BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

Van Wicklen felt the pressure of excelling at his sport for his school, but recognizes without his athletic scholarship, he would not be able to pursue his dream of competing at an elite level. CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

Eight teams in the Big 12 have winning percentages of .609 or higher - tied for the highest total of any conference in the nation.

A total of 41 of 55 (74.5 percent) league games so far have been decided by 10 points or less - including 23 of the last 30 matchups. The average margin of victory in all conference games this season is 7.1 points.

The Big 12 is the only conference with every team among the top 79 of the ESPN BPI, with eight in the top 43. Seven league squads rank among the top 49 of the latest RPI.

Big 12 men's basketball has the best cumulative strength of schedule of any conference in the nation for 2016-17.

Every team in the Big 12 has been ranked or received votes in the top 25 polls this season - including six squads this week.

The Big 12 has posted a .575 win percentage versus the ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC - the eighth straight year that it has been .500 or better against the nation's top conferences.

For the fourth time in four years, the Big 12/SEC Challenge trophy will remain with the Big 12 as the leagues split the 10 contests this season. Big 12 teams are 25-15 (.625) in the event since it began.

Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 102-26 non-conference record during 2016-17. Seventeen losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.

Big 12 teams boasts a .797 non-conference winning percentage this season - the best of any league in the nation.

The 26 combined non-league losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 28 (Big East).

The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.

Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament and has at least 100 career victories during their respective careers.

Seven coaches have career win percentages of .700 or better and the group of all 10 coaches boasts more than 3,600 career victories.

**BAYLOR (21-3, 8-3)**

- ☒ Baylor improved to 21-3 and 8-3 in Big 12 play with the win at OSU, tying the best records at those points in the season in program history (20II-I2). The Bears have won four straight against Oklahoma State for the first time in series history.
- ☒ Junior forward Johnathan Motley notched his third consecutive double-double and became the 31st player in program history (13th under Scott Drew) to surpass the 1,000-point plateau (1,021). He has six games this year with 20 points or more.
- ☒ BU has 20 wins for a school record sixth straight season and the ninth time in the past 10 years. The Bears have 146 wins overall since 20II-I2, the second-most of any Big I2 squad (Kansas).

**KANSAS (21-3, 9-2)**

- ☒ Senior guard Frank Mason has scored 21 points or more six times in the last 10 outings. He is averaging 20.4 points and 5.1 assists - no player in Big I2 or KU history has finished with 20 or more points and 5+ assists in a single season.
- ☒ Senior center Landen Lucas has 10 or more rebounds nine times this season, including eight Big I2 contests and four of his last six outings. He has at least five boards in every league game and is shooting 61.3 percent in Big I2 contests.
- ☒ Kansas has at least 21 victories overall for the 28th consecutive season. The Jayhawks need one more victory to notch their 10th league win - which would be the 23rd year in a row that KU has recorded double-digit conference victories.

**OKLAHOMA (8-15, 2-9)**

- ☒ Freshman guard Kameron McGusty extended his streak of double-digit scoring efforts to 11 by finishing with 11 points and three rebounds versus WVU. His 11 games in a row marks the longest such streak by an OU freshman in the past 25 years.
- ☒ Freshman Kristian Doolittle has grabbed at least five rebounds in 11 consecutive outings, including nine or more three times. He ranks third among all Big I2 freshmen in rebounding with 6.3 per contest and is also sixth in scoring (8.7 ppg).
- ☒ Junior forward Khadeem Lattin has 157 career blocked shots in 94 games, a total that ranks fourth on the OU all-time record list. He has recorded four or more rejections in six different outings in 2016-17.

**TCU (17-7, 6-5)**

- ☒ The six conference victories by the Horned Frogs are their most in five seasons in the Big I2 and the 6-5 record is the latest where TCU has been over .500. The team also has a three-game Big I2 win streak for the first time.
- ☒ Freshman guard Jaylen Fisher posted a career-high 17 points against Texas Tech, his third straight game in double figures. He has had multiple 3-pointers in three straight outings and the Frogs are now 12-1 when he scores in double digits.
- ☒ For the first time since the 2001-02 season, TCU has a pair of teammates with at least 100 assists - Alex Robinson (132) and Fisher (105). During the '01-02 campaign, Corey Santee dished out 180 while Junior Blount recorded 131.

