First Pitch...

The No. 10 University of Oklahoma baseball team is back in the "Sooner State" for a non-conference Bedlam match-up in Stillwater on Tuesday, March 21. The Sooners take on No. 21 Oklahoma State at 6:30 p.m. for their sixth consecutive road game.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma went 4-1 on its road swing through Georgia last week, including a series sweep at Kennesaw State over the weekend. The Sooners, who have won a NCAA-leading 21 games, are 21-3 and ranked in every major poll to enter the week. Oklahoma leads the Big 12 in hitting at .309 and pitching with a 2.62 earned run average. Despite only one hit on the road last week, sophomore Brylie Ware, who started four games at first base in place of injured senior Austin O'Brien (team-high .373 average), is third in the league in hitting with a .368 average and has reached base in 21 of 22 games played. Senior catcher **Renae Martinez** is fourth in the league with a .365 average after hitting .429 (6-for-14) in Georgia as he hit his second and third home runs of the season. He is slugging .587 and has driven in 15 runs. Sophomore left fielder **Steele Walker** rounds out the Big 12's top-10 hitters with a .347 average. Walker busted out of a post-21 game hit-streak slump with a five-RBI game on Saturday, including a go-ahead grand slam in the sixth inning to beat Kennesaw State. Oklahoma turns to freshman right-hander **Nathan Wiles** for his second career start on the bump. He threw six-shutout innings at Georgia State (3/15) to move to 3-0 on the year with a 0.60 ERA.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a welldeserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 20 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 617-468-3 (.569), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Cowboys...

No. 21 Oklahoma State is 14-6 overall and riding a seven-game winstreak into the week. Left fielder **Garrett McCain** is the Cowboys leading hitter at .364 to go with a .572 slugging percentage. Third baseman **Garrett Benge** is second on the team at .356 with five home runs and 26 RBI. OSU is hitting .294 as a team and averaging 7.15 runs per game.

All-Time vs. Oklahoma State...

Oklahoma trails Oklahoma State in the all-time series, 154-138. The Sooners hold the longest win streak of the series with an 11-game stretch from 1976-78. In the last three seasons, the Cowboys hold an 11-5 advantage. The longest game played between the two was a 12-9, 18-inning victory for Oklahoma in Stillwater on April 15, 2014. Since 2013, 13 of the 19 meetings have been decided by three runs or less, including six on-run games.

Last Time They Met...

Oklahoma capped off its first Bedlam series win since 2012 by defeating No. 12 Oklahoma State in the series finale, 9-1, at ONEOK Field in Tulsa. **Dylan Grove** got the win in just his second career start: going 5.2 innings with three strikeouts. The Sooners opened the series with a 9-1 win at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark behind a rain delay-shortened outing by **Jake Irvin** and a five-RBI night for **Cody Thomas**. The Cowboys claimed the middle game of the series, but OU fought back from a seven-run deficit and got the tying run to third in the ninth before falling, 10-9 in Tulsa.

Newcomer of the Week...

Brylie Ware was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week (3/13). He hit a team-high .562 (9-for-16) in a 4-1 week to earn his first career weekly honor. He totaled seven runs scored, seven driven in, two doubles and two walks with a .632 on-base and .688 slugging percentage. Ware became the second Sooner to earn a Big 12 weekly award this season and the first to earn Newcomer of the Week since **Sheldon Neuse** (4/7/14).

Down Six to Up Eight...

The Sooners overcame a six-run deficit to win at Kennesaw State (3/18); marking the first win when trailing by five or more since erasing a five-run gap against West Virginia (4/23/16). Solo home runs in the third and fourth by **Ben Hollas** and **Blake Brewster** inched Oklahoma closer. The two sides then traded a run in the fifth and it was 7-3 headed to the sixth. There, OU sent 10 to the plate and scored six runs, including a go-ahead grand slam by **Steele Walker** with two down. The Sooners added five insurance runs in the eighth and three more in the ninth of a 17-9 win.

Fresh Arms...

The Sooners' first 17 games of the season were started by a sophomore pitcher until junior **Devon Perez** started game 18. Oklahoma has gotten 11 wins from its sophomore class; the most in the league. In 2016, freshman pitchers from OU and Texas Tech tied for the league lead with 18 regular season wins. Fifteen of the Sooners' 21 wins have been claimed by underclassmen; ahead of TTU (12) and TCU (11).

