CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- ✎ Eight teams in the Big 12 have winning percentages of .615 or higher - tied for the highest total of any conference in the nation.
- ✎ A total of 47 of 65 (72.3 percent) league games so far have been decided by 10 points or less - including 29 of the last 40 matchups. The average margin of victory in all conference games this season is 7.4 points.
- ✎ The Big 12 is the only conference with every team among the top 82 of the ESPN BPI, with eight in the top 48. Seven league squads rank among the top 55 of the latest RPI.
- ✎ Big 12 men's basketball has the best cumulative strength of schedule of any conference in the nation for 2016-17.
- ✎ Every team in the Big 12 has been ranked or received votes in the top 25 polls this season.
- ✎ The Big 12 has posted a .575 win percentage versus the ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC - the eighth straight year that it has been .500 or better against the nation's top conferences.
- ✎ For the fourth time in four years, the Big 12/SEC Challenge trophy will remain with the Big 12 as the leagues split the 10 contests this season. Big 12 teams are 25-15 (.625) in the event since it began.
- ✎ Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 102-26 non-conference record during 2016-17. Seventeen losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.
- ✎ Big 12 teams boasts a .797 non-conference winning percentage this season - the best of any league in the nation.
- ✎ The 26 combined non-league losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 28 (Big East).
- ✎ The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.
- ✎ Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament and has at least 100 career victories during their respective careers.
- ✎ Seven coaches have career win percentages of .700 or better and the group of all 10 coaches boasts more than 3,600 career victories.

**BAYLOR (22-4, 9-4)**

- Junior forward Terry Maston finished with a career-high 22 points in 21 minutes off the bench at Texas Tech, his eighth double-figure scoring effort of the year. He more than doubled his point output (10) from the previous three games combined.
- Junior forward Johnathan Motley has scored in double figures in nine straight contests and is averaging 20.0 points in the past three outings. Baylor is 37-9 when he finishes with at least 10 points in a game.
- The Bears have recorded their sixth straight 22-win season after entering the year as one of 19 teams to have done so in the previous five. BU's 147 overall wins since 2011-12 are the second-most wins in the Big 12 during that span (Kansas, 170).

**IOWA STATE (16-9, 8-5)**

- Iowa State has won consecutive games at Kansas State for the first time since the 2000-01 season. The Cyclones have a 20-game winning streak overall when leading at the half and are 10-0 this year when scoring 80 points or more.
- Freshman forward Solomon Young has started the last two games and is shooting 80.0 percent (12-of-15) from the field during that span. He had his first career double-double with 18 points and 12 boards versus K-State.
- Senior guard Monté Morris is tied for 15th on the ISU all-time scoring list with 1,531 points. He has 77 career games with five or more assists, has played 47 without a single turnover and has 28 assists and one miscue in the last four outings.

**KANSAS (23-3, 11-2)**

- Kansas is 4-0 this against teams ranked in the Associated Press top 10 and 33-18 (.647) versus such foes during the Bill Self era. The Jayhawks have 23 wins for the 28th consecutive season and 11 league victories for the 22nd straight year.
- KU ended the WVU game on a 21-7 run to erase a 14-point deficit with 2:43 remaining in regulation and a 34-16 finish into overtime. The Jayhawks shot 61.5 percent over that last 2:43 after shooting 27.1 percent in the first 37:17 of the game.
- Senior guard Frank Mason became the sixth player in school history to make 100 consecutive starts. He was 16-of-18 (.889) from the line versus the Mountaineers, the most free throws made by a KU player since 2004 (Wayne Simien).

**KANSAS STATE (16-10, 5-8)**

- Sophomore guard Barry Brown finished with a game-high 21 points versus Iowa State, his second 20-point effort of the year. He has totaled eight steals in the past two contests and needs five thefts to match the school single-season record.
- Senior Wesley Iwundu had his eighth career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 13 boards against the Cyclones. He has scored in double digits in nine straight outings and is shooting 57.9 percent over the last two games.
- Sophomore guard Kamau Stokes has scored in double digits in 16 straight games, including every conference contest. He is averaging a team-best 13.9 points during that span, shooting 37.6 percent from 3-point range and 80.7 percent from the line.

