First Pitch...

The No. 13 University of Oklahoma baseball team ends its 19-game homestand to begin the season with a four-game series against Buffalo at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The series begins Thursday, March 9 with a 7 p.m. first pitch. Friday's action gets underway at 6:30 p.m. and Saturday's doubleheader will be the team's annual "Bark in the Park" date beginning at 2 p.m.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is coming off a narrow 4-2 loss to Wichita State on Tuesday night that ended its win-streak at 12 games. The Sooners are 13-2 overall and lead the Big 12 with a .325 batting average and 2.27 earned run average. Sophomore right-hander **Jake Irvin** gets the ball in the opener Thursday night. He is 3-0 in three starts with a 0.45 ERA. Irvin has been dominant thus far; racking up a Big 12-leading 31 strikeouts in just 20 innings pitched. He fanned 14 in six innings of work last Friday to beat Central Connecticut. Sophomore outfielder **Steele Walker** leads the league in hitting at .424 to go with 16 RBI and a .695 slugging percentage on six doubles, two triples and two home runs. Senior first baseman **Austin O'Brien** is third on the team in batting average (.389) and second in RBI (10) and slugging percentage (.593); primarily hitting behind Walker as the Sooner cleanup hitter. Walker brings an 18-game hit-streak into the weekend, while O'Brien enters on a 12-game streak.

All four games will be available to be streamed at SoonerSports.tv with a premium subscription. The series will also air locally on Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM.

Bark in the Park...

The Sooners host "Bark in the Park" on Saturday. Fans are permit ting to bring in one dog per person. Dogs must be kept on a leash and owners must sign a waiver and provide proof of vaccinations.



HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 20 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 617-468-3 (.569), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Bulls...

Buffalo comes into Norman with a 4-5 record. The Bulls are in the middle of a 26-game road trip to open the season. Buffalo enters the four-game series averaging 7.0 runs per game and a .284 team batting average. The Bulls pitching staff is led by junior college transfer **Shawn Dubin**. He has made three starts this season with a 1-0 record and a 0.60 ERA. **Chris Kwitzer** and **Brian Dudek** lead the Buffalo offense; each batting over .400 thru the first nine games. **Ben Haefner**, who has driven a team-high 11 RBI, is batting .325. The three players have accounted for 49% of the teams runs driven in.

Last Time They Met...

Oklahoma swept the first and only meeting between the two programs in 1981; a series played at Al Lang Stadium in St. Petersburg, Fla. The Sooners offense scored a combined 45 runs over the four-game series. Oklahoma was led by second baseman **Greg Carlton**, who hit .667 with seven RBI and six runs scored. In the third game of the series, **Dewayne Vaughn** pitched a complete game, scattering seven hits and only surrendering one run. At the time, the sweep pushed the Sooners' win-streak to 10, which would eventually hit 22 by the start of Big Eight play.

Thursday Baseball...

In the last three seasons, Oklahoma has played just 16 games that have fallen on a Thursday. In those games, the Sooners are 11-5, including a 4-1 mark a year ago. Three of Oklahoma's Thursday wins over that stretch have come in elimination games at the Big 12 Championship in each of the last three year.

Starting Strong...

Despite having their 12-game win-streak snapped against Wichita State (3/7), the Sooners' 13-2 start is the best to begin as season since 2011. Oklahoma started that season a perfect 16-0. The Sooners' winstreak is the best under head coach **Pete Hughes** and the longest since a 13-game win-streak in 2013.

#YardWork...

The Sooners enter the week tied with TCU for second in the Big 12 in home runs at 14. OU is averaging 0.93 home runs per game, led by junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall**, who had just one career home run entering the season, at three.

20-Strikeout Night...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** struck out a career-best 14 in a 3-0 win over Central Connecticut (3/3) as Sooner pitchers combined to strikeout 20 on the night. Irvin's 14 was the most by a Sooner since **Michael Rocha** struck out 13 against Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth inning. In relief, right-hander **Connor Berry** accomplished the rare feat of striking out four in an inning. He got the first batter looking before the next struck out swinging, but reached on a wild pitch. Berry then punched out the next two.

