#### First Pitch...

The No. 9 University of Oklahoma baseball team hosts Oral Roberts Tuesday night at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners and the Golden Eagles take the field for a 6:30 p.m. first pitch.

#### About the Sooners...

Following back-to-back series wins in Big 12 play, Oklahoma is 25-6 overall and 4-2 in conference. The Sooners remain at the top of the league's leaderboard with a .293 batting average and 2.76 earned run average. OU hitters also lead the league in home runs with 27; led by junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall**, who hit his team-leading fifth in walk-off fashion to beat No. 2 Texas Tech on Sunday. Sophomore left fielder **Steele Walker** has driven in a team-high 28 runs with a .347 batting average and .570 slugging percentage. He has recorded nine doubles, three triples and four home runs. Senior catcher **Renaé Martinez**, named the Big 12 Player of the Week on Monday, lifted his average to .333 after the Tech series. He homered for the fourth time and pushed his RBI total to .544 with seven doubles. Senior first baseman **Austin O'Brien**, who has missed the last 12 games due to a torn UCL in his left arm, is anticipated to be available for a return to the diamond. Prior to his injury, O'Brien was hitting .373, which still leads the team, with 15 RBI and a .597 slugging percentage. On the mound, Oklahoma will look to sophomore right-hander **Austin Hansen**. He last started at Kennesaw State on March 19 and did not get out of the second inning. Overall, Hansen is 3-0 with a 2.70 ERA and 20 strikeouts in 23.1 innings.

#### On the Air...

Tuesday night's game can be heard across the Sooners Sports Network and locally on the home of Sooner baseball Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM. The voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** (play-by-play) and former MLB All-Star **Mickey Tettleton** (color commentary) will call the action. The broadcast duo will be in the TV booth as the game will be simulcast as a SoonerSports.tv exclusive.

#### Leading Off

• OU's 25-6 record is the best since 27-4 in 1985. The Sooner win total is a nine-game improvement through 31 games vs. 2016.

• The Sooners have won 10-consecutive Big 12 series rubber-match games; having last lost to Baylor (2014).

• OU snapped a four-game losing streak to ORU with a 12-3 win in Norman on May 3, 2016.

• Steele Walker recorded his 100th career hit vs. Texas Tech (3/31) to tie for the eighth fastest to 100 at OU in the last 15 years; doing so in 86 career games.

• Oklahoma has won the first two Big 12 series of the season for the first time since beating Kansas and Kansas State in 2014.

• The Sooners lead the Big 12 in batting average (.293), OBP (.398), slugging percentage (.436), runs (226), home runs (27), RBI (194), ERA (2.76), strikeouts (313) and K/9 (10.28).

• Ben Hollas was named one of seven Sooners awarded the Dr. Gerald Lage Academic Achievement Award by the Big 12.

### HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 21 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 642-474-3 (.575), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

### Scouting the Golden Eagles...

Oral Roberts is 19-8 overall and 8-1 in the Summit League under fifth-year head coach **Ryan Folmar** after taking two of three from Western Illinois over the weekend. Shortstop **Dylan Snypes** is the Golden Eagles' top hitter at .342 with 10 doubles. Center fielder **Noah Cumming** is hitting .324 with six home runs and 28 RBI. Catcher **Matt Whatley** has slugged five home runs and driven in 16 runs with a .273 average. Right-hander **Logan Michaels** will toe the rubber for ORU. He is 3-1 with a 2.45 ERA in 18.1 innings with 21 strikeouts.

### All-Time vs. ORU...

Oklahoma leads the all-time series with Oral Roberts, 38-33. The Sooners snapped a four-game win-streak for the Golden Eagles in the series late last season. Prior to that, OU had won five in a row in the all-time series. Oklahoma leads the series 21-17 when playing in Norman. The Sooners last win over the Golden Eagles in Tulsa was a 3-1 decision in 2013.

