CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

Every Big 12 game last Saturday was decided by single digits. A total of 23 of 30 (76.7 percent) league games so far have been decided by 10 points or less - including every matchup this week.

The Big 12 is the only conference in the nation with three teams among the top seven of the national polls.

Every team in the Big 12 has been ranked or received votes in the top 25 polls this season - including six squads this week.

The Big 12 has posted a .600 win percentage versus the ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC - tied (Big East) for the best percentage of any conference among that group.

The Big 12 has won over 61 percent of its games versus the conferences listed above - the best two-year stretch in Big 12 history.

Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 97-21 non-conference record during 2016-17. Fourteen losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.

Big 12 teams boasts a .822 non-conference winning percentage this season - the best of any league in the nation.

The current non-conference win percentage of .822 would rank as the 14th-best in NCAA history.

Four of the five non-conference losses suffered by the five Big 12 teams with only one loss were by four points or less (average margin, 5.2 points).

The 21 combined non-league losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 28 (Big East).

The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.

Big 12 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among active conferences with a .610 mark.

Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament during their respective careers.

Seven coaches have career win percentages of .700 or better and the group of all 10 coaches boasts more than 3,600 career victories.

BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

The Big 12 Champions for Life initiative showcases the success stories of student-athletes and how an athletic scholarship has positively impacted their lives. This week features Kaylee Jensen (Oklahoma State women's basketball) and alumna Kaylyn Millick (West Virginia gymnastics). Jensen's hard work in high school lead her to OSU, where she has learned to adjust and help lead her team to victory. Millick attributes her time on the WVU gymnastics squad as the place where she grew the most, not only as an athlete but as a person. BAYLOR (17-1, 5-1)

- Junior forward Johnathan Motley had career-highs of 32 points and 20 rebounds versus Texas, the fourth player in program history to score 30 or more points and grab 20 or more rebounds in a game.
- Motley's performance is the 18th in Big 12 history where a player has scored at least 20 points and had 20 or more rebounds. He is the seventh player since the conference began play in 1996-97 to reach the 30-point, 20-rebound mark.
- BU is 5-1 versus ranked opponents this season, the third consecutive year the Bears have knocked off five or more ranked squads. Baylor has 36 wins against ranked foes since 2007-08 after having none in Scott Drew's first four seasons.



IOWA STATE (11-6, 3-3)

- Senior guard Monté Morris had his 16th career 20-point outing with 23 points and seven assists versus Kansas. He has 37 assists with just four turnovers in six conference games, including zero in three of the past four contests.
- ISU has committed fewer turnovers than its opponent in 16 of its 17 games. The Cyclones are averaging just 9.8 turnovers overall, a mark that ranks first in the Big 12 and is tied for third in the nation.
- Iowa State has recorded at least 10 steals in nine contests this season, including each of the last four games. Four different Cyclones have posted at least 20 steals in 2016-17 and the team leads the Big 12 in conference play with 55 thefts.



KANSAS (17-1, 6-0)

- Senior Frank Mason III has scored 92 points in his last four games and has finished with 18 points or more in eight of the last 11 outings. He is also 21-of-27 (.778) from the free throw line over the four-game stretch.
- Kansas' 17-game winning streak is tied for the longest in the nation (Gonzaga) and matches the fourth-longest in Bill Self's 14 seasons at KU. The Jayhawks average 85.8 points this season and have scored 80 or more in 14 of 18 contests.
- Senior center Landen Lucas has three double-doubles in his last six contests and has posted double-figure rebounding totals five times this season - all in the last seven outings. He has shot 50 percent or better in nine of the past 10 games.



KANSAS STATE (14-4, 3-3)

- Sophomore Barry Brown paced Kansas State with a career-high 22 points with four steals at Oklahoma State. He has 35 points over his last two outings and has scored in double digits in four of the past five games.
- The Wildcats recorded their first win at Gallagher-Iba Arena since 2012 and the 96 points were the most scored in a Big 12 road game in school history. Overall, the scoring total was the ninth-most recorded by Kansas State in a road contest.
- The Wildcats have scored 70 points or more in 12 games this season and have allowed their opponents to surpass the mark in just three matchups. K-State has lost all four of its games by single digits, with a combined margin of 13 total points.