**TEXAS TECH (16-8, 4-7)**

- ☒ Senior forward Anthony Livingston scored in double digits for the fourth straight outing with a team-high 14 points at TCU. He is shooting 56.3 percent over his last two games, including 5-of-9 (.556) from 3-point range.
- ☒ Junior forward Zach Smith is averaging a double-double in the past four outings (13.8 ppg, 10.0 rpg). He has grabbed at least seven boards in 12 of the last 14 contests with at least one blocked shot in all but two games in 2016-17.
- ☒ Texas Tech has shot over 40 percent in all but two games this year and ranks second in the Big I2 in field goal percentage (.482) overall. The Red Raiders have also shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line seven times in league play.

**IOWA STATE (14-9, 6-5)**

- ☒ Senior guard Matt Thomas is the 34th Cyclone in school history to reach 1,000 career points (1,013). He has 52 double-figure career scoring efforts and has converted at least four 3-pointers in four of his last five contests.
- ☒ Thomas and fellow guards Monté Morris and Naz Mitrou-Long are the second trio in ISU history to each have 1,000 or more career points at the same time (Julius Michalik, Fred Hoiberg and Loren Meyer, 1995).
- ☒ Since the Big I2 began play in 1997, Iowa State has recorded four wins over Kansas in Lawrence. The other league squads have combined for six victories - with no school having more than one.

**KANSAS STATE (16-8, 5-6)**

- ☒ Sophomore forward Dean Wade collected his third career 20-point outing with 20 points and six rebounds versus Kansas. He has 32 points in the last two contests after totaling four points in the previous two games.
- ☒ Sophomore guard Kamau Stokes has scored in double digits in 14 straight outings, including every conference contest. He is averaging a team-best 14.1 points during the 14-game span, while shooting 41.0 percent from 3-point range.
- ☒ K-State has had four players score in double digits in one game 18 times this season. The Wildcats have six players averaging eight points or more overall and the starters account for 78.2 percent of the team scoring.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (15-9, 4-7)**

- ☒ Junior Jeffrey Carroll had 13 of his 20 points by halftime against Baylor, the 14th time this season he has reached double figures by the half. He has had eight games with 20 points or more in his last 11 contests.
- ☒ Over his last six outings, sophomore guard Jawun Evans is averaging 18.0 points and 4.2 rebounds with 34 assists. He has 13 games this season with at least 10 points and five assists and 27 double-digit scoring efforts in his career.
- ☒ OSU's five-game winning streak was its longest after Jan. 1 since 2012-13 and was also the first time since that season that the Cowboys won three straight league road games. The five true road wins overall are tied for second-most in the Big I2.

**TEXAS (10-14, 4-7)**

- ☒ Half of the UT games overall have been decided by five points or less. All home league contests for Texas have had a margin of four points or fewer and the team has won three straight in conference play at home.
- ☒ Freshman forward Jarrett Allen has led the Longhorns in scoring in seven of the past nine outings and has reached double digits in scoring 17 times. He converted two free throws versus Iowa State with seven seconds left for the winning margin.
- ☒ Senior forward Shaquille Cleare has finished with double-figure point totals 10 times this season after having reached the mark just twice prior to 2016-17. He has also shot 50 percent or better 15 times this year.

**WEST VIRGINIA (19-5, 7-4)**

- ☒ Freshman James Bolden scored a career-high 17 points, including 15 in the first half, in the win at OU. He scored more than half of the Mountaineers' first half points en route to a higher point total than in his previous five games combined.
- ☒ Senior forward Nathan Adrian has scored in double figures 14 times this season and is averaging 15.0 points in his last three outings. He has also shot 50 percent or better from the field in seven of the past nine games.
- ☒ West Virginia had 12 steals at Oklahoma, its 13th performance this season with 10 or more thefts. The Mountaineers continue to lead the nation in steals, turnover forced and turnover margin.
