NOTABLES

- ALLEN'S CAREER DAY: Freshman forward Jarrett Allen posted career highs with 22 points and 19 rebounds and tied his career high with 3 blocks during Saturday's game at No. 2/1 Kansas. Allen was one rebound shy of becoming just the fifth player in UT history to record a 20-20 performance and first since Kevin Durant in 2007. Allen's 19 rebounds also marked the second-highest single-game total by a UT freshman in school history.
- JONES COMING OF AGE: In the last three games (all against Top 10 opponents), freshman guard Andrew Jones has averaged 15.7 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.3 assists per contest while converting 15-of-32 (.469) field goals, including 8-of-19 (.421) threes, and 9-of-11 (.818) free throws.
- CLEARE CONTINUES TO SHINE: Senior forward Shaquille Cleare has averaged 12.3 points in 26.7 minutes per game over the last three contests. Cleare has converted 16-of-28 (.571) field goals and 5-of-6 (.833) free throws during the stretch while reaching double figures in scoring in each of the three games.

OKLAHOMA SERIES INFO

- Monday's contest marks the 90th meeting between Texas and Oklahoma.
- The Sooners hold a 53-36 lead in the all-time series that dates back to a 59-26 OU victory in Norman on Feb. 25, 1910.
- UT holds a 20-18 advantage in the series in games played in Austin.
- Texas has won 8 of the last 14 meetings in the series entering Monday's contest.

HORNS AT HOME

- UT is in its 40th season of play at the Frank Erwin Center. The Longhorns have registered an all-time record of 484-116 (.807) in the building.
- Texas is 212-33 (.865) at the Erwin Center in the last 15 seasons (dating to the start of the 2002-03 season).
- UT is 7-4 in the Erwin Center this season and 21-7 at home during the Shaka Smart era.

KANSAS GAME NOTES

- UT posted a 19-15 advantage in points off turnovers and a 20-15 advantage in bench scoring.
- **Jarrett Allen** recorded a double-double (22 points, 19 rebounds) for the seventh time this season (19 games) and third time in Big 12 play (7 games). He set career highs in points, rebounds, FG made (9-14) and tied his career high in blocks (3).
- Allen reached double figures in scoring for the fifth straight game and 13th time this season. Allen has reached double figures in scoring in six of the first seven Big 12 contests. He reached double figures in rebounds for the eighth time this year.
- Shaquille Cleare reached double figures in scoring (11 points) for the third straight game, the seventh time this season (19 games) and ninth time in his UT career (52 games). He had his consecutive FT made streak snapped at 21 (with a miss on his second attempt of the game).
- **Eric Davis Jr.** reached double figures in scoring (12 points) for the fifth time this year (19 games) and 19th time in his career (52 games).
- Andrew Jones reached double figures in scoring (15 points) for the third straight game and 10th time this season (19 games). He set a career high in blocked shots (2) and tied his career high in FG made (6-9).

A FIRST IN PROGRAM HISTORY

- Texas just completed a brutal three-game stretch that saw the Longhorns face three consecutive Top 10 opponents.
- UT dropped a 74-72 decision at home to No. 10/9 West Virginia (Jan. 14). The Horns then fell 74-64 at No. 6/6 Baylor last Tuesday (Jan. 17) and lost at No. 2/1 Kansas 79-67 on Saturday (Jan. 21).
- This marked the first time in UT program history that the Longhorns have faced three consecutive opponents ranked in The AP Top 10.

CLOSE CALLS

- The Longhorns are 2-6 this season in games decided by 5 points or less.
- Texas is 1-5 this year in games decided by 3 points or less.
- In its first seven Big 12 Conference contests, three of UT's six losses have been by 3 points or less.

A CONSISTENT DANCER

- Texas has advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 17 of the last 18 and 25 of the last 28 years. UT is one of six schools nationally to have appeared in at least 17 of the last 18 tourneys (Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Michigan State and Wisconsin).
- UT has made a total of 33 all-time appearances in the NCAA Tournament (35-36 record).

YEAR TWO OF THE SHAKA SMART ERA

- **Shaka Smart** was introduced as the 24th head basketball coach at The University of Texas on April 3, 2015.
- The 39-year-old Smart spent six seasons (2009-15) at Virginia Commonwealth University, leading the Rams to an overall record of 163-56 (.744) and five NCAA Tournament appearances including the 2011 Final Four.
- The 183 wins tie Smart for the sixth-highest number of total victories during the first seven years of a head coaching career in NCAA history.

