First Pitch...

The No. 9 University of Oklahoma baseball team heads back on the road for its third Big 12 series of the season coming at Texas. Friday night's game gets underway at 7 p.m. and is the beginning of an eight-game road swing for the Sooners. Game two will take place Saturday at 4 p.m. and game three Sunday at 2 p.m.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is coming off back-to-back Big 12 series wins and a mid-week victory over Oral Roberts on Tuesday to hit Austin with a 26-6 overall record, the best at OU since 1985, and a 4-2 conference mark. The Sooners got their top hitter back into the lineup vs. ORU as senior first baseman **Austin O'Brien** returned from missing 12 games due to a torn left UCL. He is hitting a team-leading .380 and slugging .634. Sophomore **Brylie Ware**, who filled in at first over the last three weeks, is second with a .351 average and 23 runs scored. Sophomore outfielder **Steele Walker** is third on the team at .349 with a team-leading 29 runs, 29 RBI and 10 doubles. On the mound, sophomore right-hander **Dylan Grove** goes for OU in game one. He is 1-1 with a 2.86 earned run average. Fellow sophomore RHP **Jake Irvin** returns to the rotation Saturday. He is 5-0 with a 1.16 ERA and last pitched on March 17 at Kennesaw State.

On the Air...

Games one and three can be heard across the Sooners Sports Network with all three games airing locally on the Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM. The voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** (play-by-play) will have the call Friday and Sunday with veteran OU broadcaster **Chris Plank** filling in on Saturday. Former Sooner **Ross Hubbard** (color commentary) will be in the booth for all three games. Friday night's game will be televised nationally on FS1 with **Dave Barnett** (pbp) and **Pat Combs** (color) on the call. The remaining two games will air on the Longhorn Network with **Lowell Galindo** (pbp), **Keith Moreland** (color) and **Greg Swindell** (color).

- OU's 26-6 record is the best since 27-5 in 1985; marking a 10-game improvement through 32 games vs. 2016.
- The Sooners have won 10-consecutive Big 12 series rubber-match games; having last lost to Baylor (2014).
- OU is 20-3 at home this season; its best record since going 19-5 at L. Dale Mitchell Park in 2014. It is the first 20-win season at home since going 25-6 in 2013.
- Oklahoma has won back-to-back series over Texas for the first time since 1997 and 1998.
- Steele Walker recorded his 100th career hit vs. Texas Tech (3/31) to tie for the eighth fastest to 100 at OU in the last 15 years; doing so in 86 career games.
- Oklahoma has won the first two Big 12 series of the season for the first time since beating Kansas and Kansas State in 2014.
- The Sooners lead the Big 12 in OBP (.397), runs (232), home runs (28), RBI (200), ERA (2.70), strikeouts (321), BAA (.211) and K/9 (10.21).

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 21 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 643-474-3 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Longhorns...

Texas is 20-12 overall and 4-5 in the Big 12 under first-year head coach **David Pierce** after taking just one of three from Kansas over the weekend and a win against Sam Houston State on Tuesday. Catcher **Michael McCann** is Texas' top hitter at .368 with a .439 slugging percentage. First baseman **Kacy Clemens** is second at .313 with 28 runs scored and 11 doubles. Outfielder **Tate Shaw** holds a slugging percentage of .475 and a .288 average. RHP **Nolan Kingham** gets the ball on Friday and RHP **Morgan Cooper** on Saturday. Kingham is 4-2 with a 1.02 ERA, while Cooper is 3-2 with a 1.44 ERA.

All-Time vs. Texas...

Currently, the Longhorns lead the Sooners in the series, 127-51-2. The Sooners answered a sweep at home in 2014 by winning their second series in a row down in Austin in 2015 and have now won back-to-back and two of the last three vs. UT. Oklahoma's series victory in 2013 was the first over Texas in 15 years. OU's 2015 and 2016 series wins are the first back-to-back since 1997 and 1998; the last Sooner series win prior to 2013. The two sides have met in the College World Series six times; 1972, 1973, 1974, 1975 and 1992. Oklahoma twice defeated Texas in the NCAA Central Regional in Austin to advance to the CWS and win the 1994 National Championship.

