### Leading Off

- OU's 23-5 start is the best since 27-4 in 1985. The Sooner win total is a 10-game improvement through 28 games vs. 2016.
- The Sooners moved up in three out of five polls this week, dropped five spots in the *CBN* Top-30 and stayed even at No. 15 in the NCBWA Top-30.
- Steele Walker needs two hits in the next 15 games to become the 14th player on record (2003-present) with 100 career hits in 100 career games or less.
- The Sooners lead the Big 12 in batting average (.300), slugging percentage (.444), runs (211), hits (279), home runs (25), RBI (181), ERA (2.73), batting average against (.208) and strikeouts (279).
- Ben Hollas was named one of seven Sooners awarded the Dr. Gerald Lage Academic Achievement Award by the Big 12; the league's highest academic honor.
- Seniors Renae Martinez, Austin O'Brien and JB Olson were elected captains by their teammates in fall ball.

### First Pitch...

The No. 15 University of Oklahoma baseball team welcomes No. 2 Texas Tech to L. Dale Mitchell Park for its Big 12 home opening series this weekend. Game one of three gets underway Friday, March 31 at 6:30 p.m.

### **About the Sooners...**

Following a 2-1 series win at Baylor last weekend, Oklahoma is 23-5 overall and 2-1 in Big 12 play. The Sooners lead the conference with a team batting average of .300 and a 2.66 earned run average. Sophomore first baseman **Brylie Ware** is hitting a team-high .373 with 22 runs and 16 RBI. Sophomore outfielder **Steele Walker** is second on the team with a .336 average to go with a .573 slugging percentage on eight doubles, three triples and four home runs. Walker is one of three Sooners with four home runs this season. As a team, OU leads the Big 12 with 25 home runs. Junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** and sophomore outfielder **Blake Brewster** have also gone yard four times and each hit a game-winning home run in last weekend's series vs. the Bears. Mendenhall is hitting .287 with 22 runs, while Brewster is hitting .295 with 16 RBI. Sophomore right-hander **Dylan Grove** gets the ball in game one. He is 0-1 with a 3.22 FRA.

### On the Air...

All three games will air across the Sooner Sports Network and can be heard locally on the home of Sooner baseball, Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM. The voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will handle all of the play-by-play action. Games one and three will be television audio simulcast to the radio with no pregame show. Former MLB All-Star **Mickey Tettleton** will join Rowland in the booth on Saturday. Sooner Sports TV will broadcast all three games with game one being a SoonerSports.tv stream. **Chad McKee** will have the call on Saturday and former Sooner and MLB pitcher **George Frazier** will provide color commentary on all three games.

### **HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES**

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a welldeserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 20 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 617-468-3 (.569), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

### Scouting the Red Raiders...

No. 2 Texas Tech is 24-4 overall and 3-0 in the Big 12 following a sweep of Texas two weeks ago. The Red Raiders top hitter is right fielder **Ryan Long** at .372 with a .513 slugging percentage. Left fielder **Grant Little** is second at .370 with 21 runs scored. Right-hander **Davis Martin** is Tech's Friday night starter and owns a 4-1 record and 2.57 ERA. LHP **Steven Gingery** gets the ball on Saturday and RHP **Ryan Shetter** on Sunday. Gingery is 5-0 with a 1.05 ERA, while Setter is 2-0 with a 3.09 ERA.

### All-Time vs. Tech...

Oklahoma leads the all-time series with Texas Tech, 45-35-1, including a 31-29-1 mark in Big 12 regular season games and a 24-11-1 record in Norman. In **Pete Hughes**' first three seasons, the Sooners went 4-7 against the Red Raiders, including a pair of wins to eliminate Tech at the 2014 and 2016 Big 12 Championships. Prior to the formation of the Big 12 in 1997, the two teams faced off nine times beginning in 1976 as OU led the series, 6-3.

### Last Time They Met...

Oklahoma defeated No. 5 Texas Tech, the Big 12 regular season champions, in an elimination game on day two of the 2016 Big 12 Championship. The Sooners routed the Red Raiders in a 17-4, run-rule victory. Right-hander **Dylan Grove** tossed a seven-inning complete game with six strikeouts. OU totaled 17 hits with eight of nine players recorded a multi-hit game, including right fielder **Alex Wise**, who drove in five runs. **Stephen Gingery** allowed eight runs, three earned, in 2.2 innings for Texas Tech. During the regular season, the Red Raiders swept the Sooners in Lubbock during the first conference series of the season.