Upon Smart's arrival at Texas in the spring of 2015, he laid out his five core values for the Texas Basketball program:

- **APPRECIATION:** We see every opportunity as a gift.
- **ENTHUSIASM:** We are passionate and excited about our process for success.
- **COMPETITIVENESS:** We aggressively pursue excellence.
- **TEAMSHIP:** We commit fully to aligning ourselves with the team.
- ACCOUNTABILITY: We are responsible for our team and ourselves.

WHAT IS GONE FROM LAST YEAR?

- Gone from the 2015-16 team are a total of six upperclassmen: guards Isaiah Taylor (turned professional after his junior season and now with the Houston Rockets D-League team), Javan Felix and Demarcus Holland, forward Connor Lammert and centers Prince Ibeh and Cameron Ridley.
- These six players combined to play in a total of 745 games (459 starts).
- The 2016-17 Longhorns return just: 37.2% of their scoring (877 of 2,355), 37.5% of their rebounding (396 of 1,055), 23.9% of their assists (90 of 377) and 36.6% of their minutes played (2,432 of 6,650).

20-WIN MARK

- With its 20-13 overall record in 2015-16, Texas reached the 20win mark for the 16th time in the last 17 seasons.
- UT has reached the 20-win plateau a total of 31 times in its previous 110 seasons of basketball.

RECORD-TYING FREE THROW PERFORMANCE

The Longhorns tied a school record with a perfect effort (12-of-12) from the stripe in the home win against UAB (Dec. 21).

 This marked the fourth time in school history (since the 1960-61 season, as far back as UT records were kept for free throws) that the Longhorns have been perfect form the free throw line as a team with at least 10 attempts.

ALLEN BECOMING ASSERTIVE

Freshman forward Jarrett Allen leads the team in rebounding (8.4 rpg) and blocked shots (32) and ranks second in scoring (12.5 ppg) and minutes (30.3 mpg) through the first 19 contests. He has converted 96-of-163 (.589) field goals. Allen has recorded seven double-doubles this season, including three in Big 12 play. He has reached double figures in scoring 13 times and double figures in rebounds eight times through his first 19 contests.

- He recorded 17 points (7-13 FG), 10 rebounds (5 offensive) and 2 blocks in 31 minutes against Kent State (Dec. 27).
- Allen posted 16 points (8-9 FG) and 6 rebounds in 25 minutes against UAB (Dec. 21).
- He had 11 points (5-10 FG), 10 rebounds and 2 blocks in 33 minutes against Arkansas in Houston (Dec. 17).
- Allen registered 13 points, 12 rebounds (7 offensive) and 2 blocks in 33 minutes against UTA (Nov. 29).

- He posted 15 points (6-9 FG) and 6 boards in 34 minutes against Colorado (Nov. 22).
- Allen recorded a double-double (16 points, 12 rebounds) and 2 blocks in 36 minutes during his collegiate debut against Incarnate Word (Nov. 11). His 16 points were 4 shy of the UT freshman debut mark (20 by Kevin Durant vs. Alcorn State in 2006), and his 12 boards were 1 shy of the school's freshman debut record (13 by P.J. Tucker vs. Brown in 2003).

ALLEN BETTER IN BIG 12 PLAY

Through his first seven Big 12 Conference contests, Jarrett Allen has averaged a team-best 15.6 points, 10.9 rebounds and 2.3 blocks in 33.7 minutes per game. He has converted 61.4% (43-70) of his field goal attempts and 23-of-30 (.767) free throws. Allen has reached double figures in scoring in six of the first seven league games.

- Allen tallied 11 points (5-10 FG), 7 rebounds and a career-high 3 blocks in 35 minutes at Iowa State (Jan. 7).
- He recorded 8 points (4-4 FT), 11 rebounds and 2 blocks in 32 minutes against Oklahoma State (Jan. 4).
- Allen posted 14 points (6-8 FG, 2-2 FT) and 13 rebounds (4 offensive) in 35 minutes at K-State (Dec. 30).

