## SEC / Big 12 Challenge Notebook

 The Challenge is in its fourth consecutive season. ESPN CollegeGameday will originate from the Kansas at Kentucky game.

 The Big 12 has won the event each of its first three seasons posting a 7-3 mark last year, 6-4 two seasons ago and a 7-3 record in 2013-14 for a 20-10 (.667) mark overall.

 Big 12 teams are 42-26 (.618) against SEC foes in the past five years.

 The Big 12 is 48-30 (.615) in the last two conference challenge series it has played (vs. Pac-10, SEC) dating back to 2007.

## CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

 A total of 29 of 40 (72.5 percent) league games so far have been decided by 10 points or less - including 11 of the last 15 matchups.

 The Big 12 is the only conference with every team among the top 77 of the ESPN BPI, with eight in the top 44. Seven league squads rank among the top 43 of the latest RPI.

 Every team in the Big 12 has been ranked or received votes in the top 25 polls this season - including five squads this week.

 The Big 12 has posted a .600 win percentage versus the ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC - tied (Big East) for the best percentage of any conference among that group.

 The Big 12 has won over 61 percent of its games versus the conferences listed above - the best two-year stretch in Big 12 history.

 Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 97-21 non-conference record during 2016-17. Fourteen losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.

 Big 12 teams boasts a .822 non-conference winning percentage this season - the best of any league in the nation.

 The current non-conference win percentage of .822 would rank as the 14th-best in NCAA history.

 Four of the five non-conference losses suffered by the five Big 12 teams with only one loss were by four points or less (average margin, 5.2 points).

 The 21 combined non-league losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 28 (Big East).

 The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.

 Big 12 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among active conferences with a .610 mark.

 Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament and has at least 100 career victories during their respective careers.

 Seven coaches have career win percentages of .700 or better and the group of all 10 coaches boasts more than 3,600 career victories.

**BAYLOR (19-1, 7-1)**

- ☒ Junior forward Johnathan Motley has scored in double figures 15 times this season and has five double-doubles in the past nine games. He is averaging 24.0 points and 12.3 rebounds over the last three games, shooting 48.9 percent.
- ☒ Baylor's 19-1 record is the best 20-game start in program history and the 7-1 Big 12 mark is the top seven-game start ever. The Bears have 90 wins in conference play since 2008 after going 45-13 in the league's first 11 seasons.
- ☒ BU is 17-14 in Big 12 road games since 2014 and 26-23 in conference road matchups since 2012 - both marks are second-best in the league. The Bears are 41-4 over the last two campaigns when leading at any point in the second half.

**IOWA STATE (13-6, 5-3)**

- ☒ Senior Matt Thomas had a career-high 25 points against K-State, including a career-best seven 3-pointers. In his last two outings versus the Wildcats, he has 45 points, shooting 69.6 percent - including 12-of-18 (66.7 percent) from beyond the arc.
- ☒ ISU is 12-0 this season when leading at halftime, with 18 straight wins in such games. The Cyclones have made 10 or more 3-pointers in a game eight times this season and have fewer turnovers than their opponent in all but two contests.
- ☒ Senior guard Monté Morris is the second player in Iowa State history and third in Big 12 history to amass 1,000 career points, 600 assists and 200 steals. He needs four more thefts to move into the top 10 of the all-time Big 12 list.

**KANSAS (18-2, 7-1)**

- ☒ Freshman guard Josh Jackson led the Jayhawks with 22 points on 7-of-12 shooting at West Virginia, including 4-for-4 from 3-point range. He has had 15 points or more in six of his last seven outings with a total of 12 steals.
- ☒ Senior center Landen Lucas has grabbed 10 rebounds or more in seven of his last nine games. He is averaging 11.3 boards and 8.9 points during that stretch while shooting 62.7 percent from the field.
- ☒ The win over Texas marked the 50th straight victory for Kansas at Allen Fieldhouse. The Jayhawks own the nation's longest homecourt winning streak and are 755-109 (.874) all-time at the venue, including 216-9 (.960) under Bill Self.

**KANSAS STATE (15-5, 4-4)**

- ☒ K-State boasted five players scored in double figures for the sixth time this season at Iowa State. Senior Wesley Iwundu led the team in scoring for the 13th time in his career and the fourth time this year with 15 points.
- ☒ Four of the Wildcats' five losses have come by five points or less and by a total of 18 points. Kansas State has defeated at least one top 25 opponent in each of the last 11 seasons after recording the win over West Virginia.
- ☒ Against West Virginia, Iwundu became the first Wildcat in school history to post 1,000 points, 500 rebounds, 300 assists and 100 steals in his career. Rolando Blackman is the only former K-State player to reach the first three plateaus.

