GAMEDAY STORYLINES

► One of the youngest teams in both the Big 12 and the nation, Oklahoma has seen its freshmen and sophomores play a large role for the Sooners this season. The Sooner roster boasts 11 underclassmen (freshmen and sophomores) – the most of any OU team in the Lon Kruger era and the most of any Big 12 roster this season. The young Sooners have received ample experience through their first four Big 12 contests. OU freshmen have played a total of 327 minutes (second most in Big 12), averaging a combined 25.0 points per game, contributing 41.7 percent of OU's scoring in Big 12 play – the highest percentage in the conference. Sooner underclassmen rank second in the Big 12 in total minutes played in conference competition (605) and have scored 75.8 percent of Oklahoma's points the past four games (second in Big 12).

► OU continues to show its depth in conference play, most recently outscoring No. 2/2 Kansas in bench points, 29-5. Through four Big 12 games, Oklahoma boasts a conference-best 29.3 bench points per game in league competition. The Sooners are one of only four Big 12 squads to average over 20 bench points in league games as the conference averages 17.2 per contest. The Sooners boast a Big 12-leading eight players averaging five or more points in conference play.

GAME OVERVIEW

Oklahoma (6-9, 0-4 Big 12) hosts its second game at Lloyd Noble Center in five days when it hosts Texas Tech (13-3, 2-2 Big 12) for a Saturday night conference showdown. The Sooners will look for continued production out freshman Kameron McGusty, who is leading the team in scoring during Big 12 play with 13.3 points per game. Senior Jordan Woodard returned to action against Kansas on Jan. 10 and is expected to see an increase of minutes against the Red Raiders. Tech enters Saturday coming off a narrow win over No. 25 Kansas State. Saturday's contest tips off at 7:30 p.m. CT and air on the Sooner Radio Network (KRXO 107.7 FM "The Franchise" in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** announcing. The game will be televised nationally on ESPNU with **Jason Benetti** and **Reid Gettys** calling the action.

- ▶ Three Sooners scored in double figures on the night, led by junior Jordan Woodard with a game-high 25. Buddy Hield added 16 while Isaiah Cousins chipped in 10.
- ▶ Woodard's 25 points lifted him past 1,000 career points, becoming the 44th Sooner to score 1,000 points in a career at Oklahoma.
- ▶ Woodard shot 7-of-14 from the field and 3-of-7 from 3-point range in his 34 minutes of action.
- ▶ Isaiah Cousins recorded six rebounds on the night.
- ▶ Tech's Keenan Evans hit three free throws in the final 30 seconds to seal it for the Red Raiders.
- ▶ The game was tied 14 times and there were 15 lead changes.

► Oklahoma (6-9, 0-4 Big 12) came up short to No. 2/2 Kansas (15-1, 40 Big 12), 81-70, on Tuesday at Lloyd Noble Center. The Jayhawks improved to 145-66 in the all-time series against the Sooners and are the only Big 12 team to own a winning record over Oklahoma.

► For the third-straight game, freshman guard Kameron McGusty led the Sooners in scoring by notching double-figure scoring. McGusty, making his first collegiate start, totaled 13 points in a career-high-tying 30 minutes.

► Sophomore guard Rashard Odomes also tallied 13 points – good for his ninth game in double figures this season. Odomes shot 6-of-10 from the field and added three rebounds and a pair of steals.

► The Sooners faced a 21-12 deficit midway through the first half before closing the first half on a 22-6 run in the final 9:05. Oklahoma led Kansas, 36-27, at the break – the Jayhawks' largest halftime deficit of the season. OU has led at halftime in 11 of its 15 games this season.

► Sophomore guard Christian James led the bench with nine points on 3-of-5 shooting to go with five boards.

► Oklahoma pulled down 15 offensive boards, including 11 in the first half – the most of any half this season. Junior forward Khadeem Lattin led OU's rebounding efforts with 11 boards to go with eight points and a season-high-tying five blocks. The outing was Lattin's second game of double-digit rebounding this season.