OKLAHOMA (8-9, 2-4)

- No. 7 West Virginia is the highest-rated opponent Oklahoma has defeated in a true road game since February 17, 1993. In that contest, the unranked Sooners defeated No. 6 Kansas in Allen Fieldhouse, 80-77.
- Senior guard Jordan Woodard led the Sooners with 20 points at WVU. Since returning to the starting lineup, the Sooners have won both games and he has averaged 23.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 3.5 steals.
- Freshman guard Kameron McGusty has scored in double figures in five straight contests, averaging 13.3 points in Big 12 play. He played a career-best 39 minutes at West Virginia and has logged 30 minutes or more in three of the last five outings.



OKLAHOMA STATE (10-8, 0-6)

- The contest versus Kansas State was the 1,000th men's basketball game in 'Arena. All-time, the Cowboys are 780-220 (.780) in the venue, which opened in 1938.
- Junior Jeffrey Carroll led all five OSU starters in double figures with 24 points against K-State on 7-of-10 shooting. He has scored 21 points or more in four of his last five outings and is shooting 63.1 percent during that stretch.
- Sophomore guard Jawun Evans scored 20 or more for the first time in seven games with 20 points against the Wildcats. He has also had five or more assists in four straight outings and has dished out that many 10 times in 2016-17.



TCU (14-4, 3-3)

- Junior forward Vladimir Brodziansky had 22 points at Texas Tech, the 10th time this season and 27th in his career he has reached double figures. He is averaging 20.0 points and 8.0 rebounds in the last four games, shooting 72.3 percent from the floor.
- The Horned Frogs have outscored their opponents in bench points in all but two contests this season and held a 17-5 advantage versus the Red Raiders. TCU has also outrebounded 14 foes, posting a 13-1 record in those matchups.
- TCU tied its best start to a season in program history with the 14-3 record, the eighth time the Frogs opened a year with that mark. With its 3-2 record, TCU was over .500 in conference play for the first time in five seasons in the Big 12.



TEXAS (7-11, 1-5)

- Freshman forward Jarrett Allen is averaging 18.0 points and 8.7 rebounds in his last three outings, making 21-of-31 (.677) shots from the floor. He has scored in double digits in eight of his last nine contests, with at least six boards in every game.
- Senior forward Shaquille Cleare has reached double figures in scoring six times this season after having just done so twice previously in his Texas career. He has 26 points and 10 boards in his last two contests, shooting 63.2 percent from the field.
- The Longhorns have shot 78.3 percent or better in each of their last three games after having reached the mark twice for the season prior to the current stretch. UT has shot 41 percent or better from the floor in six straight outings.



TEXAS TECH (14-4, 3-3)

- Junior guard Keenan Evans led the Red Raiders in scoring for the third straight outing with 20 points versus TCU. He is averaging 18.0 points and shooting 57.1 percent from the floor and 88.9 percent from the line during the three-game stretch.
- Junior Zach Smith has scored 15 points or more in five straight contests, grabbing at least seven rebounds in each of those games. He has had seven or more boards in eight straight outings and is 14-of-23 (.609) from the floor in his last two outings.
- Tech has five wins its last eight games versus nationally-ranked opponents after the victory over K-State, including four straight in Lubbock. The Red Raiders have won 16 straight games at United Supermarkets Arena dating back to last year.



WEST VIRGINIA (15-3, 4-2)

- Junior guard Jevon Carter had his first career double-double with 23 points and 11 rebounds against Oklahoma. He has finished in double figures in nine straight contests and is averaging 19.0 points over the past three outings.
- The Sooners had just 12 turnovers versus WVU, the fewest a Mountaineer opponent has committed this season. Eleven different foes have had 20 miscues or more and West Virginia has had double-digit steals 11 times.
- West Virginia recorded a win versus the No. 1 team in the nation for the second straight season with the victory over Baylor. It was the third career win for head coach Bob Huggins over an opponent ranked No. 1.