**OKLAHOMA (8-11, 2-6)**

- ☒ Freshman forward Kristian Doolittle had a career-high 29 points to go along with 10 rebounds at Texas. He has scored in double digits in three straight outings after having just two double-figure efforts on the season prior to the current stretch.
- ☒ Freshman guard Kameron McGusty also recorded a career best at UT, finishing with 21 points. He has seven consecutive double-digit performances and is averaging 15.9 points while shooting 42.7 percent during the string.
- ☒ Woodard is averaging 16.6 points and 5.6 rebounds with 12 steals since returning to OU's starting lineup on January 14 against Texas Tech. He has also moved into 14th on the Oklahoma all-time scoring list (1,407 points).

**OKLAHOMA STATE (12-8, 2-6)**

- ☒ Junior Jeffrey Carroll has scored 21 points or more five times in the last seven outings. He is averaging 21.4 points and 7.6 boards since the calendar turned to January 1, shooting 62.7 percent from the field and 66.7 percent from 3-point range.
- ☒ Oklahoma State matched its win total from all of last season with the victory over TCU and improved to 7-2 against the Frogs since they joined the Big 12. The Cowboys have won back-to-back league games for the first time since February 2015.
- ☒ Head coach Brad Underwood recorded his 100th career victory with the win at Texas Tech. He reached the mark in his 122nd career game, tying him for the 10th-fastest coach in college basketball history to reach the 100-win plateau.

**TCU (14-6, 3-5)**

- ☒ Junior forward Vladimir Brodziansky recorded his fifth 20-point game of the season at OSU. Since entering the starting lineup 11 games ago, he is averaging 15.7 points and 7.1 rebounds while shooting 57.1 percent from the floor.
- ☒ TCU shot 95.2 percent from the free throw line at Oklahoma State, the sixth-best percentage in school history. The Horned Frogs finished 20-of-21, including 14-of-14 from the charity stripe in the second half.
- ☒ Over the last two outings, junior Kenrich Williams has 36 points and 24 rebounds with just one turnover. He is shooting 59.1 percent during that stretch and has 12 double-digit scoring and 11 double-figure rebounding efforts in 2016-17.

**TEXAS (8-12, 2-6)**

- ☒ Senior forward Shaquille Cleare posted a career-best 23 points versus Oklahoma and has now scored in double digits in four straight games. He had four double figure scoring efforts on the season before the current stretch.
- ☒ Freshman forward Jarrett Allen has reached double digits in scoring in seven of eight Big 12 contests. He is averaging a double-double (14.9 ppg, 11.0 rpg) in league play with 17 blocks - one less than the combined total for the rest of the team.
- ☒ In the last four games, freshman guard Andrew Jones is averaging 15.8 points and 5.0 rebounds with 13 assists. He has made 20-of-39 (.513) field goals, including 11-of-22 (.500) from 3-point range, during that string.

**TEXAS TECH (14-6, 3-5)**

- ☒ Junior guard Keenan Evans has scored in double digits in a career-best nine straight outings. He leads the Red Raiders in scoring over the last six contests with 15.8 points per game while shooting 46.3 percent from the field.
- ☒ Junior Zach Smith has scored 11 points or more in six of his last seven outings, grabbing at least seven rebounds in eight of the past 10 games. He has also recorded at least one blocked shot in all but one conference game this season.
- ☒ Texas Tech has shot 40 percent or better in seven straight contests and has reached the mark in all but one outing in 2016-17. The Red Raiders are second in the Big 12 in field goal percentage overall with a .493 mark.

**WEST VIRGINIA (16-4, 5-3)**

- ☒ West Virginia is the first team since Indiana in 2011-12 to defeat the No. 1 and No. 2 teams in the Associated Press poll in the same season. The Mountaineers are 3-0 overall versus top 25 foes this year.
- ☒ Sophomore forward Esa Ahmad had a season-best 27 points versus Kansas, more than he had in the previous four contests combined. It was his 12th double-digit scoring performance of the year.
- ☒ Junior guard Jevon Carter has nine assists with just one turnover against KU, the ninth time in 2016-17 he has had one turnover or less. He also has 15 steals in his last five outings and has five or more in a game five times this year.
