#### First Pitch...

The University of Oklahoma baseball team rides a 12-game win-streak into Tuesday night's contest. The No. 13 Sooners host non-conference rival Wichita State at L. Dale Mitchell Park for a 6:30 p.m. first pitch.

#### About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is 13-1 and riding its longest win-streak since winning 13 in a row in 2013. Sophomore outfielder **Steele Walker** is the Big 12's leading hitter at .429, while taking a 17-game hit-streak into Tuesday. He is slugging .696 with five doubles, two triples and two home runs. Sophomore **Brylie Ware**, who splits his time between third base and designated hitter, is second on the team and in the league with a .417 average. Senior first baseman **Austin O'Brien** is hitting .392 with a .608 slugging percentage and is tied with senior **Jack Flansburg** for the team lead in runs at 14. Flansburg, who has started at all four infield positions this season, is hitting .383. As a team, Oklahoma is hitting a league-leading .335 and has scored 118 runs; the fourth most in the nation. On the mound, the Sooners turn to sophomore right-handed pitcher **Dylan Grove**. Grove owns a 3.86 earned run average in 9.1 innings and has not factored into a decision in his two starts; though OU has won each game he started. Grove has totaled 11 strikeouts on the season, including seven on opening weekend against No. 17 Long Beach State. The Sooner pitching staff owns a Big 12-best 2.14 ERA.

#### On the Air...

Sooner Sports TV will broadcast the game nationally on FOX College Sports-Central. Veteran OU broadcaster **Chad McKee** (play-by-play) and former MLB All-Star **Mickey Tettleton** (color commentary) will have the call from the booth. Audio from the television broadcast will air on radio at Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM: the home for Sooner baseball all season long.

- OU's 12-game win-streak is the longest since 13 in 2013.
- All 14 games have been started by a sophomore pitcher.
- Steele Walker went 3-for-9 with three runs, two RBI and two doubles against Wichita State last season.
- Dylan Grove pitched the ninth inning of Oklahoma's 15-7 win in Wichita last year with one hit against him and one strikeout.
- Ben Hollas delivered the third walk-off knock of his career to beat Boston College (2/26).
- The Sooners lead the Big 12 in batting average (.335), OBP (.415), slugging (.512), runs (118), triples (7), RBI (100), ERA (2.14), strikeouts (142) and batting average against (.182).
- Ben Hollas was named one of seven Sooners awarded the Dr. Gerald Lage Academic Achievement Award by the Big 12; the league's highest academic honor.
- Seniors Renae Martinez, Austin O'Brien and JB Olson were elected captains by their teammates in fall ball.

### HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 20 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 617-468-3 (.569), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

### Scouting the Shockers...

Wichita State began its season 7-0, but comes to Norman at 7-3 after a weekend sweep on the road to Louisiana Tech. Right fielder and leadoff hitter **Greyson Jenista** is the Shockers' top hitter at .341. Third baseman **Alec Bohm** is second on the team with a .316 average and tied for the team-lead with nine runs scored. Right-hander **Adam Keller**, who has appeared out of the bullpen four times, gets the start. He has a 1-0 record with a 0.00 ERA in 4.1 innings.

### Last Time They Met...

Oklahoma completed a home-and-home sweep of Wichita State with a 15-7 win on the road on April 12, 2016. The Sooners held a 14-0 lead midway through before the Shockers got on the board with a six-spot in the fifth. **Jake Irvin** got the win in a short, three-inning start. **Hunter Haley** went 3-for-5 with five RBI and a double. The game was also the breakout game for **Cody Thomas**, who made his first start in three weeks and finished the night 2-for-6 with a two-run home run. Wichita shortstop **Jordan Boyer** went 3-for-4 with two RBI.

### All-Time vs. Wichita State...

Oklahoma leads the all-time series with Wichita State, 16-11, including an 8-4 win for the Sooners at the 1992 College World Series in Omaha. Oklahoma had won seven straight over the Shockers prior to a 2015 meeting, where Wichita State overcame an early 6-0 deficit to earn the victory.

### Sooner-Shocker Connection...

Wichita State's fourth-year head coach **Todd Butler** played at Oklahoma for two seasons, 1987-88. He was named an ABCA All-American in 1988 and set the Sooner record for stolen bases in a season with 46. He is tied for 14th all-time at OU with 53.

### #YardWork...

The Sooners enter the week tied with TCU for the Big 12 lead in home runs at 14. OU is averaging 1.00 home runs per game, led by junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall**, who had just one career home run entering the season, at three.

- The Sooners hit a grand slam (Jeremiah Adams, 3/4-Gm1) and an inside-the-park home run (Steele Walker, 3/5) vs. CCSU.