### Coaching Connections...

Tech head coach **Tim Tadlock** and OU pitching coach **Skip Johnson** grew up in Denton, Texas as youth league and high school teammates. Tadlock previously coached at Oklahoma from 2006-11. Texas Tech pitching coach **Ray Hayward** was a two-time All-American at OU in 1981 and 1983. He pitched in part of three MLB seasons before returning to Norman as an assistant coach from 2000-04. In addition, TTU director of operations **Joseph Hughes** played at Oklahoma from 2006-07 and was an All-Big 12 Honorable Mention as a senior.

### By the Numbers: Sooners vs. Tech...

In five career games against Texas Tech, **Kyle Mendenhall** is a .588 (10-for-17) hitter. He has scored eight runs and picked up three multihit games. Last season, **Steele Walker** hit .375 (6-for-16) in four games against the Red Raiders. **Jake Irvin** pitched one inning of relief at Tech last season and struck out the side.

### Back-to-Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma has won three consecutive series against ranked opponents following its Big 12-opening series win over No. 14 Baylor. Previously, the Sooners took two out of three from No. 17 Long Beach State on opening weekend. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

### Save the Best for Last...

**JB Olson** picked up his sixth save of the season last week; pushing his two-year career total to 10. He stands alone at seventh all-time at OU; trailing **Bucky Buckles** (1994) with 14. Olson passed a group of five pitchers tied with nine saves, including **Garrett Richards** (2007-09) and **Ralph Garza** (2013-15). In 42 career relief appearances, Olson has pitched two or more scoreless-inning 13 times.

### Starting Strong...

Despite having a 12-game win-streak snapped against Wichita State (3/7), the Sooners' 23-5 first half is the best to begin a season since a 27-4 record in 1985. The Sooners' win-streak earlier this season was the best under head coach **Pete Hughes** and the longest at OU since a 13-game win-streak in 2013.

### Against the Ranked...

Since **Pete Hughes** took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 17-34-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 5-18 against top-10 teams, including a win over No. 5 Texas Tech (5/28/16). This season marks the first time OU played a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a doubleheader with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State.

### Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 10-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-3 win at Baylor (3/24). Oklahoma won the series over the Bears to mark the fourth series win in the first Big 12 weekend in the last five seasons. OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. lowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

#### Fresh Arms...

The Sooners' first 17 games of the season were started by a sophomore pitcher until junior **Devon Perez** started game 18. Oklahoma has gotten 11 wins from its sophomore class: the second most in the league. In 2016, freshman pitchers from OU and Texas Tech tied for the league lead with 18 regular season wins. Sixteen of the Sooners' 23 wins have been claimed by underclassmen; ahead of TTU (15) and TCU (15).

### Newcomer of the Week...

**Brylie Ware** was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week (3/13). He hit a team-high .562 (9-for-16) in a 4-1 week to earn his first career weekly honor. He totaled seven runs, seven RBI, two doubles and two walks with a .632 OBP and .688 slugging percentage. Ware became the second Sooner to earn a Big 12 weekly award this season and the first to earn Newcomer of the Week since **Sheldon Neuse** (4/7/14).

### Coming in Clutch...

In OU's win over Little Rock (2/28), the Sooners produced eight of their 10 runs with two outs by going 6-for-13 with two gone in an inning. For the season, Oklahoma is hitting .254 (76-for-299) with 85 of the team's 181 RBI having been driven in with two outs. Last season, OU hit .248 in two-out situations and accounted for 99 two-out RBI; 17 of which came from **Sheldon Neuse**, who hit .414 with two outs. **Steele Walker** leads the 2017 squad with 11 followed by **Brylie Ware** at 10. Under hitting coach **Mike Anderson**, the Sooners hit a team-best .271 with two outs in 2015.

### Up Next...

The Sooners remain at home to host intrastate rival Oral Roberts on Tuesday, April 4. First pitch is scheduled for 6:30 p.m.

### Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at ninth in the country with a 2.66 ERA. The Sooners' 211 hits are the 10th most in the country and the pitching staff ranks 10th in K/9 at 10.20. Among individuals, **Jake Irvin** is tied for the third most win with five. **Renae Martinez** is the top ranked Sooner hitter as the 27th toughest player to strikeout in the country with only five in 79 at-bats.