► Senior guard Jordan Woodard returned to action after missing four games, producing seven points, five rebounds, five assists and a pair of steals in 24 minutes off the bench.

► OU outscored the Jayhawks, 38-28, in the paint. Sophomore center Jamuni McNeace totaled eight points on 4-of-6 shooting with seven rebounds.

NEXT UP: WEST VIRGINIA

► The Sooners are back on the road Wednesday against No. 10/9 West Virginia at 6 p.m. CT on ESPN2. The matchup with the 14-2 Mountaineers will be Oklahoma's third game against a current top-10 team in a six-game stretch.

► Oklahoma leads the all-time series, 8-4, and is 2-2 against WVU in Morgantown.

► The Sooners swept the regular season series against WVU last year, winning 70-68 in Norman and 76-62 in Morgantown. The Mountaineers ended OU's Big 12 Championship run by winning 69-67 in the semifinals in Kansas City.

NEW ROLES AND NEW FACES

► After losing the senior trio of Isaiah Cousins, Buddy Hield and Ryan Spangler, the Sooners are looking to a roster that features 11 underclassmen (most of the Kruger era) to continue its development and growth as the season progresses.

► OU has benefited from a dramatic increase in scoring from guards **Christian James** and **Rashard Odomes**. After averaging 2.9 points per game in 2015-16, James is the second leading scorer for the Sooners through 15 games, scoring 10.8 points per game on .429 shooting from the field and .473 from 3-point range (third in Big 12).

► Tallying just 35 total points in 2015-16 (1.9 per game), Odomes has already quadrupled his total points output with 144 on the season (averaging 9.6 per game).

► Oklahoma has seen potential from all four of its scholarship freshmen as the youngest Sooners have combined to produce 11 games of double-digit scoring – most recently a 13-point showing from Kameron McGusty against Kansas (Jan. 10).

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LATTIN BLOCK PARTY

► Junior forward **Khadeem Lattin** has already proven himself as one of the top shot blockers in Oklahoma program history. After 86 career games for the Sooners, Lattin ranks fourth in the OU record book in career blocks with 140.

► Owning a 7-foot-2 wingspan, Lattin averaged a Big 12-best 2.1 blocks per game in 2015-16, including 2.7 rejections in conference play. His efforts did not go unnoticed throughout the league, as he was voted to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team by conference coaches.

► His 77 total blocks in 2015-16 ranked 17th in the nation and fifth among players at Power Five schools. The forward registered at least six blocks on five occasions, including a career-best eight blocked shots vs. Texas Tech on Jan. 26.

► Lattin is off to another solid start on the defensive end in 2016-17, registering 32 blocks in 15 games. His 1.9 blocks per game ranks third in the Big 12 while his 2.8 per game in conference play ranks first. He's also tallied 24 steals this season, compared to his total of 32 in 36 games last season. Lattin is the only Big 12 players ranked in the conference's top seven for both blocks and steals.

► On the offensive end, Lattin has seen much improved production. After averaging 5.6 points on .557 shooting in 2015-16, Lattin boasts a 2016-17 average of 8.4 points on a .506 field goal percentage.

KRUGER KEEPS BUILDING

Lon Kruger has made his mark in college basketball as one of – if not the best – program rebuilders. Want proof? Look no further than what he's done with Oklahoma.

► In the two seasons before his hiring, the Sooners went 27-36 (.429) – capped by a 10th-place finish in the Big 12 in 2010-11. Since being brought on in 2011, Kruger has led the program to a 117-66 (.639) record, including a 102-50 (.671) mark over the past five seasons.

► Kruger's OU teams keep improving and have surpassed their win total from each subsequent season, with the 2015-16 squad finishing with a 29-8 record and making a trip to the Final Four. Before his arrival at OU, the Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.

