First Pitch...

The No. 23 University of Oklahoma baseball team enters the 21st Big 12 Championship as the three-seed for the second time in three seasons. The Sooners open the double-elimination tournament on Wednesday, May 24 against six-seed Texas at 7:30 p.m. from Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is 34-20 overall and finished the Big 12 slate at 12-11. The Sooners enter postseason play with their most wins since a 36-19 mark to enter the 2013 championship in OKC, in which OU went undefeated on the way to its second conference tournament title. The Sooners have won five top-25 RPI series; the most of any school in the country this season. Sophomore center fielder **Steele Walker** leads Oklahoma's offense with a .341 batting average and is second at .561 in slugging and .421 in on-base percentage. He has driven in and scored 48 runs. Senior catcher **Renaé Martinez** is second in hitting at .331 and third in slugging at .514. Senior first baseman **Austin O'Brien** is hitting .310 and tied with Walker for the team-lead in home runs at eight. He is five runs and three RBI shy from reaching 100 in both categories for his career. Freshman right-hander **Nathan Wiles** gets the ball in the opener for OU. He is 4-3 with a 4.47 earned run average in 44.1 innings of work. Solidifying the back-end of the bullpen are senior RHP **JB Olson** and sophomore RHP **Connor Berry**. Olson is 5-1 with eight saves and a 1.70 ERA in 27 appearances; Berry is 3-0 with a 1.35 ERA in 20 relief outings.

Every OU game in the championship can be heard across the Sooner Sports Network and will air locally on Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM. Voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will have the call. All games will be broadcast on FOX Sports Southwest-Plus and FOX College Sports-Central. **Bill Doleman** (pbp) and former MLB All-Star **Mickey Tettleton** (color) will be in the booth.

• OU leads the country with five top-25 RPI series wins and is one of 14 teams with six top-100 RPI wins or more.

• Renaé Martinez, who was 6-for-9 at Texas earlier this season, went 5-for-12 in the 2016 Big 12 Championship, while Steele Walker was 5-for-16.

• Oklahoma won three of four road Big 12 series with an overall record of 7-5. Last season, the Sooners went 1-8 in Big 12 road games. In 2015, OU was 7-5 on the road with three series wins.

• The Sooners are 23-6 at home this season; its best record since going 19-5 at L. Dale Mitchell Park in 2014. It is the first 20-win season at home since going 25-6 in 2013.

• Renaé Martinez was added to the Johnny Bench Award watch list, while Jake Irvin was named a National Pitcher of the Year semifinalist by the College Baseball Foundation.

• Austin O'Brien and Jake Irvin were both voted CoSIDA Academic All-District; OU's first honorees since 2011. O'Brien and Irvin are two of seven Academic All-Big 12 picks from OU.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 21 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 651-486-3 (.574), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Longhorns...

Texas took two out of three at home against West Virginia to claim the six-seed with a 34-20 overall record and 11-12 mark in Big 12 play under first-year head coach **David Pierce**. First baseman **Kacy Clemens** leads the Longhorns in hitting at .308 with nine home runs and 42 runs driven in and scored. Five other players have all hit five home runs, including **Kody Clemens**, who is a .265 hitter with 20 RBI. Lefty **Nick Kennedy** gets the start for Texas. He is 8-1 with a 2.36 ERA in 16 games, including seven starts.

All-Time vs. Texas...

The Longhorns lead the Sooners in the all-time series, 129-52-2. Oklahoma had won back-to-back series against Texas until falling in two out of three down in Austin back in April. Oklahoma had won three of the last four and its 2013 victory was the first over Texas in 15 years. OU's 2015 and 2016 series wins were the first in back-to-back years over UT since 1997 and 1998. The two sides have met in the College World Series six times: 1972, 1973, 1974, 1975 and 1992. Oklahoma twice defeated Texas in the NCAA Central Regional in Austin to advance to the CWS and win the 1994 National Championship. Ten of the last 15 meetings between the two sides have been decided by two runs or less with the Sooners holding a 6-4 advantage in those games.

Last Time They Met...

No. 9 Oklahoma salvaged its series at Texas with a 2-1 win in the finale on April 9. The Longhorns struck for a run in the inning, but RHP **Nathan Wiles** got a groundball and a strikeout to strand two runners in scoring position. The Sooners tied the game in the sixth on a **Renae Martinez** RBI-single and went in front in the seventh on a RBI-double from **Ben Hollas**. Right-hander **Connor Berry** earned the win in 3.1 innings of relief as he struck out five, including the final out to leave the potential tying run on base.

