#### First Pitch...

The University of Oklahoma baseball team makes its return to the NCAA postseason for the first time since 2013 and first appearance under fourth-year head coach **Pete Hughes**. The Sooners earned an at-large bid as the two-seed in the Louisville Regional and open play against three-seed Xavier on Friday at 1 p.m. CT from Jim Patterson Stadium. This marks the 37th NCAA postseason appearance for OU and the first as an at-large team since 2012.

#### About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is 34-22 overall and finished the Big 12 slate at 12-11. The Sooners won five top-25 RPI series; the most of any school in the country this season. Sophomore center fielder Steele Walker leads Oklahoma's offense with a .338 batting average and is second at .552 in slugging and .421 in on-base percentage. He has driven in 50 runs and scored 48. Senior catcher **Renae Martinez** is second in hitting at .328 and third in slugging at .522. Senior first baseman Austin O'Brien is hitting .305 and tied with Walker for the teamlead in home runs at eight, while Martinez has added seven. O'Brien is five runs and two RBI shy from reaching 100 in both categories for his career. Sophomore right-hander Jake Irvin leads the staff with a 6-2 record and 3.50 earned run average. Solidifying the backend of the bullpen are senior RHP JB Olson and sophomore RHP Connor Berry. Olson is 5-1 with eight saves and a 1.67 ERA in All-District; OU's first honorees since 2011. O'Brien and Irvin 29 appearances. Berry is 3-0 with a 1.63 ERA in 21 relief outings.

#### **HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES**

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 21 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 651-490-3 (.570), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

#### On the Air...

Every OU game in the regional can be heard across the Sooner Sports Network and will air locally on Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM. Voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will have the call. All games will be broadcast by ESPN and streamed on ESPN3 and the WatchESPN app. **Tom Hart** (pbp) and former MLB infielder **Chris Burke** (color) will be in the booth.

#### Scouting the Musketeers...

Xavier, the automatic qualifier from the Big East, earned its second consecutive bid to the tournament and third in four seasons. The Musketeers are 32-25 overall and finished third in their conference at 10-6. Xavier went 17-2 at home this season and just 15-23 away from its home park. Lefty **Zac Lowther** anchors the rotation with a 5-4 record, 2.81 ERA and 115 strikeouts in 77 innings of work. Offensively, the Musketeers are led by designated hitter **Conor Grammes** with a .336 average and 40 RBI. Third baseman **Rylan Brannon** has clubbed 14 home runs on a .322 average, while right fielder **Joe Gellenbeck** has driven in a team-high 56 with 11 home runs.

#### Notes vs. the Field...

- Oklahoma has never in its history played Xavier, Louisville or Radford.
- The Sooners last faced a current member of the Big East in 2014 when Seton Hall visited Norman opening weekend: the first series with Pete Hughes as the OU head coach in which OU won two of three.
- Oklahoma is 19-10 all-time against current teams in the ACC, including a win over Boston College (2/28) and a loss at Georgia Tech (3/14).
- The Sooners were sent to regionals hosted by ACC opponents in 2013 (Virginia Tech) and 2012 (Virginia); winning both.
- OU has not played any current member of the Big South in its history.
- Oklahoma has never played a game in the state of Kentucky.
- Sooner head coach Pete Hughes coached in the Big East at Boston College (1999-05) and the ACC at BC (2006) and Virginia Tech (2007-13), but missed playing against Louisville, which joined the Big East in 2006 and the ACC in 2015.

#### Sooners' NCAA Tournament History...

All-time, Oklahoma is 79-69 in its 36 previous trips to the NCAA post-season. The Sooners went to their first-ever in 1947 and four years later won their first of two National Championship: defeating Tennessee at the 1951 College World Series. Oklahoma has made 10 CWS appearances, including a string of five in a row from 1972-76. OU won its second National Championship in 1994; besting Georgia Tech in the final. The Sooners last went to Omaha in 2010, which was also the last time they hosted a regional. Under the current format, OU has hosted regionals in 2006, 2009 and 2010 and made it to a super regional in 2006, 2010, 2012 and 2013. Oklahoma's last postseason appearance in 2013 resulted in a regional win at Virginia Tech and a two-game sweep at LSU in the supers. The Sooners' 2013 Blacksburg Regional victory, a 10-4 win over the Hokies, came at the expense of current head coach **Pete Hughes**, who coached in the VT dugout from 2007-13.

