## CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Eight teams in the Big 12 have 17 wins and winning percentages of .630 or higher - tied for the highest total of any conference in the nation.
- A total of 51 of 70 (72.9 percent) league games so far have been decided by 10 points or less - including 33 of the last 45 matchups. The average margin of victory in all conference games this season is 7.4 points.
- The Big 12 is the only conference with every team among the top 76 of the ESPN BPI, with eight in the top 49. Seven league squads rank among the top 58 of the latest RPI.
- Big 12 men's basketball has the best cumulative strength of schedule of any conference in the nation for 2016-17.
- Every team in the Big 12 has been ranked or received votes in the top 25 polls this season.
- The Big 12 has posted a .575 win percentage versus the ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC - the eighth straight year that it has been .500 or better against the nation's top conferences.
- For the fourth time in four years, the Big 12/SEC Challenge trophy will remain with the Big 12 as the leagues split the 10 contests this season. Big 12 teams are 25-15 (.625) in the event since it began.
- Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 102-26 non-conference record during 2016-17. Seventeen losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.
- Big 12 teams boasts a .797 non-conference winning percentage this season - the best of any league in the nation.
- The 26 combined non-league losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 28 (Big East).
- The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.
- Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament and has at least 100 career victories during their respective careers.
- Seven coaches have career win percentages of .700 or better and the group of all 10 coaches boasts more than 3,600 career victories.

**BAYLOR (22-5, 9-5)**

- Junior forward Johnathan Motley has scored in double figures in 10 straight contests with the Bears posting a 37-10 record in those games. He is averaging 19.8 points and 8.0 rebounds in his last four outings.
- Junior guard Manu Lecomte had made at least one 3-pointer in 13 straight games, including three or more in each of the past seven contests. He is shooting 51.0 percent from beyond the arc during the seven-game stretch.
- Junior forward Jo Lual-Acuil has 71 blocks this season, the most in the Big 12 and seventh on the Baylor single-season list. He has at least one rejection in nine consecutive outings and has scored in double digits 16 times overall in 2016-17.

**KANSAS (24-3, 12-2)**

- The Jayhawks need one victory to clinch at least a tie for a NCAA-record 13th straight regular-season conference title. KU has 24 wins overall for the 12th consecutive year and has 12 league wins for the 17th straight campaign.
- Kansas is 4-0 this season against teams ranked in the top five of the Associated Press poll. The Jayhawks have a .900 winning percentage versus top five foes under Bill Self, the highest mark of any coach at one school in NCAA history.
- Senior guard Frank Mason III has scored 20 points or more in four of his past five games and 15 times this season. He is 53-of-59 (.898) from the free throw line in the past six contests - accounting for 47.3 percent of his team's makes during that span.

**OKLAHOMA (9-17, 3-11)**

- Sophomore guard Rashard Odomes finished with career highs in both points (29) and rebounds (10) to post his first career double-double at OSU. He is averaging 10.6 points in 2016-17 after recording 1.9 per game a year ago.
- Oklahoma's 92 points were the most in the Bedlam series by the Sooners since 1990 (107). A total of 85 of the points were scored by freshmen and sophomores as OU underclassmen are averaging 51.8 points in conference contests.
- Freshman guard Kameron McGusty has scored in double figures in 14 straight outings, the longest streak by an Oklahoma freshman since 1990-91. The string is also the longest by any Big 12 freshman this season.

**TCU (17-10, 6-8)**

- TCU shot 52.7 percent at Iowa State, the 10th time the Frogs have connected at over 50 percent and second such effort on the road. The top eight scorers for TCU are all shooting 41 percent or better from the field.
- Sophomore forward JD Miller has scored in double figures five times in his last seven outings after having reached the mark just four times the entire year prior to the current stretch. He also has at least one 3-pointer in eight consecutive games.
- Junior guard Kenrich Williams has 10 double-doubles this season after having two in his career prior to the current campaign. He has led TCU in boards in 19 of 27 games in 2016-17 with at least six rebounds in 20 of 24 contests.