MONSTER EFFORT IN "ALLEN" FIELDHOUSE

Jarrett Allen had a remarkable performance during Saturday's game in historic Allen Fieldhouse at No. 2/1 Kansas (Jan. 21). Here's a look inside the numbers:

- Allen had a career-high 22 points (9-14 FG, 4-7 FT), a career-high 19 rebounds (7 offensive) and tied a career high with 3 blocks in 34 minutes.
- He came within 1 rebound of becoming just the FIFTH player in UT history to record 20 points and 20 rebounds in a game: Kevin Durant (37 points, 23 rebounds at Texas Tech on Jan. 31, 2007), Brad Buckman (27 points, 21 rebounds at Colorado on Feb. 8, 2005), LaSalle Thompson (26 points, 21 rebounds at North Texas on Jan. 19, 1981) and Larry Robinson (26 points, 23 rebounds vs. Centenary on Dec. 27, 1971).
- His 19 rebounds marked the SECOND-highest single-game total by a UT freshman in school history (Kevin Durant had 23 boards at Texas Tech on Jan. 31, 2007).
- His 19 boards are the most by a Kansas opponent since Jackson Vroman (Iowa State) had 19 rebounds on Feb. 21, 2004.

ALLEN SHINES AGAINST THE BEST

In the last three games (ALL against Top 10 opponents), Jarrett Allen has averaged a team-best 19.3 points, 12.0 rebounds and 2.7 blocks in 33.7 minutes per game. He has converted 71.0% (22-31) of his field goal attempts and 14-of-19 (.737) free throws. In addition to his effort at No. 2/1 Kansas on Saturday, here's a look at Allen's two previous performances against Top 10 opposition:

 He recorded 17 points (7-10 FG, 3-4 FT), 10 rebounds and tied his career high with 3 blocks in 31 minutes at No. 6/6 Baylor (Jan. 17). • Allen posted 19 points (6-7 FG, 7-8 FT), 7 rebounds and 2 blocks in 36 minutes against No. 10/9 West Virginia (Jan. 14). He set a career high in FT made and tied his career high in minutes played.

ALLEN EARNS WEEKLY BIG 12 HONOR

Jarrett Allen earned Phillips 66 Big 12 Conference Co-Newcomer of the Week honors on Jan. 16. This marked his first career Big 12 weekly award. Allen averaged 18.5 points, 8.0 rebounds and 2.0 blocks in 34.5 minutes per game during UT's two contests against No. 10/9 West Virginia (Jan. 14) and TCU (Jan. 11). He converted 14-of-21 (.667) field goals and 9-of-11 (.818) free throws.

• He registered 18 points (8-14 FG, 2-3 FT) to go along with 9 rebounds and 2 blocks in 33 minutes against TCU (Jan. 11). He tied his career high in FG made.

ROACH'S RESUME

Sophomore guard **Kerwin Roach Jr.** will play a significant role in the Texas backcourt this season. He has topped the 20-point mark twice and reached double figures in scoring 20 times in 51 career games (17 starts, all this season).

- Through his first 18 games this year, he leads the team in assists (63, 3.5 apg) and steals (26) and ranks tied for third in scoring (10.6 ppg) and third in minutes (29.4 mpg).
- Roach has reached double figures in scoring in 11 of his first 18 contests this season.
- He had 11 points, 6 rebounds and 5 assists in a career-high 38 minutes against No. 10/9 West Virginia (Jan. 14).
- Roach registered a season-high 21 points (7-9 FG, 4-4 threes) and 5 assists in 37 minutes at Iowa State (Jan. 7). The 21 points were one shy of his career high (22 vs. TCU on Jan. 26, 2016) and he set a career-high in 3-pointers made.
- He tallied 11 points (3-3 FG, 5-6 FT), 5 rebounds, a careerhigh 6 assists against 2 turnovers, 2 steals and 1 blocked shot in 36 minutes against Oklahoma State (Jan. 4).
- Roach recorded 13 points (4-7 FG, 4-4 FT), 3 assists and 2 steals in 32 minutes against Kent State (Dec. 27).
- He posted a team-high 16 points (12-16 FT) and 5 rebounds against Alabama (Dec. 2). Roach set a career high in FT made.
- Roach had 16 points and 3 steals against UTA (Nov. 29). He set a career high in field goals made (8-14).
- He posted a team-high 16 points in 30 minutes against Colorado (Nov. 22).
- Roach posted 11 points (4-7 FG) and 6 rebounds in 23 minutes against Eastern Washington (Nov. 17).
- Roach earned a spot on the six-person Big 12 All-Newcomer Team last year. He was a two-time Phillips 66 Big 12 Newcomer of the Week selection (Feb. 1 and March 6).
- During fall testing, Roach recorded a 47.5-inch vertical jump.

