GAMEDAY STORYLINES

► One of the youngest teams in both the Big 12 and the nation, Oklahoma has seen its freshmen and sophomores play a large role for the Sooners this season. The Sooner roster boasts 11 underclassmen (freshmen and sophomores) – the most of any OU team in the **Lon Kruger** era and the most of any Big 12 roster this season. The young Sooners have received ample experience through their first two Big 12 contests. OU freshmen have played a total of 176 minutes (most in Big 12) and have scored 43.9 percent of OU's points in Big 12 play. Sooner underclassmen rank second in the Big 12 in total minutes played in conference competition (318) and have scored 72.0 percent of Oklahoma's points the past two games.

► Through two conference games, the Sooners' top three scorers have been newcomers off the bench. Freshman guard **Kameron McGusty** has averaged a team-best 10.0 points over the past two games while redshirt freshman forward **Matt Freeman** has shot 3-of-6 from 3-point range to average 8.5 points. JUCO transfer junior guard **Darrion Strong-Moore** has averaged 8.0 points since the start of conference play. The Sooner bench has averaged 29.5 points the past two games. Overall this season, the Oklahoma bench has outscored the opposing bench in 10 of OU's 13 games.

GAME OVERVIEW

Oklahoma (6-7, 0-2 Big 12) head to the Little Apple of Manhattan, Kan., in search of its first win inside Bramlage Coliseum since 2012. Both the Sooners and Kansas State (12-2, 1-1 Big 12) are coming off of close road losses this past weekend. Oklahoma fell to TCU, 60-57, in Fort Worth while the Wildcats lost on a last second bucket, 90-88, to Kansas at Allen Fieldhouse. Saturday's meeting with K-State is the third game in a loaded five-game stretch to open Big 12 play. OU's first five opponents (No. 2/4 Baylor, TCU, Kansas State, No. 3/2 Kansas and Texas Tech) combine for a record of 63-7. Saturday's game tips off at 2 p.m. CT and airs on the Sooner Radio Network (KR XO 107.7 FM "The Franchise" in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** announcing. The game will be televised nationally on ESPNEWS with **Mitch Holthus** and **Bryndon Manzer** calling the action.

- Led by Wesley Iwundu and Dean Wade, the Wildcats overcame a slow start to each half and beat the Sooners 80-69.
- Buddy Hield led OU in scoring with 23 points (7 of 16 FG, 3 of 8 3FG, 6 of 6 FT). It marked Hield's 30th straight game scoring at least 10 points..
- Ryan Spangler earned his 10th double-double of the season with 14 points and a game-high 10 rebounds. Also in double-figure scoring for the Sooners was Isaiah Cousins with 16.
- Jordan Woodard registered team-highs of six assists and four steals
- The Sooners shot 6 of 24 (.250) from downtown (season low).

► Oklahoma (6-7, 0-2 Big 12) suffered its first road conference loss of the season to TCU (12-2, 1-1 Big 12) on Tuesday. With the 60-57 loss, the Sooners are now 18-3 all-time against the Horned Frogs, including 8-2 in Fort Worth.

► The Sooners led for over 35 minutes in their second true road game of the year, but the Horned Frogs used a 12-0 run late in the contest to come back and win.

► For the second time this season, three Sooner reserves scored in double figures. Freshman guard Kameron McGusty led Oklahoma's scoring efforts with 11 points, three rebounds, three assists and four steals. Junior guard Darrion Strong-Moore and freshman forward Matt Freeman produced 10 points each on a combined 8-of-14 shooting.

► Strong-Moore's 10 points on 4-of-8 shooting marked a career high and the first double-digit scoring performance at OU. The Sooners' five scholarship newcomers have all scored in double digits at least once this season.

► Oklahoma's reserves scored 35 points. The Sooners scored 25 bench points in the first half - its most in an opening half this season.

► The Sooners pulled down 12 offensive boards and scored a season-high-tying 17 second chance points.

► OU forced 16 TCU turnovers, including 10 off of steals. The Sooners have forced 15 or more opponent miscues in eight games this season and have forced more turnovers than they surrendered in all but three games.

