First Pitch...

The University of Oklahoma baseball team plays its final road series of the regular season with a three-game set at Kansas State this weekend. The action gets underway Friday, May 5 at 6:35 p.m. from Tointon Family Stadium.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma picked up its fourth top-20 RPI series win, second on the road, with two wins at No. 25 West Virginia last weekend. The Sooners head to Manhattan at 30-16 overall and 8-7 in Big 12 play. Senior catcher **Renae Martinez** and sophomore center fielder Steele Walker are tied for the team lead in hitting with a .345 batting average. Martinez has scored and driven in 28 runs with eight doubles and five home runs. Walker leads the team with a .552 slugging percentage with 12 doubles, six home runs and 41 runs scored and driven in. Sophomore designated hitter Brylie Ware is third with a .315 average and 29 runs scored. He hit his sixth double of the season and first career home run against the Mountaineers this past weekend. The Sooners will roll out the same rotation on backto-back weekends with sophomore right-hander **Jake Irvin** in the Friday night role. Irvin, sophomore RHP **Kyle Tyler** and junior RHP **Devon Perez** all took no decision vs. WVU, but accounted for 15 innings with just four runs charged against them and 15 strikeouts to three walks. Irvin is 5-0 with a 2.14 earned run average, while Tyler is 0-01 with a 3.27 ERA and Perez is 4-2 with a 4.10 ERA.

- OU's 30-16 record marks an eight-game improvement for wins vs. a 22-23-1 record through 46 games in 2016.
- Austin O'Brien is a .333 (7-for-21) career hitter vs. K-State with eight runs and four RBI. Kyle Mendenhall has hit .280 (7for-25) in his career vs. the Wildcats.
- · Oklahoma has won two road Big 12 series with an overall record of 5-4. Last season, the Sooners went 1-8 in Big 12 road games. In 2015, OU was 7-5 on the road with three series wins.
- The Sooners are 21-5 at home this season; its best record since going 19-5 at L. Dale Mitchell Park in 2014. It is the first 20-win season at home since going 25-6 in 2013.
- Brandon Zaragoza was named to the Brooks Wallace Award watch list by the College Baseball Hall of Fame. The award. which was won by OU's Sheldon Neuse in 2016, is given to the nation's top shortstop.
- Steele Walker and TTU's Hunter Hargrove are the only players in the Big 12 in the top five in batting average, hits, runs, RBI. Walker ranks third in hits and runs, fourth in RBI, fifth in hitting,

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 21 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 647-484-3 (.572), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Wildcats...

Kansas State is coming off four straight non-conference wins with a sweep of Abilene Christian over the weekend and a Tuesday victory over Wichita State. The Wildcats, who are 25-20 overall and 4-11 in the Big 12, previously claimed a home series over West Virginia two weekends ago. Left fielder **Will Brennan** is hitting a team-high .360 with 31 runs scored and seven stolen bases. Second baseman **Cameron Thompson** is second on the team at .322 with 34 runs, 11 steals and four triples. First baseman **Jake Scudder** provides the power with league-leading 13 home runs on a .308 average with 10 doubles, 52 RBI and a .598 slugging percentage. RHP **Justin Heskett** (5-2, 3.14), LHP **Parker Rigler** (4-4, 3.03) and RHP **Kasey Ford** (2-0, 5.02) make up the K-State rotation.

All-Time vs. K-State...

Oklahoma leads the series against Kansas State with a 156-69 all-time record, including a 53-31 advantage in Manhattan. The Sooners won the first six games of the series and own the series' longest win streak at 27 games. In the last four seasons, the two sides have met in the Big 12 Championship four times with OU winning three, including elimination games in 2015 and 2016.

Last Time They Met...

Eight Sooners recorded a multi-hit game and all nine players in the lineup had a hit as Oklahoma eliminated Kansas State, 13-7, at the 2016 Big 12 Championship in OKC. The Wildcats plated two in the first, but OU responded with four in the second and six in the third. **Alex Wise** was 2-for-4 with a three-run triple and a RBI-double. **Alec Hansen** got the win in six innings with seven strikeouts. During the regular season, Oklahoma won two out of three over K-State at home after the Wildcats claimed the opener. In game two, **Jake Irvin** went seven innings with five strikeouts in a 10-1 win. Hansen wrapped up the series win: taking a no-hitter into the sixth in what was his first start in over a month and his first win in nearly a year. He struck out nine in six innings as the Sooners won 12-0, in a seven-inning, run-rule victory.

Bullpen Bagels...

The Öklahoma bullpen had a streak of 13 consecutive scoreless innings snapped at Michigan (4/13). It was the team's longest such streak of the season and second of 10 innings or more in 2017. The streak came to an end in the fifth inning of a 5-2 loss to the Wolverines after **Ryan Madden** held UM scoreless in his first three innings of relief. As a unit, the Sooner relievers have combined to throw 137 complete shutout innings; accounting for 74% of the innings started by a relief pitcher.

The Last 22 Games...

