#### First Pitch...

The University of Oklahoma baseball team reaches the midway point of its season-opening 19-game homestand with a Tuesday afternoon tilt against Little Rock. The Sooners and Trojans take the field for first pitch at 3 p.m. from L. Dale Mitchell Park.

#### About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is 8-1 and riding a seven-game win-streak following a four-game sweep of its home 19 Ways Invitational over the week-end. The Sooners wrapped up the weekend with a come-from-behind, walk-off win over ACC opponent Boston College. Sophomore third baseman **Brylie Ware** has made five starts and leads OU in hitting at .455 (10-for-22). He posted four two-hit games a week ago and has totaled six RBI. Senior first baseman **Austin O'Brien** is second with a .433 average and .633 slugging percentage. Senior **Jack Flansburg**, who has started games at three infield positions, is hitting .429 with a team-leading 11 runs and .643 slugging percentage. The Sooners are hitting a Big 12-leading .331 as a team and have outscored their opponents, 75-26, including a season-high 17 runs scored Saturday night vs. Villanova. Oklahoma turns to sophomore right-hander **Ryan Madden** on the hill against Little Rock. He picked up the win last Tuesday against Grambling State in 4.2 innings of work with five strikeouts. Opposing hitters are batting just .179 off OU pitchers, who have averaged 9.56 strikeouts per nine innings.

Tuesday's game will air on the home of Sooner baseball, Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM. The voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will have the call. Sooner Sports TV will broadcast the game on FOX Sports Southwest. Veteran OU broadcaster **Chad McKee** (play-by-play) and former MLB All-Star **Mickey Tettleton** (color commentary) will be in the booth.

#### Leading Off

- Oklahoma is ranked for the first time since week two of last season when it was No. 25 by *Baseball America*.
- OU's seven-game win-streak is the longest since 13 in 2013.
- Ben Hollas delivered the third walk-off knock of his career on Sunday to beat Boston College.
- All nine games have been started by a sophomore pitcher.
- The Sooners lead the Big 12 in hitting (.331), slugging (.410), hits (102), triples (6) and batting average against (.179).
- Seniors Renae Martinez, Austin O'Brien and JB Olson were elected captains by their teammates in fall ball.
- JuCo transfer Brylie Ware (Neosho) was named the 2016 NJCAA Player of the Year and won the Triple Crown with a .589 average, 29 home runs and 122 RBI.
- Kyler Murray is the second OU quarterback to play baseball under Pete Hughes, who was a third baseman and quarterback at Davidson College (1986-90).

### HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 20 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 617-468-3 (.569), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

### Scouting the Trojans...

Coming into the midweek matchup against the Sooners, Little Rock is 2-5 overall. The Trojans enter Tuesday's game following a series win over Purdue at home, which saw Little Rock shut out the Boilermakers on both Saturday and Sunday. Little Rock's offense is led by catcher **Cameron Knight**, who leads the team with a .458 batting average through seven games. Center fielder **Hunter Owens** is one of four players with a home run and has driven in a team-high eight runs on a .400 average. Lefty **Cole Townsend** is expected to take the hill. He has made one start and one relief appearance; totaling seven innings and 10 strikeouts.

### Last Time They Met...

**Alex Wise** doubled in each of his first two at-bats and scored the game-tying run on a wild pitch in the third. After a walk loaded the bases, **Jack Flansburg** hit a two-run single that put OU in front, 3-1. The Sooners would go on to defeat the Trojans 5-2 on March 29, 2016 and conclude its 10-game road swing with a 6-4 record. Right-hander **Kyle Tyler** picked up his first collegiate win; allowing only one unearned run in four innings, while striking out three. Also in the victory, **Sheldon Neuse** nailed down his fourth save of the season for the Sooners.

### All-Time vs. Little Rock...

Oklahoma leads the all-time series with Little Rock, 24-6, and won their second consecutive game against the Trojans with a 5-2 road win in 2016. The Sooners, who have played Little Rock on the road only twice, are 22-6 at home and 9-4 against the Trojans since 2004. Oklahoma last hosted Little Rock in 2015: a 22-0 Sooner victory. **Craig Aikin** set the OU record for hits in a game with a 6-for-7, six-RBI, four-run day at the plate.

### Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2017 as it reached No. 18 in the *Collegiate Baseball News* Top-30 on February 27. The Sooners had previously been ranked on February 22, 2016 when they were No. 25 by *Baseball America*. The No. 21 ranking to open the 2016 was the previous high for OU under head coach **Pete Hughes**. Oklahoma has spent 11 weeks on the charts in Hughes' tenure and owns a 19-22 record when ranked.

### Steele Still Streaking...

In the eighth inning of Oklahoma's Sunday game against Boston College (2/26), the 11-game hit-streak of **Steele Walker** was in jeopardy. To that point, he as 0-for-3 on the day and came up with two on and the Sooners trailing by three. Walker salvaged his streak by punching a base hit through the right side that scored a run and would later come in to score the game-tying run in an eventual walk-off. The streak, which started against Kansas State (5/26/16) at the Big 12 Championship, is the longest by a Sooner since **Craig Aikin** safely hit in 17 games between the end of the 2014 season and beginning of the 2015 season. Over Walker's streak, he is hitting .388 (19-for-49). The streak marks Walker's second of 10 or more in his career.

### Ben There, Done That...

Senior center fielder **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for Oklahoma and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16).

### TreMENDous Feat...

Junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** homered in back-to-back games of a doubleheader on February 25. He first hit a solo home run against Northern Illinois and later added a two-run shot off the light pole in left field against Villanova. **Steele Walker** was the last player to homer in back-to-back games and the last to do so in a doubleheader as he recorded the feat at Austin Peay (5/19/16).

### Four-Hit Freshman...

In Oklahoma's 17-1 rout of Villanova (2/25), freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** went 4-for-5 with three runs out of the nine hole. He became the first Sooner freshman to record four hits in a game since 2014. That season, **Sheldon Neuse** did so at UTA (3/11/14) and vs. Oklahoma State (5/23/14) in the Big 12 Championship. **Austin O'Brien** also had a four-hit day that year by going 4-for-5 against Belmont (3/16/14) at home.

### Irvin Ks 10 Again...

Opening day starter **Jake Irvin** matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts in the Sooners' win over Long Beach State (2/17). He struck out the side in the first. Irvin previously struck out 10 against No. 25 Oklahoma State (4/20/16); a game in which he struck out the side in the first and the first two batters of the second. His opening day total was the most by a Sooner in the first game of the year since **Andrew Doyle** fanned 10 vs. Western Illinois in 2009.

### Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma has won back-to-back series against ranked opponents following its season-opening series win over No. 17 Long Beach State. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

### Freshman Starting Shortstop...

In the season opener against Long Beach State (2/17), **Brandon Zaragoza** became the first Sooner freshman to start at shortstop on opening day in a decade. **Bryant Hernandez** was the last to do so.

### A Different Meaning to 19 Ways...

The Sooners open the season with a string of 19 consecutive games played at home thanks to the opening series being moved from California to Norman. It tied for the longest homestand on record (1962-present), which was recorded in 1976; the year OU reached in fifth consecutive College World Series and won a program-record 62 games.

### Tommy John Triumphs...

A pair of Sooners returned to competitive, collegiate baseball in Oklahoma 11-2 win over Grambling State (2/21) after rehabilitating from Tommy John surgery. Sophomore **Domenic DeRenzo**, who was shut down in mid-May of 2016 and underwent surgery in June, started as the designated hitter and went 0-for-3 with three RBI on a bases-loaded walk and a rare two-run sacrifice-fly. Redshirt-junior right-hander **Joey Zurawik**, who began his college career at Texas Tech and has had two Tommy John surgeries, pitched the eighth inning.

### Three Games In; Three Runs In...

In OU's opening series, freshman **Brandon Zaragoza** tied for the team lead with three RBI; notching one in each game. He is the first Sooner freshman on record (2003-present) to have driven in one run in each of the first three games of the season. Zaragoza matched fellow shortstop **Danny Black**, a JuCo transfer in 2010, as the only newcomer with at least one RBI in each of the first three games of the season.

