horned Frogs.
- ▶ The game featured nine lead changes and two ties. OU's largest lead in the contest was 12, which came late in the second half (2:22).
- ▶ The win sealed OU as the third seed heading into the 2016 Big 12 Championship in Kansas City.
- ▶ Oklahome led by just one (31-30) at the half before outscoring the Horned Frogs, 44-37, in the second half.

- ▶ Oklahoma (6-6) fell to No. 4 Baylor (13-0), 76-50, on Friday at Lloyd Noble Center. OU dropped a Big 12 opener for just the second time in the Lon Kruger era. Oklahoma is now 4-2 in the first game of Big 12 competition under Kruger.
- ▶ With the loss, OU owns a 44-13 record against the Bears and is 8-5 against Baylor under Kruger.
- ▶ Junior forward Khadeem Lattin blocked three shots to move into fourth on OU's career blocks list. Tied in fourth on the all-time list with Johnnie Gilbert, Lattin's 132 career blocks joins Al Beal (230), Stacey King (228) and Wayman Tisdale (132) at the top of the Sooner leaderboard. Lattin's 2.0 block per game this season ranks fourth in the Big 12. The junior rounded out his night with eight points, five rebounds and one steal.
- ▶ Sophomore guard Christian James notched his 10th double-digit scoring performance of the season with 11 points on 4-of-7 shooting. James, who entered Friday's contest ranked second in the Big 12 for 3-point percentage, went 3-of-6 from behind the arc. The guard is shooting 24-of-47 (.511) from 3-point range this season.
- ▶ Sophomore guard Rashard Odomes pulled down a career-high-tying seven rebounds while scoring five points with two assists.
- ▶ The Sooner bench outscored Baylor's reserves, 24-22, behind nine points from freshman guard Kameron McGusty. Freshman forward Matt Freeman added seven points and a career-best four rebounds.
- ▶ Freshmen and sophomores scored 36 of OU's 50 points. Seven underclassmen saw at least 13 minutes of action.

# **NEXT UP: KANSAS STATE**

- ▶ Oklahoma and Kansas State will face off for the 204th time on Saturday, Jan. 7 in Manhattan, Kan. The 2 p.m. contest will air on ESPNews.
- ▶ The Sooners lead the all-time series 106-97 while the Wildcats own a 59-36 advantage over OU when playing in Manhattan. K-State has won the last four games against Oklahoma inside Bramlage Coliseum.
- ▶ Oklahoma head coach Lon Kruger played for Kansas State from 1970-74. He was named the Big Eight Player of the Year in 1973 and 1974. In 2003, Kruger was inducted into the Kansas State Hall of Fame. His number was retired at K-State in 2006.

# **NEW ROLES AND NEW FACES**

- ▶ After losing the senior trio of Isaiah Cousins, Buddy Hield and Ryan Spangler, the Sooners are looking to a roster that features 11 underclassmen (most of the Kruger era) to continue its development and growth as the season progresses.
- ▶ OU has benefited from a dramatic increase in scoring from quards **Christian James** and **Rashard Odomes**. After

averaging 2.9 points per game in 2015-16, James is the second leading scorer for the Sooners through nine games, scoring 12.3 points per game on .448 shooting from the field and .511 from 3-point range (second in Big 12). James is the only returning Big 12 player to average less than 3.0 points in 2015-16 and over 12.0 points in 2016-17.

- ▶ Tallying just 35 total points in 2015-16 (1.9 per game), Odomes has already tripled his total points output with 116 on the season (averaging 9.7 per game).
- ▶ Oklahoma has seen potential from all four of its scholarship freshmen as the youngest Sooners have combined to produce seven games of double-digit scoring most recently a 13-point showing from Jordan Shepherd in his second collegiate start (Dec. 21 vs. Auburn).

