CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Eight teams in the Big 12 have winning percentages of .625 or higher - tied for the highest total of any conference in the nation.
- A total of 42 of 60 (70 percent) league games so far have been decided by 10 points or less - including 24 of the last 35 matchups. The average margin of victory in all conference games this season is 7.7 points.
- The Big 12 is the only conference with every team among the top 82 of the ESPN BPI, with eight in the top 46. Seven league squads rank among the top 55 of the latest RPI.
- Big 12 men's basketball has the best cumulative strength of schedule of any conference in the nation for 2016-17.
- Every team in the Big 12 has been ranked or received votes in the top 25 polls this season.
- The Big 12 has posted a .575 win percentage versus the ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC - the eighth straight year that it has been .500 or better against the nation's top conferences.
- For the fourth time in four years, the Big 12/SEC Challenge trophy will remain with the Big 12 as the leagues split the 10 contests this season. Big 12 teams are 25-15 (.625) in the event since it began.
- Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 102-26 non-conference record during 2016-17. Seventeen losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.
- Big 12 teams boasts a .797 non-conference winning percentage this season - the best of any league in the nation.
- The 26 combined non-league losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 28 (Big East).
- The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.
- Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament and has at least 100 career victories during their respective careers.
- Seven coaches have career win percentages of .700 or better and the group of all 10 coaches boasts more than 3,600 career victories.

BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

The Big 12 Champions for Life initiative showcases the success stories of student-athletes and how an athletic scholarship has positively impacted their lives. **BAYLOR (22-3, 9-3)**

- The Baylor won-loss record through 25 games is its best overall mark and Big 12 record in program history. The Bears have recorded their sixth straight 22-win season after entering the year as one of 19 teams to have done so the previous five.
- Junior forward Johnathan Motley recorded his seventh 20-point performance this year with 25 points and seven boards versus TCU. He is averaging 24.5 points in his last two contests and has miss only six field goals combined.
- BU is 5-0 this season when senior guard Ishmail Wainright has five or more points, rebounds and assists in the same game. He has nine assists in his last two outings and has dished out five or more seven times in 2016-17.

**IOWA STATE (15-9, 7-5)**

- Iowa State has swept Oklahoma for only the fifth time since 1967 and first time since 2012 after Saturday's win. The Cyclones made 12 field goals from 3-point range versus OU, the 12th straight outing they have made at least nine in a game this year.
- Senior guard Monté Morris had nine assists with zero turnovers against the Sooners, his 47th career game without a miscue. He has 23 assists with no turnovers the last three contests and a 28.0 assist-to-turnover ratio the last five.
- Forward Solomon Young made his first career start in the matchup against OU, the first Cyclone freshman to start a game since Morris in 2013-14. Young tallied eight points on 4-of-5 shooting, posting his highest point total since December 20.

**KANSAS (22-3, 10-2)**

- Freshman guard Josh Jackson finished with a career-high 31 points at Texas Tech, including the game-winning free throw with 2.8 seconds left. It was the most points by a KU freshman since March 8, 2014 (Andrew Wiggins, 22 at West Virginia).
- Senior guard Frank Mason is expected to make his 100th consecutive start on Monday, only the sixth Kansas player in school history to do so. He has moved into 13th place on the Jayhawks' all-time scoring list with 1,634 points.
- Kansas has 22 victories for the 28th consecutive season and has reached double-figure league victories for the 23rd straight campaign. The Jayhawks are 11-2 in games away from Allen Fieldhouse and 4-1 in contests decided by five points or less.

**KANSAS STATE (16-9, 5-7)**

- Senior Wesley Iwundu paced five Wildcats in double figures with 14 points at West Virginia. He has reached double digits in eight straight contests and has at least six rebounds in all but one game during that stretch.
- Sophomore guard Kamau Stokes has scored in double digits in 15 straight outings, including every conference contest. He is averaging a team-best 14.0 points during that span, shooting 39.5 percent from 3-point range and 80.0 percent from the line.
- Against West Virginia, K-State used a different lineup for the first time in 2016-17 when senior forward D.J. Johnson sat out due to an ankle injury. It broke a string of 51 consecutive games played for Johnson.