Starting Strong...

Despite having their 12-game win-streak snapped against Wichita State (3/7), the Sooners' 21-3 start is the best to begin a season since 2010. Oklahoma started that season 22-3. The Sooners' win-streak was the best under head coach **Pete Hughes** and the longest since a 13-game win-streak in 2013.

Coming in Clutch...

In OU's win over Little Rock (2/28), the Sooners produced eight of their 10 runs with two outs by going 6-for-13 with two gone in an inning. For the season, Oklahoma is hitting .272 (71-for-261) with 80 of the team's 166 RBI having been driven in with two outs. Last season, OU hit .248 in two-out situations and accounted for 99 two-out RBI: 17 of which came from **Sheldon Neuse**, who hit .414 with two outs. **Steele Walker** leads the 2017 squad with 11 followed by **Brylie Ware** at 10. Under hitting coach **Mike Anderson**, the Sooners hit a team-best .271 with two outs in 2015.

Up Next...

Big 12 play opens on the road as Oklahoma visits Baylor for a three-game series in Waco. Game one is scheduled for Friday, March 24 at 6:35 pm.

Keepin' it 100...

In national statistical rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at second in the country in hits (247) and runs (194). The Sooners' 158 runs scored are the sixth most in the country and the pitching staff ranks eighth in ERA at 2.23. Among individuals, **Jake Irvin** is one of eight pitchers in the country with a NCAA-leading five wins. **Renae Martinez** is the top ranked Sooner hitter as the third toughest player to strikeout in the country with only one in 63 at-bats.

20-Strikeout Night...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** struck out a career-best 14 in a 3-0 win over Central Connecticut (3/3) as OU pitchers combined to strikeout 20. Irvin's 14 was the most by a Sooner since **Michael Rocha** struck out 13 against Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth inning. In relief, right-hander **Connor Berry** accomplished the rare feat of striking out four in an inning. He got the first batter looking before the next struck out swinging, but reached on a wild pitch. Berry then punched out the next two.

Crimson Over Orange; Twice as Nice...

Last season, OU won Big 12 series over Texas and OSU for the first time since 1998; the only other time it has happened. The **Larry Cochell**-led Sooners took two of three from the No. 16 Cowboys. OU won the opener at Driller Stadium and then split the next two at All Sports Stadium. Oklahoma then swept the Longhorns at home to close out the regular season. In 2016, **Pete Hughes** and the Sooners picked up a home series win over Texas and took the opener from OSU at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark then split at ONEOK Field.

#YardWork...

The Sooners enter the week tied with TCU and West Virginia for second in the Big 12 in home runs at 15. OU is averaging 0.79 home runs per game, led by junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall**, who had just one career home run entering the season, at three.

Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2017 as it reached No. 18 in the *Collegiate Baseball News* Top-30 on February 27. The Sooners had previously been ranked on February 22, 2016 when they were No. 25 by *Baseball America*. The current No. 10 ranking by *CBN* is the high for OU under coach **Pete Hughes**. Oklahoma has spent 14 weeks on the charts in Hughes' tenure and owns a 32-24 record when ranked.

Steele's Streak Snapped...

The Sooners last turn at bat against Buffalo (3/11) ended on a ground-ball-double play with **Steele Walker** in the hole. He finished the game 0-for-4 as his 21-game hit-streak came to an end. Walker hit .405 (34-for-84) during the streak. Walker's streak is tied for the fifth longest in program history with **Kevin Burdick** (1986) and **Zach Leske** (2000). It was the longest by a Sooner since **Matt Oberste** set the program mark with 30 in 2013.

Ben There, Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16).

TreMENDous Feat...

Junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** homered in back-to-back games of a doubleheader on February 25. He first hit a solo home run against Northern Illinois and later added a two-run shot off the light pole in left field against Villanova. **Steele Walker** was the last player to homer in back-to-back games and the last to do so in a doubleheader as he recorded the feat at Austin Peay (5/19/16).

A Different Meaning to 19 Ways...

The Sooners open the season with a string of 19 consecutive games played at home thanks to the opening series being moved from California to Norman. It tied for the longest homestand on record (1962-present), which was recorded in 1976; the year OU reached in fifth consecutive College World Series and won a program-record 62 games.