# **LATTIN BLOCK PARTY**

- ▶ Junior forward **Khadeem Lattin** has already proven himself as one of the top shot blockers in Oklahoma program history. After 83 career games for the Sooners, Lattin ranks fourth in the OU record book in career blocks with 132.
- ▶ Owning a 7-foot-2 wingspan, Lattin averaged a Big 12-best 2.1 blocks per game in 2015-16, including 2.7 rejections in conference

play. His efforts did not go unnoticed throughout the league, as he was voted to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team by conference coaches

- ▶ His 77 total blocks in 2015-16 ranked 17th in the nation and fifth among players at Power Five schools. The forward registered at least six blocks on five occasions, including a career-best eight blocked shots vs. Texas Tech on Jan. 26.
- Lattin is off to another solid start on the defensive end in 2016-17, registering 24 blocks in 12 games. His 2.0 blocks per game ranks third in the Big 12. He's also tallied 22 steals this season, compared to his total of 32 in 36 games last season. Lattin is one of two Big 12 players ranked in the conference's top 10 for both blocks and steals.
- ▶ On the offensive end. Lattin has seen much improved production. After averaging 5.6 points on .557 shooting in 2015-16. Lattin boasts a 2016-17 average of 9.0 points on a .500 field goal percentage.

# **KRUGER KEEPS BUILDING**

- ▶ Kruger's OU teams keep improving and have surpassed their win total from each subsequent season, with the 2015-16 squad finishing with a 29-8 record and making a trip to the Final Four. Before his arrival at OU, the Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.
- ▶ In five full seasons at Oklahoma, Kruger has produced four NCAA Tournament appearances, three top-three finishes in the Big 12, a national player of the year in Buddy Hield and a trip to the 2016 Final Four. Oklahoma was ranked in the top 10 of the AP Top 25 poll for every week of the 2015-16 season and made its first appearance as the poll's No. 1 team for the first time in more than 25 years.
- ▶ With 111 wins in his first five seasons at OU, Kruger owns the second most victories in the first five seasons of coaching the Sooners. Only Billy Tubbs accumulated more wins (115) in his first five years at OU. Kruger is the first coach in OU history to win six NCAA tournament games within his first five seasons.
- ▶ Boasting 596 career victories, Kruger ranks 10th in Division 1 wins among active coaches and 35th overall in NCAA Division I history.

# THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

It's known as the house Alvan Adams built and Wayman Tisdale filled. It's also where Billy Tubbs resurrected Oklahoma basketball, where Blake Griffin flew high and where Buddy Hield became Buddy Buckets. Now, Lon Kruger is continuing the remarkable run of Sooner success inside the Lloyd Noble Center.

- ▶ Oklahoma has gone 58-9 (.866) at Lloyd Noble Center in the past five years, including 32-4 (.889) in the last four seasons. Overall, the Sooners are 69-14 (.831) at the LNC in the Kruger era.
- ▶ The Sooners have won 437 of their last 505 encounters at Lloyd Noble Center, good for a remarkable .869 winning percentage. Included in the stretch was a school-record 51-game winning streak (ended in 1990-91). The Sooners also recorded a Big 12 Conference-record 37-game home court winning streak (ended in 2003).
- ▶ OU is 13-7 at home against AP Top 25 opponents in the Kruger era and has won 12 of the last 15 such contests.
- ▶ Oklahoma has won 126 of its last 132 non-conference games at LNC, including 60 of its last 63. The Sooners are 34-3 in Norman against non-conference opponents under Kruger.
- Overall, the Sooners own a 532-95 (.850) record in the LNC since the building opened in 1975.
- ▶ Student interest in OU basketball has continued to grow through Kruger's tenure. Student attendance has increased by more than 100 percent from Kruger's first season (2011-12). This year, OU student season tickets sold out in less than 24 hours - the fastest rate in the OU era.

# **WATCHING WOODARD**

▶ A 2015-16 All-Big 12 honorable mention selection, **Jordan Woodard** was the team's second-leading scorer last season with averages of 13.0 points (10th in Big 12), 3.4 assists (9th), 3.0 rebounds and 1.6 steals (5th) in 29.8 minutes. The Big 12 coaches voted Woodard a preseason All-Big 12 Honorable Mention selection ahead of the 2016-17 season.

