#### First Pitch...

The No. 10 University of Oklahoma baseball team steps out of conference this weekend when it visits Michigan out of the Big Ten. The Sooners and Wolverines start their three-game series Thursday, April 13 at 3 p.m. CT. Games two and three follow at 3 p.m. Friday and 1 p.m. Saturday.

#### About the Sooners...

Oklahoma hits the road with a 27-9 overall record and it 5-4 with a pair of series wins, including one on the road, in Big 12 play. Senior catcher **Renae Martinez** is the Sooners top hitter with a .355 batting average and second in slugging at .561. Sophomore **Brylie Ware**, who splits his time between the corner infield spots and designated hitter, is second with a .348 batting average and first with a .439 on-base percentage. Sophomore outfielder **Steele Walker**, one of two Sooners to start all 36 games, is hitting .346 with a team-leading .574 slugging percentage. He has driven in a team-high 33 runs on 10 doubles, five home runs and three triples. Walker, Martinez and junior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** are tied for the team lead in home runs with five. The Oklahoma bullpen has matched a season-high by not allowing a run in its last 10 complete innings pitched. Redshirt-junior lefty **Austin Kerns** has appeared in a team-high 19 games of relief. He is 2-2 with a 3.26 earned run average in 19.1 innings. Sophomore right-hander **Connor Berry** boasts a team-best 0.93 ERA. He is holding opponents to a .118 average and has struck out 30 in 19.1 innings, while earning his first career win last Sunday at Texas.

The entire series will be broadcast across the Sooners Sports Network: airing locally on the Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM. The voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** (play-by-play) will have the call. Video of the game will be streamed on by BTN+: a student-run arm of the Big Ten Network.

#### Leading Off

• OU's 27-9 record is the best since 28-8 in 2013; marking a nine-win improvement through 36 games vs. 2016.

• The Sooners lead the all-time series against Michigan, 12-3. This series marks the first time Oklahoma visits the Wolverines and first match-up since 2007 in San Diego.

• OU is 20-3 at home this season; its best record since going 19-5 at L. Dale Mitchell Park in 2014. It is the first 20-win season at home since going 25-6 in 2013.

• Steele Walker recorded his 100th career hit vs. Texas Tech (3/31) to tie for the eighth fastest to 100 at OU in the last 15 years; doing so in 86 career games.

• Walker and Hunter Hargrove (TTU) are the only players in the top five of Big 12 hitters in hits, runs and RBI.

• Oklahoma has won the first two Big 12 series of the season for the first time since beating Kansas and Kansas State in 2014.

• The Sooners lead the Big 12 in OBP (.389), home runs (30), ERA (2.79), strikeouts (356), K/9 (10.14).

### HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 21 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 644-477-3 (.574), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

### Scouting the Wolverines...

The Wolverines began the ranked as high as number 13 in the nation. Michigan comes into the series off a 2-1, 13-inning win on Tuesday against Eastern Michigan. The Wolverines also entered the week ranked fourth in the NCAA, first among Power 5 conferences, with 73 stolen bases. The offense is led by second baseman **Ako Thomas**, who is hitting a team-high .346 with 18 RBI, and a .465 OBP. The sophomore has also swiped 18 bases in 21 attempts for the Wolverines. Third baseman **Drew Lugbauer** is hitting .289 with a team-leading nine home runs and 42 RBI. Lefty **Oliver Jaskie** is expected to start the opener. He is 4-1 with a 4.19 ERA in eight starts.

### All-Time vs. UM...

Oklahoma leads the all-time series with Michigan, 12-3. The Sooners had won back-to-back games over the Wolverines prior to an 8-5 loss in the most recent matchup a decade ago. The first meeting between the two schools, a 3-1 win in Norman, occurred in the 1977 NCAA Central Regional. UM eliminated OU later in the regional, 2-5, to end the Sooners run of five CWS appearances in a row. Beginning in 1987, Oklahoma run nine in a row against Michigan, including home series wins in 1993, 1996 and 2003.

### Last Time They Met...

In March 2007, the Sooners squared off with the Wolverines at the Tony Gwynn Classic in San Diego. The Sooners jumped out to an early 2-0 lead, before dropping the contest, 8-5. In the game, Michigan leadoff hitter **Jason Christian** would hit for the cycle, while driving in two runs. The Sooners' offense was led by **Aljay Davis** (3-for-5) and **Aaron Baker** (2-for-5). Baker would also extend his reached bases-streak to a team-best 18 games. The loss snapped an 11-game winning streak for the Sooners. Five OU players would be named to the All-Tournament Team, including future big leaguer **Jackson Williams**.

### Against the Big Ten...

Oklahoma last faced a Big Ten opponent in 2015; a three-game series against Purdue at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners are 4-3 against Big Ten foes under **Pete Hughes**, including series wins over Rutgers (2014), Purdue (2015) and a loss to Ohio State (2014) at the UCF Tournament. All-time, Oklahoma is 36-12 against the Big Ten. Michigan is the Sooners' most common opponent from the league. In postseason play, Oklahoma is 4-2 against the Big Ten with wins over Ohio State (1951) and Penn State (1973) in Omaha.

### Up Next...

The Sooners wrap up an eight-game home swing against Dallas Baptist. Oklahoma visits the Patriots on Tuesday, April 18.

