CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

✎ The five games played this week have been decided by a combined total of 11 points - an average margin of victory of 2.2 points.

✎ The Big 12 is the only conference in the nation with three teams among the top seven of the national polls.

✎ Every team in the Big 12 has been ranked or received votes in the top 25 polls this season - including six squads this week alone.

✎ The Big 12 has posted a .600 win percentage versus the ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC - tied (Big East) for the best percentage of any conference among that group.

✎ The Big 12 has won over 61 percent of its games versus the conferences listed above - the best two-year stretch in Big 12 history.

✎ Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 97-21 non-conference record during 2016-17. Fourteen losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.

✎ Big 12 teams boasts a .822 non-conference winning percentage this season - the best of any league in the nation.

✎ The current non-conference win percentage of .822 would rank as the 14th-best in NCAA history.

✎ Four of the five non-conference losses suffered by the five Big 12 teams with only one loss were by four points or less (average margin, 5.2 points).

✎ The 21 combined non-league losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 28 (Big East).

✎ The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.

✎ Big 12 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among active conferences with a .610 mark.

✎ Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament during their respective careers.

✎ Seven coaches have career win percentages of .700 or better and the group of all 10 coaches boasts more than 3,600 career victories.

BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

The Big 12 Champions for Life initiative showcases the success stories of student-athletes and how an athletic scholarship has positively impacted their lives. This week showcases Nina Davis (Baylor women's basketball) and Will Licon (Texas swimming & diving). Davis used the rejection she received as a top high school player to fuel her drive to succeed on the court, while taking full advantage of the academic experience of college. Licon's personality blossomed because of the confidence he gained from his success in the pool while swimming for UT. His scholarship afforded him the opportunity for that growth, as well as providing the resources in achieving a successful academic career. **BAYLOR (14-0, 2-0)**

- ✎ Baylor is one of the final two remaining unbeaten (Gonzaga) in the nation for the first time in school history. The Bears' 14-0 start is tied for the sixth-best undefeated opening in the Big 12 since the league began play in 1996-97.
- ✎ BU has posted its second-best start and the second-longest winning streak in program history, behind only a 17-0 string to open the 2011-12 campaign. The Bears have 139 overall wins since the '11-12 season, the second-most in the Big 12 (Kansas).
- ✎ Junior forward Johnathan Motley has had a double-double in each of his last three outings. He is averaging 17.3 points and 11.3 rebounds over the past four contests, while shooting 59.2 percent from the floor.

**IOWA STATE (9-4, 1-1)**

- ✎ Senior guard Nazareth Mitrou-Long has led the Cyclones in scoring three times in the past four games after finishing with 17 points at Baylor. He is averaging 23.0 points over the four-game span, shooting 64.7 percent from the field.
- ✎ Senior guard Monté Morris has increased his career scoring total to 1,320 points, moving past Jeff Hornacek for 19th on the all-time ISU list. Morris has 19 assists with just two turnovers over the past four outings.
- ✎ Iowa State has committed fewer turnovers than its opponent in 12 of 13 games this season and matched its season-low with only five at Baylor. The Cyclones have single-digit miscues in three of their last four contests.

**KANSAS (13-1, 2-0)**

- ✎ Kansas has won 50 consecutive home games, including 47 inside Allen Fieldhouse. The streak is the longest active home string in the nation and the Jayhawks have also played in front of 250 straight sold out crowds at Allen Fieldhouse.
- ✎ Senior center Landen Lucas finished with 18 points and 12 rebounds in 28 minutes versus K-State, surpassing the 500-rebound mark (503) for his career. He has combined for 37 points and 41 boards in the past three outings.
- ✎ Junior guard Sviatoslav Mykhailiuk has scored in double figures in eight straight contests, including 14.0 points per game over his last four outings - all starts. He has made at least one 3-pointer in 13 of 14 games this year.

**KANSAS STATE (12-2, 1-1)**

- ✎ K-State scored its most points (88) inside Allen Fieldhouse since February 7, 1962 and its 50.8 percent shooting mark was a season-high by a KU opponent. The Wildcats have shot 50 percent or better six times in 2016-17.
- ✎ Sophomore forward Dean Wade led five players in double digits with 20 points on 6-of-12 shooting. He has scored in double digits in six of his last seven outings and has 38 points on 13-of-22 (.591) shooting in the past two games.
- ✎ Kansas State has posted at least 14 points off turnovers in each of its first 14 contests. The Wildcats have recorded double-digit steals in each of their last two outings and five times overall this season.

