First Pitch...

A late change to the schedule brings opening weekend to L. Dale Mitchell Park for the University of Oklahoma baseball team. Originally scheduled to be on the road, the Sooners host No. 17 Long Beach State in Norman due to inclement weather in California.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is coming off a 30-27-1 campaign with an 11-13 record and fifth-place finish in the Big 12 a season ago. Seven position players that started 30 or more games last season return, including sophomore outfielder Steele Walker. He is one of three Louisville Slugger Freshman All-Americans from 2016 and hit .290 with 17 doubles; tied for the second most on record by an OU freshman. Senior first baseman Austin O'Brien, who was an All-Big 12 Freshman Team performer in 2014, is the only four-year player under fourth-year head coach Pete Hughes. O'Brien enters his final season in Norman with 104 career hits and 10 home runs. In 2016, he hit .267 with a .424 slugging percentage on nine doubles and five home runs. Senior Jack Flansburg started multiple games at all four infield positions last season, including each of the first 47 games of the year before being sidelined with a hamstring injury. He earned All-Big 12 Honorable Mention as a .278 hitter with 32 runs scores and 29 driven in. Sophomore right-hander Jake Irvin finished his rookie campaign as the Friday night starter. He resumes that roll after posting a 6-2 record with a 4.47 earned run average in 2016.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 20 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 617-468-3 (.569), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Dirtbags...

Long Beach State is coming off a 38-22 2016 campaign, which ended in a one-run loss to Miami (Fla.) in the Coral Gables Regional Final. The Dirtbags are ranked No. 17 in the USA Today and No. 20 in the Baseball America preseason polls. Receiving 65 votes, in the Big West Conference 2017 preseason baseball coach's poll, Long Beach is projected to finish second in the conference. First baseman **Daniel Jackson** was an All-Big West Second selection hitting a team-high .321 in 2016 with .491 slugging percentage and six home runs. Right-handed pitcher **Darren McCaughan** comes into the season as the reigning Big West Pitcher of the year. In 2016, McCaughan made 16 starts and finished the year with a 10-1 record, 2.03 ERA and 0.83 WHIP with 84 strikeouts in 111 innings pitched. He also became the 12th player in Long Beach State history to compete for the Team USA Collegiate National Team.

Last Time They Met...

The 2016 series between OU and LBSU began with the Sooners getting swept in a doubleheader. A bright spot for the Sooners was **Jack Flansburg**, who went 4-for-7, including a home run in game one of the doubleheader. **Sheldon Neuse** blasted a three-run homer in game two to give OU a 3-2 lead, but the Dirtbags would battle back as McCaughan claimed the 6-3 victory with six innings of work. The Sooners managed to win the series finale thanks to a three-run, walk-off home run from **Hunter Haley** to complete a ninth-inning comeback as Oklahoma defeated Long Beach State, 6-3. The victory marked the beginning of a six game win streak.

All-Time vs. Long Beach...

Oklahoma has lost four of its six match-ups all-time against Long Beach State. The two teams first met in 1989 at the NCAA West I Regional in Tucson, Ariz. The Dirtbags won, 11-4, in a winner's bracket game. In 1997, LBSU got the better of OU, 1-0, in the opener of the NCAA South I Regional in Baton Rouge, La. Oklahoma picked up its first win of the series in 2006; a 2-1 decision at the Rice Tournament. **P.J. Sandoval** went toe-to-toe with future MLB pitcher **Vance Worley** to earn the win. In 2016, LBSU took the first two games before the Sooners won the series finale on a walk-off, three-run home run by **Hunter Haley**.

Up Next...

Oklahoma hosts Grambling State in its originally-scheduled home opener on Tuesday. First pitch is set for 3 pm with a second game to be played at the same time on Wednesday afternoon. The Sooners and Tigers have met once; an OU win at the 1985 NCAA Central Regional in Austin, Texas.

D1Baseball.com Rankings...

Several Sooners earned spots on various preseason rankings lists put out by D1Baseball.com over the last few weeks. Senior right-hander **JB Olson** checks in as the No. 47 ranked relief pitcher in the country after posting a 2.03 ERA as the OU setup man in 2016. A trifecta of Sooners, led by No. 56 **Dylan Grove**, appear on the list of top prospects for the 2018 draft. He is joined by No. 73 **Jake Irvin** and No. 109 **Domenic DeRenzo**.

Returning Freshman All-Americans...

Back in June, three Sooner rookies were named Louisville Slugger Freshman All-Americans by *Collegiate Baseball News*. Catcher **Domenic DeRenzo**, righty **Jake Irvin** and outfielder **Steele Walker** all represented Oklahoma. They became just the second class in OU history to feature three freshman All-Americans; joining **Craig Ai-kin**, **Jacob Evans** and **Anthony Hermelyn** from 2013. In 2014, **Sheldon Neuse** was the first to earn freshman All-America under Hughes.

Weekly Awards:

Skip Brought on Board...

On June 27, exactly three years after head coach **Pete Hughes** was hired, he announced the addition of **Skip Johnson** to the Oklahoma staff. Johnson took over as the Sooners pitching coach after 10 seasons at rival Texas. He previously was the head coach at Navarro College for 13 seasons. During his 10 seasons in Austin, 32 pitchers were drafted, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first round picks.