### A Stoney Shot for the Ages...

After sitting out 12 games over the course of 23 days due to a torn left UCL suffered against Buffalo (3/11), **Austin O'Brien** made his return to the diamond vs. Oral Roberts (4/4). He went 2-for-4 with a game-winning, seventh-inning grand slam to break a 2-2 tie and put the game at its final score of 6-2. It marked his third home run of the season, 13th of his career and second career grand slam. O'Brien's first career grand slam came at Oklahoma State (4/15/14) as a freshman in the first inning of an eventual OU win in 18 innings.

### Player of the Week...

**Renae Martinez** earned his first career weekly honor as the Big 12 Player of the Week (4/3). He hit .364 and lugged .818 in a series win over No. 2 Texas Tech. Martinez totaled six RBI on the weekend: matching a career-high with a bases-clearing, three-run double on Friday, a solo home run on Saturday and a first-inning, two-run, two-out double. He became the first Sooner to win Big 12 Player of the Week since **Cody Thomas** (5/16/16).

### Back-to-Back-to-Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma has won four consecutive series against ranked opponents following its Big 12-home opening series win over No. 12 Texas Tech, OU's first top-five series win since sweeping Baylor in 2012. Previously, the Sooners took two out of three from No. 17 Long Beach State on opening weekend and two of three from Baylor in the Big 12-opening series. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

### Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner seven times; all at home. Six of those seven wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against No. 2 Texas Tech (4/2). Tied 4-4, **Kyle Mendenhall** led off the bottom of the ninth and blasted a 2-2 pitch over the wall in left-center for his team-leading fifth home run.

### 100 in Under 100...

**Steele Walker** collected two hits against Texas Tech (3/31) to reach 100 career hits. Doing so in his 86th career game, he tied for the eighth fastest to reach 100 hits at OU since 2003. Overall, Walker became the 14th Sooner with 100 career hits in less than 100 career games in the last 15 seasons.

### Young Arms...

The Sooners' first 17 games were started by a sophomore pitcher until junior **Devon Perez** started game 18. Oklahoma has gotten 14 wins from its sophomore class; tied with Texas Tech for most in the league. In 2016, freshman pitchers from OU and Tech tied for the league lead with 18 regular season wins. Nineteen of the Sooners' 27 wins have been claimed by underclassmen: one back of TTU.

Despite having a 12-game win-streak snapped against Wichita State (3/7), the Sooners' 27-8 record is the best since a 28-8 record in 2013. The Sooners' win-streak earlier this season was the best under Hughes and the longest at OU since a 13-game win-streak in 2013.

### Bouncing Back...

The Sooners lost back-to-back games for the first time this season in the 33rd and 34th games of the season to open their series at Texas (4/7-8). Following a loss this year, Oklahoma is 7-1 after a bounceback 2-1 win in the finale against the Longhorns (4/9). In those eight games, OU averages 6.13 runs and a run differential of 2.00 runs per game. Oklahoma pitchers have allowed four runs or less in six of the team's seven wins following a loss. During the 2016 season, the Sooners went 10-14-1 following a loss, including a 5-5 tie against No. 20 Mississippi State (3/6/16) at Dodger Stadium.

### Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at fourth in the country with a 10.14 strikeouts-per-nine innings average. The Sooners' 2.73 team ERA ranks ninth in the country and 175 walks is the top offensive statistic; ranking 16th.

### Ben There, Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16).

### Newcomer of the Week...

**Brylie Ware** was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week (3/13). He hit a team-high .562 (9-for-16) in a 4-1 week to earn his first career weekly honor. He totaled seven runs, seven RBI, two doubles and two walks with a .632 OBP and .688 slugging percentage. Ware became the second Sooner to earn a Big 12 weekly award this season and the first to earn Newcomer of the Week since **Sheldon Neuse** (4/7/14).

### Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2017 at No. 18 in the *Collegiate Baseball News* Top-30 (2/27). The Sooners had previously been ranked on No. 25 by *Baseball America* (2/22/16). Last week's No. 9 ranking by *BA* is the high for OU under **Pete Hughes**. Oklahoma has spent 17 weeks on the charts in his tenure and owns a 38-30 record when ranked. The Sooners are ranked for the seventh week in a row, including four in all five polls.

### Against the Ranked...

Since **Pete Hughes** took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 19-35-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 7-19 against top-10 teams, including three wins over top-five Texas Tech (2016-No. 5, 2017-No. 2) teams. This season marks the first time OU played a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a double-header with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State.

### Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 10-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-3 win at Baylor (3/24). Oklahoma won the series over the Bears to mark the fourth series win in the first Big 12 weekend in the last five seasons. OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

### Down Six to Up Eight...

The Sooners overcame a six-run deficit to win at Kennesaw State (3/18); marking the first win when trailing by five or more since erasing a five-run gap against West Virginia (4/23/16). Solo home runs in the third and fourth by **Ben Hollas** and **Blake Brewster** inched Oklahoma closer. The two sides then traded a run in the fifth and it was 7-3 headed to the sixth. There, OU sent 10 to the plate and scored six runs, including a go-ahead grand slam by **Steele Walker** with two down. The Sooners added five insurance runs in the eighth and three more in the ninth of a 17-9 win.

### 20-Strikeout Night...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** struck out a career-best 14 in a 3-0 win over Central Connecticut (3/3) as OU pitchers combined to strikeout 20. Irvin's 14 was the most by a Sooner since **Michael Rocha** struck out 13 against Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth inning. In relief, right-hander **Connor Berry** accomplished the rare feat of striking out four in an inning. He got the first batter looking before the next struck out swinging, but reached on a wild pitch. Berry then punched out the next two.