The Sooners enter the weekend first in the Big 12 in home runs at 25. OU is averaging 0.89 home runs per game with **Blake Brewster**, **Kyle Mendenhall** and **Steele Walker** all with four apiece. **Home Run Notes**

### Down Six to Up Eight...

The Sooners overcame a six-run deficit to win at Kennesaw State (3/18); marking the first win when trailing by five or more since erasing a five-run gap against West Virginia (4/23/16). Solo home runs in the third and fourth by **Ben Hollas** and **Blake Brewster** inched Oklahoma closer. The two sides then traded a run in the fifth and it was 7-3 headed to the sixth. There, OU sent 10 to the plate and scored six runs, including a go-ahead grand slam by **Steele Walker** with two down. The Sooners added five insurance runs in the eighth and three more in the ninth of a 17-9 win.

### Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2017 as it reached No. 18 in the *Collegiate Baseball News* Top-30 on February 27. The Sooners had previously been ranked on February 22, 2016 when they were No. 25 by *Baseball America*. Last week's No. 10 ranking by *CBN* is the high for OU under coach **Pete Hughes**. Oklahoma has spent 15 weeks on the charts in Hughes' tenure and owns a 34-26 record when ranked.

In relief, right-hander **Connor Berry** accomplished the rare feat of striking out four in an inning. He got the first batter looking before the next struck out swinging, but reached on a wild pitch. Berry then punched out the next two.

### Steele's Streak Snapped...

The Sooners last turn at bat against Buffalo (3/11) ended on a groundball-double play with **Steele Walker** in the hole. He finished the game O-for-4 as his 21-game hit-streak came to an end. Walker hit .405 (34for-84) during the streak. Walker's streak is tied for the fifth longest in program history with **Kevin Burdick** (1986) and **Zach Leske** (2000). It was the longest by a Sooner since **Matt Oberste** set the program mark with 30 in 2013.

### Ben There, Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16).

### TreMENDous Feat...

Junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** homered in back-to-back games of a doubleheader on February 25. He first hit a solo home run against Northern Illinois and later added a two-run shot off the light pole in left field against Villanova. Steele Walker was the last player to homer in back-to-back games and the last to do so in a doubleheader as he recorded the feat at Austin Peav (5/19/16).

### A Different Meaning to 19 Ways...

The Sooners opened the season with a string of 19 consecutive games played at home thanks to the opening series being moved from California to Norman. Oklahoma went 17-2 on the homestand. It tied for the longest homestand on record (1962-present), which was recorded in 1976; the year OU reached in fifth consecutive College World Series and won a program-record 62 games.

### Four-Hit Freshman...

In Oklahoma's 17-1 rout of Villanova (2/25), freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** went 4-for-5 with three runs out of the nine hole. He became the first Sooner freshman to record four hits in a game since 2014. That season. **Sheldon Neuse** did so at UTA (3/11/14) and vs. Oklahoma State (5/23/14) in the Big 12 Championship. Austin O'Brien also had a four-hit day that year by going 4-for-5 against Belmont (3/16/14) at home.

### Irvin Ks 10 Again...

Opening day starter **Jake Irvin** matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts in the Sooners' win over Long Beach State (2/17). He struck out the side in the first. Irvin previously struck out 10 against No. 25 Oklahoma State (4/20/16); a game in which he struck out the side in the first and the first two batters of the second. His opening day total was the most by a Sooner in the first game of the year since **Andrew Doyle** fanned 10 vs. Western Illinois in 2009.

### Freshman Starting Shortstop...

In the season opener against Long Beach State (2/17), **Brandon Zaragoza** became the first Sooner freshman to start at shortstop on opening day in a decade. **Bryant Hernandez** was the last to do so.

### Crimson Over Orange; Twice as Nice...

Last season, OU won Big 12 series over Texas and OSU for the first time since 1998; the only other time it has happened. The **Larry Cochell**-led Sooners took two of three from the No. 16 Cowboys. OU won the opener at Driller Stadium and then split the next two at All Sports Stadium. Oklahoma then swept the Longhorns at home to close out the regular season. In 2016, **Pete Hughes** and the Sooners picked up a home series win over Texas and took the opener from OSU at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark then split at ONEOK Field.
