CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- ✎ Baylor is the fourth different Big 12 team to be ranked No. 1 in the nation since 2010. The total is the most of any conference in America.
- ✎ The Big 12 is the only conference in the nation with three teams among the top 10 of the national polls.
- ✎ Every team in the Big 12 has been ranked or received votes in the top 25 polls this season - including four squads this week.
- ✎ The Big 12 has posted a .600 win percentage versus the ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC - tied (Big East) for the best percentage of any conference among that group.
- ✎ The Big 12 has won over 61 percent of its games versus the conferences listed above - the best two-year stretch in Big 12 history.
- ✎ Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 97-21 non-conference record during 2016-17. Fourteen losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.
- ✎ Big 12 teams boasts a .822 non-conference winning percentage this season - the best of any league in the nation.
- ✎ The current non-conference win percentage of .822 would rank as the 14th-best in NCAA history.
- ✎ Four of the five non-conference losses suffered by the five Big 12 teams with only one loss were by four points or less (average margin, 5.2 points).
- ✎ The 21 combined non-league losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 28 (Big East).
- ✎ The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.
- ✎ Big 12 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among active conferences with a .610 mark.
- ✎ Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament during their respective careers.
- ✎ Seven coaches have career win percentages of .700 or better and the group of all 10 coaches boasts more than 3,600 career victories.

**BAYLOR (15-1, 3-1)**

- Junior forward Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. notched his second double-double of the year with 10 points and 12 rebounds at West Virginia. He has scored in double digits in eight of the last nine outings.
- Baylor is ranked No. 1 for the first time in school history and was one of the final two undefeated teams in the nation for the first time. The Bears are 36-10 all-time when ranked in the top 10 and 11-3 when among the top five teams.
- Junior forward Johnathan Motley has moved into eighth place on the BU career blocked shots list with 104. He is averaging 15.0 points and 10.0 rebounds over the past six contests, while shooting 55.4 percent from the floor.

**IOWA STATE (11-4, 3-1)**

- Senior guard Monté Morris finished with a career-high 30 points at OSU, moving into 18th on the ISU career scoring list (1,372 points). He has 52 points in his last two outings and has scored in double digits in seven straight contests.
- Morris also had five assists with no turnovers against the Cowboys and has notched 22 assists with just one miscue in last four games. He moved into a tie for fourth on the Big 12 career list with 636 assists (John Roberson, TTU).
- Iowa State has won eight straight games versus Oklahoma State and the four consecutive conference road wins ties a school record. The Cyclones have two active eight-game win streaks against league foes for the first time (OSU, TCU - 8).

**KANSAS (15-1, 4-0)**

- Senior Frank Mason III led Kansas with 28 points on 11-of-20 shooting at Oklahoma. He is averaging 27.0 points in his last two games while shooting 54.8 percent and has recorded nine 20-point scoring efforts this season.
- Head coach Bill Self won his 400th game at Kansas with the victory over the Sooners in Norman. He is 400-84 all-time at KU for an .826 winning percentage, the best mark of any coach in school history.
- KU has shot 50 percent or better in 10 games this year, including seven of the past 11 outings. The Jayhawks are also shooting 77.6 percent from the free throw line in conference play after hitting at just a .592 clip in non-league competition.

**KANSAS STATE (13-3, 2-2)**

- Sophomore Kamau Stokes paced three Wildcats in double figures with 17 points at Texas Tech. He has finished in double digits in six straight games and has made 8-of-12 (.667) from 3-point range over the last two outings.
- Kansas State earned the No. 25 ranking in this week's Associated Press poll, its first top 25 ranking since January 20, 2014 (No. 22). The 'Cats loss at Tech was the first time this season they were defeated after leading at the half (13-1).
- The Wildcats have scored 70 points or more in 11 games this season and have allowed their opponents to surpass the mark in only one matchup. Kansas State has scored at least 14 points off turnovers in all but one contest.

