First Pitch...

The No. 24 University of Oklahoma baseball team plays its final home series of the 2017 regular season this weekend when it welcomes No. 5 TCU to L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners take the field against the Horned Frogs in game one on Friday, May 12 at 6:30 p.m.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma picked up its third series win on the road in conference play last week to improve to 32-17 overall and 10-8 in the league. The Sooners head into the weekend ranked No. 24 by *Baseball America* and are slotted 21st in the RPI. Senior catcher **Renaé Martinez** leads OU with a .355 batting average and is second in on-base percentage (.434) and third in slugging (.533). He doubled four times at Kansas State last weekend to tie **Steele Walker** for the team-lead at 12. Walker, the Sooners' sophomore center fielder, is second with a .333 average, first in slugging (.559) and third in OBP (.410). He has eight home runs, 43 runs scored and 45 driven in. As a team, Oklahoma has hit 43 home runs. Senior first baseman **Austin O'Brien** has total seven, including three in the last four games, and sophomore designated hitter **Brylie Ware** has come through with the first two of his OU career in each of the last two series finales. On the mound, the Sooners turn to sophomore right-hander **Jake Irvin** on Friday night. He is 6-0 with a 2.44 earned run average and 58 strikeouts after a six-inning win a week ago.

On the Air...

The entire series can be heard across the Sooner Sports Network and will air locally on Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM. Voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will have the call alongside former Sooner **Ross Hubbard**. Sooner Sports TV will broadcast the first to games on FOX Sports Oklahoma. Former big leaguers **George Frazier** and **Mickey Tettleton** will be in the booth. For game three, **Dave Barnett** (pbp) and **Pat Combs** (color) will be in Norman for the game on FOX College Sports-Central.

• OU's 32-17 record marks a seven-game improvement for wins vs. a 25-23-1 record through 49 games in 2016.

• Steele Walker went 5-for-10 in three games at TCU last season. He doubled twice, scored two and drove in two.

• Oklahoma won three of four road Big 12 series with an overall record of 7-5. Last season, the Sooners went 1-8 in Big 12 road games. In 2015, OU was 7-5 on the road with three series wins.

• The Sooners are 21-5 at home this season; its best record since going 19-5 at L. Dale Mitchell Park in 2014. It is the first 20-win season at home since going 25-6 in 2013.

• Brandon Zaragoza was named to the Brooks Wallace Award watch list by the College Baseball Hall of Fame and Renaé Martinez was added to the Johnny Bench Award watch list.

• Austin O'Brien and Jake Irvin were both voted CoSIDA Academic All-District; OU's first honorees since Elliott Blair in 2011.

• Steele Walker is the only Big 12 hitter in the top five in the league in hits (third), runs (third), RBI (fifth) and slugging (third).

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 21 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 649-485-3 (.573), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Horned Frogs...

No. 5 TCU is coming off a series win over Texas to lift its record to 35-11 overall and 15-6 in the Big 12. Following this weekend, the Horned Frogs, who sit atop the league standings, will be in non-conference play at California. Right fielder **Austen Wade** leads the TCU lineup with a .351 average, a team-high 13 doubles and has added 13 stolen bases for a team that has totaled 81 on the season. First baseman **Luken Baker** is second in hitting at .316 with a team-high .532 slugging on eight doubles and eight home runs. Catcher **Evan Skoug** has hit a team-leading 12 home runs and is hitting .282 with 43 RBI. Lefty **Nick Lodolo** gets the ball in game one. He is 5-1 with a 4.71 ERA.

All-Time vs. TCU...

TCU has won eight in a row over Oklahoma, including a sweep in Fort Worth a year ago and a Big 12-clinching sweep in Norman in 2015. Overall, the Sooners lead the series 57-32 vs. the Horned Frogs, who have an 8-4 advantage in league games since joining the Big 12 in 2013. Since 2012, 11 of 16 games have been decided by two runs or less, including two extra-inning games. Oklahoma hosted TCU at the 2006 Norman Regional. The Horned Frogs opened with a 6-5 win over the Sooners before OU eliminated TCU, 15-6, on the way to advancing to the Houston Super Regional.