The Sooners hit the road for the first time in 2017. Oklahoma will be in Georgia for a week with midweek games against Georgia Tech (3/14) and Georgia State (3/15) and a series at Kennesaw State (3/17-19).

Steele Still Streaking...

In the eighth inning of Oklahoma's Sunday game against Boston College (2/26), the 11-game hit-streak of **Steele Walker** was in jeopardy. To that point, he as 0-for-3 on the day and came up with two on and the Sooners trailing by three. Walker salvaged his streak by punching a base hit through the right side that scored a run and would later come in to score the game-tying run in an eventual walk-off. Walker's streak was extended to 18 vs. Wichita State (3/7). The streak, which started against Kansas State (5/26/16) at the Big 12 Championship, is the longest by a Sooner since **Craig Aikin** safely hit in 17 games between the end of the 2014 season and beginning of the 2015 season. Over Walker's streak, he is hitting .417 (30-for-72). The streak marks Walker's second of 10 or more in his career. He is the 17th player in program history with a hit-streak of 18 games or better and the first to do so since Matt Oberste set the program mark with 30 in 2013.

Keepin' it 100...

In national statistical rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at fourth in the country with 163 hits. The Sooners' 120 runs scored are the sixth most in the country and the pitching staff ranks 10th in both K/9 (10.70) and WHIP (1.04). Among individuals, **Jake Irvin** is tied with 56 pitchers for the third most wins at three, is eighth in the country with 31 strikeouts and 10th with a 0.50 WHIP.

Coming in Clutch...

In OU's win over Little Rock (2/28), the Sooners produced eight of their 10 runs with two outs by going 6-for-13 with two gone in an inning. For the season, Oklahoma is hitting .292 (47-for-161) with 46 of the team's 101 RBI having been driven in with two outs. Last season, OU hit .248 in two out situations and accounted for 99 two-out RBI: 17 of which came from **Sheldon Neuse**, who hit .414 with two outs. Under hitting coach **Mike Anderson**, the Sooners hit a team-best .271 with two outs in 2015.

Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2017 as it reached No. 18 in the *Collegiate Baseball News* Top-30 on February 27. The Sooners had previously been ranked on February 22, 2016 when they were No. 25 by *Baseball America*. The current No. 13 ranking by *CBN* is the high for OU under head coach **Pete Hughes**. Oklahoma has spent 12 weeks on the charts in Hughes' tenure and owns a 24-23 record when ranked.

Junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** homered in back-to-back games of a doubleheader on February 25. He first hit a solo home run against Northern Illinois and later added a two-run shot off the light pole in left field against Villanova. **Steele Walker** was the last player to homer in back-to-back games and the last to do so in a doubleheader as he recorded the feat at Austin Peay (5/19/16).

A Different Meaning to 19 Ways...

The Sooners open the season with a string of 19 consecutive games played at home thanks to the opening series being moved from California to Norman. It tied for the longest homestand on record (1962-present), which was recorded in 1976; the year OU reached in fifth consecutive College World Series and won a program-record 62 games.

Four-Hit Freshman...

In Oklahoma's 17-1 rout of Villanova (2/25), freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** went 4-for-5 with three runs out of the nine hole. He became the first Sooner freshman to record four hits in a game since 2014. That season, **Sheldon Neuse** did so at UTA (3/11/14) and vs. Oklahoma State (5/23/14) in the Big 12 Championship. Austin O'Brien also had a four-hit day that year by going 4-for-5 against Belmont (3/16/14) at home.

Irvin Ks 10 Again...

Opening day starter Jake Irvin matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts in the Sooners' win over Long Beach State (2/17). He struck out the side in the first. Irvin previously struck out 10 against No. 25 Oklahoma State (4/20/16); a game in which he struck out the side in the first and the first two batters of the second. His opening day total was the most by a Sooner in the first game of the year since Andrew **Doyle** fanned 10 vs. Western Illinois in 2009.

Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma has won back-to-back series against ranked opponents following its season-opening series win over No. 17 Long Beach State. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa, Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

Freshman Starting Shortstop...

In the season opener against Long Beach State (2/17), **Brandon Zaragoza** became the first Sooner freshman to start at shortstop on opening day in a decade. **Bryant Hernandez** was the last to do so.

Tommy John Triumphs...

A pair of Sooners returned to competitive, collegiate baseball in Oklahoma 11-2 win over Grambling State (2/21) after rehabilitating from Tommy John surgery. Sophomore **Domenic DeRenzo**, who was shut down in mid-May of 2016 and underwent surgery in June, started as the designated hitter and went O-for-3 with three RBI on a bases-loaded walk and a rare two-run sacrifice-fly. Redshirt-junior right-hander **Joey Zurawik**, who began his college career at Texas Tech and has had two Tommy John surgeries, pitched the eighth inning.

Three Games In; Three Runs In...

In OU's opening series, freshman **Brandon Zaragoza** tied for the team lead with three RBI; notching one in each game. He is the first Sooner freshman on record (2003-present) to have driven in one run in each of the first three games of the season. Zaragoza matched fellow shortstop **Danny Black**, a JuCo transfer in 2010, as the only newcomer with at least one RBI in each of the first three games of the season.

D1Baseball.com Rankings...

Several Sooners earned spots on preseason rankings lists put out by D1Baseball.com. Senior right-hander **JB Olson** checks in as the No. 47 ranked relief pitcher in the country after posting a 2.03 ERA as the OU setup man in 2016. A trifecta of Sooners, led by No. 56 **Dylan Grove**, appear on the list of top prospects for the 2018 draft. He is joined by No. 73 Jake Irvin and No. 109 Domenic DeRenzo.

Returning Freshman All-Americans...

Back in June, three Sooner rookies were named Louisville Slugger Freshman All-Americans by Collegiate Baseball News. Catcher Domenic DeRenzo, righty Jake Irvin and outfielder Steele Walker all represented Oklahoma. They became just the second class in OU history to feature three freshman All-Americans; joining Craig Aikin, Jacob Evans and Anthony Hermelyn from 2013. In 2014, Shel**don Neuse** was the first to earn freshman All-America under Hughes.

Skip Brought on Board...

On June 27, exactly three years after head coach **Pete Hughes** was hired, he announced the addition of **Skip Johnson** to the Oklahoma staff. Johnson took over as the Sooners pitching coach after 10 seasons at rival Texas. He previously was the head coach at Navarro College for 13 seasons. During his 10 seasons in Austin, 32 pitchers were drafted, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first round picks.

Walker Wields Wood Well With Woodchucks...

Following his freshman campaign, outfielder Steele Walker spent his summer with the Wisconsin Woodchucks of the Northwoods League. He won the league's batting crown with a .406 average as he collected 86 hits in 53 games, including a club-record 20-game hit streak. The closest challenger to Walker for the batting title was 46 points back at .360. For the summer, he scored 47 runs and drove in 31, while adding 11 doubles and seven home runs.

Black History Month...

This season marks the 40th anniversary of **Michael Pace** integrating OU baseball as he became the first black player in program history. Pace made his Sooner debut at old Haskell Park in Norman against New Mexico on March 15, 1977. In limited action he hit .349 (15-for-43) with 11 runs scored and four home runs. Pace was drafted and signed out of the 11th round by the Philadelphia Phillies.

Opening the Gates...

This season's home-opening series, originally scheduled to be played in California and moved only two days before first pitch, brought in the fifth largest opening weekend crowd on record (1988-present). In 2016, Oklahoma broke its own opening weekend attendance record with 4,466 passing through the gates at L. Dale Mitchell Park to see the Sooners face Northeastern. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Home Field Notes...

Oklahoma finished its 2016 home slate by winning all four Big 12 series at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners posted a .640 win percentage with a 16-9 record: the best since 2013 (.806). OU averaged 1,211 in home attendance; marking a rise in each of the past three seasons and the highest since 2012 (1,283).