### 20-Strikeout Night...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** struck out a career-best 14 in a 3-0 win over Central Connecticut (3/3) as Sooner pitchers combined to strikeout 20 on the night. Irvin's 14 was the most by a Sooner since **Michael Rocha** struck out 13 against Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth inning. In relief, right-hander **Connor Berry** accomplished the rare feat of striking out four in an inning. He got the first batter looking before the next struck out swinging, but reached on a wild pitch. Berry then punched out the next two.

### Up Next...

The Sooners wrap up a 19-game homestand to begin the series when Buffalo comes to Norman. Game one is Thursday, March 9 at 7 p.m. The series continues Friday at 6:30 p.m. and Saturday at 2 p.m. Saturday will be a doubleheader and is "Bark in the Park" day.

### Steele Still Streaking...

In the eighth inning of Oklahoma's Sunday game against Boston College (2/26), the 11-game hit-streak of **Steele Walker** was in jeopardy. To that point, he as 0-for-3 on the day and came up with two on and the Sooners trailing by three. Walker salvaged his streak by punching a base hit through the right side that scored a run and would later come in to score the game-tying run in an eventual walk-off. Walker's streak was extended to 17 in the Sooners series vs. CCSU (3/3-5). The streak, which started against Kansas State (5/26/16) at the Big 12 Championship, is the longest by a Sooner since **Craig Aikin** safely hit in 17 games between the end of the 2014 season and beginning of the 2015 season. Over Walker's streak, he is hitting .420 (29-for-69). The streak marks Walker's second of 10 or more in his career.

### Keepin' it 100...

In national statistical rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at second in the country with seven triples. The Sooners' 118 runs scored are the fourth most in the country and the pitching staff's 0.99 WHIP ranks fourth. Among individuals, **Jake Irvin** is tied with 55 pitchers for the second most wins at three, is eighth in the country with 31 strikeouts and 10th with a 0.50 WHIP.

### Coming in Clutch...

In OU's win over Little Rock (2/28), the Sooners produced eight of their 10 runs with two outs by going 6-for-13 with two gone in an inning. For the season, Oklahoma is hitting .300 (45-for-150) with 45 of the team's 100 RBI having been driven in with two outs. Last season, OU hit .248 in two out situations and accounted for 99 two-out RBI: 17 of which came from **Sheldon Neuse**, who hit .414 with two outs. Under hitting coach **Mike Anderson**, the Sooners hit a team-best .271 with two outs in 2015.

### Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2017 as it reached No. 18 in the *Collegiate Baseball News* Top-30 on February 27. The Sooners had previously been ranked on February 22, 2016 when they were No. 25 by *Baseball America*. The No. 21 ranking to open the 2016 was the previous high for OU under head coach **Pete Hughes**. Oklahoma has spent 12 weeks on the charts in Hughes' tenure and owns a 24-22 record when ranked.

### Fresh Arms...

All 14 games have been started by a sophomore pitcher this season. Oklahoma has gotten four six from its sophomore class; tied with Texas Tech for most in the league. In 2016, freshman pitchers from OU and TTU tied for the league lead with 18 regular season wins. Nine of the Sooners' 13 wins have been claimed by underclassmen though 14 games: ahead of both Tech and TCU at eight.

### Ben There, Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16).

### TreMENDous Feat...

Junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** homered in back-to-back games of a doubleheader on February 25. He first hit a solo home run against Northern Illinois and later added a two-run shot off the light pole in left field against Villanova. **Steele Walker** was the last player to homer in back-to-back games and the last to do so in a doubleheader as he recorded the feat at Austin Peay (5/19/16).

### A Different Meaning to 19 Ways...

The Sooners open the season with a string of 19 consecutive games played at home thanks to the opening series being moved from California to Norman. It tied for the longest homestand on record (1962-present), which was recorded in 1976: the year OU reached in fifth consecutive College World Series and won a program-record 62 games.

### Four-Hit Freshman...

In Oklahoma's 17-1 rout of Villanova (2/25), freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** went 4-for-5 with three runs out of the nine hole. He became the first Sooner freshman to record four hits in a game since 2014. That season, **Sheldon Neuse** did so at UTA (3/11/14) and vs. Oklahoma State (5/23/14) in the Big 12 Championship. **Austin O'Brien** also had a four-hit day that year by going 4-for-5 against Belmont (3/16/14) at home.

### Irvin Ks 10 Again...

Opening day starter **Jake Irvin** matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts in the Sooners' win over Long Beach State (2/17). He struck out the side in the first. Irvin previously struck out 10 against No. 25 Oklahoma State (4/20/16); a game in which he struck out the side in the first and the first two batters of the second. His opening day total was the most by a Sooner in the first game of the year since **Andrew Doyle** fanned 10 vs. Western Illinois in 2009.

### Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma has won back-to-back series against ranked opponents following its season-opening series win over No. 17 Long Beach State. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

### Freshman Starting Shortstop...

In the season opener against Long Beach State (2/17), **Brandon Zaragoza** became the first Sooner freshman to start at shortstop on opening day in a decade. **Bryant Hernandez** was the last to do so.

### Tommy John Triumphs...

A pair of Sooners returned to competitive, collegiate baseball in Oklahoma 11-2 win over Grambling State (2/21) after rehabilitating from Tommy John surgery. Sophomore **Domenic DeRenzo**, who was shut down in mid-May of 2016 and underwent surgery in June, started as the designated hitter and went 0-for-3 with three RBI on a bases-loaded walk and a rare two-run sacrifice-fly. Redshirt-junior right-hander **Joey Zurawik**, who began his college career at Texas Tech and has had two Tommy John surgeries, pitched the eighth inning.

### Three Games In; Three Runs In...

In OU's opening series, freshman **Brandon Zaragoza** tied for the team lead with three RBI: notching one in each game. He is the first Sooner freshman on record (2003-present) to have driven in one run in each of the first three games of the season. Zaragoza matched fellow shortstop **Danny Black**, a JuCo transfer in 2010, as the only newcomer with at least one RBI in each of the first three games of the season.

### D1Baseball.com Rankings...

Several Sooners earned spots on preseason rankings lists put out by D1Baseball.com. Senior right-hander **JB Olson** checks in as the No. 47 ranked relief pitcher in the country after posting a 2.03 ERA as the OU setup man in 2016. A trifecta of Sooners, led by No. 56 **Dylan Grove**, appear on the list of top prospects for the 2018 draft. He is joined by No. 73 **Jake Irvin** and No. 109 **Domenic DeRenzo**.

### Returning Freshman All-Americans...

Back in June, three Sooner rookies were named Louisville Slugger Freshman All-Americans by *Collegiate Baseball News*. Catcher **Domenic DeRenzo**, righty **Jake Irvin** and outfielder **Steele Walker** all represented Oklahoma. They became just the second class in OU history to feature three freshman All-Americans; joining **Craig Aikin**, **Jacob Evans** and **Anthony Hermelyn** from 2013. In 2014, **Sheldon Neuse** was the first to earn freshman All-America under Hughes.

### Skip Brought on Board...

On June 27, exactly three years after head coach **Pete Hughes** was hired, he announced the addition of **Skip Johnson** to the Oklahoma staff. Johnson took over as the Sooners pitching coach after 10 seasons at rival Texas. He previously was the head coach at Navarro College for 13 seasons. During his 10 seasons in Austin, 32 pitchers were drafted, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first round picks.

### Walker Wilds Wood Well With Woodchucks...

Following his freshman campaign, outfielder **Steele Walker** spent his summer with the Wisconsin Woodchucks of the Northwoods League. He won the league's batting crown with a .406 average as he collected 86 hits in 53 games, including a club-record 20-game hit streak. The closest challenger to Walker for the batting title was 46 points back at .360. For the summer, he scored 47 runs and drove in 31, while adding 11 doubles and seven home runs.

### Black History Month...

This season marks the 40th anniversary of **Michael Pace** integrating OU baseball as he became the first black player in program history. Pace made his Sooner debut at old Haskell Park in Norman against New Mexico on March 15, 1977. In limited action he hit .349 (15-for-43) with 11 runs scored and four home runs. Pace was drafted and signed out of the 11th round by the Philadelphia Phillies.

### Opening the Gates...

This season's home-opening series, originally scheduled to be played in California and moved only two days before first pitch, brought in the fifth largest opening weekend crowd on record (1988-present). In 2016, Oklahoma broke its own opening weekend attendance record with 4,466 passing through the gates at L. Dale Mitchell Park to see the Sooners face Northeastern. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

### Home Field Notes...

Oklahoma finished its 2016 home slate by winning all four Big 12 series at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners posted a .640 win percentage with a 16-9 record; the best since 2013 (.806). OU averaged 1,211 in home attendance; marking a rise in each of the past three seasons and the highest since 2012 (1,283).

### Against the West...

Under head coach Pete Hughes, the Sooners are 12-5 against schools from California. When playing against teams from the Pacific or Hawaii Time Zones, OU is 18-10. When playing in the Pacific of Hawaii Time Zones, Oklahoma is 13-4-1. Since 2014, the Sooners have played seven of the 11 Pac-12 schools and posted a 3-4 record.