**OKLAHOMA (6-9, 0-4)**

- Guards Kameron McGusty and Rashard Odomes led Oklahoma with 13 points apiece versus Kansas. McGusty has scored in double figures in three straight contests and earned his first career start in the game against the Jayhawks.
- Senior guard Jordan Woodard returned to the court after missing the last four games due to a medical condition. He had seven points, five rebounds, five assists and one turnover in 24 minutes off the bench.
- Head coach Lon Kruger has used seven different lineup combinations this season, the most in one season at OU under Kruger. Through four Big 12 games, 66.5 percent of the Sooner scoring has come from freshmen or sophomores.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (10-6, 0-4)**

- Senior guard Phil Forte had his 22nd career 20-point outing with 24 points versus Iowa State - the most 20-point efforts of any active Big 12 player. He increased his career scoring total to 1,532 points, 12th on the OSU all-time scoring list.
- Junior Jeffrey Carroll is averaging 19.7 points over his last three contests while shooting 61.0 percent from the field. He is the only Big 12 player ranked among the top eight in the league in scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage.
- The next OSU home game (K-State, Jan. 18) will mark the 1,000th basketball contest played on the historic white maple floor at Gallagher-Iba Arena. The playing surface dates back to the first game on Dec. 9, 1938 - a 21-15 win over Kansas.

**TCU (13-3, 2-2)**

- TCU recorded its first win at Texas since February 18, 1987 - when current head coach Jamie Dixon was its starting point guard. The second league win for the Horned Frogs matched their Big 12 victory total from all of last season.
- Since entering the starting lineup seven games ago, junior forward Vladimir Brodziansky leads the Frogs in scoring with 12.4 points per game. He has 42 rebounds and 16 blocked shots during that span, while shooting 54.1 percent.
- TCU outrebounded Texas (36-32) and held an advantage in bench points (15-11) as well. The Frogs are 12-0 when outrebounding their foes and have outscored the opponent bench in all but two contests this season.

**TEXAS (7-9, 1-3)**

- Freshman forward Jarrett Allen finished with a career-high 18 points to go along with nine rebounds versus TCU. He has scored in double figures 10 times this year and has at least nine boards in five of his last seven outings.
- The Longhorns shot 42.9 percent versus the Horned Frogs, their fourth straight game over 42 percent. UT was 9-of-11 (.818) from the free throw line, just the third time this year it has finished over 80 percent from the charity stripe.
- Sophomore Tevin Mack has scored in double digits a team-high 11 times this season, including two of his last three contests. He is averaging 17.0 points and 6.3 rebounds during the three-game stretch, shooting 52.8 percent from the floor.

**TEXAS TECH (13-3, 2-2)**

- Texas Tech has five wins its last eight games versus nationally-ranked opponents after the victory over K-State, including four straight in Lubbock. The Red Raiders have won 16 straight games at United Supermarkets Arena dating back to last year.
- Junior guard Keenan Evans led TTU with 18 points versus the Wildcats, including the go-ahead layup with 14.3 seconds left. He has scored in double digits in five straight and 10 of his last 11 outings, shooting 50 percent or better six times.
- Senior guard Devon Thomas has 11 assists with just two turnovers in his last three outings. He has had one turnover or less in 13 of 16 games in 2016-17, including seven performances without a single miscue.

**WEST VIRGINIA (14-2, 3-1)**

- West Virginia recorded a win versus the No. 1 team in the nation for the second straight season with the victory over Baylor. It was the third career win for head coach Bob Huggins over an opponent ranked No. 1.
- Senior forward Nathan Adrian finished with a career-high 22 points against the Bears, adding six rebounds and making 7-of-10 from the field. It was his 10th double-figure scoring effort this season.
- The Mountaineers forced Baylor into 29 turnovers, the most the Bears have ever had in a Big 12 contest. It was the 11th time this year a WVU foe has had at least 20 miscues, with every opponent having at least 13 turnovers.

Phillips 66 Weekly Awards

A Big 12 Player and Newcomer of the Week will be chosen each Monday, beginning November 16. Nominations are submitted by the school communications offices and winners are selected by a panel of media voters who cover the league on a regular basis. This year marks the 21st year for Phillips 66 as a sponsor of the Big 12 Conference.

Postseason Awards

The Big 12 presents the only official all-conference awards at the end of the regular season. Major award winners are chosen, along with the All-Big 12 teams. Each Big 12 head coach votes on the squads and is not permitted to vote for his own players. The awards will be announced in March prior to the Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's Basketball Championship. Academic All-Big 12 teams are also chosen in men's basketball and will be announced prior to the postseason.
