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CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- A total of 80 percent of the teams in the Big 12 have 17 wins or more - tied for the best percentage of any conference in the nation. Every Big 12 squad has double-digit victory totals.
- During conference play, 63 of 90 (70 percent) games were decided by 10 points or less - including 45 of the last 63 matchups. The average margin of victory in all conference games this season is 7.9 points.
- The Big 12 is the only conference with every team among the top 78 of the ESPN BPI, with eight in the top 53. Six league squads rank among the top 58 of the latest RPI.
- Big 12 men's basketball has the best cumulative strength of schedule of any conference in the nation for 2016-17.
- Every team in the Big 12 has been ranked or received votes in the top 25 polls this season.
- The Big 12 has posted a .575 win percentage versus the ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC - the eighth straight year that it has been .500 or better against the nation's top conferences.
- For the fourth time in four years, the Big 12/SEC Challenge trophy will remain with the Big 12 as the leagues split the 10 contests this season. Big 12 teams are 25-15 (.625) in the event since it began.
- Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 102-26 non-conference record during 2016-17. Seventeen losses were by single digits, including four in overtime.
- Big 12 teams boasts a .797 non-conference winning percentage this season - the best of any league in the nation.
- The 26 combined non-league losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 28 (Big East).
- The Big 12 is ranked second nationally among all conferences in the RPI. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.
- Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament and has at least 100 career victories during their respective careers.
- Seven coaches have career win percentages of .700 or better and the group of all 10 coaches boasts more than 3,600 career victories.

BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

The Big 12 Champions for Life initiative showcases the success stories of student-athletes and how an athletic scholarship has positively impacted their lives. For Baylor's Ishmail Wainright, a college education was his family's No. 1 priority. He knows success on the court can only be achieved with success in the classroom. Dante Buford from Oklahoma knew receiving his scholarship was important, as he is the first in his family to go to college. After academic challenges during his first year, Buford knows the importance of what that scholarship means. With a lot of student-athletes focusing on the athletic part of their scholarship, Texas Tech's Justin Gray stands out. His determination to graduate and pursue graduate school shows a passion for education. K-State's Carlie Ervin II has put in the time just for the opportunity to play in the Big 12, and he has no plans to take anything for granted. BAYLOR (25-6, 12-6)

- ✎ Baylor has tied the school record for most wins during a regular season and also matched the 2011-12 squad for most victories in conference play. The second-place finish by BU equaled the top Big 12 finish in school history (2009-10).
- ✎ Junior forward Johnathan Motley has scored in double figures in 14 straight contests. He has 13 double-doubles this year, tied for the most in the Big 12 and eighth on the BU single-season chart.
- ✎ Baylor has 150 wins overall since 2011-12, the second-most in the Big 12 (Kansas, 175) during that span. Head coach Scott Drew is 214-109 (.689) since 2007-08, the first year he had a full allotment of scholarships.



IOWA STATE (20-10, 12-6)

- ✎ Senior guard Monté Morris has 68 assists with six turnovers in the last nine games, including four outings with at least seven assists and zero miscues. He owns a 6.2 assist-to-turnover ratio, which would shatter the overall Big 12 record (4.8).
- ✎ The Cyclones have had 20 victories or more in six consecutive seasons, which is a school record. Iowa State is averaging 10.0 field goals from 3-point range this year and has connected on double-digit 3-pointers in four of the last five outings.
- ✎ ISU has won 24 games over ranked teams in the last four seasons, a total that is tied for third nationally. The Cyclones have four victories over Associated Press top 10 squads in two seasons under head coach Steve Prohm.



KANSAS (28-3, 16-2)

- ✎ Senior guard Frank Mason III nearly recorded a triple-double in the win at Oklahoma State, finishing with 27 points, nine assists and eight rebounds. It was his 18th 20-point game of the season.
- ✎ Kansas has won the outright Big 12 regular season title, it's 13th straight outright or shared crown. The Jayhawks have won it unshared nine times and will be the No. 1 seed at the 2017 Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's Basketball Championship.
- ✎ KU has at least 28 wins for the second straight campaign and eighth time in 14 seasons under head coach Bill Self. The Jayhawks have 16 league wins for the third time in school history (16-0, 2002; 16-2 in 2012).