- ▶ Woodard has seen remarkable development from season to season particularly from behind the 3-point arc. After shooting 17-for-67 (.254) from 3-point range in 2014-15, Woodard sunk 80 treys on 176 attempts (.455) his junior year to finish second in the Big 12 in 3-point shooting.
- ▶ With three-plus seasons of experience in the Sooner starting lineup under his belt, Woodard has already made a dent in the OU record book. Sitting on 1,324 points at OU, Woodard recently became just the 21st Sooner to score over 1,300 points in a career. He surpassed both Blake Griffin (1,278) and Cameron Clark (1,284) in OU's all-time scoring rankings, moving up to No. 21 on the list. He also ranks in the top 10 of four statistical categories in the OU record book (free throws, free throw percentage, assists, steals).
- ▶ With 410 made foul shots and a career free throw percentage of .807, Woodard is just the seventh Sooner to ever sink 400 career free throws. No Sooner has ever finished his collegiate career with over 400 made free throws at a rate of over .800.

# **SOONER TIP-INS**

▶ SWITCHING IT UP: After five games of using the same starting lineup, head coach Lon Kruger swapped Kristian Doolittle for Matt Freeman at the forward position. It was the first time since February of 2013 that Kruger has adjusted a starting lineup during the season. Dante Buford received the start at the forward position in OU's next two games (Dec. 7 vs. Oral Roberts and Dec. 10 vs. Wichita State) before reutrning to Doolittle. The Sooners have used five different lineups this season - the second-most starting lineup combinations during his six seasons at Oklahoma. Kruger sent out six different lineups during the 2012-13 campaign.

- ▶ **GETTING TO THE LINE:** After shooting 95-of-147 (.646) from the free throw line in the first six games of the season, Oklahomas has shot 87-of-110 (.791) in its last five outings. Jordan Woodard (.818) and Khadeem Lattin (.810) both rank in the Big 12's top five in free throw percentage.
- ▶ FROM DEEP: Coming off of a prolific season of 3-point shooting in 2015-16 that included hitting a program-record 382-of-906 (.422) shots from behind the arc, the Sooners are off to another hot start from deep. Oklahoma ranks 22nd nationally and third in the Big 12 in 3-point field goal percentage (.410), sinking an average of 7.7 treys per game. OU has been paced by Jordan Woodard (26 made 3-pointers) and Christian James (21 made 3-pointers). James is second in the Big 12 by shooting his 3-point attempts at a 55.6 percent clip while Woodard is second in the conference in 3-point makes with 2.6 per game.
- ▶ BULLDOGS BACK TOGETHER: Oklahoma's starting lineup in the first five games included freshman forward Kristian Doolittle, the first freshman to start for the Sooners since Jordan Woodard in the 2013-14 season. Doolittle finished his debut with five points and three rebounds in 19 minutes. Doolittle and Woodard played together for one season at Edmond Memorial High School (Edmond, Okla.), winning the Oklahoma 6A title. The duo is the first pair of former high school teammates to start in a game for the Sooners since Blake and Taylor Griffin (Oklahoma Christian School in Edmond, Okla.) in 2008-09.

# **KRUGER'S SOONER TURNAROUND**

- ▶ Kruger has been leaving his trademark rebuilding stamp on college basketball programs throughout his career. He is the only Division I coach to ever take five different schools to the NCAA Tournament. In 2015 he became the first coach since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985 to take four programs to the Sweet 16 or beyond.
- After inheriting a program that went 27-36 (.429) in the two seasons prior to his arrival, Kruger has coached the Sooners to a 117-63 (.650) record in six seasons. Over the last four full campaigns, OU posted a 96-41 (.701) mark and advanced to the NCAA Tournament each season, capped by a trip to the 2016 Final Four in Houston. The Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.
- ▶ With a career college coaching record of 596-367 (.619), Kruger owns the 10th most wins among active Division I coaches. He owns a 20-17 record in NCAA Tournament games and has compiled 16 20-plus-win seasons, including nine in the last 10 years. His collegiate teams have made postseason appearances in 21 of the last 26 years.
- ▶ Under Kruger, Sooner players have earned First-Team All-Big 12 selections on three occasions and racked up 14 Academic All-Big 12 honors. Buddy Hield, who played four seasons for Kruger (2012-16), was named the winner of the 2016 Wooden Award, Naismith Trophy and the Oscar Robertson Trophy as the national player of the year (first consensus player of the year for OU since Blake Griffin in 2009).
- ▶ Three Sooners have been drafted into the NBA during Kruger's tenure. Buddy Hield was selected as the sixth overall pick in the 2016 NBA Draft while Isaiah Cousins (2016) and Romero Osby (2013) were chosen in the second round of their respected drafts.




