CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

Eight teams in the Big 12 have 17 wins and winning percentages of .607 or higher - tied for the highest total of any conference in the nation.

A total of 53 of 73 (72.6 percent) league games so far have been decided by 10 points or less - including 35 of the last 48 matchups. The average margin of victory in all conference games this season is 7.4 points.

The Big 12 is the only conference with every team among the top 78 of the ESPN BPI, with eight in the top 49. Seven league squads rank among the top 56 of the latest RPI.

Big 12 men's basketball has the best cumulative strength of schedule of any conference in the nation for 2016-17.

Every team in the Big 12 has been ranked or received votes in the top 25 polls this season.

The Big 12 has posted a .575 win percentage versus the ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC - the eighth straight year that it has been .500 or better against the nation's top conferences.

For the fourth time in four years, the Big 12/SEC Challenge trophy will remain with the Big 12 as the leagues split the 10 contests this season. Big 12 teams are 25-15 (.625) in the event since it began.

Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 102-26 non-conference record during 2016-17. Seventeen losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.

Big 12 teams boasts a .797 non-conference winning percentage this season - the best of any league in the nation.

The 26 combined non-league losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 28 (Big East).

The Big 12 has been ranked among the top three conferences in the RPI so far this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.

Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament and has at least 100 career victories during their respective careers.

Seven coaches have career win percentages of .700 or better and the group of all 10 coaches boasts more than 3,600 career victories.

**BAYLOR (23-5, 10-5)**

- Junior forward Johnathan Motley has scored in double figures in 11 straight contests and leads the Big 12 with 11 double-doubles. He is averaging 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in his last five outings, while shooting 57.1 percent.
- Junior forward Jo Lual-Acuil matched his career high with seven blocked shots against Oklahoma. He has 78 rejections this season, the most in the Big 12 and sixth on the BU single-season chart.
- Baylor's 10-5 record is the best through 15 games of Big 12 play in school history. It marks the fifth time the Bears have had double-digit wins in Big 12 competition and the 23 victories overall are the ninth-most in program history.

**IOWA STATE (18-9, 10-5)**

- Iowa State has won 10 conference games for the sixth consecutive campaign and has five league road victories for the fifth time in school history (first since 2001). The Cyclones are also 13-0 when scoring 80 or more points in 2016-17.
- Senior guard Monté Morris has moved into a tie (Jeff Hornacek) for first in school history with 211 career steals. The theft total is third on the Big 12 all-time list and his 713 assists rank third in conference history.
- Morris boasts 45 assists with just four turnovers in his last six contests and has nine 20-point games this season. He has 79 career outings with five or more assists and has played 48 without a single turnover.

**KANSAS (25-3, 13-2)**

- Kansas has won 13 straight Big 12 regular-season titles, matching UCLA (1967-79) for the most consecutive league titles in college basketball history. The Jayhawks have 60 conference titles in their history overall, also a NCAA best.
- KU has 25 wins overall for the 12th straight season and also has 13 league victories for the 12th year in a row (both beginning in 2005-06). Kansas is 4-0 this season against teams ranked in the top five of the Associated Press poll.
- Senior guard Frank Mason III has scored 20 points or more in five of his past six games and 16 times this season. He is shooting 53.6 percent from 3-point range during Big 12 play and has made at least one 3-pointer in 25 straight games overall.

**KANSAS STATE (17-11, 6-9)**

- Senior Wesley Iwundu notched his fifth career 20-point outing to go along with nine rebounds versus OSU. He has 21 double-figure scoring performances this season, including each of the last 11 contests.
- K-State has topped the 2,000-point plateau for the 11th consecutive season and the Wildcats have 200 or more 3-pointers for just the eighth time in school history (first since 2012-13). The team has 232 steals, ninth on the school single-season list.
- Kansas State has six victories away from home, including five true road wins and three in Big 12 play - the most since 2012-13. The 'Cats have allowed six opponents to score 80 points or more this year, but three have come in the last four games.