#### The Country's Top Conference...

A year after sending all three of its tournament teams to the College World Series, the Big 12 rated at the number one RPI conference in 2017. Seven of the league's nine teams earned a spot in the postseason: tied with the 13-team ACC for the second most and trailing the 14-team SEC, which had eight teams selected. Oklahoma won five of eight series in the Big 12 for the second year in a row, including two at home against national seeds Texas Tech and TCU and road series at two-seeds Baylor and West Virginia. The Big 12 is the first number one RPI conference since major conference realignment following the 2012 season to receive less than four regional hosts. The Red Raiders and Horned Frogs, who tied for the league lead at 16-8, were both selected as hosts, while five schools are two-seeds and tournament champion Oklahoma State is the lone three-seed.

#### Seizing a Second Chance...

**Renae Martinez** spent his first two season at UC Irvine and as a redshirt-freshman went to Omaha with the Cinderella Anteaters. Seeking an opportunity to be an everyday catcher, he went through the junior college route and landed at El Camino College-Compton near his hometown of San Pedro, Calif. Martinez committed to the Sooners and served as the backup to freshman All-American **Domenic DeRenzo** for most of 2016. A torn UCL shut down DeRenzo late in the season and Martinez finished out the year as the starting backstop; hitting .423 over the final nine games. Prior to being forced into the lineup, Martinez was hitting just .128 on May 14, 2016. After being named a California Collegiate All-Star with the Neptune Beach Peal over the summer, he was honored to be elected a team captain by his teammates at OU in the fall.

#### Winning on the Road...

Oklahoma completed its four Big 12 road series with a 7-5 record, including three series victories. The Sooners took two of three at No. 14 Baylor, No. 25 West Virginia and Kansas State plus won once at Texas. In 2016, OU was just 1-8 in true road games in conference play due to the Bedlam Series, which the Sooners won, being played at a neutral site. Oklahoma was also 7-5 in road conference games in 2015.

#### Chasing the 100-100 List...

Austin O'Brien sits at 98 RBI and 95 runs scored in his career entering the postseason. He is in the hunt to become the first OU player to reach 100 in each category since Max White (2010-13). Beginning with Jackson Williams (2005-07), seven Sooners reached the milestone over the next seven years. O'Brien would be the first to do so while playing his entire career in the BBCOR era. All-time, 39 players have reached the 100-run, 100-RBI mark as a Sooners. The first to do was was Keith Drumright (1974-76) with 147 runs and 114 RBI. Current student assistant and former four-year starter **Hunter Haley** was the most recent Sooner to threaten joining the list as he registered 99 RBI and 98 runs before a broken wrist suffered in late April last season.

#### Newcomer of the Year...

Sophomore **Brylie Ware** was voted the Big 12 Co-Newcomer of the Year by the league's coaches. He went to Neosho County (Kan.) Community College in 2016 after receiving only one Division I offer (K-State). He was the first NJCAA Triple Crown Winner since 1988 and named the NJCAA Player of the Year with a .589 average, 29 home run and 122 RBI. As a Sooner, he primarily was used as the DH and also earned starts at both corner infield positions. Ware is a .304 hitter with five home runs and 29 RBI. All five of his home runs have come since April 30. He joins **Greg Dobbs** (2001) and **Ole Sheldon** (2001) as the Sooners three Big 12 Newcomer of the Year recipients and is OU's first individual award winner since **Sheldon Neuse** was the 2014 Freshman of the Year.

#### Save the Best for Last...

**JB Olson** picked up his eighth save of the season at K-State (5/7); pushing his two-year career total to 12. He stands alone at seventh all-time at OU; trailing **Bucky Buckles** (1994) with 14. Earlier this season, Olson passed a group of five pitchers tied with nine saves. In 51 career relief appearances, Olson has pitched two or more scorelessinning 18 times.

#### Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner nine times; all at home. Seven of those nine wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against No. 5 TCU (5/14) with an **Austin O'Brien** ninth-inning single to win, 10-9. It was the second consecutive walk-off win of the Horned Frogs as **Renae** Martinez blasted a three-run shot in the ninth to even the series with a 9-8 Sooner victory.