### Last Time They Met...

A trio of Sooner freshmen helped Oklahoma snap a four-game skid to Oral Roberts on May 3, 2016. OU won the game, 12-3, behind six innings of one-hit ball from **Dylan Grove** in his first career start. **Domenic DeRenzo** homered twice and drove in five runs in a 2-for-3 effort. **Steele Walker** went 2-for-5 with two RBI and veteran **Sheldon Neuse** was 2-for-4 with three RBI. The Sooners jumped on the Golden Eagles early with four in the first, three in the second and led 12-0 after four. **Nick Whatley** went 2-for-4; providing half of ORU's hits.

### Player of the Week...

**Renae Martinez** earned his first career weekly honor as the Big 12 Player of the Week (4/3). He hit .364 and lugged .818 in a series win over No. 2 Texas Tech. Martinez totaled six RBI on the weekend; matching a career-high with a bases-clearing, three-run double on Friday, a solo home run on Saturday and a first-inning, two-run, two-out double. He became the first Sooner to win Big 12 Player of the Week since **Cody Thomas** (5/16/16).

### Back-to-Back-to-Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma has won four consecutive series against ranked opponents following its Big 12-home opening series win over No. 12 Texas Tech, OU's first top-five series win since sweeping Baylor in 2012. Previously, the Sooners took two out of three from No. 17 Long Beach State on opening weekend and two of three from Baylor in the Big 12-opening series. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

### Save the Best for Last...

**JB Olson** picked up his sixth save of the season last week; pushing his two-year career total to 10. He stands alone at seventh all-time at OU; trailing **Bucky Buckles** (1994) with 14. Olson passed a group of five pitchers tied with nine saves, including **Garrett Richards** (2007-09) and **Ralph Garza** (2013-15). In 43 career relief appearances, Olson has pitched two or more scoreless-inning 14 times.

### Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner seven times; all at home. Six of those seven wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against No. 2 Texas Tech (4/2). Tied 4-4, **Kyle Mendenhall** led off the bottom of the ninth and blasted a 2-2 pitch over the wall in left-center for his team-leading fifth home run.

### 100 in Under 100...

**Steele Walker** collected two hits against Texas Tech (3/31) to reach 100 career hits. Doing so in his 86th career game, he tied for the eighth fastest to reach 100 hits at OU since 2003. Overall, Walker became the 14th Sooner with 100 career hits in less than 100 career games in the last 15 seasons.

### Starting Strong...

Despite having a 12-game win-streak snapped against Wichita State (3/7), the Sooners' 25-6 record is the best to begin a season since a 27-4 record in 1985. The Sooners' win-streak earlier this season was the best under head coach **Pete Hughes** and the longest at OU since a 13-game win-streak in 2013.

### Against the Ranked...

Since **Pete Hughes** took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 19-35-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 7-19 against top-10 teams, including three wins over top-five Texas Tech (2016-No. 5, 2017-No. 2) teams. This season marks the first time OU played a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a double-header with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State.

### Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 10-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-3 win at Baylor (3/24). Oklahoma won the series over the Bears to mark the fourth series win in the first Big 12 weekend in the last five seasons. OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

### Coming in Clutch...

In OU's win over Little Rock (2/28), the Sooners produced eight of their 10 runs with two outs by going 6-for-13 with two gone in an inning. For the season, Oklahoma is hitting .250 (82-for-328) with 89 of the team's 194 RBI having been driven in with two outs. Last season, OU hit .248 in two-out situations and accounted for 99 two-out RBI; 17 of which came from **Sheldon Neuse**, who hit .414 with two outs.

**Steele Walker** leads the 2017 squad with 12 followed by **Rena Martinez** at 11. Under hitting coach **Mike Anderson**, the Sooners hit a team-best .271 with two outs in 2015.

### Up Next...

Oklahoma returns to the road for the next seven games beginning this weekend at Texas. The Sooners and Longhorns get the action underway Friday, April 7 in a nationally televised match-up on FS1 at 7 p.m.

