#### First Pitch...

The University of Oklahoma baseball team hosts Villanova, Northern Illinois and Boston College for its 19 Ways Invitational beginning Friday at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners face Villanova Friday at 3 p.m. for their first game of the weekend before a Saturday noon game vs. Northern Illinois and 6:30 pm nightcap in a rematch with the Wildcats. The weekend comes to a close Sunday at noon when the Sooners take on Boston College.

#### **About the Sooners...**

Oklahoma is 4-1 after the first full week of action this season, including winning each of its last three games. The Sooners have held the opposition to exactly two runs in all four of their wins and own a +18 run differential overall. Senior infielder **Jack Flansburg**, who has started four games at third base, is hitting a team-best .571 (8-for-14) with seven runs scored and one of OU's three home runs. Senior first baseman Austin O'Brien is hitting .467 (7-for-15) and has recorded three multi-hit games on the season. He has slugged two doubles and a triple with three RBI. Sophomore center fielder **Steele** Walker has hit successfully in eight consecutive games, dating back to last season, and owns a .400 (8-for-20) average. On the hill in Friday's opener will be sophomore right-hander Jake Irvin. Irvin pitched seven-shutout innings of one-hit ball to beat No. 17 Long Beach State in the opener a week ago. Three additional sophomore righties round out the Sooner rotation for the weekend.

#### **HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES**

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a welldeserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 20 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 617-468-3 (.569), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

#### On the Air...

Three of four Sooner games this weekend will air of Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM and two will be televised by Sooner Sports TV. Voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** (play-by-play) and former MLB All-Star **Mickey Tettleton** (color) will have the call on Friday night, which will be carried on radio and FOX Sports Oklahoma. Game one on Saturday will be a radio and webcast on SoonerSports.tv with Rowland, while game two will be webcast only with **Theron Smith** filling in on the call. Veteran OU broadcaster **Chad McKee** (pbp) and former Sooner and 10-year MLB veteran **George Frazier** (color) will have the call on FSOK and radio on Sunday.

#### Scouting the Wildcats...

Villanova is looking to bounce back this weekend after getting swept by Norfolk State on opening weekend. The Wildcats are facing the Sooners for the first time ever on Friday. Right-handed pitcher **Hunter Schryver** allowed four hits and two runs in his first appearance of the season and gets the ball Friday afternoon. Right fielder **Donovan May** leads the Wildcats in hits with four in 14 at-bats. May had two hits and a RBI-double last Saturday. The Wildcats had hit totals of eight, 10 and seven in their first three games, respectively.

#### Scouting the Huskies...

Northern Illinois is 1-3 after it opened the season on a four-game weekend against South Dakota State and Chicago State. The Huskies began their season with losses of 7-2 and 11-1 in a back-to-back last Friday against SDSU and CSU. NIU recorded nine hits on just one run with **Brad Wood** going 2-for-4. The Huskies would go on to lose one more to Chicago State, using a late rally to tie the game in the eighth inning before falling in the 12th, 7-6. Wood went 3-for-4 in that game with **Jesus Tovar** racking up three hits as well. The Huskies played CSU in a make-up on Wednesday to pick up their first win of the year.

#### Scouting the Eagles...

Boston College is 0-3 on the year after losing three games on opening weekend to Bethune-Cookman by a total of three runs. Lefty **Dan Metzdorf** pitched four innings and allowed seven hits and three runs a week ago and gets the ball on Sunday. **Michael Strem** went 3-for-5 on Sunday with a RBI and recorded his 49th double, tying him for fourth in school history. The Golden Eagles left 28 men on base during the series in-cluding 11 during the final game.

#### Irvin Ks 10 Again...

Opening day starter **Jake Irvin** matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts in the Sooners' win over Long Beach State (2/17). He struck out the side in the first. Irvin previously struck out 10 against No. 25 Oklahoma State (4/20/16); a game in which he struck out the side in the first and the first two batters of the second. His opening day total was the most by a Sooner in the first game of the year since **Andrew Doyle** fanned 10 vs. Western Illinois in 2009.

#### Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma has won back-to-back series against ranked opponents following its season-opening series win over No. 17 Long Beach State. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

#### Freshman Starting Shortstop...

In the season opener against Long Beach State (2/17), **Brandon Zaragoza** became the first Sooner freshman to start at shortstop on opening day in a decade. **Bryant Hernandez** was the last to do so.

#### What is 19 Ways?...

Coach **Pete Hughes** brought to Norman a community service program which he developed as the coach at Virginia Tech called "19 Ways". The program is named in honor of his late mother, Alice, whose favorite number was 19. Each year, the goal of the Sooner baseball program will be to make an impact on the Norman community in 19 different ways. At the start of the 2016 season, there were seven other collegiate baseball and softball programs across the country hosting a 19 Ways initiative. Northeastern baseball became the latest program to get behind the program: joining Notre Dame, Northern Illinois, Virginia Tech, Southern New Hampshire, Tufts softball and Delaware softball.

#### **Hughes' Coaching Tree...**

Boston College head coach **Mike Gambino** was an assistant coach for **Pete Hughes** at Boston College from 2003-05 and later at Virginia Tech from 2007-10 before taking over the reins of the Eagles program, where he played for Hughes his final two seasons. Northern Illinois head coach **Mike Kunigonis** also spent time on a Hughes staff. Beginning as a volunteer and later an assists under Hughes, the two coaches together in Blacksburg from 2008-13.