Sooners Tournament History...

All-time, Oklahoma is 36-33 in the Big 12 Championship. The Sooners and Baylor are the only two teams to qualify for all 21 championships in the league's history. Texas holds a 4-1 advantage over Oklahoma in the Big 12 Championship; though the two teams have not met in a postseason game since 2008. Joining OU and UT in the bracket are two-seed TCU and seven-seed Kansas. Oklahoma has never played the Horned Frogs in the Big 12 Championship and last played Kansas in 2013; winning the championship game, 7-2. The Sooners went undefeated in 2013 to win the title. OU won the league's first championship in 1997 and overcame a game one loss to Texas A&M before winning four in a row, including a 19-17 decision vs. Texas Tech in the final.

2016 Tournament Recap...

The Sooners came out of the loser's bracket to reach Saturday at the Big 12 Championship a year ago. Five-seed Oklahoma fell to four-seed West Virginia, 6-0, in the opener. The Sooners then eliminated eight-seed Kansas State, 13-7. Oklahoma followed with a 17-4, run-rule victory over one-seed and regular season champion Texas Tech. **Dylan Grove** pitched a seven-inning complete game and **Alex Wise** drove in five runs. Oklahoma's season came to an end with a run-rule loss to West Virginia, 11-1, in seven innings.

Hosting Bid...

Oklahoma moved itself back into the hunt for hosting a NCAA Regional following its series win over TCU (RPI: 6). As a league, the Big 12 owns the top conference RPI with six of nine teams ranked in the top-25. Over the last four seasons, the leading RPI conference received a minimum of four hosts each year. The Sooners enter the weekend ranked No. 25 in the RPI and have the most top-25 RPI series wins in the country with five. Oklahoma is one of 14 teams in the top-25 RPI with six top-100 RPI series wins or better. The Sooners last hosted a regional in 2010; also the last time OU appeared in Omaha.

Seizing a Second Chance...

Renaé Martinez spent his first two seasons at UC Irvine and as a redshirt-freshman went to Omaha with the Cinderella Anteaters. Seeking an opportunity to be an everyday catcher, he went through the junior college route and landed at El Camino College-Compton near his hometown of San Pedro, Calif. Martinez committed to the Sooners and served as the backup to freshman All-American **Domenic DeRenzo** for most of 2016. A torn UCL shut down DeRenzo late in the season and Martinez finished out the year as the starting backstop; hitting .423 over the final nine games. Prior to being forced into the lineup, Martinez was hitting just .128 on May 14, 2016. After being named a California Collegiate All-Star with the Neptune Beach Peal over the summer, he was honored to be elected a team captain by his teammates at OU in the fall.

Winning on the Road...

Oklahoma completed its four Big 12 road series with a 7-5 record, including three series victories. The Sooners took two of three at No. 14 Baylor, No. 25 West Virginia and Kansas State plus won once at Texas. In 2016, OU was just 1-8 in true road games in conference play due to the Bedlam Series, which the Sooners won, being played at a neutral site. Oklahoma was also 7-5 in road conference games in 2015.

The Last 30 Games...

Oklahoma has played 30 consecutive games against RPI top-100 teams beginning with Oklahoma State (3/21). Over that span, the Sooners own a 13-17 record, including 6-4 at home, 7-11 on the road, 12-11 in the Big 12 and 8-8 against ranked opponents. In those 30 games, **Steele Walker** is hitting a team-best .336 with 27 runs and 23 RBI. **Renaé Martinez** is hitting .313 with 21 RBI. OU is averaging 0.93 home runs per game in that stretch. In relief, **Connor Berry** (3-0) and **JB Olson** (5-1) are a combined 8-1 with a 1.40 ERA.

Bullpen Bagels...

The Oklahoma bullpen had a streak of 13 consecutive scoreless innings snapped at Michigan (4/13). It was the team's longest such streak of the season and second of 10 innings or more in 2017. The streak came to an end in the fifth inning of a 5-2 loss to the Wolverines after **Ryan Madden** held UM scoreless in his first three innings of relief. As a unit, the Sooner relievers have combined to throw 155 complete shutout innings; accounting for 72% of the innings started by a relief pitcher. Oklahoma is 14-1 when the bullpen does not concede a run, which has directly contributed to the Sooners being 27-1 when leading after seven innings.

Save the Best for Last...

