First Pitch...

The No. 12 University of Oklahoma baseball team hits the road for the first time in the 2017 season. The Sooners open a five-game swing in Georgia by playing Georgia Tech Tuesday, March 14 at 3 p.m. CT. The following day, OU visits Georgia State for a 5 p.m. CT first pitch.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma responded to its 12-game win-streak being snapped against Wichita State on Tuesday by rattling off four wins against Buffalo on the weekend. The Sooners outscored the Bulls, 33-13, for the series. After allowing 10 runs in the opener, OU pitchers gave up just one run over the next three games and strung together 25-consecutive scoreless-innings. Sophomore right-hander **Dylan Grove** gets the ball on Tuesday night at Georgia Tech. He is 0-1 with a 4.05 earned run average in three starts. Grove has struck out 20 in just 13.1 innings of work. Sophomore designated hitter **Brylie Ware** was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week on Monday after hitting .562 last week. He is hitting a team-leading .462 with 15 RBI and 13 runs. Sophomore outfielder **Steele Walker** is second on the team at .387 with 19 RBI and six runs. He is slugging a team-high .613 with seven doubles, two triples and two home runs. The Sooners are without senior first baseman **Austin O'Brien** this week, though he did travel with the team, after a left elbow injury was sustained in the ninth inning of Saturday's game. O'Brien, who is hitting .373 and slugging .597, tore his UCL and a muscle in his forearm, but will not require surgery. Oklahoma is hitting a league-leading .328 as a team with all nine players with 30 at-bats or more hitting .300 or better.

On the Air...

Both games will be broadcast locally on the home of Sooner baseball Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM. The voice of the Sooners Toby Rowland will provide all of the play-by-play action. Tuesday night's contest at Georgia Tech will be televised and streamed on the ACC Network Extra.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 20 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 617-468-3 (.569), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Yellow Jackets...

Georgia Tech is 10-4 overall and 1-2 following a three-game series against Miami (Fla.) this past weekend. The Yellow Jackets will throw RHP **Ben Schniederjans** on Tuesday night. He has no record with a 5.40 ERA in five innings across four relief appearances. Catcher **Joey Bart** is the team's top hitter at .433 with eight home runs and 22 RBI. Second baseman **Wade Bailey** is second on the team with a .429 average and a team-high eight doubles and 27 runs scored.

Last Time They Met...

Oklahoma upset No. 3 Georgia Tech, 6-2, in Fullerton, Calif. at the Kia Classic. The Sooners put four runs on the board in the first and held the Yellow Jackets scoreless until a pair of unearned runs came across on a home run by **Jeremy Slayden** in the eighth. **Mark Roberts** was excellent on the hill for OU; going eight innings with eight strikeouts to just two walks. As a team, the Sooners registered just seven hits, but **Ole Sheldon** and **Matt Bosc** each drove in two runs.

All-Time vs. Georgia Tech...

The Sooners are undefeated in the all-time series, 6-0. All six contests have been played at a neutral site. The two teams first met in 1988 in Las Vegas. Most famously, Oklahoma and Georgia Tech squared off in the 1994 College World Series National Championship game. OU won the game, 13-5, as center fielder **Chip Glass** was named Most Outstanding Player. Current Georgia Tech head coach **Danny Hall** was in his first season at the helm of the program in 1994.

Oklahoma Powers to Series Title...

At old Rosenblatt Stadium in Omaha on June 11, 1994, the Oklahoma Sooners defeated the Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets for the second national championship in program history. OU's three through five hitters combined to drive in seven runs, including a three-run out of the park home run to right in the sixth by **Damon Minor**. The Sooners ace in the pen, **Bucky Buckles**, pitched the last 3.2 innings to get the save for **Tim Walton**, the third OU pitcher of the day. Glass also homered on the day for the Sooners as did Georgia Tech's future big leaguers **Nomar Garciaparra** and **Jason Varitek**. Future MLB outfielder **Jay Payton** went 2-for-5 for GT.

Scouting the Panthers...

Georgia State is 9-7 on the season and 5-1 at home. Panther pitchers are holding opponents to a .210 average. **Rhett Harper** has three saves in six games with a 1.04 ERA and .167 BAA. Shortstop **Romero Greer** is the team's leading hitter at .346. Center fielder **Ryan Blanton** has slugged three home runs with 13 RBI on a .279 average.