► Of Oklahoma's 57 points, 41 came from freshmen and sophomores. The freshmen trio of Kristian Doolittle, Freeman and McGusty combined for 29 points. Eight players in their first two seasons at OU totaled 51 points on the evening.

► The Sooner defense limited TCU to 1-of-12 shooting to start the night.

NEXT UP: KANSAS

► Oklahoma and Kansas will face off for the 211th time on Tuesday, Jan. 10 at 8 p.m. CT inside Lloyd Noble Center in Norman, Okla. The 210 previous meetings between the two programs mark the second most contests against any opponent in Oklahoma history. The Sooners have only faced Oklahoma State (231 games) more times than the Jayhawks.

► Kansas leads the overall series, 144-66. The Jayhawks are the only Big 12 team to own a winning record all-time against the Sooners. KU leads the series in Norman, 49-42.

► The Jayhawks swept the Sooners last season in two closely-contested matchups that included a triple-overtime thriller at Allen Fieldhouse. Buddy Hield scored 46 points in the 109-106 loss and shot 8-of-15 from 3-point range.

NEW ROLES AND NEW FACES

► After losing the senior trio of Isaiah Cousins, Buddy Hield and Ryan Spangler, the Sooners are looking to a roster that features 11 underclassmen (most of the Kruger era) to continue its development and growth as the season progresses.

► OU has benefited from a dramatic increase in scoring from guards **Christian James** and **Rashard Odomes**. After averaging 2.9 points per game in 2015-16, James is the second leading scorer for the Sooners through nine games, scoring 11.5 points per game on .421 shooting from the field and .480 from 3-point range (third in Big 12). James is the only returning Big 12 player to average less than 3.0 points in 2015-16 and over 12.0 points in 2016-17.

► Tallying just 35 total points in 2015-16 (1.9 per game), Odomes has already tripled his total points output with 121 on the season (averaging 9.3 per game).

► Oklahoma has seen potential from all four of its scholarship freshmen as the youngest Sooners have combined to produce nine games of double-digit scoring - most recently an 11-point showing from Kameron McGusty against TCU (Jan. 3).

LATTIN BLOCK PARTY

► Junior forward **Khadeem Lattin** has already proven himself as one of the top shot blockers in Oklahoma program history. After 84 career games for the Sooners, Lattin ranks fourth in the OU record book in career blocks with 134.

► Owning a 7-foot-2 wingspan, Lattin averaged a Big 12-best 2.1 blocks per game in 2015-16, including 2.7 rejections in conference play. His efforts did not go unnoticed throughout the league, as he was voted to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team by conference coaches.

► His 77 total blocks in 2015-16 ranked 17th in the nation and fifth among players at Power Five schools. The forward registered at least six blocks on five occasions, including a career-best eight blocked shots vs. Texas Tech on Jan. 26.

► Lattin is off to another solid start on the defensive end in 2016-17, registering 26 blocks in 14 games. His 2.0 blocks per game ranks third in the Big 12. He's also tallied 23 steals this season, compared to his total of 32 in 36 games last season. Lattin is the only Big 12 players ranked in the conference's top six for both blocks and steals.

► On the offensive end, Lattin has seen much improved production. After averaging 5.6 points on .557 shooting in 2015-16, Lattin boasts a 2016-17 average of 8.8 points on a .519 field goal percentage.

KRUGER KEEPS BUILDING

Lon Kruger has made his mark in college basketball as one of – if not the best – program rebuilders. Want proof? Look no further than what he's done with Oklahoma.

► In the two seasons before his hiring, the Sooners went 27-36 (.429) – capped by a 10th-place finish in the Big 12 in 2010-11. Since being brought on in 2011, Kruger has led the program to a 117-64 (.646) record, including a 102-48 (.680) mark over the past five seasons.

► Kruger's OU teams keep improving and have surpassed their win total from each subsequent season, with the 2015-16 squad finishing with a 29-8 record and making a trip to the Final Four. Before his arrival at OU, the Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.

