First Pitch...

The University of Oklahoma baseball team welcomes Grambling State for its originally scheduled home opener on Tuesday, February 21 at 3 p.m. The Sooners and Tigers then face off for a second midweek game on Wednesday at the same time.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma came away with two wins over No. 17 Long Beach State at L. Dale Mitchell Park on opening weekend. The Sooners opened the season with a 6-2 win on Friday before clinching the series on Sunday with a 4-2, come-from-behind decision. Sophomore right-hander **Jake Irvin** led the way with the game one win with seven shutout innings on one-hit ball. For the series, senior third baseman **Jack Flansburg** hit .500 (5-for-10) with three runs scored. Senior catcher **Renae Martinez** started two of the three games behind the plate and went 3-for-7 with a solo home run and three RBI. As a team, Oklahoma out-hit Long Beach, 25-19, while the OU pitching staff held the Dirtbags to a .192 batting average. This week, the Sooners turn to a pair of sophomores on the mound. Right-hander **Austin Hansen** takes the hill for his first career start at OU after going 4-0 with a 2.93 earned run average in 17 relief appearances as a freshman. Righty **Ryan Madden** made three starts in 2016, all in league play, and went 1-3 with a 4.50 ERA. Hansen gets the ball on Tuesday followed by Madden on Wednesday.

Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM will be the home of Sooner baseball all season long on the air and online at Sportstalk1400.com. This week's midweek contests will simulcast the television audio through the radio broadcast. Both games will be televised by Sooner Sports TV on FOX Sports Southwest Tuesday and FOX Sports Oklahoma Wednesday. Veteran OU broadcaster **Chad McKee** will handle the play-by-play along with former Sooner and 10-year MLB veteran **George Frazier** providing the color commentary.

• Oklahoma faces a ranked opponent on opening weekend for the first time since visiting No. 1 UCLA to begin the 2008 season.

• The Sooners salvaged the series finale against the Dirtbags in 2016 by erasing a three-run deficit in the ninth and walking off on a three-run home run by Hunter Haley.

• Seniors Renae Martinez, Austin O'Brien and JB Olson were elected captains by their teammates in fall ball.

• The Sooners are 24-3 when playing the first game of the season at home since 1962.

• In 2015, Oklahoma alums made the second most starts on the mound in MLB with 68 behind Long Beach State's 70.

• JuCo transfer Brylie Ware (Neosho) was named the 2016 NJCAA Player of the Year and won the Triple Crown with a .589 average, 29 home runs and 122 RBI.

• Kyler Murray is the second OU quarterback to play baseball under Pete Hughes, who was a third baseman and quarterback at Davidson College (1986-90).

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 20 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 617-468-3 (.569), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Tigers...

Gambling State went 2-1 on opening weekend in the MLB Urban Invitational Tournament. The Tigers opened the season with victories against Alcorn State and Southern, before losing to University of Illinois-Chicago, 9-3, on Sunday. Gambling strung together 14 hits in its win over rival Southern on Saturday in New Orleans. Five players recorded a two-hit day with catcher **Johan Mojica** going 2-for-2 with a double and four RBI.

Last Time They Met...

Keith Hamilton improved to 6-0 as Oklahoma moved past Grambling State at the 1985 NCAA Central Region on May 24 by a score of 5-2 in the only meeting all-time between the two programs. Shortstop **Kevin Pearson** and third baseman **Jim Richardson** each went 2-for-5 in the middle of the Sooner lineup.

Irvin Ks 10 Again...

Opening day starter **Jake Irvin** matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts in the Sooners' win over Long Beach State (2/17). He struck out the side in the first. Irvin previously struck out 10 against No. 25 Oklahoma State (4/20/16); a game in which he struck out the side in the first and the first two batters of the second. His opening day total was the most by a Sooner in the first game of the year since **Andrew Doyle** fanned 10 vs. Western Illinois in 2009.

Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma has won back-to-back series against ranked opponents following its season-opening series win over No. 17 Long Beach State. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

Freshman Starting Shortstop...

In Friday's contest against Long Beach, **Brandon Zaragoza** became the first Sooner freshman to start at shortstop on opening day in a decade. **Bryant Hernandez** was the last to do so.

A New Meaning to 19 Ways...

The Sooners open the season with a string of 19 consecutive games played at home thanks to the opening series being moved from California to Norman. It tied for the longest homestand on record (1962-present), which was recorded in 1976; the year OU reached in fifth consecutive College World Series and won a program-record 62 games.

Three Games In; Three Runs In...

In the season's opening series, freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** tied for the team lead with three RBI; notching one in each game. He is the first Sooner freshman on record (2003-present) to have driven in one run in each of the first three games of the season. Zaragoza matched fellow shortstop **Danny Black**, a junior college transfer in 2010, as the only newcomer with at least one RBI in each of the first three games of the season.

Up Next...

Oklahoma hosts the 19 Ways Invitational Friday through Sunday. The Sooners will be joined by Boston College, Northern Illinois, and Villanova. Oklahoma opens the weekend on Friday afternoon against Villanova at 3 p.m. On Saturday, the Sooners will play a pair of games; first against Northern Illinois at noon and the nightcap against Villanova at 6:30 p.m. Oklahoma's final game of the weekend will be played at noon on Sunday against Boston College.

D1Baseball.com Rankings...

Several Sooners earned spots on preseason rankings lists put out by D1Baseball.com. Senior right-hander **JB Olson** checks in as the No. 47 ranked relief pitcher in the country after posting a 2.03 ERA as the OU setup man in 2016. A trifecta of Sooners, led by No. 56 **Dylan Grove**, appear on the list of top prospects for the 2018 draft. He is joined by No. 73 **Jake Irvin** and No. 109 **Domenic DeRenzo**.

Returning Freshman All-Americans...

Back in June, three Sooner rookies were named Louisville Slugger Freshman All-Americans by *Collegiate Baseball News*. Catcher **Domenic DeRenzo**, righty **Jake Irvin** and outfielder **Steele Walker** all represented Oklahoma. They became just the second class in OU history to feature three freshman All-Americans: joining **Craig Aikin**, **Jacob Evans** and **Anthony Hermelyn** from 2013. In 2014, **Sheldon Neuse** was the first to earn freshman All-America under Hughes.

Skip Brought on Board...

On June 27, exactly three years after head coach **Pete Hughes** was hired, he announced the addition of **Skip Johnson** to the Oklahoma staff. Johnson took over as the Sooners pitching coach after 10 seasons at rival Texas. He previously was the head coach at Navarro College for 13 seasons. During his 10 seasons in Austin, 32 pitchers were drafted, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first round picks.

Walker Wields Wood Well With Woodchucks...

Following his freshman campaign, outfielder **Steele Walker** spent his summer with the Wisconsin Woodchucks of the Northwoods League. He won the league's batting crown with a .406 average as he collected 86 hits in 53 games, including a club-record 20-game hit streak. The closest challenger to Walker for the batting title was 46 points back at .360. For the summer, he scored 47 runs and drove in 31, while adding 11 doubles and seven home runs.

Black History Month...

This season marks the anniversary of **Michael Pace** integrating OU baseball as he became the first black player in program history. Pace made his Sooner debut at old Haskell Park in Norman against New Mexico on March 15, 1977. In limited action he hit .349 (15-for-43) with 11 runs scored and four home runs. Pace was drafted and signed out of the 11th round by the Philadelphia Phillies.

Opening the Gates...

This season's home-opening series, originally scheduled to be played in California and moved only two days before first pitch, brought in the fifth largest opening weekend crowd on record (1988-present). In 2016, Oklahoma broke its own opening weekend attendance record with 4,466 passing through the gates at L. Dale Mitchell Park to see the Sooners face Northeastern. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Home Field Notes...