Starting Strong...

Despite having their 12-game win-streak snapped against Wichita State (3/7), the Sooners' 17-2 start is the best to begin a season since 2010. Oklahoma started that season 20-2. The Sooners' win-streak was the best under head coach **Pete Hughes** and the longest since a 13-game win-streak in 2013.

Coming in Clutch...

In OU's win over Little Rock (2/28), the Sooners produced eight of their 10 runs with two outs by going 6-for-13 with two gone in an inning. For the season, Oklahoma is hitting .295 (61-for-207) with 64 of the team's 133 RBI having been driven in with two outs. Last season, OU hit .248 in two out situations and accounted for 99 two-out RBI: 17 of which came from **Sheldon Neuse**, who hit .414 with two outs. Under hitting coach **Mike Anderson**, the Sooners hit a team-best .271 with two outs in 2015.

Up Next...

The Sooners stay in Georgia for a three-game series against Kennesaw State. Game one is Friday, March 17 at 5 p.m. CT.

Keepin' it 100...

In national statistical rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at second in the country with 208 hits. The Sooners' 153 runs scored are the fourth most in the country and the pitching staff ranks 10th in both K/9 (10.70) and WHIP (1.04). Among individuals, **Jake Irvin** is one of 16 pitchers in the country with a NCAA-leading four wins. **Steele Walker** is also top-10 in the nation in hits at 29, which ranks sixth.

20-Strikeout Night...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** struck out a career-best 14 in a 3-0 win over Central Connecticut (3/3) as Sooner pitchers combined to strikeout 20 on the night. Irvin's 14 was the most by a Sooner since **Michael Rocha** struck out 13 against Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth inning. In relief, right-hander **Connor Berry** accomplished the rare feat of striking out four in an inning. He got the first batter looking before the next struck out swinging, but reached on a wild pitch. Berry then punched out the next two.

Steele's Streak Snapped...

The Sooners last turn at bat against Buffalo (3/11) ended on a ground-ball-double play with **Steele Walker** in the hole. He finished the game 0-for-4 as his 21-game hit-streak came to an end. Walker hit .405 (34-for-84) during the streak. Walker's streak is tied for the fifth longest in program history with **Kevin Burdick** (1986) and **Zach Leske** (2000). It was the longest by a Sooner since **Matt Oberste** set the program mark with 30 in 2013.

YardWork...

The Sooners enter the week tied with TCU and West Virginia for second in the Big 12 in home runs at 15. OU is averaging 0.79 home runs per game, led by junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall**, who had just one career home run entering the season, at three.

Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2017 as it reached No. 18 in the *Collegiate Baseball News* Top-30 on February 27. The Sooners had previously been ranked on February 22, 2016 when they were No. 25 by *Baseball America*. The current No. 13 ranking by *CBN* is the high for OU under head coach **Pete Hughes**. Oklahoma has spent 12 weeks on the charts in Hughes' tenure and owns a 28-23 record when ranked.

The Sooners' first 17 games of the season were started by a sophomore until junior **Devon Perez** started game 18. Oklahoma has gotten nine wins from its sophomore class; the most in the league. In 2016, freshman pitchers from OU and Texas Tech tied for the league lead with 18 regular season wins. Twelve of the Sooners' 17 wins have been claimed by underclassmen; ahead of TCU and TTU at 10.

Ben There, Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16).

TreMENDous Feat...

Junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** homered in back-to-back games of a doubleheader on February 25. He first hit a solo home run against Northern Illinois and later added a two-run shot off the light pole in left field against Villanova. **Steele Walker** was the last player to homer in back-to-back games and the last to do so in a doubleheader as he recorded the feat at Austin Peay (5/19/16).

A Different Meaning to 19 Ways...

The Sooners open the season with a string of 19 consecutive games played at home thanks to the opening series being moved from California to Norman. It tied for the longest homestand on record (1962-present), which was recorded in 1976; the year OU reached in fifth consecutive College World Series and won a program-record 62 games.

Four-Hit Freshman...

In Oklahoma's 17-1 rout of Villanova (2/25), freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** went 4-for-5 with three runs out of the nine hole. He became the first Sooner freshman to record four hits in a game since 2014. That season, **Sheldon Neuse** did so at UTA (3/11/14) and vs. Oklahoma State (5/23/14) in the Big 12 Championship. **Austin O'Brien** also had a four-hit day that year by going 4-for-5 against Belmont (3/16/14) at home.