### Up Next...

Oklahoma hosts Central Connecticut State for a four-game series beginning on Friday, March 3 at 6:30 p.m. The Sooners and Blue Devils play two on Saturday and wrap the series Sunday afternoon.

### D1Baseball.com Rankings...

Several Sooners earned spots on preseason rankings lists put out by D1Baseball.com. Senior right-hander **JB Olson** checks in as the No. 47 ranked relief pitcher in the country after posting a 2.03 ERA as the OU setup man in 2016. A trifecta of Sooners, led by No. 56 **Dylan Grove**, appear on the list of top prospects for the 2018 draft. He is joined by No. 73 **Jake Irvin** and No. 109 **Domenic DeRenzo**.

### Returning Freshman All-Americans...

Back in June, three Sooner rookies were named Louisville Slugger Freshman All-Americans by *Collegiate Baseball News*. Catcher **Domenic DeRenzo**, righty **Jake Irvin** and outfielder **Steele Walker** all represented Oklahoma. They became just the second class in OU history to feature three freshman All-Americans; joining **Craig Aikin**, **Jacob Evans** and **Anthony Hermelyn** from 2013. In 2014, **Sheldon Neuse** was the first to earn freshman All-America under Hughes.

### Skip Brought on Board...

On June 27, exactly three years after head coach **Pete Hughes** was hired, he announced the addition of **Skip Johnson** to the Oklahoma staff. Johnson took over as the Sooners pitching coach after 10 seasons at rival Texas. He previously was the head coach at Navarro College for 13 seasons. During his 10 seasons in Austin, 32 pitchers were drafted, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first round picks.

### Walker Wilds Wood Well With Woodchucks...

Following his freshman campaign, outfielder **Steele Walker** spent his summer with the Wisconsin Woodchucks of the Northwoods League. He won the league's batting crown with a .406 average as he collected 86 hits in 53 games, including a club-record 20-game hit streak. The closest challenger to Walker for the batting title was 46 points back at .360. For the summer, he scored 47 runs and drove in 31, while adding 11 doubles and seven home runs.

### Black History Month...

This season marks the 40th anniversary of **Michael Pace** integrating OU baseball as he became the first black player in program history. Pace made his Sooner debut at old Haskell Park in Norman against New Mexico on March 15, 1977. In limited action he hit .349 (15-for-43) with 11 runs scored and four home runs. Pace was drafted and signed out of the 11th round by the Philadelphia Phillies.

### 2016: Sooners in MLB...

Oklahoma tied Vanderbilt for having the most players from an NCAA program make their MLB debuts in 2016.

### Opening the Gates...

This season's home-opening series, originally scheduled to be played in California and moved only two days before first pitch, brought in the fifth largest opening weekend crowd on record (1988-present). In 2016, Oklahoma broke its own opening weekend attendance record with 4,466 passing through the gates at L. Dale Mitchell Park to see the Sooners face Northeastern. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

### Home Field Notes...

Oklahoma finished its 2016 home slate by winning all four Big 12 series at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners posted a .640 win percentage with a 16-9 record; the best since 2013 (.806). OU averaged 1,211 in home attendance; marking a rise in each of the past three seasons and the highest since 2012 (1,283).

### Against the West...

Under head coach Pete Hughes, the Sooners are 12-5 against schools from California. When playing against teams from the Pacific or Hawaii Time Zones, OU is 18-10. When playing in the Pacific or Hawaii Time Zones, Oklahoma is 13-4-1. Since 2014, the Sooners have played seven of the 11 Pac-12 schools and posted a 3-4 record.

### Opening Day Starters...

Sophomore right-hander **Jake Irvin** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fourth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last six seasons and third in four seasons with **Pete Hughes** at the helm. Irvin also became the third consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

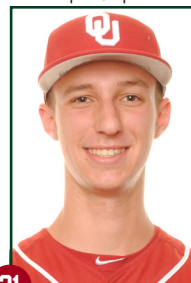