► In five full seasons at Oklahoma, Kruger has produced four NCAA Tournament appearances, three top-three finishes in the Big 12, a national player of the year in Buddy Hield and a trip to the 2016 Final Four. Oklahoma was ranked in the top 10 of the AP Top 25 poll for every week of the 2015-16 season and made its first appearance as the poll's No. 1 team for the first time in more than 25 years.

► With 111 wins in his first five seasons at OU, Kruger owns the second most victories in the first five seasons of coaching the Sooners. Only Billy Tubbs accumulated more wins (115) in his first five years at OU. Kruger is the first coach in OU history to win six NCAA tournament games within his first five seasons.

► Boasting 596 career victories, Kruger ranks 10th in Division 1 wins among active coaches and 35th overall in NCAA Division I history.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

It's known as the house Alvan Adams built and Wayman Tisdale filled. It's also where Billy Tubbs resurrected Oklahoma basketball, where Blake Griffin flew high and where Buddy Hield became Buddy Buckets. Now, Lon Kruger is continuing the remarkable run of Sooner success inside the Lloyd Noble Center.

► Oklahoma has gone 58-9 (.866) at Lloyd Noble Center in the past five years, including 32-4 (.889) in the last four seasons. Overall, the Sooners are 69-14 (.831) at the LNC in the Kruger era.

► The Sooners have won 437 of their last 505 encounters at Lloyd Noble Center, good for a remarkable .869 winning percentage. Included in the stretch was a school-record 51-game winning streak (ended in 1990-91). The Sooners also recorded a Big 12 Conference-record 37-game home court winning streak (ended in 2003).

► OU is 13-7 at home against AP Top 25 opponents in the Kruger era and has won 12 of the last 15 such contests.

► Oklahoma has won 126 of its last 132 non-conference games at LNC, including 60 of its last 63. The Sooners are 34-3 in Norman against non-conference opponents under Kruger.

► Overall, the Sooners own a 532-95 (.850) record in the LNC since the building opened in 1975.

► Student interest in OU basketball has continued to grow through Kruger's tenure. Student attendance has increased by more than 100 percent from Kruger's first season (2011-12). This year, OU student season tickets sold out in less than 24 hours – the fastest rate in the OU era.

WATCHING WOODARD

► A 2015-16 All-Big 12 honorable mention selection, **Jordan Woodard** was the team's second-leading scorer last season with averages of 13.0 points (10th in Big 12), 3.4 assists (9th), 3.0 rebounds and 1.6 steals (5th) in 29.8 minutes. The Big 12 coaches voted Woodard a preseason All-Big 12 Honorable Mention selection ahead of the 2016-17 season.

► Woodard has seen remarkable development from season to season – particularly from behind the 3-point arc. After shooting 17-for-67 (.254) from 3-point range in 2014-15, Woodard sunk 80 treys on 176 attempts (.455) his junior year to finish second in the Big 12 in 3-point shooting.

► With three-plus seasons of experience in the Sooner starting lineup under his belt, Woodard has already made a dent in the OU record book. Sitting on 1,324 points at OU, Woodard recently became just the 21st Sooner to score over 1,300 points in a career. He surpassed both Blake Griffin (1,278) and Cameron Clark (1,284) in OU's all-time scoring rankings, moving up to No. 21 on the list. He also ranks in the top 10 of four statistical categories in the OU record book (free throws, free throw percentage, assists, steals).

► With 410 made foul shots and a career free throw percentage of .807, Woodard is just the seventh Sooner to ever sink 400 career free throws. No Sooner has ever finished his collegiate career with over 400 made free throws at a rate of over .800.

SOONER TIP-INS

► **SWITCHING IT UP:** After five games of using the same starting lineup, head coach **Lon Kruger** swapped **Kristian Doolittle** for **Matt Freeman** at the forward position. It was the first time since February of 2013 that Kruger has adjusted a starting lineup during the season. **Dante Buford** received the start at the forward position in OU's next two games (Dec. 7 vs. Oral Roberts and Dec. 10 vs. Wichita State) before reuniting to Doolittle. The Sooners have used five different lineups this season - the second-most starting lineup combinations during his six seasons at Oklahoma. Kruger sent out six different lineups during the 2012-13 campaign.