Irvin Ks 10 Again...

Opening day starter **Jake Irvin** matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts in the Sooners' win over Long Beach State (2/17). He struck out the side in the first. Irvin previously struck out 10 against No. 25 Oklahoma State (4/20/16); a game in which he struck out the side in the first and the first two batters of the second. His opening day total was the most by a Sooner in the first game of the year since **Andrew Doyle** fanned 10 vs. Western Illinois in 2009.

Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma has won back-to-back series against ranked opponents following its season-opening series win over No. 17 Long Beach State. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

Freshman Starting Shortstop...

In the season opener against Long Beach State (2/17), **Brandon Zaragoza** became the first Sooner freshman to start at shortstop on opening day in a decade. **Bryant Hernandez** was the last to do so.

Tommy John Triumphs...

A pair of Sooners returned to competitive, collegiate baseball in Oklahoma 11-2 win over Grambling State (2/21) after rehabilitating from Tommy John surgery. Sophomore **Domenic DeRenzo**, who was shut down in mid-May of 2016 and underwent surgery in June, started as the designated hitter and went 0-for-3 with three RBI on a bases-loaded walk and a rare two-run sacrifice fly. Redshirt-junior right-hander **Joey Zurawik**, who began his college career at Texas Tech and has had two Tommy John surgeries, pitched the eighth inning.

Three Games In; Three Runs In...

In OU's opening series, freshman **Brandon Zaragoza** tied for the team lead with three RBI; notching one in each game. He is the first Sooner freshman on record (2003-present) to have driven in one run in each of the first three games of the season. Zaragoza matched fellow shortstop **Danny Black**, a JuCo transfer in 2010, as the only newcomer with at least one RBI in each of the first three games of the season.

D1Baseball.com Rankings...

Several Sooners earned spots on preseason rankings lists put out by D1Baseball.com. Senior right-hander **JB Olson** checks in as the No. 47 ranked relief pitcher in the country after posting a 2.03 ERA as the OU setup man in 2016. A trifecta of Sooners, led by No. 56 **Dylan Grove**, appear on the list of top prospects for the 2018 draft. He is joined by No. 73 **Jake Irvin** and No. 109 **Domenic DeRenzo**.

Returning Freshman All-Americans...

Back in June, three Sooner rookies were named Louisville Slugger Freshman All-Americans by *Collegiate Baseball News*. Catcher **Domenic DeRenzo**, righty **Jake Irvin** and outfielder **Steele Walker** all represented Oklahoma. They became just the second class in OU history to feature three freshman All-Americans; joining **Craig Aikin**, **Jacob Evans** and **Anthony Hermelyn** from 2013. In 2014, **Sheldon Neuse** was the first to earn freshman All-America under Hughes.

Skip Brought on Board...

On June 27, exactly three years after head coach **Pete Hughes** was hired, he announced the addition of **Skip Johnson** to the Oklahoma staff. Johnson took over as the Sooners pitching coach after 10 seasons at rival Texas. He previously was the head coach at Navarro College for 13 seasons. During his 10 seasons in Austin, 32 pitchers were drafted, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first round picks.

Walker Fields Wood Well With Woodchucks...

Following his freshman campaign, outfielder **Steele Walker** spent his summer with the Wisconsin Woodchucks of the Northwoods League. He won the league's batting crown with a .406 average as he collected 86 hits in 53 games, including a club-record 20-game hit streak. The closest challenger to Walker for the batting title was 46 points back at .360. For the summer, he scored 47 runs and drove in 31, while adding 11 doubles and seven home runs.

Black History Month...

This season marks the 40th anniversary of **Michael Pace** integrating OU baseball as he became the first black player in program history. Pace made his Sooner debut at old Haskell Park in Norman against New Mexico on March 15, 1977. In limited action he hit .349 (15-for-43) with 11 runs scored and four home runs. Pace was drafted and signed out of the 11th round by the Philadelphia Phillies.

Opening the Gates...

This season's home-opening series, originally scheduled to be played in California and moved only two days before first pitch, brought in the fifth largest opening weekend crowd on record (1988-present). In 2016, Oklahoma broke its own opening weekend attendance record with 4,466 passing through the gates at L. Dale Mitchell Park to see the Sooners face Northeastern. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.