#### All-Academic Team...

**Austin O'Brien** was honored as one of just two three-time Academic All-Big 12 selections. He was joined by **Jack Flansburg**, **Ben Hol**las, Jake Irvin and Kyle Tyler. Connor Berry and JB Olson earned spots on the Second Team. O'Brien and Irvin were also voted CoSIDA Academic All-District; the Sooners first such honorees since 2011.

#### 100 in Under 100...

**Steele Walker** collected two hits against Texas Tech (3/31) to reach 100 career hits. Doing so in his 86th career game, he tied for the eighth fastest to reach 100 hits at OU since 2003. Overall, Walker became the 14th Sooner with 100 career hits in less than 100 career games in the last 15 seasons.

#### Award Watch...

Freshman shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** was named to the Brooks Wallace Award Watch list by the College Baseball Foundation. The award goes to the top shortstop in college baseball and was claimed by OU's **Sheldon Neuse** in 2016. In its most recent update, the Johnny Bench Award for the nation's top catcher included **Renae Martinez** on its list of 15 semifinalists. In 2009, Sooner catcher **J.T. Wise** took home the hardware as he was honored by the Wichita Sports Commission. Most recently, **Jake Irvin** was named a semifinalist for the National Pitcher of the Year as awarded by the College Baseball Foundation. Sooner **Jon Gray** won the award in 2013.

#### Learning Left...

After starting five different left fielders in five consecutive games, head coach **Pete Hughes** turned to infielder **Cade Harris** to make it six in a row on April 23 in the series finale against Kansas. Harris started 37 games at third base as a freshman and an additional three this season plus two at shortstop. He has anchored left field in each of the last 14 games, while batting leadoff. **Steele Walker**, who has played 17 in a row out in center, has started a team-leading 23 games in left this season.

#### Sooner Speedster...

**Kyler Murray** is the fastest Sooner on the baseball diamond and perhaps the football field as well. OU's back-up quarterback has stolen a team-leading 12 bases in 13 attempts, including 12 in a row.

#### Against the Ranked...

Since **Pete Hughes** took over the Sooners for the 2014 season, Oklahoma is 23-41-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 9-20 against top-10 teams, including three wins over top-five Texas Tech (2016-No. 5, 2017-No. 2) teams. This season marked the first time OU played a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a double-header with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State.

#### Back-to-Back-to-Back Top-25 Series Wins...

Dating back to last season, Oklahoma had won four consecutive series against ranked opponents following its Big 12-home opening series win over No. 12 Texas Tech. OU's first top-five series win since sweeping Baylor in 2012. Previously, the Sooners took two out of three from No. 17 Long Beach State on opening weekend and two of three from Baylor in the Big 12-opening series. In 2016, the Sooners took two out of three as the visiting team in the Bedlam Series against No. 12 Oklahoma State played in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. Under head coach **Pete Hughes'** direction, Oklahoma previously claimed top-25 series wins over No. 25 Texas (2015) and No. 10 Texas Tech (2015).

#### Ben There. Done That...

Senior **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off single to beat Boston College (2/26) in a come-from-behind, 5-4 Sooner victory. It marked the first walk-off win of the season for OU and the sixth overall dating back to last season. Five of the Sooners' last six walk offs have come on Sundays. Twice in 2016, Hollas came through with the walk-off knock. He launched a single to right to beat Texas (4/3/16) and hit a comebacker to the mound that was thrown away to beat West Virginia (4/22/16). On the road, Hollas added a go-ahead 10th-inning single to his résumé to beat No. 25 West Virginia (4/30/17).

#### A Stoney Shot for the Ages...

After sitting out 12 games over the course of 23 days due to a torn left UCL suffered against Buffalo (3/11), **Austin O'Brien** made his return to the diamond vs. Oral Roberts (4/4). He went 2-for-4 with a gamewinning, seventh-inning grand slam to break a 2-2 tie and put the game at its final score of 6-2. It marked his third home run of the season, 13th of his career and second career grand slam. O'Brien's first career grand slam came at Oklahoma State (4/15/14) as a freshman in the first inning of an eventual OU win in 18 innings.