KANSAS STATE (19-12, 8-10)

- ✎ K-State will be the No. 6 seed at the Big 12 Championship - its highest since 2014 (No. 5) and first time since that year it will have a first-round bye. It marks the first time in the history of the Championship that the 'Cats will be seeded sixth.
- ✎ Kansas State has 19 overall wins for the first time since recording 20 in 2013-14 and its eight Big 12 victories are the most since 2014-15. The 'Cats are 7-7 away from home this season, their most wins since the 2012-13 campaign.
- ✎ K-State has topped the 2,000-point plateau for the 11th consecutive season and the Wildcats have 200 or more 3-pointers for the eighth time in school history (first since 2012-13). The team has 250 steals, fourth on the school single-season list.



OKLAHOMA (11-19, 5-13)

- ✎ Freshmen Kameron McGusty matched his career high with 22 points versus TCU, connecting on 8-of-14 shots from the field. He has scored in double figures in all but one contest since January 1, including 20 points or more four times.
- ✎ Freshman forward Kristian Doolittle notched his third double-double of the year with 19 points and 13 boards against the Horned Frogs. He has 31 points and 18 rebounds in the past two contests, making 12-of-13 (.923) from the line.
- ✎ Head coach Lon Kruger earned his 600th career victory with the win over Kansas State. He is the third active Big 12 coach to reach the plateau, the 33rd overall to win 600 games and is ranked 10th nationally among active Division I coaches.



OKLAHOMA STATE (20-11, 9-9)

- ✎ Sophomore guard Jawun Evans recorded his third career double-double with 22 points and a career-high 15 assists against Kansas. The 15 assists is tied for the second-most by a Division I player in any game this season.
- ✎ Evans has scored 21 points or more in four of his last five outings, with 57 assists in the past six contests. Evans and Jeffrey Carroll are just the 10th duo in OSU history to score 500 or more points in the same year.
- ✎ Oklahoma State has won at least 20 games in a season for the 35th time in school history and first since 2013-14. The Cowboys secured their 20th victory faster than all but one squad (2012-13) in school history.



TCU (17-14, 6-12)

- ✎ Junior guard Kenrich Williams has 13 double-doubles this season, tied for the most in the Big 12. He has four double-doubles in his last six outings and is averaging 11.3 points and 9.8 rebounds during that span, while shooting 54.7 percent.
- ✎ Junior forward Vladimir Brodziansky has 72 blocked shots this season, third on the school single-season list. He has scored in double digits 22 times this year and has at least five rebounds in six of the past eight games.
- ✎ Senior guard Brandon Parrish played his 128th career game in the regular season finale versus Oklahoma, one short of matching the school record. He has six double-figure scoring performances this season.



TEXAS (10-21, 4-14)

- ✎ Freshman forward Jarrett Allen was one rebound short of notching his third straight double-double, finishing with 20 points and nine rebounds against Baylor. He is averaging 16.7 points and 10.3 rebounds in his last three outings.
- ✎ Allen has led the Longhorns in scoring in 12 of the past 16 contests and has posted double-digit point totals 23 times this year. He has grabbed at least seven rebounds in 18 of his last 20 outings.
- ✎ Texas has had 14 of its 31 games this season decided by five points or less, including 10 by three points or fewer. Seven of the Longhorns' nine conference home games have had margins of four points or less.



TEXAS TECH (18-13, 6-12)

- ✎ Junior guard Keenan Evans has a streak of 19 consecutive games in double figures, including four with 20 points or more. He is averaging 19.1 points and shooting 91.1 percent from the free throw line over the last eight contests.
- ✎ Junior guard Niem Stevenson has scored in double figures in six of his last eight outings after reaching the mark seven times on the year prior to the current stretch. He has been a starter in seven of the past nine contests.
- ✎ The Red Raiders have won at least 18 games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since recording four straight 20-victory campaigns from 2001-02 to '04-05. Tech has 15 conference wins in the last two years, its best total since 2007-08.



WEST VIRGINIA (24-7, 12-6)

- ✎ Junior guard Daxter Miles Jr. finished with 23 points off the bench against Iowa State, more than he had in the previous four games combined. It was his 10th double-figure scoring output of the 2016-17.
- ✎ The Mountaineers lead the nation in turnover margin (+8.8), turnovers forced (21.2) and steals (10.9). The last 10 WVU opponents have committed at least 14 turnovers, including 20 or more four times.
- ✎ West Virginia has posted the 31st 20-win season in school history and the third straight. It marks the 28th campaign with 20 or victories for Bob Huggins in 35 years as a head coach.

The Big 12 has won at least 71 percent of its non-conference games each of the past 16 seasons, with six of the best eight marks coming since 2008-09.