**OKLAHOMA (6-7, 0-2)**

- ✎ For the second time this season, three Sooner reserves scored in double figures, led by freshman Kameron McGusty with 11 points at TCU. It was his third double-digit scoring output of the year as he matched his season-high with 27 minutes played.
- ✎ Junior forward Khadeem Lattin has five blocked shots in his last two outings and has recorded multiple rejections in a game nine times in 2016-17. He has moved into fourth on the OU career blocks chart with 134.
- ✎ Freshman and sophomores scored 41 of the Sooners' 57 points at TCU, including 29 from freshmen. Eight players in their first two seasons at OU contributed 51 of the 57 points versus the Horned Frogs.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (10-4, 0-2)**

- ✎ Junior Jeffrey Carroll scored a career-high 24 points at Texas, his fifth 20-point outing of the season. He is averaging 17.2 points over the last five games, with 27 rebounds and a .554 shooting percentage.
- ✎ Senior guard Phil Forte saw his consecutive free throws made streak end at 25, but still finished 3-of-4 from the line versus UT. He has missed just two from the charity stripe this year and leads the nation in free throw percentage (.959).
- ✎ OSU has scored at least 92 points in every home game this year, topping the 100-point mark five times. The Cowboys are ranked fourth nationally in scoring (91.9 ppg) and are also in the top 10 for free throws, steals and offensive rebounds.

**TCU (12-2, 1-1)**

- ✎ TCU has matched the third-best starts in program history, trailing only the 1951-52 (13-1) and 2014-15 (13-1) squads. The Horned Frogs recorded their earliest conference victory in five seasons in the Big 12 with the win over Oklahoma.
- ✎ Junior guard Alex Robinson led the Frogs with 18 points and six assists versus OU, his ninth time in double figures this season. He has dished out at least four assists in 13 consecutive games, including 10 against four turnovers in the past two outings.
- ✎ Junior Kenrich Williams is tied for the league lead with five double-doubles this season. He has had 10 or more boards in five of the last eight games and his 18 rebounds at UNLV are the most by any Big 12 player this season.

**TEXAS (7-7, 1-1)**

- ✎ Sophomore Tevin Mack recorded a career-high 27 points against Oklahoma State, finishing 10-of-17 (.588) from the floor. It was more points than his previous two games combined as he shot 50 percent or better for the fifth time in 2016-17.
- ✎ Freshman forward Jarrett Allen has posted double-digit rebounding totals six times in 14 games after grabbing 11 boards versus OSU. He has also shot 50 percent or better in seven of his last eight outings.
- ✎ Texas recorded a 37-32 rebounding edge versus the Cowboys. The Longhorns have outrebounded six of their last eight opponents after having done so just twice in the first six games of 2016-17.

**TEXAS TECH (12-2, 1-1)**

- ✎ Texas Tech has four wins its last six games versus nationally-ranked opponents after the win over West Virginia, including three straight in Lubbock. The Red Raiders have won 15 straight games at United Supermarkets Arena dating back to last year.
- ✎ Junior forward Zach Smith led four Tech players in double figures with 15 points and seven rebounds against WVU. He is averaging 10.8 rebounds over his last four contests and has six double-figure rebounding efforts in 2016-17.
- ✎ Junior guard Niem Stevenson had 13 points off the bench versus the Mountaineers, matching his scoring total from the previous three games combined. He also grabbed a season-best eight rebounds after totaling five in the prior three outings.

**WEST VIRGINIA (12-2, 1-1)**

- ✎ Sophomore forward Esa Ahmad led the Mountaineers in scoring for the sixth time this season with 13 points at Texas Tech. He has finished in double digits in 10 games and is shooting 70.6 percent over the past five outings.
- ✎ Junior guard Jevon Carter has dished out 12 assists against just two turnovers over his last two contests and 21 assists with only four turnovers in the past four games. He has eight outings with one miscue or less in 2016-17.
- ✎ All but two Mountaineer opponents have had at least 19 turnovers this year, including three with more than 30. West Virginia leads the nation in scoring margin (+29.9) steals (13.1 spg), turnover margin (+14.0) and turnovers forced (24.8 pg).

Phillips 66 Weekly Awards

A Big 12 Player and Newcomer of the Week will be chosen each Monday, beginning November 16. Nominations are submitted by the school communications offices and winners are selected by a panel of media voters who cover the league on a regular basis. This year marks the 21st year for Phillips 66 as a sponsor of the Big 12 Conference.

Postseason Awards

The Big 12 presents the only official all-conference awards at the end of the regular season. Major award winners are chosen, along with the All-Big 12 teams. Each Big 12 head coach votes on the squads and is not permitted to vote for his own players. The awards will be announced in March prior to the Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's Basketball Championship. Academic All-Big 12 teams are also chosen in men's basketball and will be announced prior to the postseason.
