First Pitch...

The No. 10 University of Oklahoma baseball team opens Big 12 play at Baylor this weekend. The Sooners meet the Bears for the first of three from Ferrell Field at Baylor Ballpark in Waco on Friday, March 24 at 6:30 p.m. as OU completes a stretch of nine road games.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is 21-4 on the season, marking a 10-game improvement over the first 25 games of 2016. The Sooners lead the Big 12 in hitting and pitching with a .309 batting average and 2.61 earned run average. Senior catcher **Renae Martinez** picked up two hits in Tuesday night's 4-3 loss to Oklahoma State to tie for the team lead in average at .373. He has scored 19 runs, driven in 16 and smacked three home runs. Sophomore left fielder Steele Walker is fourth on the team with a .357 average and has driven in a team-leading 25 runs. He has seven doubles, three triples and three home runs for a .582 slugging percentage. Oklahoma expects to get redshirtfreshman outfielder Kyler Murray, who began spring football practice this week, back into the lineup after being slowed by a hamstring injury earlier this month. The Sooner bullpen is holding opponents to a .194 batting average and owns an 11.04 strikeouts-per-nine inning average. Senior right-hander **JB Olson** serves as the team's closer and has recorded five saves in a team-high 13 appearances with a 1.96 ERA and 23 strikeouts in 18.1 innings. Sophomore right-hander **Connor Berry** sports a 1.16 ERA with 20 strikeouts in 12 innings.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a welldeserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 20 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 617-468-3 (.569), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Bears...

No. 14 Baylor is 17-4 under second-year head coach **Steve Rodriguez** and 1-2 in the Big 12 after salvaging its first series with a Sunday win against West Virginia at home last weekend. The Bears are coming off a midweek win over Dallas Baptist and own a 12-3 record at their home park. Designated hitter **Matt Menard** is hitting .342 with 15 runs scored and 10 driven in. Right fielder **Kameron Esthay** has scored 24 runs with 19 RBI and four home runs on a .292 average. Senior RHP **Nick Lewis**, who has not started a game vs. OU in his career, gets the nod on Friday. He is 3-1 with a 2.73 ERA and 29 strikeouts across 29.2 innings in five starts.

All-Time vs. Baylor...

Despite having lost three consecutive series to the Bears prior to 2016, the Sooners lead the all-time series, 40-36. Oklahoma took two out of three last year after Baylor claimed two out of three in the three previous series. In the 2013 Big 12 Baseball Championship opener, **Jon Gray** pitched OU to a 2-0 victory in a complete-game, 12-strikeout effort. The Sooners' last visit to Waco resulted in the Bears claiming the series by Saturday, but Oklahoma salvaged Sunday's game in dominating fashion, 13-3.

Last Time They Met...

Oklahoma walked off twice to claim the 2016 Baylor series. The Sooners never led until the final run of the game in either win. In game one, **Steele Walker** led off the eighth with a double, was sacrificed to third and scored the tying run on an **Alex Wise** sacrifice-fly. **Sheldon Neuse** hit a leadoff-single in the ninth and the Sooners had two on after a walk to **Jack Flansburg. Renae Martinez** was then asked to sacrifice: a bunt fielded in front of the mound and thrown away as Neuse came in to score the winning run. Sunday's finale went to extra innings as both teams scored in the sixth, seventh and eighth inning: all ended with the score tied. **Cade Harris** and **Ben Hollas** singled to set the table in the 11th and Flansburg delivered the walk-off single. Each team hit four home runs in the game with **Hunter Haley** hitting two for OU.

Catching Connection...

Oklahoma freshman catcher **Brady Lindsly** and Baylor freshman catcher **Shea Langaliers** were high school teammates at Keller (Texas) High School the last four seasons. Langaliers was the primary catcher, while Lindsly moved to shortstop. Langaliers has started 20 of 21 games and is hitting .288 with 13 RBI. Lindsly has started 11 games, recording at least one hit in each start, with a .286 average, seven runs and four RBI.

O'Brien vs. Baylor...

Senior first baseman **Austin O'Brien** remains on the shelf following a torn UCL against Buffalo (3/12). The only four-year player on the Sooners roster, O'Brien has appeared in nine career games against Baylor, including seven starts. He is a career .323 (10-for-31) hitter against the Bears with four RBI and home run and a double. O'Brien has recorded four multi-hit games in the series, including a three-hit day as a freshman.

Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 9-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 5-0 loss at Texas Tech (3/24/15). Oklahoma lost the series to the Red Raiders to mark the first series loss in the first Big 12 weekend since 2012 against Texas. OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. lowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

Up Next...

The Sooners are off in the midweek ahead of their Big 12 home opener. Oklahoma hosts Texas Tech for a three-game series at L. Dale Mitchell Park beginning Friday, March 31 at 6:30 p.m.

Milestone Tracker...

Jake Irvin has 42 strikeouts on the season to push hit career total to 93; which leaves him seven shy of 100. **JB Olson** picked up his fifth save of the season last week. He is in a five-way tie for seventh all-time in career saves at nine; a list that includes **Garrett Richards** and Ralph Garza. Offensively, Steele Walker needs four hits in the next 18 games to be the 14th player on record (2003-present) with 100 career hits in 100 career games or less. He currently has 96 hits

Newcomer of the Week...

Brylie Ware was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week (3/13). He hit a team-high .562 (9-for-16) in a 4-1 week to earn his first career weekly honor. He totaled seven runs scored, seven driven in, two doubles and two walks with a .632 on-base and .688 slugging percentage. Ware became the second Sooner to earn a Big 12 weekly award this season and the first to earn Newcomer of the Week since **Sheldon Neuse** (4/7/14).