ROACH PLAYS THIEF

- **Kerwin Roach Jr.** recorded a career-high 6 steals in just 21 minutes of action during the home win against UAB (Dec. 21).
- This marked the most steals by a UT player in a single game since Daniel Gibson had 6 steals vs. Iowa State on Feb. 5,

2005.

• Roach leads the team with 26 steals (1.4 spg) in his first 18 games this season.

CLEARE TAKES LEADERSHIP ROLE

Senior forward **Shaquille Cleare** (pronounced: CLAIR) shed more than 30 pounds during the summer and early fall and reduced his body fat to less than 8 percent entering the 2016-17 season. At Texas, he has reached double figures in scoring nine times in 52 career games (19 starts, all this season).

- Through the first 19 games, Cleare ranks second on the team in rebounding (4.9 rpg) and fifth in scoring (7.8 ppg). He has converted 50.9% (59-116) from the floor and a teambest 86.1% (31-36) from the free throw line.
- Cleare has reached double figures in scoring seven times this season.
- He posted 10 points (4-7 FG, 2-2 FT) and 6 rebounds in 28 minutes at K-State (Dec. 30).
- Cleare recorded 10 points (3-4 FG, 4-4 FT) and 6 rebounds in 20 minutes against UAB (Dec. 21).
- He had 10 points (3-6 FG, 4-4 FT), 7 rebounds and 2 blocks in 23 minutes against Arkansas in Houston (Dec. 17).
- Cleare had 8 points and tied his UT career high in rebounds (8) in 21 minutes against Long Beach State (Dec. 10).
- He posted 11 points (5-9 FG), 4 boards and 1 block in 23 minutes against Alabama (Dec. 2).
- He played in 69 career games at Maryland during his freshman (2012-13) and sophomore (2013-14) seasons. He sat out the 2014-15 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

Shaquille Cleare has averaged 12.3 points in 26.7 minutes per game over his last three contests - ALL coming against Top 10 opponents. He has converted 16-of-28 (.571) field goals and 5-of-6 (.833) free throws during this stretch and has reached double figures in scoring in ALL three contests.

- He recorded 11 points (4-9 FG, 3-4 FT), 1 assist and 1 block in 22 minutes at No. 2/1 Kansas (Jan. 21).
- Cleare tied his UT career high with 14 points (6-10 FG, 2-2 FT) and added 6 rebounds in 25 minutes at No. 6/6 Baylor (Jan. 17).
- He posted 12 points (6-9 FG), 4 rebounds, 1 block, 1 assist and 1 steal in a career-high 33 minutes against No. 10/9 West Virginia (Jan. 14).

CLEARE'S STREAK AT THE LINE SNAPPED AT 21

- Shaquille Cleare had his streak of consecutive free throws made snapped at 21 during Saturday's game at No. 2/1 Kansas.
- Cleare made his first FT attempt but missed his second in the first half in Lawrence. He had been perfect at the stripe dating back to the Long Beach State game on Dec. 10.
- His streak of 21 marked the most consecutive FT made by a UT player since J'Covan Brown hit 28 straight from Jan. 7, 2012-Jan. 21, 2012.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONES'

Freshman guard Andrew Jones ranks second on the team in assists (51, 2.7 apg) and steals (24), tied for third in scoring (10.6 ppg) and fourth in rebounding (3.8 rpg) through the first 19 contests. He has converted 51-of-69 (.739) free throws and has reached double figures in scoring 10 times this season.

- Jones tallied 14 points (5-7 FG, 2-3 threes) and tied his career high with 7 rebounds in 29 minutes at Iowa State (Jan. 7).
- He had 10 points (6-10 FT), 4 rebounds and 2 assists without a turnover in 28 minutes against Oklahoma State (Jan. 4).
- Jones recorded 16 points (6-9 FG, 4-7 threes), 5 rebounds, 6 assists and 2 steals in 22 minutes against UAB (Dec. 21).
- He tied his career highs in scoring (17 points) and steals (3) and set career highs in assists (7), free throws made (8-11) and minutes (32) against Arkansas in Houston (Dec. 17).
- Jones had 17 points (6-10 FG) and 3 steals in 21 minutes against Eastern Washington (Nov. 17).
- He had 12 points (3-6 FG, 6-8 FT) and 4 assists in 23 minutes against UL Monroe (Nov. 14).
- Jones recorded 10 points and 6 rebounds in 22 minutes against Incarnate Word (Nov. 11).