Walker Wields Wood Well With Woodchucks...

Following his freshman campaign, outfielder **Steele Walker** spent his summer with the Wisconsin Woodchucks of the Northwoods League. He won the league's batting crown with a .406 average as he collected 86 hits in 53 games, including a club-record 20-game hit streak. The closest challenger to Walker for the batting title was 46 points back at .360. For the summer, he scored 47 runs and drove in 31, while adding 11 doubles and seven home runs.

Black History Month...

This season marks the anniversary of **Michael Pace** integrating OU baseball as he became the first black player in program history. Pace made his Sooner debut at old Haskell Park in Norman against New Mexico on March 15, 1977. In limited action he hit .349 (15-for-43) with 11 runs scored and four home runs. Pace was drafted and signed out of the 11th round by the Philadelphia Phillies.

Home Field Notes...

Oklahoma finished its 2016 home slate by winning all four Big 12 series at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners posted a .640 win percentage with a 16-9 record; the best since 2013 (.806). OU averaged 1,211 in home attendance; marking a rise in each of the past three seasons and the highest since 2012 (1,283).

Oklahoma is Home...

The Sooner roster features 12 players from within the state's borders and seven from Texas. This season matches the most Oklahoma born players at OU since 12 in 2012 and the second year in a row with as many or more players from Oklahoma. Prior to last season, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home, while just five were from Texas.

Against the West...

Under head coach Pete Hughes, the Sooners are 10-4 against schools from California. When playing against teams from the Pacific or Hawaii Time Zones, OU is 16-9. When playing in the Pacific of Hawaii Time Zones, Oklahoma is 13-4-1. Since 2014, the Sooners have played seven of the 11 Pac-12 schools and posted a 3-4 record.

Big League Pitchers...

In 2015, Sooner baseball alums combined to start 68 games on the mound in Major League Baseball. That total ranks the second highest among NCAA teams; second only to Long Beach State (70). **Garrett Richards** (32), **Chase Anderson** (27) and **Jon Gray** (9) each took to the hill in 2015 with Gray making his MLB debut on August 4.

Sophomore right-hander **Jake Irvin** is scheduled to start on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He will become the fourth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last six season and third in four season with **Pete Hughes** at the helm. Irvin also becomes the third consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

Since **Pete Hughes** took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 13-32-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. Crimson Over Orange; Twice as Nice...

Last season, Oklahoma won its Big 12 series over Texas and Oklahoma State for the first time since 1998; the only other time it has happened. The **Larry Cochell**-led Sooners took two out of three from the No. 16 Cowboys in the Bedlam Series. OU won the opener at Driller Stadium and then split the next two at All Sports Stadium. Oklahoma then swept the Longhorns at home to close out the regular season. In 2016, **Pete Hughes** and the Sooners picked up a home series win over Texas and took the opener from OSU at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark then split at ONEOK Field.

Irvin's Rise...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** opened his 2016 freshman season in the rotation for the Sooners in a four-game series against Northeastern. From there, he moved to the bullpen and pitched in spot duty or long relief. At Texas Tech (3/26), Irvin struck out the side in one inning of work and followed with two-scoreless frames at Little Rock (3/29). He earned the start in Oklahoma's next midweek; a 12-2 win over Dallas Baptist (4/5) in which he got the win in five innings with five strikeouts. Irvin pitched OU to another midweek win over Wichita State (4/12) and struck out 10 in 5.1 innings against Oklahoma State (4/20). He has since risen through the Sooner rotation; pitching on Sunday at Kansas (5/1), Saturday against Kansas State (5/7) and Friday night vs. Oklahoma State (5/13).

Rare Run-Rules...

Oklahoma picked up its second run-rule of the season with a 12-0, seven-inning decision over Kansas State (5/8). The Sooners previously defeated Kansas (5/1) in seven, 17-6. Prior to that, OU had last won by run-rule against New Orleans (4/21/13). Oklahoma had last won by run-rule twice in a season in 2013 as it first defeated Arkansas-Pine Bluff (2/19/13). The win against the Wildcats this season marked the first time the OU baseball and softball teams won on a run-rule on the same day since Sooner baseball defeated Western Illinois (2/21/09).

Wild Walk Offs the Norm for Norman Nine...

Oklahoma has won five games in walk-off fashion this season, including four in Big 12 play and three coming on Sundays. The Sooners added to their total with two to claim a series win over Baylor (4/8, 4/10). Oklahoma did not lead in either game until the winning run touched home. **Sheldon Neuse** singled and **Jack Flansburg** walked in the ninth of game one. **Renae Martinez** came in to pinchhit and put down a sacrifice-bunt that was thrown away and allowed Neuse to score the walk-off run in a 4-3 win. In the second walk-off vs. Baylor, a game that featured four home runs by each side, it was three-straight singles that decided the game in extra innings. In the 11th, **Cade Harris** and **Ben Hollas** singled with two down to set up the game-winning hit for Flansburg; a 7-6 final. It marked the first series win for Oklahoma over Baylor since a 2012 sweep at home.
