#### First Pitch...

The No. 19 University of Oklahoma baseball team wraps up en eightgame road swing, all against top-100 RPI opponents, on Tuesday, April 18 at Dallas Baptist. The Sooners meet the Patriots at Horner Ballpark for a 6:30 p.m. first pitch.

#### **About the Sooners...**

Oklahoma, playing without key contributors due to injury over the last few games, has lost six of seven and enters the week at 27-12 overall and 7-9 on the road. Sophomore outfielder Steele Walker is the Sooners' top hitter at .352 with a team-leading .566 slugging percentage on 10 doubles, three triples and five home runs. Walker also leads the team in runs with 35 and RBI at 33. Senior catcher Renae Martinez is second of four OU starters hitting .300 or better this season. He is hitting .339 and slugging .530 with seven doubles and five home runs. Freshman catcher Brady Lindsly has seen an increase in playing time over the last week. His average is up to .308 (16-for-52) as he added a 2-for-4, two-RBI game in Oklahoma's series finale at Michigan (4/15). For the third Tuesday in a row, the Sooners looks to sophomore right-handed pitcher **Austin Hansen** on the mound. He took his first career loss at Oral Roberts (4/11) a week ago and enters Tuesday night's contest at 3-1 overall with a 3.03 earned run average. Hansen has made seven starts and one relief appearance this season with 24 strikeouts in 29.2 innings, while opponents are hitting just .167 off of him. Redshirt-junior lefty **Austin Kerns** has appeared in a team-high 21 games in relief with a 2-2 record and 2.82 ERA in 22.2 innings with 17 strikeouts.

#### **HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES**

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 21 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 644-480-3 (.572), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

#### Scouting the Patriots...

Dallas Baptist is 20-15 overall and 3-3 in the Missouri Valley Conference under 10th-year head coach **Dan Heefner** after taking two of three games from Central Arkansas over the weekend. The Patriots are 13-5 in their home ballpark this season. The offense is led by infielder **Devlin Granberg**, who is hitting a team-high .386 and holds a slugging percentage of .535. Catcher **Matt Duce** is second at .326 with 43 hits, 13 doubles, and 31 RBI. Outfielder **Jameson Hannah** is hitting .318 and leading the team with 36 runs scored and 48 hits.

#### All-Time vs. DBU...

The Sooners lead the all-time series with the Patriots, 22-10. Prior to last season, Dallas Baptist had won eight in a row dating back to 2011, including a 10-inning, 3-2 win at TCU in the 2011 NCAA Fort Worth Regional. Six of the eight-consecutive losses were by two runs or less. Oklahoma won the first 14 games of the series, which started with a 12-3 decision in 1978. Since 2004, DBU is ahead in the series, 10-8.

#### Last Time They Met...

Oklahoma beat the Patriots 12-2 in Norman last season on April 5, 2016. The Sooners snapped an eight-game losing streak in the series against DBU. **Sheldon Neuse** stretched his reached base streak to 13 games with a first inning-single. In the game, Neuse had two runs scored and two hits. **Steele Walker** posted his first three-hit game of the year and added two runs scored. **Jake Irvin** earned his first career win on the mound after striking out five in five innings.

#### Bullpen Bagels...

The Öklahoma bullpen had a streak of 13 consecutive scoreless innings snapped at Michigan (4/13). It was the team's longest such streak of the season and second of 10 innings or more in 2017. The streak came to an end in the fifth inning of a 5-2 loss to the Wolverines after **Ryan Madden** held UM scoreless in his first three innings of relief. As a unit, the Sooner relievers have combined to throw 116 complete shutout innings; accounting for 76% of the innings started by a relief pitcher.

#### The Last 15 Games...

Oklahoma has played 15 consecutive games against RPI top-100 teams beginning with Oklahoma State (3/21). Over that span, the Sooners own a 6-9 record, including 3-1 at home, 3-8 on the road, 5-4 in the Big 12 and 4-6 against ranked opponents. In those 14 games, **Steele Walker** is hitting a team-best .360 (18-for-50) with a .580 slugging and .475 on-base percentage for a 1.055 OPS with 14 runs score. **Renae Martinez** has driven in 11 runs on a .308 (16-for-52) average. Right-hander **Vincenzo Aiello** has appeared in five games out of the bullpen with 12 strikeouts in 6.2 innings and earned one save.

#### Everyday Lefty...

**Austin Kerns** has pitched in a team-leading 21 games; all out of the bullpen. It is tied for the third most appearances by a Big 12 reliever and tied for 12th most in the country. The lefty has not allowed an earned run since facing Oklahoma State (3/21); tossing 10 innings with just two unearned runs scored against him and just two walks issued. A year ago, Kerns made three starts and 13 relief appearances totaling 22.1 innings and a 5.64 ERA. This year, he has equaled his inning total and owns a 2.82 ERA.

#### In the Lone Star State...

Oklahoma seeks its fourth win of the season in seven tries in the state of Texas when it visits Dallas Baptist on Tuesday. The Sooners have not won more than three times in the Lone Star State since posting a 6-5 record there in 2013. Oklahoma was winless in nine games in Texas in 2016, 3-4 in 2015 and 2-5 in 2014 for a cumulative record of 8-21 under head coach **Pete Hughes**. Oklahoma's last midweek win in Texas came over UT Arlington (3/11/14) at Globe Lift Park, 3-2.