JONES SHOWING IMPROVEMENT

Andrew Jones has averaged 15.7 points, 4.0 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 1.7 steals in 29.3 minutes per game over his last three contests - ALL coming against Top 10 opponents. He has converted 15-of-32 (.469) field goals, including 8-of-19 (.421) from three-point range, and 9-of-11 (.818) free throws during the stretch and reached double digits in scoring in ALL three games.

- He recorded 15 points (6-9 FG, 3-4 threes), 5 rebounds, 5 assists, 2 steals and a career-high 2 blocks in 29 minutes at No. 2/1 Kansas (Jan. 21).
- Jones posted 15 points (6-7 FT), 4 boards and 4 assists without a turnover in 31 minutes at No. 6/6 Baylor (Jan. 17).
- He tied his career high with 17 points (4-9 threes, 3-4 FT), 3 rebounds and 2 steals in 28 minutes against No. 10/9 West Virginia (Jan. 14).

DAVIS LOOKING TO BREAK OUT

Sophomore guard **Eric Davis Jr.** emerged as a team leader during spring and summer workouts. Davis has reached double figures in scoring 19 times in 52 career games (11 career starts).

- Through the first 19 games this season, Davis is third on the team in assists (28), sixth in scoring (7.2 ppg) and fourth in minutes played (26.2 mpg).
- He had 12 points (4-4 FT) and tied a career high with 3 steals in a career-high 36 minutes at No. 2/1 Kansas (Jan. 21).
- Davis registered 16 points (5-8 FG, 3-6 threes, 3-4 FT) in 28 minutes against Oklahoma State (Jan. 4).
- He recorded 16 points (4-8 FG, 3-7 threes, 5-6 FT) in 25 minutes against Long Beach State (Dec. 10).
- Davis set a career high with 7 rebounds in 24 minutes against ULM (Nov. 14).
- He posted 16 points (5-6 FT) and 6 rebounds in 32 minutes against Incarnate Word (Nov. 11).
- Davis earned a spot on the six-person Big 12 All-Newcomer Team last year. He was a two-time Phillips 66 Big 12 Newcomer of the Week (Nov. 30 and Dec. 14).
- Davis ranked fifth on the team in scoring (7.4 ppg) while converting a team-best 38.2 percent (42-110) from 3-point range and 79.6 percent (43-54) from the free throw line in his freshman season.

HORNS WELCOME TOP 5 RECRUITING CLASS

In their first full recruiting cycle, head coach **Shaka Smart** and the UT coaching staff pulled in a four-man freshman class that ranked as the **No. 5 recruiting class in the nation by Scout.com**. All four incoming freshmen were ranked among the Top 100 players nationally.

- Jarrett Allen was ranked as the No. 15 overall prospect in the nation by ESPN, No. 15 by Rivals.com and No. 15 by Scout.com. A McDonald's All-American, he also competed for Team USA in the 2016 Nike Hoop Summit. Allen averaged 19.7 points and 13.3 rebounds as a senior while leading St. Stephen's Episcopal School (Austin, Texas) to a 25-5 mark and the Southwest Prepatory Conference title. He scored 33 points in the 66-57 win against Bellaire Episcopal in the SPC championship game.
- James Banks was ranked as the No. 49 overall prospect in the nation by Scout.com, No. 57 by ESPN and No. 83 by Rivals.com. He led La Lumiere School (La Porte, Ind.) to a 27-4 overall mark during his senior season while averaging 6 points, 8 rebounds and 3 blocks per game. La Lumiere advanced to the championship game at the 2016 Dick's Sporting Goods High School Nationals in New York City in April. Banks also participated in the prestigious Kentucky Derby Festival Classic in Louisville in April and the BallIsLife All-American Game in May.
- Andrew Jones was ranked as the No. 19 overall prospect in the nation by Scout.com, No. 22 by Rivals.com and No. 29 by ESPN following his senior year. A McDonald's All-American, he also was the 13th player in UT history to participate in the Jordan Brand Classic and posted 15 points (7-11 FG) in 16 minutes for the West team. Jones averaged 30 points, 10 rebounds and 7 assists per game as a senior while leading Irving MacArthur (Irving, Texas) to a 22-7 overall record.
- Jacob Young was ranked as the No. 87 prospect in the nation by Scout.com and No. 106 by Rivals.com following his senior year. A two-time Class 5A all-state selection by the Texas Association of Basketball Coaches (TABC), he helped pace Yates HS (Houston, Texas) to the third round of the Class 5A state playoffs as a senior.