Oklahoma has played 22 consecutive games against RPI top-100 teams beginning with Oklahoma State (3/21). Over that span, the Sooners own a 9-13 record, including 4-3 at home, 5-10 on the road, 8-7 in the Big 12 and 6-7 against ranked opponents. In those 22 games, **Steele Walker** is hitting a team-best .342 (27-for-79) with a .544 slugging and .447 on-base percentage with 20 runs scored and 16 driven in. **Renae Martinez** has driven in 13 runs on a .329 (25-for-76) average. Right-hander **JB Olson**, who missed significant time, has appeared in nine games with a 2-0 record, two saves and a 0.00 ERA over 16.2 innings of work.

Everyday Lefty...

Austin Kerns has pitched in a team-leading 24 games; all out of the bullpen. It is tied for the second most appearances by a Big 12 reliever and tied for 10th most in the country. The lefty had not allowed an earned run since facing Oklahoma State (3/21): tossing 10 innings with just two unearned runs scored against him and just two walks issued until facing Dallas Baptist (4/18). A year ago, Kerns made three starts and 13 relief appearances totaling 22.1 innings and a 5.64 ERA. This year, he has surpassed his inning total with 24.2 and owns a 5.11 ERA.

Player of the Week...

Renae Martinez earned his first career weekly honor as the Big 12 Player of the Week (4/3). He hit .364 and slugged .818 in a series win over No. 2 Texas Tech. Martinez totaled six RBI on the weekend: matching a career-high with a bases-clearing, three-run double on Friday, a solo home run on Saturday and a first-inning, two-run, two-out double. He became the first Sooner to win Big 12 Player of the Week since **Cody Thomas** (5/16/16).

Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner seven times; all at home. Six of those seven wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against No. 2 Texas Tech (4/2). Tied 4-4, **Kyle Mendenhall** led off the bottom of the ninth and blasted a 2-2 pitch over the wall in left-center for his team-leading fifth home run.

100 in Under 100...

Steele Walker collected two hits against Texas Tech (3/31) to reach 100 career hits. Doing so in his 86th career game, he tied for the eighth fastest to reach 100 hits at 0U since 2003. Overall, Walker became the 14th Sooner with 100 career hits in less than 100 career games in the last 15 seasons.

A Year Older, Stronger...

At the 46-game mark of 2016, OU was 22-23-1 overall and 7-12 in the Big 12 following series-opening loss to K-State at home. The Sooners' current 30-16 record marks an eight-game improvement in wins from this same point one year ago. In 2016, Oklahoma was 4-14-1 against Top-100 RPI teams through 46 games vs. 11-14 this season: good enough for a 79-spot improvement in the RPI from 105 to 26.

A Stoney Shot for the Ages...

After sitting out 12 games over the course of 23 days due to a torn left UCL suffered against Buffalo (3/11), **Austin O'Brien** made his return to the diamond vs. Oral Roberts (4/4). He went 2-for-4 with a gamewinning, seventh-inning grand slam to break a 2-2 tie and put the game at its final score of 6-2. It marked his third home run of the season, 13th of his career and second career grand slam. O'Brien's first career grand slam came at Oklahoma State (4/15/14) as a freshman in the first inning of an eventual OU win in 18 innings.

Save the Best for Last...

JB Olson picked up his seventh save of the season last week; pushing his two-year career total to 11. He stands alone at seventh all-time at OU; trailing **Bucky Buckles** (1994) with 14. Olson passed a group of five pitchers tied with nine saves. In 50 career relief appearances, Olson has pitched two or more scoreless-inning 17 times.

Ben There, Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16). On the road, Hollas added a go-ahead 10th-inning single to his résumé to beat No. 25 West Virginia (4/30/17).

Newcomer of the Week...

Brylie Ware was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week (3/13). He hit a team-high .562 (9-for-16) in a 4-1 week to earn his first career weekly honor. He totaled seven runs, seven RBI, two doubles and two walks with a .632 OBP and .688 slugging percentage. Ware became the second Sooner to earn a Big 12 weekly award this season and the first to earn Newcomer of the Week since **Sheldon Neuse** (4/7/14).

Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 10-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-3 win at Baylor (3/24). Oklahoma won the series over the Bears to mark the fourth series win in the first Big 12 weekend in the last five seasons. OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. lowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

Down Six to Up Eight...

The Sooners overcame a six-run deficit to win at Kennesaw State (3/18); marking the first win when trailing by five or more since erasing a five-run gap against West Virginia (4/23/16). Solo home runs in the third and fourth by **Ben Hollas** and **Blake Brewster** inched Oklahoma closer. The two sides then traded a run in the fifth and it was 7-3 headed to the sixth. There, OU sent 10 to the plate and scored six runs, including a go-ahead grand slam by **Steele Walker** with two down. The Sooners added five insurance runs in the eighth and three more in the ninth of a 17-9 win.

20-Strikeout Night...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** struck out a career-best 14 in a 3-0 win over Central Connecticut (3/3) as OU pitchers combined to strikeout 20. Irvin's 14 was the most by a Sooner since **Michael Rocha** struck out 13 against Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth inning. In relief, right-hander **Connor Berry** accomplished the rare feat of striking out four in an inning. He got the first batter looking before the next struck out swinging, but reached on a wild pitch. Berry then punched out the next two.

Back-to-Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma had won four consecutive series against ranked opponents following its Big 12-home opening series win over No. 12 Texas Tech, OU's first top-five series win since sweeping Baylor in 2012. Previously, the Sooners took two out of three from No. 17 Long Beach State on opening weekend and two of three from Baylor in the Big 12-opening series. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).