The Sooners jump back into Big 12 play as they return home to face Kansas, April 21-23. Friday night's opener will be the second "Bark in the Park" hosted at L. Dale Mitchell Park.

#### Player of the Week...

**Renae Martinez** earned his first career weekly honor as the Big 12 Player of the Week (4/3). He hit .364 and lugged .818 in a series win over No. 2 Texas Tech. Martinez totaled six RBI on the weekend; matching a career-high with a bases-clearing, three-run double on Friday, a solo home run on Saturday and a first-inning, two-run, two-out double. He became the first Sooner to win Big 12 Player of the Week since **Cody Thomas** (5/16/16).

#### Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner seven times; all at home. Six of those seven wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against No. 2 Texas Tech (4/2). Tied 4-4, **Kyle Mendenhall** led off the bottom of the ninth and blasted a 2-2 pitch over the wall in left-center for his team-leading fifth home run.

#### 100 in Under 100...

Steele Walker collected two hits against Texas Tech (3/31) to reach 100 career hits. Doing so in his 86th career game, he tied for the eighth fastest to reach 100 hits at OU since 2003. Overall, Walker became the 14th Sooner with 100 career hits in less than 100 career games in the last 15 seasons.

The Sooners' first 17 games were started by a sophomore pitcher until junior **Devon Perez** started game 18. Oklahoma has gotten 14 wins from its sophomore class; one back of Texas Tech for most in the league. In 2016, freshman pitchers from OU and Tech tied for the league lead with 18 regular season wins. Nineteen of the Sooners' 27 wins have been claimed by underclassmen; trailing TTU (22) and TCU (20).

#### A Year Older, Stronger...

At the 39-game mark of the 2016 season, Oklahoma sat at 19-19-1 overall and 5-8 in the Big 12 following a series-opening, 1-0, extrainning win over West Virginia (4/22/16) in Norman. The Sooners' current 27-12 record marks an eight-game improvement in wins from this same point one year ago. In 2016. Oklahoma was 3-14-1 against Top-100 RPI teams through 39 games vs. 8-11 this season; good enough for an 85-spot improvement in the RPI from 106 to 21...

#### A Stoney Shot for the Ages...

After sitting out 12 games over the course of 23 days due to a torn left UCL suffered against Buffalo (3/11), **Austin O'Brien** made his return to the diamond vs. Oral Roberts (4/4). He went 2-for-4 with a gamewinning, seventh-inning grand slam to break a 2-2 tie and put the game at its final score of 6-2. It marked his third home run of the season, 13th of his career and second career grand slam. O'Brien's first career grand slam came at Oklahoma State (4/15/14) as a freshman in the first inning of an eventual OU win in 18 innings.

#### MLB Opening Day Starter...

#### Save the Best for Last...

**JB Olson** picked up his sixth save of the season last week; pushing his two-year career total to 10. He stands alone at seventh all-time at OU; trailing **Bucky Buckles** (1994) with 14. Olson passed a group of five pitchers tied with nine saves. In 43 career relief appearances, Olson has pitched two or more scoreless-inning 14 times.

#### Ben There, Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16).

#### Newcomer of the Week...

Brylie Ware was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week (3/13). He hit a team-high .562 (9-for-16) in a 4-1 week to earn his first career weekly honor. He totaled seven runs, seven RBI, two doubles and two walks with a .632 OBP and .688 slugging percentage. Ware became the second Sooner to earn a Big 12 weekly award this season and the first to earn Newcomer of the Week since **Sheldon Neuse** (4/7/14).

#### Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 10-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-3 win at Baylor (3/24). Oklahoma won the series over the Bears to mark the fourth series win in the first Big 12 weekend in the last five seasons. OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

#### Down Six to Up Eight...

The Sooners overcame a six-run deficit to win at Kennesaw State (3/18); marking the first win when trailing by five or more since erasing a five-run gap against West Virginia (4/23/16). Solo home runs in the third and fourth by Ben Hollas and Blake Brewster inched Oklahoma closer. The two sides then traded a run in the fifth and it was 7-3 headed to the sixth. There, OU sent 10 to the plate and scored six runs. including a go-ahead grand slam by **Steele Walker** with two down. The Sooners added five insurance runs in the eighth and three more in the ninth of a 17-9 win.

#### 20-Strikeout Night...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** struck out a career-best 14 in a 3-0 win over Central Connecticut (3/3) as OU pitchers combined to strikeout 20. Irvin's 14 was the most by a Sooner since **Michael Rocha** struck out 13 against Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth inning. In relief, right-hander **Connor Berry** accomplished the rare feat of striking out four in an inning. He got the first batter looking before the next struck out swinging, but reached on a wild pitch. Berry then punched out the next two.

#### Back-to-Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma had won four consecutive series against ranked opponents following its Big 12-home opening series win over No. 12 Texas Tech, OU's first top-five series win since sweeping Baylor in 2012. Previously, the Sooners took two out of three from No. 17 Long Beach State on opening weekend and two of three from Baylor in the Big 12-opening series. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).