**OKLAHOMA (9-18, 3-12)**

- Freshman guard Kameron McGusty has scored in double figures in 15 straight outings, the longest streak by an Oklahoma freshman since 1990-91. The string is also the longest by any Big 12 freshman this season.
- Sophomore guard Rashard Odomes has led the Sooners in rebounding each of the last two contests. He is averaging 14.8 points and 6.8 boards over the past five outings and has 10.5 points per game overall after averaging 1.9 a year ago.
- Against Baylor, 48 of the 54 points scored were from freshmen and sophomores. OU underclassmen have scored 73.7 percent of the Sooners points during Big 12 play and the bench is averaging 30.3 points since Jordan Woodard was injured.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (19-9, 8-7)**

- Oklahoma State has five consecutive road victories, its longest streak in Big 12 play since the 2012-13 squad won five straight. The last time the Cowboys won six in a row in league competition was when the 1950-51 team went 6-1 in the Missouri Valley.
- Sophomore guard Jawun Evans is averaging 19.7 points and 4.7 rebounds over the past nine contests, with the Cowboys boasting a 7-1 record in those games. He also has 30 assists with just six turnovers in the last three outings.
- Senior forward Leyton Hammonds has scored in double figures in three of the past four contests, averaging 14.0 points and 6.5 boards during that span. He has also shot 50 percent or better in five straight games.

**TCU (17-11, 6-9)**

- Junior guard Alex Robinson has scored 15 points or more in each of his last two outings, shooting 54.2 percent during that span. He has recorded at least four assists in all but four contests in 2016-17.
- TCU had nine turnovers at Kansas, the sixth time this season it has had fewer than 10 miscues in a contest. The Horned Frogs also had eight blocked shots, tying for the third-most in any game this season.
- Sophomore forward JD Miller has scored in double figures six times in his last eight outings after having reached the mark just four times the entire year prior to the current stretch. He also has at least one 3-pointer in eight consecutive games.

**TEXAS (10-18, 4-11)**

- Texas has had 14 of its 28 contests this season decided by five points or less, including 10 by three points or fewer. All seven of the Longhorns' conference home games have had margins of four points or less.
- Freshman forward Jarrett Allen has led the Longhorns in scoring in 10 of the past 13 outings and has posted double-digit point totals 21 times this year. He is averaging 17.4 points and 8.1 rebounds in February, shooting 63.0 percent from the field.
- Sophomore guard Eric Davis Jr. finished with 14 points at West Virginia, more than in his previous two games combined. He reached double figures in scoring for the ninth time in 2016-17 and the 23rd time in his career.

**TEXAS TECH (17-11, 5-10)**

- Each of Texas Tech's last six losses have come by single digits, with the average margin of defeat at 4.4 points. The Red Raiders' last four games (in a 10-day span) were against the top four teams in the Big 12 standings.
- Junior forward Zach Smith has recorded a double-double in three of the past five outings and is averaging 13.4 points and 7.2 boards during that span. He has grabbed at least seven rebounds in 14 of the last 18 contests.
- Junior guard Keenan Evans has a streak of 16 consecutive games in double figures, including four with 20 points or more. He is averaging 21.2 points and shooting 49.2 percent over the last five contests.

**WEST VIRGINIA (22-6, 10-5)**

- Junior guard Jevon Carter has 78 points and 31 rebounds over the last four games, shooting 50 percent or better in each contest. He has 78 steals this season - a total that leads the Big 12 and ranks sixth nationally.
- Freshman forward Lamont West had 23 points versus Texas, nearly double his total from the previous four games (12 points) combined. He has six double-figure scoring performances this year, including two 20-point efforts in the last six games.
- West Virginia has recorded its 31st 20-win season in school history and the third straight. It marks the 28th campaign with 20 or victories for Bob Huggins in 35 years as a head coach.