Oklahoma finished its 2016 home slate by winning all four Big 12 series at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners posted a .640 win percentage with a 16-9 record; the best since 2013 (.806). OU averaged 1,211 in home attendance; marking a rise in each of the past three seasons and the highest since 2012 (1,283).

Against the West...

Under head coach Pete Hughes, the Sooners are 12-5 against schools from California. When playing against teams from the Pacific or Hawaii Time Zones, OU is 18-10. When playing in the Pacific of Hawaii Time Zones, Oklahoma is 13-4-1. Since 2014, the Sooners have played seven of the 11 Pac-12 schools and posted a 3-4 record.

Opening Day Starters...

Sophomore right-hander **Jake Irvin** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fourth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last six seasons and third in four seasons with **Pete Hughes** at the helm. Irvin also became the third consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

Against the Ranked...

Since **Pete Hughes** took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 15-33-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 5-18 against top-10 teams, including a win over No. 5 Texas Tech (5/28/16). This season marks the first time OU plays a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a doubleheader with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State.

Crimson Over Orange; Twice as Nice...

Last season, Oklahoma won its Big 12 series over Texas and Oklahoma State for the first time since 1998; the only other time it has happened. The **Larry Cochell**-led Sooners took two out of three from the No. 16 Cowboys in the Bedlam Series. OU won the opener at Driller Stadium and then split the next two at All Sports Stadium. Oklahoma then swept the Longhorns at home to close out the regular season. In 2016, **Pete Hughes** and the Sooners picked up a home series win over Texas and took the opener from OSU at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark then split at ONEOK Field.

Irvin's Rise...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** opened his 2016 freshman season in the rotation for the Sooners in a four-game series against Northeastern. From there, he moved to the bullpen and pitched in spot duty or long relief. At Texas Tech (3/26), Irvin struck out the side in one inning of work and followed with two-scoreless frames at Little Rock (3/29). He earned the start in Oklahoma's next midweek; a 12-2 win over Dallas Baptist (4/5) in which he got the win in five innings with five strikeouts. Irvin pitched OU to another midweek win over Wichita State (4/12) and struck out 10 in 5.1 innings against Oklahoma State (4/20). He has since risen through the Sooner rotation; pitching on Sunday at Kansas (5/1), Saturday against Kansas State (5/7) and Friday night vs. Oklahoma State (5/13).

Rare Run-Rules...

Oklahoma picked up its second run-rule of the season with a 12-0, seven-inning decision over Kansas State (5/8). The Sooners previously defeated Kansas (5/1) in seven, 17-6. Prior to that, OU had last won by run-rule against New Orleans (4/21/13). Oklahoma had last won by run-rule twice in a season in 2013 as it first defeated Arkansas-Pine Bluff (2/19/13). The win against the Wildcats this season marked the first time the OU baseball and softball teams won on a run-rule on the same day since Sooner baseball defeated West-ern Illinois (2/21/09).

Wild Walk Offs the Norm for Norman Nine...

Oklahoma has won five games in walk-off fashion this season, including four in Big 12 play and three coming on Sundays. The Sooners added to their total with two to claim a series win over Baylor (4/8, 4/10). Oklahoma did not lead in either game until the winning run touched home. **Sheldon Neuse** singled and **Jack Flansburg** walked in the ninth of game one. **Renae Martinez** came in to pinch-hit and put down a sacrifice-bunt that was thrown away and allowed Neuse to score the walk-off run in a 4-3 win. In the second walk-off vs. Baylor, a game that featured four home runs by each side, it was three-straight singles that decided the game in extra innings. In the 11th, **Cade Harris** and **Ben Hollas** singled with two down to set up the game-winning hit for Flansburg; a 7-6 final. It marked the first series win for Oklahoma over Baylor since a 2012 sweep at home.