ALLEN'S PRESEASON ACCOLADES

Freshman Jarrett Allen earned several preseason honors this fall.

- Allen was named to the John R. Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 on Nov. 15. The watch list features 50 players in consideration for the 2017 Wooden Award as the top player in college basketball.
- He was named to the Naismith Trophy Men's 50 preseason watch list on Nov. 10. The watch list features 50 players in consideration for the 2017 Naismith Men's College Player of the Year.
- Allen was named to the 20-person watch list for the 2017 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award on Oct. 21. Named after the Hall of Famer and three-time NCAA Champion, the annual honor in its third year recognizes the top center in men's college basketball.

MAKING HISTORY

- Jarrett Allen was the top-ranked center in the country by ESPN.
- This marks the first time in UT program history that the Longhorns have signed the No. 1 center in ESPN's recruiting rankings.

YANCY PROVIDES EXPERIENCE

Guard **Kendal Yancy** returns for his senior season as the most experienced returning player on the UT roster. Now in his fourth year in the backcourt rotation, he has played in 113 career games (49 starts) and has reached double figures in scoring 18 times.

- He suffered a high left ankle sprain during the game at K-State (Dec. 30) and missed the next four games.
- Yancy returned and played 10 minutes at No. 6/6 Baylor (Jan. 17) and 18 minutes at No. 2/1 Kansas (Jan. 21).
- He has reached double figures in scoring five times this season.
- He registered 14 points (5-7 FG, 3-3 FT) in 21 minutes against UAB (Dec. 21).
- Yancy recorded 11 points and a season-high 5 rebounds in 23 minutes against Long Beach State (Dec. 10).
- He added 12 points (5-6 FG) in 23 minutes against ULM (Nov. 14).
- Yancy posted a team-high 19 points against Incarnate Word (Nov. 11). He set his career high in steals (4) and FT made (8-9) and tied his career high in minutes (37).
- Yancy played in 30 games (15 starts) and averaged 3.0 points and 1.8 rebounds in 10.5 minutes per contest last year.
- He earned the team's Most Improved Player honor as a sophomore in 2014-15.
- Yancy is a three-time Big 12 Commissioner's Honor Roll selection (min. 3.0 GPA) and earned Academic All-Big 12 Second Team accolades as a sophomore.

BLOCK PARTY FOR BANKS

Freshman center James Banks ranks second on the team in blocked shots (27) while averaging 2.4 rebounds in 12.6 minutes per contest through his first 18 contests. Banks has registered at least one blocked shot in 13 of his 18 games played.

- He registered 2 blocks in just 5 minutes against Oklahoma State (Jan. 4).
- Banks had 3 blocks in 10 minutes against Kent State (Dec. 27).
- He recorded 2 points, 9 rebounds and 5 blocks in 24 minutes during his collegiate debut against Incarnate Word (Nov. 11).
- Banks set the UT freshman debut mark for most blocked shots (5). The previous mark was 3 (Cameron Ridley vs. Fresno State in 2012; Damion James vs. Alcorn State in 2006).

YOUNG FINDING HIS ROLE

Freshman guard **Jacob Young** is averaging 3.9 points in 18.7 minutes per game through the first 19 contests.

- Young made his first collegiate start against No. 10/9 West Virginia (Jan. 14) and had 8 points (2-4 threes, 2-2 FT) in 22 minutes.
- He posted a season-high 11 points (4-8 FG, 3-6 threes) in 24 minutes against Alabama (Dec. 2).
- Young had 10 points (4-7 FG) and 2 assists without a turnover in a career-high 32 minutes against Incarnate Word (Nov. 11).

ADDING "MO'-MENTUM

Senior forward Mareik Isom (pronounced: muh-REAK EYE-sum) spent his first four seasons at Arkansas-Little Rock and played in 95 career games (18 starts). After redshirting as a true freshman in 2012-13), he completed his bachelor's degree in psychology in December 2015. Isom enrolled in graduate-level classes at UT this summer and is eligible to compete immediately for the Longhorns in the upcoming 2016-17 season. He was a two-time Sun Belt Conference Honor Roll selection (2013-14 and 2014-15).