Seizing a Second Chance...

Renae Martinez spent his first two seasons at UC Irvine and as a redshirt-freshman went to Omaha with the Cinderella Anteaters. Seeking an opportunity to be an everyday catcher, he went through the junior college route and landed at El Camino College-Compton near his hometown of San Pedro, Calif. Martinez committed to the Sooners and served as the backup to freshman All-American **Domenic DeRenzo** for most of 2016. A torn UCL shut down DeRenzo late in the season and Martinez finished out the year as the starting backstop; hitting .423 over the final nine games. Prior to being forced into the lineup, Martinez was hitting just .128 on May 14, 2016. After being named a California Collegiate All-Star with the Neptune Beach Peal over the summer, he was honored to be elected a team captain by his teammates at OU in the fall.

Winning on the Road...

Oklahoma completed its four Big 12 road series with a 7-5 record, including three series victories. The Sooners took two of three at No. 14 Baylor, No. 25 West Virginia and Kansas State plus won once at Texas. In 2016, OU was just 1-8 in true road games in conference play due to the Bedlam Series, which the Sooners won, being played at a neutral site. Oklahoma was also 7-5 in road conference games in 2015.

The Last 25 Games...

Oklahoma has played 25 consecutive games against RPI top-100 teams beginning with Oklahoma State (3/21). Over that span, the Sooners own an 11-14 record, including 4-3 at home, 7-11 on the road, 10-8 in the Big 12 and 6-7 against ranked opponents. In those 22 games, **Renae Martinez** is hitting a team-best .348 with 17 RBI and a .494 slugging percentage. On the mound, closer **JB Olson** has made 10 appearances and totaled 19 innings of work with a 0.00 ERA, 2-0 record and three saves.

Bullpen Bagels...

The Oklahoma bullpen had a streak of 13 consecutive scoreless innings snapped at Michigan (4/13). It was the team's longest such streak of the season and second of 10 innings or more in 2017. The streak came to an end in the fifth inning of a 5-2 loss to the Wolverines after **Ryan Madden** held UM scoreless in his first three innings of relief. As a unit, the Sooner relievers have combined to throw 143 complete shutout innings; accounting for 73% of the innings started by a relief pitcher. Oklahoma is 14-1 when the bullpen does not concede a run, which has directly contributed to the Sooners being 27-0 when leading after seven innings.

The Sooners wrap up the regular season as the host of the Bedlam Series. Oklahoma and Oklahoma State meet at Tulsa's ONEOK Field for game one Thursday, May 18 at 7:05 p.m. Games two and three follow at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City.

Save the Best for Last...

JB Olson picked up his eighth save of the season last week; pushing his two-year career total to 12. He stands alone at seventh all-time at OU; trailing **Bucky Buckles** (1994) with 14. Earlier this season, Olson passed a group of five pitchers tied with nine saves. In 51 career relief appearances, Olson has pitched two or more scoreless-inning 18 times.

Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner seven times; all at home. Six of those seven wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against No. 2 Texas Tech (4/2). Tied 4-4, **Kyle Mendenhall** led off the bottom of the ninth and blasted a 2-2 pitch over the wall in left-center for his team-leading fifth home run.

100 in Under 100...

Steele Walker collected two hits against Texas Tech (3/31) to reach 100 career hits. Doing so in his 86th career game, he tied for the eighth fastest to reach 100 hits at OU since 2003. Overall, Walker became the 14th Sooner with 100 career hits in less than 100 career games in the last 15 seasons.