### Fresh Arms...

The Sooners' first 17 games were started by a sophomore pitcher until junior **Devon Perez** started game 18. Oklahoma has gotten 12 wins from its sophomore class; the second most in the league. In 2016, freshman pitchers from OU and Texas Tech tied for the league lead with 18 regular season wins. Seventeen of the Sooners' 25 wins have been claimed by underclassmen; tied with TCU and ahead of Tech (16).

### Newcomer of the Week...

**Brylie Ware** was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week (3/13). He hit a team-high .562 (9-for-16) in a 4-1 week to earn his first career weekly honor. He totaled seven runs, seven RBI, two doubles and two walks with a .632 OBP and .688 slugging percentage. Ware became the second Sooner to earn a Big 12 weekly award this season and the first to earn Newcomer of the Week since **Sheldon Neuse** (4/7/14).

### Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at fourth in the country with a 10.30 strikeouts-per-nine innings average. The Sooners' 2.69 team ERA ranks 10th in the country and 226 runs scored is the top offensive statistic; ranking 11th. Among individuals, **Jake Irvin** is tied for the 12th most wins with five. **Rena Martinez** is the top ranked Sooner hitter as the 16th toughest player to strikeout in the country with only five in 90 at-bats.

### Down Six to Up Eight...

The Sooners overcame a six-run deficit to win at Kennesaw State (3/18); marking the first win when trailing by five or more since erasing a five-run gap against West Virginia (4/23/16). Solo home runs in the third and fourth by **Ben Hollas** and **Blake Brewster** inched Oklahoma closer. The two sides then traded a run in the fifth and it was 7-3 headed to the sixth. There, OU sent 10 to the plate and scored six runs, including a go-ahead grand slam by **Steele Walker** with two down. The Sooners added five insurance runs in the eighth and three more in the ninth of a 17-9 win.

### 20-Strikeout Night...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** struck out a career-best 14 in a 3-0 win over Central Connecticut (3/3) as OU pitchers combined to strikeout 20. Irvin's 14 was the most by a Sooner since **Michael Rocha** struck out 13 against Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth inning. In relief, right-hander **Connor Berry** accomplished the rare feat of striking out four in an inning. He got the first batter looking before the next struck out swinging, but reached on a wild pitch. Berry then punched out the next two.

### Steele's Streak Snapped...

The Sooners last turn at bat against Buffalo (3/11) ended on a ground-ball-double play with **Steele Walker** in the hole. He finished the game 0-for-4 as his 21-game hit-streak came to an end. Walker hit .405 (34-for-84) during the streak. Walker's streak is tied for the fifth longest in program history with **Kevin Burdick** (1986) and **Zach Leske** (2000). It was the longest by a Sooner since **Matt Oberste** set the program mark with 30 in 2013.

### Ben There, Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16).

### TreMENDous Feat...

Junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** homered in back-to-back games of a doubleheader on February 25. He first hit a solo home run against Northern Illinois and later added a two-run shot off the light pole in left field against Villanova. **Steele Walker** was the last player to homer in back-to-back games and the last to do so in a doubleheader as he recorded the feat at Austin Peay (5/19/16).

### A Different Meaning to 19 Ways...

The Sooners opened the season with a string of 19 consecutive games played at home thanks to the opening series being moved from California to Norman. Oklahoma went 17-2 on the homestand. It tied for the longest homestand on record (1962-present), which was recorded in 1976: the year OU reached in fifth consecutive College World Series and won a program-record 62 games.

### Four-Hit Freshman...

In Oklahoma's 17-1 rout of Villanova (2/25), freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** went 4-for-5 with three runs out of the nine hole. He became the first Sooner freshman to record four hits in a game since 2014. That season, **Sheldon Neuse** did so at UTA (3/11/14) and vs. Oklahoma State (5/23/14) in the Big 12 Championship. **Austin O'Brien** also had a four-hit day that year by going 4-for-5 against Belmont (3/16/14) at home.

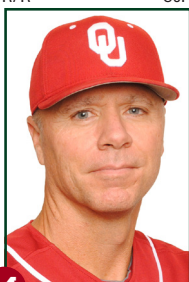