Last Time They Met...

On April 3, 2016, Oklahoma claimed its first series win over Texas at home since a sweep in 1998. OU won the game 4-3. **Sheldon Neuse** hit his team-leading fifth home run of the season in the first inning. **Jake Elliott** matched his season-high with six strikeouts and **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off hit, a RBI-single to right in the ninth to claim a 4-3 win. The Sooners won the first game of the series, 6-1, before the Longhorns evened things up with a 5-3 win on Saturday.

By the Numbers: Sooner vs. UT...

Austin O'Brien, Oklahoma's lone four-year player, has the most experience against Texas. In eight career games, he is a .308 (8-for-26) hitter, including a home run in game one last year in Norman. **Jack Flansburg** went 3-for-10 in last year's series with five RBI.

A Stoney Shot for the Ages...

After sitting out 12 games over the course of 23 days due to a torn left UCL suffered against Buffalo (3/11), **Austin O'Brien** made his return to the diamond vs. Oral Roberts (4/4). He went 2-for-4 with a game-winning, seventh-inning grand slam to break a 2-2 tie and put the game at its final score of 6-2. It marked his third home run of the season, 13th of his career and second career grand slam. O'Brien's first career grand slam came at Oklahoma State (4/15/14) as a freshman in the first inning of an eventual OU win in 18 innings.

Player of the Week...

Renae Martinez earned his first career weekly honor as the Big 12 Player of the Week (4/3). He hit .364 and lugged .818 in a series win over No. 2 Texas Tech. Martinez totaled six RBI on the weekend: matching a career-high with a bases-clearing, three-run double on Friday, a solo home run on Saturday and a first-inning, two-run, two-out double. He became the first Sooner to win Big 12 Player of the Week since **Cody Thomas** (5/16/16).

Crimson Over Orange; Twice as Nice...

Last season, OU won Big 12 series over Texas and OSU for the first time since 1998; the only other time it has happened. The **Larry Cochell**-led Sooners took two of three from the No. 16 Cowboys. OU won the opener at Driller Stadium and then split the next two at All Sports Stadium. Oklahoma then swept the Longhorns at home to close out the regular season. In 2016, **Pete Hughes** and the Sooners picked up a home series win over Texas and took the opener from OSU at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark then split at ONEOK Field.

Back-to-Back-to-Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma has won four consecutive series against ranked opponents following its Big 12-home opening series win over No. 12 Texas Tech, OU's first top-five series win since sweeping Baylor in 2012. Previously, the Sooners took two out of three from No. 17 Long Beach State on opening weekend and two of three from Baylor in the Big 12-opening series. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

Skip Brought on Board...

On June 27, exactly three years after head coach **Pete Hughes** was hired, he announced the addition of **Skip Johnson** to the Oklahoma staff. Johnson took over as the Sooners pitching coach after 10 seasons at rival Texas. He previously was the head coach at Navarro College for 13 seasons. During his 10 seasons in Austin, 32 pitchers were drafted, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first round picks.

Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner seven times; all at home. Six of those seven wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against No. 2 Texas Tech (4/2). Tied 4-4, **Kyle Mendenhall** led off the bottom of the ninth and blasted a 2-2 pitch over the wall in left-center for his team-leading fifth home run.

100 in Under 100...

Steele Walker collected two hits against Texas Tech (3/31) to reach 100 career hits. Doing so in his 86th career game, he tied for the eighth fastest to reach 100 hits at OU since 2003. Overall, Walker became the 14th Sooner with 100 career hits in less than 100 career games in the last 15 seasons.

Up Next...

Oklahoma returns the favor for a rematch of Tuesday night's win over Oral Roberts on Tuesday, April 14. The Sooners visit Tulsa for a 6:30 p.m. contest against the Golden Eagles.

Starting Strong...

Despite having a 12-game win-streak snapped against Wichita State (3/7), the Sooners' 26-6 record is the best to begin a season since a 27-5 record in 1985. The Sooners' win-streak earlier this season was the best under head coach **Pete Hughes** and the longest at OU since a 13-game win-streak in 2013.