JB Olson picked up his eighth save of the season at K-State (5/7); pushing his two-year career total to 12. He stands alone at seventh all-time at OU; trailing **Bucky Buckles** (1994) with 14. Earlier this season, Olson passed a group of five pitchers tied with nine saves. In 51 career relief appearances, Olson has pitched two or more scoreless-inning 18 times.

Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner nine times; all at home. Seven of those nine wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against No. 5 TCU (5/14) with an **Austin O'Brien** ninth-inning single to win, 10-9. It was the second consecutive walk-off win of the Horned Frogs as **Renaé Martinez** blasted a three-run shot in the ninth to even the series with a 9-8 Sooner victory.

All-Academic Team...

Austin O'Brien was honored as one of just two three-time Academic All-Big 12 selections. He was joined by **Jack Flansburg**, **Ben Hollas**, **Jake Irvin** and **Kyle Tyler**. **Connor Berry** and **JB Olson** earned spots on the Second Team.

Wiles by the Numbers...

In his rookie season, **Nathan Wiles** has totaled 18 appearances on the hill, including six starts and 12 relief outings. He is 4-3 with a 4.47 ERA and 36 strikeouts in 44.1 innings. Wiles earned a four-inning save against Buffalo (3/9) and followed with a sport start, the first of his career, against Georgia State (3/15). He won that game in a season-high six innings with seven strikeouts. In Big 12 play, Wiles owns a 3.65 ERA in nine games, which includes three starts. His first Big 12 start came at Baylor (3/26). Wiles pitched 4.1 innings of scoreless ball and earned the win, while on a pitch count: totaling 70 pitches in the game. Take away a 1.2-inning start in which he allowed eight runs at Michigan (4/14) on just four days rest and his ERA drops to 2.95 overall. Over his last five relief appearances, Wiles owns a 3.37 ERA with six strikeouts in 10.2 innings pitched.

100 in Under 100...

Steele Walker collected two hits against Texas Tech (3/31) to reach 100 career hits. Doing so in his 86th career game, he tied for the eighth fastest to reach 100 hits at OU since 2003. Overall, Walker became the 14th Sooner with 100 career hits in less than 100 career games in the last 15 seasons.

*Teammates Caufield and Kaiser recorded the same number of hits in the same number of games just one day apart (March 17 and 18 at Arizona State with Caufield reaching the feat one day sooner).

Player of the Week...

Following his walk-off single vs. TCU (5/14), **Austin O'Brien** was named the Big 12 Player of the Week. He hit .357 and slugged .714 with a team-high six RBI in the series win. It marked the first weekly award of O'Brien's career.

Young Arms...

The Sooners' first 17 games were started by a sophomore pitcher until junior **Devon Perez** started game 18. Oklahoma has gotten 17 wins from its sophomores; two back of Texas Tech and Texas for the league lead. In 2016, freshmen from OU and Tech tied for the league lead with 18 regular season wins. Twenty-two of the Sooners' 34 wins have been claimed by underclassmen; trailing TCU and TTU with 28.

A Year Older, Stronger...

Entering the 2016 Big 12 Championship, OU was 28-25-1 overall. The Sooners' current 34-20 record marks a six-game improvement in wins from this same point one year ago. In 2016, Oklahoma was 8-17-1 against Top-100 RPI teams through 54 games vs. 16-19 this season; good enough for a 44-spot improvement in the RPI from 69 to 25.

Award Watch...

Freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** was named to the Brooks Wallace Award Watch list by the College Baseball Foundation. The award goes to the top shortstop in college baseball and was claimed by OU's **Sheldon Neuse** in 2016. In its most recent update, the Johnny Bench Award for the nation's top catcher included **Renae Martinez** on its watch list. In 2009, Sooner catcher **J.T. Wise** took home the hardware as he was honored by the Wichita Sports Commission. Most recently, **Jake Irvin** was named a semifinalist for the National Pitcher of the Year as awarded by the College Baseball Foundation. Sooner **Jon Gray** won the award in 2013.

Learning Left...

After starting five different left fielders in five consecutive games, head coach **Pete Hughes** turned to infielder **Cade Harris** to make it six in a row on April 23 in the series finale against Kansas. Harris started 37 games at third base as a freshman and an additional three this season plus two at shortstop. He has anchored left field in each of the last 12 games, while batting leadoff. **Steele Walker**, who has played 15 in a row out in center, has started a team-leading 23 games in left this season.

Against the Ranked...

Since **Pete Hughes** took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 23-40-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 9-20 against top-10 teams, including three wins over top-five Texas Tech (2016-No. 5, 2017-No. 2) teams. This season marked the first time OU played a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a double-header with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State.