The Sooners' first 17 games were started by a sophomore pitcher until junior **Devon Perez** started game 18. Oklahoma has gotten 17 wins from its sophomores; tied with Texas one back of Texas Tech for the league lead. In 2016, freshmen from OU and Tech tied for the league lead with 18 regular season wins. Twenty two of the Sooners' 32 wins have been claimed by underclassmen; trailing TTU (26) and TCU (25).

A Year Older, Stronger...

At the 49-game mark of 2016, OU was 25-23-1 overall and 10-12 in the Big 12 following series-opening win over OSU in OKC. The Sooners' current 32-17 record marks a seven-game improvement in wins from this same point one year ago. In 2016, Oklahoma was 7-15-1 against Top-100 RPI teams through 49 games vs. 13-15 this season; good enough for a 75-spot improvement in the RPI from 96 to 21.

#YardWork...

The Sooners are fourth in the Big 12 in home runs at 43. OU is averaging 0.88 home runs per game with **Steele Walker** leading with eight.

Against the Ranked...

Since **Pete Hughes** took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 21-39-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 7-19 against top-10 teams, including three wins over top-five Texas Tech (2016-No. 5, 2017-No. 2) teams. This season marked the first time OU played a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a double-header with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State.

Back-to-Back-to-Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma had won four consecutive series against ranked opponents following its Big 12-home opening series win over No. 12 Texas Tech, OU's first top-five series win since sweeping Baylor in 2012. Previously, the Sooners took two out of three from No. 17 Long Beach State on opening weekend and two of three from Baylor in the Big 12-opening series. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

Ben There, Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16). On the road, Hollas added a go-ahead 10th-inning single to his résumé to beat No. 25 West Virginia (4/30/17).

Award Watch...

Freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** was named to the Brooks Wallace Award Watch list by the College Baseball Foundation. Learning Left...

After starting five different left fielder in five consecutive games, head coach **Pete Hughes** turned to infielder **Cade Harris** to make it six in a row on April 23 in the series finale against Kansas. Harris started 37 games at third base as a freshman and an additional three this season plus two at shortstop. He has anchored left field in each of the last seven games as OU has turned in the same lineup in each of those seven games. **Steele Walker**, who has played 10 in a row out in center, has started a team-leading 23 games in left this season.

A Stoney Shot for the Ages...

After sitting out 12 games over the course of 23 days due to a torn left UCL suffered against Buffalo (3/11), **Austin O'Brien** made his return to the diamond vs. Oral Roberts (4/4). He went 2-for-4 with a game-winning, seventh-inning grand slam to break a 2-2 tie and put the game at its final score of 6-2. It marked his third home run of the season, 13th of his career and second career grand slam. O'Brien's first career grand slam came at Oklahoma State (4/15/14) as a freshman in the first inning of an eventual OU win in 18 innings.

MLB Opening Day Starter...

Jon Gray started MLB opening day for the Colorado Rockies (4/3). It marked the second year in a row a former Sooner started on opening day. Gray is the seventh OU pitcher all-time to start on opening day.

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** struck out a career-best 14 in a 3-0 win over Central Connecticut (3/3) as OU pitchers combined to strikeout 20. Irvin's 14 was the most by a Sooner since **Michael Rocha** struck out 13 against Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth inning. In relief, right-hander

Connor Berry accomplished the rare feat of striking out four in an inning. He got the first batter looking before the next struck out swinging, but reached on a wild pitch. Berry then punched out the next two.

Opening Weekend: Tyler had his best performance as a Sooner despite not getting a decision against Long Beach State (2/19). Oklahoma would go on for a 4-2, come-from-behind win after he pitched a career-high 5.2 innings. Tyler struck out three and gave up two runs on four hits and two walks. He left the game trailing 2-1 and the Sooner tied and took the lead in the next half inning.

Best Start of 2016: On a pitch-count, Tyler registered the win despite just four innings of work at Little Rock on March 29, 2016. It marked the first win of his collegiate career as the Sooners were victorious, 5-2. He struck out three and threw a season-high 72 pitches, while allowing just one unearned run.