Down Six to Up Eight...

The Sooners overcame a six-run deficit to win at Kennesaw State (3/18); marking the first win when trailing by five or more since erasing a five-run gap against West Virginia (4/23/16). Solo home runs in the third and fourth by Ben Hollas and Blake Brewster inched Oklahoma closer. The two sides then traded a run in the fifth and it was 7-3 headed to the sixth. There, OU sent 10 to the plate and scored six runs, including a go-ahead grand slam by **Steele Walker** with two down. The Sooners added five insurance runs in the eighth and three more in the ninth of a 17-9 win.

Fresh Arms...

The Sooners' first 17 games of the season were started by a sophomore pitcher until junior **Devon Perez** started game 18. Oklahoma has gotten 11 wins from its sophomore class; the most in the league. In 2016, freshman pitchers from OU and Texas Tech tied for the league lead with 18 regular season wins. Fifteen of the Sooners' 21 wins have been claimed by underclassmen; ahead of TTU (13) and TCU (11).

Starting Strong...

Despite having their 12-game win-streak snapped against Wichita State (3/7), the Sooners' 21-4 start is the best to begin a season since 2010. Oklahoma started that season 22-3. The Sooners' win-streak was the best under head coach **Pete Hughes** and the longest since a 13-game win-streak in 2013.

Coming in Clutch...

In OU's win over Little Rock (2/28), the Sooners produced eight of their 10 runs with two outs by going 6-for-13 with two gone in an inning. For the season, Oklahoma is hitting .274 (75-for-274) with 81 of the team's 168 RBI having been driven in with two outs. Last season, OU hit .248 in two-out situations and accounted for 99 two-out RBI; 17 of which came from **Sheldon Neuse**, who hit .414 with two outs. Steele Walker leads the 2017 squad with 11 followed by Brylie Ware at 10. Under hitting coach Mike Anderson, the Sooners hit a team-best .271 with two outs in 2015.

Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at fifth in the country in runs with 197. The Sooners' 257 hits are the sixth most in the country and the pitching staff ranks ninth in ERA at 2.61. Among individuals, **Jake Irvin** is one of 11 pitchers in the country with a NCAA-leading five wins. Renae Martinez is the top ranked Sooner hitter as the third toughest player to strikeout in the country with only two in 67 at-bats.

Against the Ranked...

Since Pete Hughes took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 15-33-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 5-18 against top-10 teams, including a win over No. 5 Texas Tech (5/28/16). This season marks the first time OU played a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLÁ in 2008 when the Sooners split a doubleheader with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State.

Steele's Streak Snapped...

The Sooners last turn at bat against Buffalo (3/11) ended on a groundball-double play with **Steele Walker** in the hole. He finished the game O-for-4 as his 21-game hit-streak came to an end. Walker hit .405 (34for-84) during the streak. Walker's streak is tied for the fifth longest in program history with Kevin Burdick (1986) and Zach Leske (2000). It was the longest by a Sooner since **Matt Oberste** set the program mark with 30 in 2013.

Ben There, Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16).

TreMENDous Feat...

Junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** homered in back-to-back games of a doubleheader on February 25. He first hit a solo home run against Northern Illinois and later added a two-run shot off the light pole in left field against Villanova. Steele Walker was the last player to homer in back-to-back games and the last to do so in a doubleheader as he recorded the feat at Austin Peav (5/19/16).

A Different Meaning to 19 Ways...

The Sooners opened the season with a string of 19 consecutive games played at home thanks to the opening series being moved from California to Norman. Oklahoma went 17-2 on the homestand. It tied for the longest homestand on record (1962-present), which was recorded in 1976; the year OU reached in fifth consecutive College World Series and won a program-record 62 games.

Four-Hit Freshman...

In Oklahoma's 17-1 rout of Villanova (2/25), freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** went 4-for-5 with three runs out of the nine hole. He became the first Sooner freshman to record four hits in a game since 2014. That season. **Sheldon Neuse** did so at UTA (3/11/14) and vs. Oklahoma State (5/23/14) in the Big 12 Championship. Austin O'Brien also had a four-hit day that year by going 4-for-5 against Belmont (3/16/14) at home.

Irvin Ks 10 Again...

Opening day starter **Jake Irvin** matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts in the Sooners' win over Long Beach State (2/17). He struck out the side in the first. Irvin previously struck out 10 against No. 25 Oklahoma State (4/20/16); a game in which he struck out the side in the first and the first two batters of the second. His opening day total was the most by a Sooner in the first game of the year since **Andrew Doyle** fanned 10 vs. Western Illinois in 2009.

Freshman Starting Shortstop...

In the season opener against Long Beach State (2/17), **Brandon Zaragoza** became the first Sooner freshman to start at shortstop on opening day in a decade. **Bryant Hernandez** was the last to do so.

Crimson Over Orange; Twice as Nice...

Last season, OU won Big 12 series over Texas and OSU for the first time since 1998; the only other time it has happened. The **Larry Cochell**-led Sooners took two of three from the No. 16 Cowboys. OU won the opener at Driller Stadium and then split the next two at All Sports Stadium. Oklahoma then swept the Longhorns at home to close out the regular season. In 2016, Pete Hughes and the Sooners picked up a home series win over Texas and took the opener from OSU at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark then split at ONEOK Field.