**OKLAHOMA (9-16, 3-10)**

- Sophomore center Jamuni McNeace posted his first career double-double with 14 points and 14 rebounds against Texas. It was more points than in his previous seven outings combined and matched his rebounding total from those seven games.
- Freshman guard Kameron McGusty extended his streak of double-digit scoring efforts to 13 by finishing with 11 points versus UT. The double-figure string is the longest by any Big 12 freshman this season.
- Senior guard Jordan Woodard tore the ACL in his right knee at Iowa State and will miss the remainder of the season. He saw action in 125 career games and ranks in the top 10 at OU for assists, free throws and steals and 14th in scoring (1,440 points).

**OKLAHOMA STATE (17-9, 6-7)**

- OSU has won four straight road games, its longest string since winning five straight Big 12 away contests in 2012-13. The Cowboys have six road wins overall, the second-most in the Big 12 and their most since the 2004-05 squad won seven.
- The Cowboys are averaging 85.8 points this year - which would rank as the second-best scoring mark in Big 12 history (Kansas, 90.9 ppg, 2001-02). Seven different players are averaging five points or more for Oklahoma State.
- Sophomore guard Jawun Evans 18.4 points and 4.9 rebounds over the last seven games, with OSU boasting a 6-1 record in those contests. He is one of 10 players on the team shooting 42 percent or better during the seven-game stretch.

**TCU (17-9, 6-7)**

- Sophomore forward JD Miller has scored in double figures four times in his last six outings after having reached the mark just four times the entire year prior to the current stretch. He also has at least one 3-pointer in seven consecutive games.
- The Horned Frogs shot a season-best 92.3 percent from the free throw line against Oklahoma State, making 12-of-13 attempts. The top two season efforts have come versus the Cowboys after making 22-of-24 (.917) against them earlier this year.
- Junior guard Kenrich Williams has 10 double-doubles this season after having two in his career prior to the current campaign. He has led TCU in boards in 19 of 26 games in 2016-17 with at least six rebounds in 20 of 23 contests.

**TEXAS (10-16, 4-9)**

- Freshman forward Jarrett Allen has led the Longhorns in scoring in nine of the past 11 outings and has posted double-digit point totals 19 times. He is averaging 18.6 points and 9.2 rebounds in February, shooting 63.1 percent from the field.
- Seven of the UT losses in league play have been decided by 10 points or less, with eight of 16 defeats overall determined by five or fewer. All home Big 12 contests for Texas have had a margin of four points or less.
- Sophomore guard Kerwin Roach Jr. has scored in double figures in back-to-back contests and has 10 assists and five steals during that span. He has reached double digits in scoring 15 times overall this season.

**TEXAS TECH (17-9, 5-8)**

- Tech has three wins over ranked opponents at home this year and has won five of its last six versus ranked foes at home dating back to last season. TTU has defeated a pair of top 10 opponents in the same season for the first time since 2007-08.
- Junior guard Niem Stevenson started his fourth straight game and finished with 21 points against BU. He is averaging 21.5 points with 16 rebounds in the past two outings and has scored in double digits in five of the last six contests.
- Junior guard Keenan Evans has posted double-digit scoring totals in 14 consecutive games and has shot 50 percent or better from the field 14 times overall in 2016-17. He has converted 31 of his 43 season 3-pointers over the last 16 outings.

**WEST VIRGINIA (20-6, 8-5)**

- West Virginia has recorded its 31st 20-win season in school history and third straight. It marks the 28th campaign with 20 or victories for Bob Huggins in 35 years as a head coach.
- Sophomore forward Esa Ahmad has scored in double figures in five of his last seven outings and is 11-of-17 (.647) from the floor in his last two contests. He has 16 double-digit scoring performances overall this season.
- All but seven Mountaineer opponents have had at least 18 turnovers this year, including three above 30. WVU has 15 or more steals eight times and leads the nation in steals, turnovers and turnover margin.
