## First Pitch...

Entering the back-nine of its 19-game homestand, the University of Oklahoma baseball team welcomes Central Connecticut State to L. Dale Mitchell Park for a four-game series. The Sooners and Blue Devils hit the field for game one Friday at 6:30 p.m. Saturday features a doubleheader beginning at 2 p.m. followed by a 1 p.m. Sunday finale.

#### **About the Sooners...**

Oklahoma is 9-1 and riding an eight-game win-streak following a 10-5 win over Little Rock on Tuesday afternoon. The Sooners are hitting .329 as a team and holding opponents to a .194 average. Senior first baseman **Austin O'Brien** leads OU with a .471 (16-for-34) average and .735 slugging percentage with 12 runs scored. Senior **Jack Flansburg**, who has started at three different infield positions this season, is third with a .387 average and tied with O'Brien for the team-lead in runs at 12. Sophomore outfielder Steele Walker has split his time between left and center field this season. He is hitting .375 with three doubles, two triples and a team-high 10 RBI. Walker, O'Brien and Flansburg have hit three through five in the order in all 10 games this season. Sophomore right-hander **Jake Irvin** gets the ball for Oklahoma in Friday night's opener. He is 2-0 with a 0.64 earned run average. Irvin has gone seven innings in each start this season. He struck out 10 to beat Long Beach State (2/17) on opening day and followed with seven strikeouts to beat Villanova at last weekend's 19 Ways Invitational.

This weekend's games will air on the home of Sooner baseball, Sport stalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM. The voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will have the call on Friday and Sunday. Veteran OU broadcaster **Chad McKee** (play-by-play) and former OU and MLB pitcher George Frazier (color commentary) will be in the booth for Saturday's doubleheader. ## **HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES**

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 20 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 617-468-3 (.569), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

## Scouting the Blue Devils...

Central Connecticut is 4-1 on the young season after a 3-1 weekend against South Dakota State and Maine in Delray Beach, Fla. over the weekend. Reigning NEC player of the week **Dean Lockery** is hitting a team-leading .474 (9-for-19) with eight runs scored and six driven in. Infielder and pitcher **Andrew Hinckley** was an Olerud Award semifinalist a year ago. He is 2-0 on the mound with a 2.70 ERA and 14 strikeouts in 10 innings. At the plate, he is 1-for-3 in one start. Head coach **Charlie Hickey** is in his 18th season with the Blue Devils and has guided the program four NCAA Regionals, most recently in 2010.

## Last Time They Met...

Oklahoma and Central Connecticut have played just once before. The Sooners hosted the 2004 NCAA Oklahoma City Regional at Bricktown Ballpark. The Blue Devils had won 41 games that season on their way to a third consecutive regional appearance. In an elimination game, OU bested CCSU, 6-1. Sooner lefty and future MLB pitcher **David Purcey** pitched a complete game with nine strikeouts. Central's future big leaguer, **Evan Scribner**, pitched two innings of relief.

## Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2017 as it reached No. 18 in the *Collegiate Baseball News* Top-30 on February 27. The Sooners had previously been ranked on February 22, 2016 when they were No. 25 by *Baseball America*. The No. 21 ranking to open the 2016 was the previous high for OU under head coach **Pete Hughes**. Oklahoma has spent 11 weeks on the charts in Hughes' tenure and owns a 20-22 record when ranked.

## Steele Still Streaking...

In the eighth inning of Oklahoma's Sunday game against Boston College (2/26), the 11-game hit-streak of **Steele Walker** was in jeopardy. To that point, he as 0-for-3 on the day and came up with two on and the Sooners trailing by three. Walker salvaged his streak by punching a base hit through the right side that scored a run and would later come in to score the game-tying run in an eventual walk-off. Walker's streak was extended to 13 with a base hit against Little Rock (2/28). The streak, which started against Kansas State (5/26/16) at the Big 12 Championship, is the longest by a Sooner since **Craig Aikin** safely hit in 17 games between the end of the 2014 season and beginning of the 205 season. Over Walker's streak, he is hitting .377 (20-for-53). The streak marks Walker's second of 10 or more in his career.

## Coming in Clutch...

In Tuesday's win over Little Rock, the Sooners produces eight of their 10 runs with two outs by going 6-for-13 with two gone in an inning. For the season, Oklahoma is hitting .282 (31-for-110) with 30 of the team's 74 RBI having been driven in with two outs. Last season, OU hit .248 in two out situations and accounted for 99 two-out RBI: 17 of which came from **Sheldon Neuse**, who hit .414 with two outs. Under hitting coach **Mike Anderson**, the Sooners hit a team-best .271 with two outs in 2015.

#### Fresh Arms

All 10 games have been started by a sophomore pitcher this season. Oklahoma has gotten four wins from its sophomore class; second only to Texas Tech in the league with five. In 2016, freshman pitchers from OU and TTU tied for the league lead with 18 regular season wins. Seven of the Sooners' nine wins have been claimed by underclassmen though 10 games; ahead of both Tech and TCU at six.

#### Ben There. Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16).

## TreMENDous Feat...

Junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** homered in back-to-back games of a doubleheader on February 25. He first hit a solo home run against Northern Illinois and later added a two-run shot off the light pole in left field against Villanova. **Steele Walker** was the last player to homer in back-to-back games and the last to do so in a doubleheader as he recorded the feat at Austin Peay (5/19/16).

#### Four-Hit Freshman...

In Oklahoma's 17-1 rout of Villanova (2/25), freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** went 4-for-5 with three runs out of the nine hole. He became the first Sooner freshman to record four hits in a game since 2014. That season, **Sheldon Neuse** did so at UTA (3/11/14) and vs. Oklahoma State (5/23/14) in the Big 12 Championship. **Austin O'Brien** also had a four-hit day that year by going 4-for-5 against Belmont (3/16/14) at home.