► In five full seasons at Oklahoma, Kruger has produced four NCAA Tournament appearances, three top-three finishes in the Big 12, a national player of the year in Buddy Hield and a trip to the 2016 Final Four. Oklahoma was ranked in the top 10 of the AP Top 25 poll for every week of the 2015-16 season and made its first appearance as the poll's No. 1 team for the first time in more than 25 years.

► With 111 wins in his first five seasons at OU, Kruger owns the second most victories in the first five seasons of coaching the Sooners. Only Billy Tubbs accumulated more wins (115) in his first five years at OU. Kruger is the first coach in OU history to win six NCAA tournament games within his first five seasons.

► Boasting 596 career victories, Kruger ranks 10th in Division 1 wins among active coaches and 35th overall in NCAA Division I history.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

It's known as the house Alvan Adams built and Wayman Tisdale filled. It's also where Billy Tubbs resurrected Oklahoma basketball, where Blake Griffin flew high and where Buddy Hield became Buddy Buckets. Now, Lon Kruger is continuing the remarkable run of Sooner success inside the Lloyd Noble Center.

► Oklahoma has gone 58-10 (.853) at Lloyd Noble Center in the past five years, including 32-5 (.865) in the last four seasons. Overall, the Sooners are 69-15 (.821) at the LNC in the Kruger era.

► The Sooners have won 437 of their last 506 encounters at Lloyd Noble Center, good for a remarkable .869 winning percentage. Included in the stretch was a school-record 51-game winning streak (ended in 1990-91). The Sooners also recorded a Big 12 Conference-record 37-game home court winning streak (ended in 2003).

► OU is 13-8 at home against AP Top 25 opponents in the Kruger era and has won 12 of the last 16 such contests.

► Oklahoma has won 126 of its last 132 non-conference games at LNC, including 60 of its last 63. The Sooners are 34-3 in Norman against non-conference opponents under Kruger.

► Overall, the Sooners own a 532-96 (.850) record in the LNC since the building opened in 1975.

► Student interest in OU basketball has continued to grow through Kruger's tenure. Student attendance has increased by more than 100 percent from Kruger's first season (2011-12). This year, OU student season tickets sold out in less than 24 hours – the fastest rate in the OU era.

WATCHING WOODARD

► A 2015-16 All-Big 12 honorable mention selection, **Jordan Woodard** was the team's second-leading scorer last season with averages of 13.0 points (10th in Big 12), 3.4 assists (9th), 3.0 rebounds and 1.6 steals (5th) in 29.8 minutes. The Big 12 coaches voted Woodard a preseason All-Big 12 Honorable Mention selection ahead of the 2016-17 season.

► Woodard has seen remarkable development from season to season – particularly from behind the 3-point arc. After shooting 17-for-67 (.254) from 3-point range in 2014-15, Woodard sunk 80 treys on 176 attempts (.455) his junior year to finish second in the Big 12 in 3-point shooting.

► With three-plus seasons of experience in the Sooner starting lineup under his belt, Woodard has already made a dent in the OU record book. Sitting on 1,324 points at OU, Woodard recently became just the 21st Sooner to score over 1,300 points in a career. He surpassed both Blake Griffin (1,278) and Cameron Clark (1,284) in OU's all-time scoring rankings, moving up to No. 20 on the list. He also ranks in the top 10 of four statistical categories in the OU record book (free throws, free throw percentage, assists, steals).

► With 412 made foul shots and a career free throw percentage of .807, Woodard is just the seventh Sooner to ever sink 400 career free throws. No Sooner has ever finished his collegiate career with over 400 made free throws at a rate of over .800.

SOONER TIP-INS

► **SWITCHING IT UP:** After five games of using the same starting lineup, head coach **Lon Kruger** swapped **Kristian Doolittle** for **Matt Freeman** at the forward position. It was the first time since February of 2013 that Kruger has adjusted a starting lineup during the season. **Dante Buford** received the start at the forward position in OU's next two games (Dec. 7 vs. Oral Roberts and Dec. 10 vs. Wichita State) before reuniting with Doolittle. **Jordan Woodard, Jordan Shepherd and Darrien Strong-Moore** have all had a chance to start at point guard. In total, the Sooners have used seven different lineups this season – the most lineups used in one season under Kruger.