#### A Different Meaning to 19 Ways...

The Sooners open the season with a string of 19 consecutive games played at home thanks to the opening series being moved from California to Norman. It tied for the longest homestand on record (1962-present), which was recorded in 1976; the year OU reached in fifth consecutive College World Series and won a program-record 62 games.

#### Tommy John Triumphs...

A pair of Sooners returned to competitive, collegiate baseball in Oklahoma 11-2 win over Grambling State (2/21) after rehabilitating from Tommy John surgery. Sophomore **Domenic DeRenzo**, who was shut down in mid-May of 2016 and underwent surgery in June, started as the designated hitter and went 0-for-3 with three RBI on a bases-loaded walk and a rare two-run sacrifice-fly. Redshirt-junior right-hander **Joey Zurawik**, who began his college career at Texas Tech and has had two Tommy John surgeries, pitched the eighth inning.

#### Three Games In: Three Runs In...

In OU's opening series, freshman **Brandon Zaragoza** tied for the team lead with three RBI: notching one in each game. He is the first Sooner freshman on record (2003-present) to have driven in one run in each of the first three games of the season. Zaragoza matched fellow shortstop **Danny Black**, a JuCo transfer in 2010, as the only newcomer with at least one RBI in each of the first three games of the season.

#### Un Next...

Oklahoma reaches the midway point of its 19-game homestand when it hosts Little Rock for a 3 p.m. first pitch on Tuesday, February 28.

#### D1Baseball.com Rankings...

Several Sooners earned spots on preseason rankings lists put out by D1Baseball.com. Senior right-hander **JB Olson** checks in as the No. 47 ranked relief pitcher in the country after posting a 2.03 ERA as the OU setup man in 2016. A trifecta of Sooners, led by No. 56 **Dylan Grove**, appear on the list of top prospects for the 2018 draft. He is joined by No. 73 **Jake Irvin** and No. 109 **Domenic DeRenzo**.

#### **Returning Freshman All-Americans...**

Back in June, three Sooner rookies were named Louisville Slugger Freshman All-Americans by *Collegiate Baseball News*. Catcher **Domenic DeRenzo**, righty **Jake Irvin** and outfielder **Steele Walker** all represented Oklahoma. They became just the second class in OU history to feature three freshman All-Americans; joining **Craig Aikin**, **Jacob Evans** and **Anthony Hermelyn** from 2013. In 2014, **Sheldon Neuse** was the first to earn freshman All-America under Hughes.

#### Skip Brought on Board...

On June 27, exactly three years after head coach **Pete Hughes** was hired, he announced the addition of **Skip Johnson** to the Oklahoma staff. Johnson took over as the Sooners pitching coach after 10 seasons at rival Texas. He previously was the head coach at Navarro College for 13 seasons. During his 10 seasons in Austin, 32 pitchers were drafted, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first round picks.

#### Walker Wields Wood Well With Woodchucks...

Following his freshman campaign, outfielder **Steele Walker** spent his summer with the Wisconsin Woodchucks of the Northwoods League. He won the league's batting crown with a .406 average as he collected 86 hits in 53 games, including a club-record 20-game hit streak. The closest challenger to Walker for the batting title was 46 points back at .360. For the summer, he scored 47 runs and drove in 31, while adding 11 doubles and seven home runs.

#### Black History Month...

This season marks the anniversary of **Michael Pace** integrating OU baseball as he became the first black player in program history. Pace made his Sooner debut at old Haskell Park in Norman against New Mexico on March 15, 1977. In limited action he hit .349 (15-for-43) with 11 runs scored and four home runs. Pace was drafted and signed out of the 11th round by the Philadelphia Phillies.

#### Opening the Gates...

This season's home-opening series, originally scheduled to be played in California and moved only two days before first pitch, brought in the fifth largest opening weekend crowd on record (1988-present). In 2016, Oklahoma broke its own opening weekend attendance record with 4,466 passing through the gates at L. Dale Mitchell Park to see the Sooners face Northeastern. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

#### Home Field Notes...

Oklahoma finished its 2016 home slate by winning all four Big 12 series at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners posted a .640 win percentage with a 16-9 record; the best since 2013 (.806). OU averaged 1,211 in home attendance; marking a rise in each of the past three seasons and the highest since 2012 (1,283).

#### Against the West...

Under head coach Pete Hughes, the Sooners are 12-5 against schools from California. When playing against teams from the Pacific or Hawaii Time Zones, OU is 18-10. When playing in the Pacific of Hawaii Time Zones, Oklahoma is 13-4-1. Since 2014, the Sooners have played seven of the 11 Pac-12 schools and posted a 3-4 record.

#### 2016: Sooners in MLB...

Oklahoma tied Vanderbilt for having the most players from an NCAA program make their MLB debuts in 2016.

#### Against the Ranked...

Since **Pete Hughes** took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 15-33-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 5-18 against top-10 teams, including a win over No. 5 Texas Tech (5/28/16). This season marks the first time OU plays a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a doubleheader with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (*CBN*) Long Beach State.