- As a redshirt junior (2015-16), Isom played in 34 games (9 starts) and averaged 5.9 points, 2.7 rebounds and 0.5 blocks in 19.1 minutes per game while helping the Trojans post a 30-5 record (17-3 Sun Belt Conference champions) and advance to the NCAA Tournament Round of 32.
- He converted 39.6 percent (42-106) from 3-point range and 78.4 percent (29-37) from the free throw line last year. Isom reached double figures in scoring eight times, including a season-high 16 points against Texas State (Feb. 27).
- In his redshirt sophomore season (2014-15), he played in 31 games (8 starts) and averaged 6.8 points and 2.9 rebounds in 15.9 minutes per contest. Isom led the Sun Belt in 3-point shooting percentage (45.0 percent).
- Isom is an **Austin**, **Texas native** who played at Bowie HS.
- He had surgery on Nov. 1 on his left ankle and made his first appearance this season against No. 10/9 West Virginia on Jan. 14.

MACK SUSPENDED INDEFINITELY

Sophomore guard/forward **Tevin Mack** was suspended indefinitely on Thursday, Jan. 12 for a violation of team rules.

- Coach Smart quote: "We have a set of standards that we expect people in our program to adhere to. Tevin has failed to reach them."
- In his first 15 contests this year, Mack led the team in scoring (14.8 ppg) and minutes (31.3 mpg) while hitting 45.9% (79-172) from the floor, including a team-best 39.1% (34-87) from 3-point range.
- He had reached double figures in scoring in 11 of his first 15 games.

MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICA TRADITION CONTINUES

- **Jarrett Allen** and **Andrew Jones** both compete in the 2016 McDonald's All-American Game.
- Allen and Jones became the 17th and 18th players in UT history to participate in the McDonald's All-American Game.
- This marks the fourth time in UT program history that the Longhorns have had at least two McDonald's All-Americans in the same year: 2004 (LaMarcus Aldridge, Daniel Gibson and Mike Williams), 2006 (D.J. Augustin and Kevin Durant) and 2010 (Cory Joseph and Tristan Thompson).

TRIO OF HORNS WIN GOLD MEDAL FOR TEAM USA

- Head coach Shaka Smart was able to spend almost three full weeks with freshmen Jarrett Allen and James Banks during the summer.
- Smart served as the head coach for the USA U18 National Team, which competed in July at the FIBA Americas U18 Championship in Valdivia, Chile. Allen and Banks both earned spots on the final 12-man roster for Team USA.
- Allen led Team USA and ranked fourth in the tournament overall in rebounding (9.0 rpg) and topped the squad in minutes played (23.8 mpg). He ranked third on the team in scoring (10.6 ppg) and tied for third in blocked shots (5).
- Banks played in four of the five games during the tourney and led Team USA in blocks (7). He ranked sixth on the squad in rebounding (4.5 rpg) despite playing just 9.8 minutes per contest. Banks added 2.3 ppg and grabbed 9 of his 18 rebounds off the offensive glass.
- Smart posted a 5-0 mark with the Under-18 National Team. The
 Americans recorded a +30.4 average margin of victory (93.463.0) and led the tournament in scoring (93.4 ppg), field goal
 percentage (.461) assists (25.0 apg), steals (13.4 spg) and blocked
 shots (6.8 bpg).

OSETKOWSKI SITS OUT TRANSFER YEAR

Junior forward **Dylan Osetkowski** (pronounced: oh-set-COW-skee) spent his freshman and sophomore seasons at Tulane University (2014-15 and 2015-16) and played in 65 career games for the Green Wave. He elected to transfer to Texas and began taking classes in Austin in Summer 2016. Osetkowski will sit out the 2016-17 season due to NCAA transfer rules and have two seasons of eligibility remaining, beginning in the 2017-18 season.

- Osetkowski impressed during his one public appearance in a Texas uniform this fall. He posted a game-high 17 points (7-7 FG) and 10 rebounds in 24 minutes during the Texas Tip-Off.
- As a sophomore at Tulane (2015-16), he registered a team-best 11 double-doubles and led the squad in rebounding (8.3 rpg) while starting all 34 games for the Green Wave. Osetkowski ranked third on the team in scoring (11.3 ppg) and second in minutes (32.4 mpg).