► **ALMOST THERE:** The Sooners look to snap a seven-game losing streak on Saturday against Texas Tech. Despite losing nine games this season, the Sooners have found themselves with a chance to win in almost every contest this year. Oklahoma has led at halftime in six of its nine losses and has led at the half in two of its three true road games this season (at Wisconsin on Dec. 3 and at TCU on Jan. 3). Six of OU's nine losses have been decided by six points or less.

► **FROM DEEP:** Coming off of a prolific season of 3-point shooting in 2015-16 that included hitting a program-record 382-of-906 (.422) shots from behind the arc, the Sooners are off to another hot start from deep. Oklahoma ranks third in the Big 12 in 3-point field goal percentage (.388), sinking an average of 7.3 treys per game. OU has been paced by **Jordan Woodard** (27 made 3-pointers) and **Christian James** (26 made 3-pointers). James is third in the Big 12 by shooting his 3-point attempts at a 47.3 percent clip. OU has shot 50 percent or higher from downtown in three games this season, most recently going 6-of-11 (.545) at Kansas State on Jan. 7.

► **GETTING DEFENSIVE:** The Sooners have won or tied the turnover margin in 10 of its 15 games this season. Oklahoma is averaging 7.9 steals per game (45th in NCAA) and forcing 14.5 turnovers a contest (74th in NCAA). The Sooners are blocking 5.0 shots per contest (45th in NCAA).

► **BULLDOGS BACK TOGETHER:** Oklahoma's starting lineup in the first five games included freshman forward **Kristian Doolittle**, the first freshman to start for the Sooners since **Jordan Woodard** in the 2013-14 season. Doolittle finished his debut with five points and three rebounds in 19 minutes. Doolittle and Woodard played together for one season at Edmond Memorial High School (Edmond, Okla.), winning the Oklahoma 6A title. The duo is the first pair of former high school teammates to start in a game for the Sooners since **Blake and Taylor Griffin** (Oklahoma Christian School in Edmond, Okla.) in 2008-09.

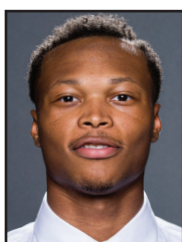

KRUGER'S SOONER TURNAROUND

► Kruger has been leaving his trademark rebuilding stamp on college basketball programs throughout his career. He is the only Division I coach to ever take five different schools to the NCAA Tournament. In 2015 he became the first coach since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985 to take four programs to the Sweet 16 or beyond.

► After inheriting a program that went 27-36 (.429) in the two seasons prior to his arrival, Kruger has coached the Sooners to a 117-66 (.639) record in six seasons. Over the last four full campaigns, OU posted a 96-41 (.701) mark and advanced to the NCAA Tournament each season, capped by a trip to the 2016 Final Four in Houston. The Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.

► With a career college coaching record of 596-370 (.617), Kruger owns the 10th most wins among active Division I coaches. He owns a 20-17 record in NCAA Tournament games and has compiled 16 20-plus-win seasons, including nine in the last 10 years. His collegiate teams have made postseason appearances in 21 of the last 26 years.

► Under Kruger, Sooner players have earned First-Team All-Big 12 selections on three occasions and racked up 14 Academic All-Big 12 honors. Buddy Hield, who played four seasons for Kruger (2012-16), was named the winner of the 2016 Wooden Award, Naismith Trophy and the Oscar Robertson Trophy as the national player of the year (first consensus player of the year for OU since Blake Griffin in 2009).

► Three Sooners have been drafted into the NBA during Kruger's tenure. Buddy Hield was selected as the sixth overall pick in the 2016 NBA Draft while Isaiah Cousins (2016) and Romero Osby (2013) were chosen in the second round of their respected drafts.