Coming in Clutch...

In OU's win over Little Rock (2/28), the Sooners produced eight of their 10 runs with two outs by going 6-for-13 with two gone in an inning. For the season, Oklahoma is hitting .253 (86-for-340) with 90 of the team's 200 RBI having been driven in with two outs. Last season, OU hit .248 in two-out situations and accounted for 99 two-out RBI; 17 of which came from **Sheldon Neuse**, who hit .414 with two outs. **Steele Walker** and **Renaee Martinez** lead the 2017 squad with 12. Under hitting coach **Mike Anderson**, the Sooners hit a team-best .271 with two outs in 2015.

Fresh Arms...

The Sooners' first 17 games were started by a sophomore pitcher until junior **Devon Perez** started game 18. Oklahoma has gotten 13 wins from its sophomore class; tied for the most in the league. In 2016, freshman pitchers from OU and Texas Tech tied for the league lead with 18 regular season wins. Eighteen of the Sooners' 26 wins have been claimed by underclassmen: one ahead of TCU and Tech (17).

Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at fourth in the country with a 10.20 strikeouts-per-nine innings average. The Sooners' 2.64 team ERA ranks eighth in the country and 232 runs scored is the top offensive statistics; ranking 14th. Among individuals, **Jake Irvin** is tied for the 13th most wins with five. **Renaee Martinez** is the top ranked Sooner hitter as the 11th toughest player to strikeout in the country with only five in 94 at-bats.

Save the Best for Last...

JB Olson picked up his sixth save of the season last week; pushing his two-year career total to 10. He stands alone at seventh all-time at OU; trailing **Bucky Buckles** (1994) with 14. Olson passed a group of five pitchers tied with nine saves, including **Garrett Richards** (2007-09) and **Ralph Garza** (2013-15). In 43 career relief appearances, Olson has pitched two or more scoreless-inning 14 times.

Ben There, Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16).

Newcomer of the Week...

Brylie Ware was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week (3/13). He hit a team-high .562 (9-for-16) in a 4-1 week to earn his first career weekly honor. He totaled seven runs, seven RBI, two doubles and two walks with a .632 OBP and .688 slugging percentage. Ware became the second Sooner to earn a Big 12 weekly award this season and the first to earn Newcomer of the Week since **Sheldon Neuse** (4/7/14).

Against the Ranked...

Since **Pete Hughes** took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 19-35-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 7-19 against top-10 teams, including three wins over top-five Texas Tech (2016-No. 5, 2017-No. 2) teams. This season marks the first time OU played a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a double-header with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State.

Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 10-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-3 win at Baylor (3/24). Oklahoma won the series over the Bears to mark the fourth series win in the first Big 12 weekend in the last five seasons. OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

Down Six to Up Eight...

The Sooners overcame a six-run deficit to win at Kennesaw State (3/18); marking the first win when trailing by five or more since erasing a five-run gap against West Virginia (4/23/16). Solo home runs in the third and fourth by **Ben Hollas** and **Blake Brewster** inched Oklahoma closer. The two sides then traded a run in the fifth and it was 7-3 headed to the sixth. There, OU sent 10 to the plate and scored six runs, including a go-ahead grand slam by **Steele Walker** with two down. The Sooners added five insurance runs in the eighth and three more in the ninth of a 17-9 win.

20-Strikeout Night...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** struck out a career-best 14 in a 3-0 win over Central Connecticut (3/3) as OU pitchers combined to strikeout 20. Irvin's 14 was the most by a Sooner since **Michael Rocha** struck out 13 against Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth inning. In relief, right-hander **Connor Berry** accomplished the rare feat of striking out four in an inning. He got the first batter looking before the next struck out swinging, but reached on a wild pitch. Berry then punched out the next two.

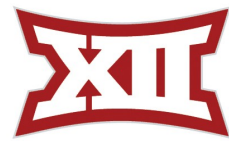

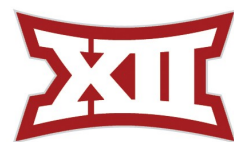