#### Irvin Ks 10 Again...

Opening day starter **Jake Irvin** matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts in the Sooners' win over Long Beach State (2/17). He struck out the side in the first. Irvin previously struck out 10 against No. 25 Oklahoma State (4/20/16); a game in which he struck out the side in the first and the first two batters of the second. His opening day total was the most by a Sooner in the first game of the year since **Andrew Doyle** fanned 10 vs. Western Illinois in 2009.

## Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma has won back-to-back series against ranked opponents following its season-opening series win over No. 17 Long Beach State. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

## Up Next...

Oklahoma welcomes Wichita State to Norman on Tuesday, March 7. The Sooners and the Shockers take the field for a 6:30 pm first pitch.

## Freshman Starting Shortstop...

In the season opener against Long Beach State (2/17), **Brandon Zaragoza** became the first Sooner freshman to start at shortstop on opening day in a decade. **Bryant Hernandez** was the last to do so.

#### A Different Meaning to 19 Ways...

The Sooners open the season with a string of 19 consecutive games played at home thanks to the opening series being moved from California to Norman. It tied for the longest homestand on record (1962-present), which was recorded in 1976; the year OU reached in fifth consecutive College World Series and won a program-record 62 games.

#### Tommy John Triumphs...

A pair of Sooners returned to competitive, collegiate baseball in Oklahoma 11-2 win over Grambling State (2/21) after rehabilitating from Tommy John surgery. Sophomore **Domenic DeRenzo**, who was shut down in mid-May of 2016 and underwent surgery in June, started as the designated hitter and went 0-for-3 with three RBI on a bases-loaded walk and a rare two-run sacrifice-fly. Redshirt-junior right-hander **Joey Zurawik**, who began his college career at Texas Tech and has had two Tommy John surgeries, pitched the eighth inning.

## Three Games In; Three Runs In...

In OU's opening series, freshman **Brandon Zaragoza** tied for the team lead with three RBI: notching one in each game. He is the first Sooner freshman on record (2003-present) to have driven in one run in each of the first three games of the season. Zaragoza matched fellow shortstop **Danny Black**, a JuCo transfer in 2010, as the only newcomer with at least one RBI in each of the first three games of the season.

## D1Baseball.com Rankings...

Several Sooners earned spots on preseason rankings lists put out by D1Baseball.com. Senior right-hander **JB Olson** checks in as the No. 47 ranked relief pitcher in the country after posting a 2.03 ERA as the OU setup man in 2016. A trifecta of Sooners, led by No. 56 **Dylan Grove**, appear on the list of top prospects for the 2018 draft. He is joined by No. 73 **Jake Irvin** and No. 109 **Domenic DeRenzo**.

#### Returning Freshman All-Americans...

Back in June, three Sooner rookies were named Louisville Slugger Freshman All-Americans by *Collegiate Baseball News*. Catcher **Domenic DeRenzo**, righty **Jake Irvin** and outfielder **Steele Walker** all represented Oklahoma. They became just the second class in OU history to feature three freshman All-Americans; joining **Craig Aikin**, **Jacob Evans** and **Anthony Hermelyn** from 2013. In 2014, **Sheldon Neuse** was the first to earn freshman All-America under Hughes.

## Skip Brought on Board...

On June 27, exactly three years after head coach **Pete Hughes** was hired, he announced the addition of **Skip Johnson** to the Oklahoma staff. Johnson took over as the Sooners pitching coach after 10 seasons at rival Texas. He previously was the head coach at Navarro College for 13 seasons. During his 10 seasons in Austin, 32 pitchers were drafted, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first round picks.

## Walker Wields Wood Well With Woodchucks...

Following his freshman campaign, outfielder **Steele Walker** spent his summer with the Wisconsin Woodchucks of the Northwoods League. He won the league's batting crown with a .406 average as he collected 86 hits in 53 games, including a club-record 20-game hit streak. The closest challenger to Walker for the batting title was 46 points back at .360. For the summer, he scored 47 runs and drove in 31, while adding 11 doubles and seven home runs.

## Opening the Gates...

This season's home-opening series, originally scheduled to be played in California and moved only two days before first pitch, brought in the fifth largest opening weekend crowd on record (1988-present). In 2016, Oklahoma broke its own opening weekend attendance record with 4,466 passing through the gates at L. Dale Mitchell Park to see the Sooners face Northeastern. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

### Home Field Notes...

Oklahoma finished its 2016 home slate by winning all four Big 12 series at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners posted a .640 win percentage with a 16-9 record; the best since 2013 (.806). OU averaged 1,211 in home attendance: marking a rise in each of the past three seasons and the highest since 2012 (1,283).

## Against the West...

Under head coach Pete Hughes, the Sooners are 12-5 against schools from California. When playing against teams from the Pacific or Hawaii Time Zones, OU is 18-10. When playing in the Pacific of Hawaii Time Zones, Oklahoma is 13-4-1. Since 2014, the Sooners have played seven of the 11 Pac-12 schools and posted a 3-4 record.

## **Opening Day Starters...**

Sophomore right-hander **Jake Irvin** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fourth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last six seasons and third in four seasons with **Pete Hughes** at the helm. ## Against the Ranked...

Since **Pete Hughes** took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 15-33-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 5-18 against top-10 teams, including a win over No. 5 Texas Tech (5/28/16). This season marks the first time OU plays a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a doubleheader with the Bruins, Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State.

## Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 12 players from within the state's borders and seven from Texas. This season matches the most Oklahoma born players at OU since 12 in 2012 and the second year in a row with as many or more players from Oklahoma than Texas.