**TEXAS TECH (17-10, 5-9)**

- Junior guard Keenan Evans matched his career high with 28 points at WVU and extended his streak to 15 consecutive games in double figures - including four with 20 points or more. He has 33 of his 47 season 3-pointers over the last 17 outings.
- Junior Niem Stevenson has his top three scoring performances of the year over the last three games and has been in double digits in six of his last seven contests. He is averaging 20 points and 7.3 rebounds during the three-game stretch.
- Tech has three wins over ranked opponents at home this year and has won five of its last six versus ranked foes at home dating back to last season. TTU has defeated a pair of top 10 opponents in the same season for the first time since 2007-08.

**IOWA STATE (17-9, 9-5)**

- Senior guard Monté Morris has moved into a tie (Jeff Hornacek) for first in school history with 211 career steals. The theft total is third on the Big 12 all-time list and his 707 assists rank third in conference history.
- Morris notched his 14th career game with 10 or more assists in the win over TCU. He has 78 career outings with five or more assists, has played 48 without a single turnover and boasts 39 assists with just two miscues in the past five outings.
- Iowa State is 15-0 this season when leading at the half and has a 21-game winning streak in such games. The Cyclones are also 11-0 when scoring 80 or more points in 2016-17 and are averaging 18.0 assists in their last three contests.

**KANSAS STATE (17-10, 6-8)**

- Kansas State shot 53.5 percent at Texas, the 11th time this season it has hit at 50 percent or better from the field. The Wildcats made 10-of-12 (.833) from the free throw line, their best percentage since December 17.
- K-State has six victories away from home, including five true road wins and three in Big 12 play - the most in all three categories since 2012-13. The 'Cats also swept the season series with the Longhorns for the first time since 2013.
- Senior Wesley Iwundu has 20 double-figure scoring performances this season, including each of the last 10 outings. He has moved into a tie for third (Rolando Blackman, Jacob Pullen) on the K-State all-time list with 116 starts in his career.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (18-9, 7-7)**

- Oklahoma State registered its first series sweep of OU since 2004 with the victory on Saturday. Brad Underwood becomes just the fourth coach (Iba, Sutton, Hansen) in school history to win both season meetings with the Sooners.
- Sophomore guard Jawun Evans is averaging 19.5 points over the past eight contests, with the Cowboys boasting a 7-1 record in those games. He also has 21 assists with just four turnovers in the last two outings.
- Senior guard Phil Forte has moved into seventh on the OSU all-time scoring list, with 1,680 career points. He also leads the nation in free throw percentage (.949) and has converted 16 consecutive attempts from the charity stripe.

**TEXAS (10-17, 4-10)**

- Texas has had 14 of its 27 contests this season decided by five points or less, including 10 by three points or fewer. All seven of the Longhorns' conference home games have had margins of four points or less.
- Senior guard Kendal Yancy played 30 minutes against Kansas State, his most since the season opener. He finished with 13 points - his highest point total since December 21 and the sixth time he has been in double-digits this year.
- Freshman forward Jarrett Allen has led the Longhorns in scoring in nine of the past 12 outings and has posted double-digit point totals 20 times. He is averaging 17.5 points and 8.3 rebounds in February, shooting 61.1 percent from the field.

**WEST VIRGINIA (21-6, 9-5)**

- Junior guard Jevon Carter has 77 steals this season - a total that leads the Big 12 and ranks sixth nationally. He has multiple thefts in four straight outings and has at least one in all but two contests in 2016-17.
- All but seven Mountaineer opponents have had at least 18 turnovers this year, including three with more than 30. The Mountaineers have had 15 or more steals eight times and are recording 42.5 deflections per contest.
- West Virginia has recorded its 31st 20-win season in school history and third straight. It marks the 28th campaign with 20 or victories for Bob Huggins in 35 years as a head coach.