**OKLAHOMA (8-16, 2-10)**

- Senior guard Jordan Woodard tore the ACL in his right knee at Iowa State and will miss the remainder of the season. He saw action in 125 career games and ranks in the top 10 at OU for assists, free throws and steals and 14th in scoring (1,440 points).
- Freshman guard Kameron McGusty extended his streak of double-digit scoring efforts to 12 by finishing with 12 points at ISU. The double-figure string is the longest by any Big 12 freshman this season.
- Junior forward Khadeem Lattin has grabbed a combined 26 rebounds over his last two contests. He also has 12 blocked shots in his past four outings and has at least one rejection in 19 of 24 games in 2016-17.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (16-9, 5-7)**

- OSU has wins in six of its last seven contests, its best stretch since winning seven in a row in 2012-13. The Cowboys are averaging 86.4 points this year - which would rank as the second-best scoring mark in Big 12 history (Kansas, 90.9 ppg, 2001-02).
- Junior Jeffrey Carroll has scored at least 18 point in nine of his last 10 outings and 16 times overall this year. Since January 1, he is averaging a team-best 19.5 points while shooting .541 from the field and .844 from the free throw line.
- Sophomore Devon Dillard has scored in double digits in three of the last six contests with at least eight points in five of those games. He has 53 points during the six-game string, more than 60 percent of his season points total.

**TCU (17-8, 6-6)**

- Freshman guard Jaylen Fisher had a career-high point total for the second straight game, finishing with 18 points at Baylor. He has scored in double figures for four straight outings, with TCU at 12-2 this season when Fisher reaches the plateau.
- Sophomore forward JD Miller has 13 field goals from 3-point range in his last six outings after not having any in the previous six contests. He has half of his season total for 3-points in the past four games, shooting 73.3 percent from beyond the arc.
- The six conference victories by the Horned Frogs are their most in five seasons in the Big 12. TCU had a season-low seven turnovers at Baylor on Saturday and has 143 fewer miscues overall than it did a year ago.

**TEXAS (10-15, 4-8)**

- Freshman forward Jarrett Allen has led the Longhorns in scoring in eight of the past 10 outings and has posted double-digit point totals 18 times. He is averaging 19.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in February, shooting 67.3 percent from the field.
- Six of the UT losses in league play have been decided by 10 points or less, with seven of 15 defeats overall determined by five or fewer. All home Big 12 contests for Texas have had a margin of four points or less.
- Freshman guard Andrew Jones has finished with 10 points or more in nine consecutive outings and 16 times overall this season. He has also dished out 32 assists over his last five contests.

**TEXAS TECH (16-9, 4-8)**

- Junior guard Niem Stevenson started his third straight game and had a career-high 22 points versus Kansas. He has finished in double digits in four of the last five contests after having done so five times on the season prior to the current string.
- Junior guard Keenan Evans has posted double-digit scoring totals in 13 consecutive games and has shot 50 percent or better from the field 13 times overall in 2016-17. He has converted 29 of his 41 season 3-pointers over the last 15 outings.
- Junior forward Zach Smith is averaging a double-double in the past five contests (15.2 ppg, 10.0 rpg). He has grabbed at least nine boards in four straight games and at least one blocked shot in all but two matchups in 2016-17.

**WEST VIRGINIA (20-5, 8-4)**

- West Virginia recorded the 31st 20-win season in school history and third straight with the victory over K-State. It marks the 28th campaign with 20 or victories for Bob Huggins in 35 years as a head coach.
- All but six Mountaineer opponents have had at least 18 turnovers this year, including three above 30. WVU has 15 or more steals eight times in 2016-17 and has forced foes to turn it over on 29.4 percent of possessions, a mark that is first nationally.
- Sophomore forward Esa Ahmad has scored in double figures in four of his last six outings and was 5-of-6 (.833) from the floor against K-State. He has 15 double-digit scoring performances overall this season.
