CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Every Big 12 game on Saturday was decided by single digits. Nineteen of 26 (73.1 percent) league games so far have been decided by 10 points or less.
- The Big 12 is the only conference in the nation with three teams among the top seven of the national polls.
- Every team in the Big 12 has been ranked or received votes in the top 25 polls this season - including six squads this week.
- The Big 12 has posted a .600 win percentage versus the ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC - tied (Big East) for the best percentage of any conference among that group.
- The Big 12 has won over 61 percent of its games versus the conferences listed above - the best two-year stretch in Big 12 history.
- Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 97-21 non-conference record during 2016-17. Fourteen losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.
- Big 12 teams boasts a .822 non-conference winning percentage this season - the best of any league in the nation.
- The current non-conference win percentage of .822 would rank as the 14th-best in NCAA history.
- Four of the five non-conference losses suffered by the five Big 12 teams with only one loss were by four points or less (average margin, 5.2 points).
- The 21 combined non-league losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 28 (Big East).
- The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.
- Big 12 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among active conferences with a .610 mark.
- Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament during their respective careers.
- Seven coaches have career win percentages of .700 or better and the group of all 10 coaches boasts more than 3,600 career victories.

**BAYLOR (16-1, 4-1)**

- XII** Baylor has won four straight against K-State for the first time in series history. The Bears have won at least four of their first five Big 12 games for the sixth time in 21 years, including four of the past six seasons (1998, 2008, '12, '13, '16, '17).
- XII** BU is 5-1 versus ranked opponents this season, the third consecutive year the Bears have knocked off five or more ranked squads. Baylor has 36 wins against ranked foes since 2007-08 after having none in Scott Drew's first four seasons.
- XII** Junior forward Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. has 24 rebounds in his last two outings and has grabbed at least eight boards in five of his last six contests. He has also scored in double figures in eight of the past 10 games.

**KANSAS (17-1, 6-0)**

- XII** Senior Frank Mason III has scored 92 points in his last four games and has finished with 18 points or more in eight of the last 11 outings. He is also 21-of-27 (.778) from the free throw line over the four-game stretch.
- XII** Kansas' 17-game winning streak is tied for the longest in the nation (Gonzaga) and matches the fourth-longest in Bill Self's 14 seasons at KU. The Jayhawks average 85.8 points this season and have scored 80 or more in 14 of 18 contests.
- XII** Senior center Landen Lucas has three double-doubles in his last six contests and has posted double-figure rebounding totals five times this season - all in the last seven outings. He has shot 50 percent or better in nine of the past 10 games.

**OKLAHOMA (7-9, 1-4)**

- XII** Senior guard Jordan Woodard was 14-of-14 from the free throw line against Texas Tech, the most foul shots made without a miss in his career. He moved into fifth on the OU record list for career free throws made with 426.
- XII** Woodard has scored 22 points or more in his last three starts and has surpassed the 20-point plateau five times overall this year. He has also moved into 16th place on the all-time OU scoring list with 1,358 career points.
- XII** Sophomore guard Rahshard Odomes finished with a career-high 24 points versus Tech and has 47 points in his last three contests. He is shooting 64.5 percent in the past three outings and has shot 50 percent or better eight times in 2016-17.

**TCU (14-3, 3-2)**

- XII** TCU has tied its best start to a season in program history - the eighth time the Horned Frogs have opened a year with a 14-3 record. TCU is over .500 in conference play for the first time in five seasons in the Big 12.
- XII** Junior forward Vladimir Brodziansky recorded his third career double-double with 25 points and 14 rebounds versus Iowa State. He is averaging 19.3 points and 8.7 rebounds over the last three contests, shooting 73.5 percent from the floor.
- XII** TCU's bench outscored the Cyclones, 33-26 - the 15th time in 17 games the Frogs have outperformed their opponents' bench. Freshman guard Desmond Bane had 12 points and has contributed 34 as a non-starter in the last four games.