Four-Hit Freshman...

In Oklahoma's 17-1 rout of Villanova (2/25), freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** went 4-for-5 with three runs out of the nine hole. He became the first Sooner freshman to record four hits in a game since 2014. That season, **Sheldon Neuse** did so at UTA (3/11/14) and vs. Oklahoma State (5/23/14) in the Big 12 Championship. **Austin O'Brien** also had a four-hit day that year by going 4-for-5 against Belmont (3/16/14) at home.

Irvin Ks 10 Again...

Opening day starter **Jake Irvin** matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts in the Sooners' win over Long Beach State (2/17). He struck out the side in the first. Irvin previously struck out 10 against No. 25 Oklahoma State (4/20/16); a game in which he struck out the side in the first and the first two batters of the second. His opening day total was the most by a Sooner in the first game of the year since **Andrew Doyle** fanned 10 vs. Western Illinois in 2009.

Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma has won back-to-back series against ranked opponents following its season-opening series win over No. 17 Long Beach State. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

Freshman Starting Shortstop...

In the season opener against Long Beach State (2/17), **Brandon Zaragoza** became the first Sooner freshman to start at shortstop on opening day in a decade. **Bryant Hernandez** was the last to do so.

Against the Ranked...

Since **Pete Hughes** took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 15-33-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 5-18 against top-10 teams, including a win over No. 5 Texas Tech (5/28/16). This season marks the first time OU plays a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a doubleheader with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State.

Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 9-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 5-O loss at Texas Tech (3/24/15). Oklahoma lost the series to the Red Raiders to mark the first series loss in the first Big 12 weekend since 2012 against Texas. OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

Tommy John Triumphs...

A pair of Sooners returned to competitive, collegiate baseball in Oklahoma 11-2 win over Grambling State (2/21) after rehabilitating from Tommy John surgery. Sophomore **Domenic DeRenzo**, who was shut down in mid-May of 2016 and underwent surgery in June, started as the designated hitter and went O-for-3 with three RBI on a bases-loaded walk and a rare two-run sacrifice-fly. Redshirt-junior right-hander **Joey Zurawik**, who began his college career at Texas Tech and has had two Tommy John surgeries, pitched the eighth inning.

Three Games In: Three Runs In...

In OU's opening series, freshman **Brandon Zaragoza** tied for the team lead with three RBI; notching one in each game. He is the first Sooner freshman on record (2003-present) to have driven in one run in each of the first three games of the season. Zaragoza matched fellow shortstop **Danny Black**, a JuCo transfer in 2010, as the only newcomer with at least one RBI in each of the first three games of the season.

D1Baseball.com Rankings...

Several Sooners earned spots on preseason rankings lists put out by D1Baseball.com. Senior right-hander **JB Olson** checks in as the No. 47 ranked relief pitcher in the country after posting a 2.03 ERA as the OU setup man in 2016. A trifecta of Sooners, led by No. 56 **Dylan Grove**. appear on the list of top prospects for the 2018 draft. He is joined by No. 73 Jake Irvin and No. 109 Domenic DeRenzo.

Returning Freshman All-Americans...

Three Sooners were named 2016 Louisville Slugger Freshman All-Americans by CBN. Domenic DeRenzo, Jake Irvin and Steele **Walker** all represented OU. They became just the second class in OU history to feature three freshman All-Americans; joining **Craig Aikin**, Jacob Evans and Anthony Hermelyn from 2013. In 2014, Shel**don Neuse** was the first to earn freshman All-America under Hughes.

Skip Brought on Board...

On June 27, exactly three years after head coach **Pete Hughes** was hired, he announced the addition of **Skip Johnson** to the Oklahoma staff. Johnson took over as the Sooners pitching coach after 10 seasons at rival Texas. He previously was the head coach at Navarro College for 13 seasons. During his 10 seasons in Austin, 32 pitchers were drafted, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first round picks.

Walker Wields Wood Well With Woodchucks...

Following his freshman campaign, outfielder Steele Walker spent his summer with the Wisconsin Woodchucks of the Northwoods League. He won the league's batting crown with a .406 average as he collected 86 hits in 53 games, including a club-record 20-game hit streak. The closest challenger to Walker for the batting title was 46 points back at .360. For the summer, he scored 47 runs and drove in 31, while adding 11 doubles and seven home runs.