UT INKS TRIO DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

Jase Febres (Houston, Texas), Royce Hamm Jr. (Houston, Texas) and Jericho Sims (Minneapolis, Minn.) signed National Letters of Intent to play basketball next season at The University of Texas during the early signing period. The trio will join the Longhorns for the 2017-18 season.

- **Febres** [pronounced: JAYCE FEB-rus] (6-5, 180), a guard from Westfield HS who plays under coach Van Price, is ranked as the No. 47 overall prospect in the nation by Scout.com and No. 63 by Rivals.com. He averaged 17.1 ppg, 5.8 rpg and 3.8 apg assists per game during his junior year.
- Hamm Jr. (6-7, 200), a forward from Aldine Davis HS who plays under coach Larry Skinner, is ranked as the No. 74 overall prospect in the nation by ESPN and No. 89 by Scout. com. He averaged 22.1 ppg and 7.1 rpg as a junior while leading the Falcons to a 29-3 record.

• Sims (6-9, 220), a forward from Cristo Rey Jesuit HS who plays under coach Stanley Clay, is ranked as the No. 48 overall prospect in the nation by Scout.com, No. 54 by Rivals.com and No. 67 by ESPN. He averaged 21.8 ppg, 11.2 rpg, 3.7 apg and 1.4 bpg as a junior.

NAVY SEAL TEAM PT - YEAR TWO AT TEXAS

- After using Navy SEAL Team PT for his final four years at VCU, head coach Shaka Smart and Basketball strength/conditioning coach Daniel Roose brought the preseason program to Texas.
- All players and members of the UT coaching and support staff took part in a four-day training session on Sept. 19-22.
- The goals of the training were to improve communication, leadership and team-building while getting players out of their comfort zone.
- John McGuire (@SEALTeamPT), who spent 10 years as a Navy SEAL and the past 18 years organizing training sessions that incorporate some of the same rugged regimens, led the training.

SUCCESS IN THE CLASSROOM

- Five Texas players earned a spot on the 2016 Academic All-Big 12 Men's Basketball Team. Prince Ibeh and Danny Newsome were named to the First Team, while Demarcus Holland, Connor Lammert and Isaiah Taylor were selected to the Second Team.
 UT's five total selections were the most in the league.
- Texas Basketball has received public recognition awards for its
 multi-year NCAA Division I Academic Progress Rate (APR) in
 EACH of the last SEVEN years (2010-16). The awards are given
 each spring to teams scoring in the top 10 percent of all squads
 in their respective sport. UT has earned a perfect 1,000 score in
 EACH of the last SEVEN multi-year APR reports. In addition,
 Men's Basketball has posted perfect 1,000 APR single-year scores
 in EVERY season dating back to 2005-06 (10 consecutive years).

THREE-POINT STREAK

- The last time Texas did NOT convert a 3-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc that day.
- The Longhorns enter Monday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 877 consecutive games.
- In fact, UT has converted at least one 3-pointer in 1,005 of 1,012 games since the 3-pointer was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- The Horns have failed to ATTEMPT at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988 at TCU, 69-55 win).

OFF THE COURT WITH THE HORNS

- Shaquille Cleare's father, Brian, played basketball at the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma (Chickasha, Okla.). He wears jersey No. 32 to honor his father, who also wore No. 32 during his collegiate playing days.
- Eric Davis Jr.'s father, Eric Sr., played football at Saginaw Valley College (1992-94). His uncle, Tony Davis, played basketball at the University of Minnesota. Eric's mother's name is Merry Christmas.
- Tevin Mack's brother, Jermaine Washington, played basketball for two seasons at the University of Nevada (2003-05). In Washington's senior year, Nevada defeated Texas in the 2005 NCAA First Round.
- Kerwin Roach Jr.'s father, Kerwin Sr., played basketball at Texas Southern University. Kerwin won back-to-back 5A state championships in the triple jump for North Shore HS as a junior (2014) and senior (2015). Roach also set a Nike Clyde Littlefield Texas Relays meet record with a jump of 50-8.00 (15.44 meters) in April 2015 on the UT campus.
- Kendal Yancy's brother, Terrel Harris, played basketball at Oklahoma State and went on to play professionally with the Miami Heat (2011-13) and New Orleans Hornets.