**TEXAS TECH (13-4, 2-3)**

- XII** Juniors Keenan Evans and Zach Smith led Texas Tech with 16 points each at Oklahoma. Evans has reached double figures in a career-best six straight outings, while Smith has hit the mark in 11 of his last 13 contests.
- XII** Senior guard Devon Thomas has 15 assists with just three turnovers in his last four outings. He has had one turnover or less in 14 of 17 games in 2016-17, including seven performances without a single miscue.
- XII** Texas Tech has five wins its last eight games versus nationally-ranked opponents after the victory over K-State, including four straight in Lubbock. The Red Raiders have won 16 straight games at United Supermarkets Arena dating back to last year.

**IOWA STATE (11-6, 3-3)**

- XII** Senior guard Monté Morris had his 16th career 20-point outing with 23 points and seven assists versus Kansas. He has 37 assists with just four turnovers in six conference games, including zero in three of the past four contests.
- XII** ISU has committed fewer turnovers than its opponent in 16 of its 17 games. The Cyclones are averaging just 9.8 turnovers overall, a mark that ranks first in the Big 12 and is tied for third in the nation.
- XII** Iowa State has recorded at least 10 steals in nine contests this season, including each of the last four games. Four different Cyclones have posted at least 20 steals in 2016-17 and the team leads the Big 12 in conference play with 55 thefts.

**KANSAS STATE (13-4, 2-3)**

- XII** Senior forward D.J. Johnson collected his fifth career 20-point game, including his third this season, with a team-high 20 points on 9-of-13 shooting versus Baylor. He is shooting a team-best 64.4 percent over the last seven contests.
- XII** The Wildcats have scored 70 points or more in 11 games this season and have allowed their opponents to surpass the mark in only two matchups. K-State has lost all four of its games by single digits, with a combined margin of 13 total points.
- XII** Sophomore Kamau Stokes has scored in double figures in seven straight outings, with 39 assists. He has converted 27-of-32 (.844) from the free throw line during that stretch and is shooting 70.9 percent from the stripe in 2016-17.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (10-7, 0-5)**

- XII** Junior Jeffrey Carroll led the Cowboy scoring effort with 23 points at Kansas, his seventh 20-point effort of the season and third in the past four games. He is the only Big 12 player ranked among the top seven in the league in scoring and rebounding.
- XII** Junior Mitchell Solomon finished with a career-high 16 points at KU, all in the second half. He was 6-of-6 from the floor in 21 minutes and matched his scoring total from the previous four games combined.
- XII** The next OSU home game (K-State, Jan. 18) will mark the 1,000th basketball contest played on the historic white maple floor at Gallagher-Iba Arena. The playing surface dates back to the first game on Dec. 9, 1938 - a 21-15 win over Kansas.

**TEXAS (7-10, 1-4)**

- XII** Freshman forward Jarrett Allen is averaging 18.5 points and 8.0 rebounds in his last two outings, making 14-of-21 (.667) shots from the floor. He has scored in double digits in seven of his last eight contests, with at least six boards in every game.
- XII** The Longhorns shot 47.9 percent versus WVU, their fifth straight game over 42 percent. UT was 18-of-23 (.783) from the line, the third time in four games it has been over 75 percent after having reached the mark just three times on the season.
- XII** Senior forward Shaquille Cleare has reached double digits in scoring five times this season after having just done so twice previously in his Texas career. He played a season-high 33 minutes against the Mountaineers.

**WEST VIRGINIA (15-2, 4-1)**

- XII** Junior guard Jevon Carter has finished in double figures in eight straight contests and is averaging 17.0 points while shooting 52.2 percent in the past two games. He has eight outings with at least four steals in 2016-17.
- XII** Senior guard Teyvon Myers recorded a career-high 16 points in the win at Texas in 24 minutes off the bench. It was more points than in his previous four games combined as he notched his seventh double-digit effort of the year.
- XII** West Virginia recorded a win versus the No. 1 team in the nation for the second straight season with the victory over Baylor. It was the third career win for head coach Bob Huggins over an opponent ranked No. 1.