► **ALMOST THERE:** The Sooners look to snap a five-game losing streak and return to a .500 winning percentage on Saturday against Kansas State. Despite losing seven games this season, the Sooners have found themselves with a chance to win in almost every contest this year. Oklahoma has led at halftime in five of its seven losses and has led at the half in both true road games this season (at Wisconsin on Dec. 3 and at TCU on Jan. 3). Five of OU's seven losses have been decided by six points or less.

► **FROM DEEP:** Coming off of a prolific season of 3-point shooting in 2015-16 that included hitting a program-record 382-of-906 (.422) shots from behind the arc, the Sooners are off to another hot start from deep. Oklahoma ranks third in the Big 12 in 3-point field goal percentage (.390), sinking an average of 7.5 treys per game. OU has been paced by **Jordan Woodard** (26 made 3-pointers) and **Christian James** (24 made 3-pointers). James is third in the Big 12 by shooting his 3-point attempts at a 48.0 percent clip while Woodard is second in the conference in 3-point makes with 2.6 per game.

► **GETTING DEFENSIVE:** The Sooners have won or tied the turnover margin in 10 of its 13 games this season. Oklahoma is averaging 8.2 steals per game (31st in NCAA) and forcing 15.5 turnovers a contest (56th in NCAA). The Sooners are blocking 5.1 shots per contest (43rd in NCAA).

► **BULLDOGS BACK TOGETHER:** Oklahoma's starting lineup in the first five games included freshman forward **Kristian Doolittle**, the first freshman to start for the Sooners since **Jordan Woodard** in the 2013-14 season. Doolittle finished his debut with five points and three rebounds in 19 minutes. Doolittle and Woodard played together for one season at Edmond Memorial High School (Edmond, Okla.), winning the Oklahoma 6A title. The duo is the first pair of former high school teammates to start in a game for the Sooners since **Blake and Taylor Griffin** (Oklahoma Christian School in Edmond, Okla.) in 2008-09.

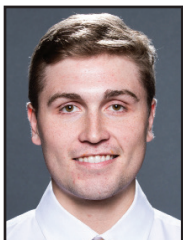

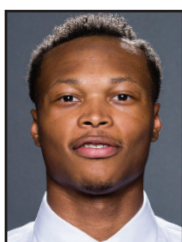

KRUGER'S SOONER TURNAROUND

► Kruger has been leaving his trademark rebuilding stamp on college basketball programs throughout his career. He is the only Division I coach to ever take five different schools to the NCAA Tournament. In 2015 he became the first coach since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985 to take four programs to the Sweet 16 or beyond.

► After inheriting a program that went 27-36 (.429) in the two seasons prior to his arrival, Kruger has coached the Sooners to a 117-64 (.646) record in six seasons. Over the last four full campaigns, OU posted a 96-41 (.701) mark and advanced to the NCAA Tournament each season, capped by a trip to the 2016 Final Four in Houston. The Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.

► With a career college coaching record of 596-368 (.619), Kruger owns the 10th most wins among active Division I coaches. He owns a 20-17 record in NCAA Tournament games and has compiled 16 20-plus-win seasons, including nine in the last 10 years. His collegiate teams have made postseason appearances in 21 of the last 26 years.

► Under Kruger, Sooner players have earned First-Team All-Big 12 selections on three occasions and racked up 14 Academic All-Big 12 honors. Buddy Hield, who played four seasons for Kruger (2012-16), was named the winner of the 2016 Wooden Award, Naismith Trophy and the Oscar Robertson Trophy as the national player of the year (first consensus player of the year for OU since Blake Griffin in 2009).

► Three Sooners have been drafted into the NBA during Kruger's tenure. Buddy Hield was selected as the sixth overall pick in the 2016 NBA Draft while Isaiah Cousins (2016) and Romero Osby (2013) were chosen in the second round of their respected drafts.
