First Pitch...

The University of Oklahoma baseball team opens its season on the road for the first time since 2012 when it hits the road for Coastal Carolina's "Baseball at the Beach" in Conway and Myrtle Beach, S.C. The Sooners' four-game slate on opening weekend begins Friday, Feb. 16 against Indiana at 11 a.m. CT at TicketReturn.com Field; home of the Single-A Myrtle Beach Pelicans. Oklahoma plays twice at Coastal on Feb. 17 against South Alabama at 10 a.m. and the host Chanticleers at 2 p.m. The weekend wraps with a 1 p.m. first pitch against Virginia Tech on Feb. 18 back in Myrtle Beach.

About the Sooners...

Under first-year head coach **Skip Johnson**, Oklahoma enters 2018 off its first NCAA Regional appearance since 2013. The Sooners went 35-24 overall and 12-11, good for third place, in the Big 12 a year ago. OU returns all 59 starts on the mound from 2017, including junior right-hander **Jake Irvin** and senior right-hander **Devon Perez**. Irvin went 6-3 with a 3.53 earned run average in the Sooners' Friday night role last season. Perez stepped into the Saturday spot midway through 2017 and went 6-2 with a 3.50 ERA and was seventh in the nation with a 7.36 strikeout-to-walk ratio. Offensively, Oklahoma's lineup centers around junior outfielder **Steele Walker**. A preseason All-American, he hit .333 and slugged .541 as a sophomore. Walker hit eight home runs and drove in 51 runs.

• OU led the country with five top-25 RPI series wins and was one of 14 teams with six or more top-100 RPI series wins.

• A program-record 10 Sooners were honored All-Big 12 awards in 2017. Brylie Ware and Steele Walker were named First Team, while Renae Martinez and JB Olson earned Second Team. Six earned Honorable Mention or All-Freshman.

• Since 1962, OU is 37-19 on opening day and has not played its season opener away from home since 2008, when it visited No. 1 UCLA.

• Steele Walker was one of only two Big 12 hitters to finish in the top six in BA (.333, 6th), RBI (51, t-5th) and SLG (.541, 5th) along with Tech's co-Big 12 Player of the Year Hunter Hargrove (.344, 4th - 51, t-5th, - .535, 8th).

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

On the Air...

All four games will air locally on Sportstalk 1400 AM and 99.3 FM in Norman. OU communications director **Brendan Flynn** will handle the play-by-play from the booth throughout the weekend. Audio of the games can also be streamed at Sportstalk1400.com and on mobile via the Sportstalk page on the TuneIn application.

New Skip in Town...

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach in OU history on June 19, 2017. He spent the 2017 season as the Sooners' pitching coach and originally arrived in Norman with 24 years of collegiate coaching experience in the state of Texas. Johnson started his career as an assistant at Navarro College for one season before taking the reins of the program in 1994 and winning 450 games between then and 2006. He then took on the role of pitching coach at Texas; a position he held from 2007-16.

Scouting the Field...

Indiana and South Alabama enter 2018 in several preseason Top-25 polls. The Hoosiers peak at No. 20 by *Baseball America*, while the Jaguars top out at No. 17 by *Collegiate Baseball News*. Indiana went 34-24-2 in 2017 and finished with one win at the Lexington Regional. USA played in the Hattiesburg Regional a year ago and finished the season 40-21 after a 1-2 showing in the postseason. Coastal Carolina missed out on the 2017 postseason after winning the 2016 National Championship. The Chanticleers were 37-19-1 and won the Sun Belt regular season title. South Alabama was tabbed the preseason favorite in the Sun Belt's East Division; one spot ahead of Coastal. Virginia Tech is under the direction of first-year coach John Szefc after a 23-32 season. The Hokies were picked sixth in the ACC's Coastal Division.

Series Notes...

Overall, Oklahoma is 8-3 against its four opponents on opening weekend. The most common opponent is South Alabama, which OU holds a 4-2 advantage. The first meeting between the two schools was a 5-4 win for the Jaguars at the 1991 NCAA South Regional in Baton Rouge, La. The Sooners are 2-0 against Indiana, 1-1 vs. Virginia Tech and 1-0 vs. Coastal Carolina.

Regional Rematches...

The Sooners won the 2013 NCAA Blacksburg Regional in just three games. Oklahoma opened the tournament with a 7-3 win over Coastal Carolina. **Jon Gray** pitched a complete game with 11 strikeouts in the first match-up between the two schools. In the regional final, the Sooners defeated the host Virginia Tech, 10-4, overcoming a 2-0 deficit after the fifth inning. Oklahoma poured in four runs in the sixth and six in the ninth with a total of 13 hits; 12 of which were singles.

Back to the Palmetto State...

Oklahoma last played in the state of South Carolina in 2012 against the two-time defending National Champion Gamecocks in the NCAA Super Regionals. The Sooners lost in two by scores of 5-0 and 5-1. In the deciding game, **Jon Gray** pitched five-shutout innings with eight strikeouts before USC struck for two runs in the seven and three in the eighth against the OU bullpen.

Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 37-19 on opening day and 25-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 24-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 50-6 going back to 1962, including 34-2 at L. Dale Mitchell. In its last season opener on the road, Oklahoma lost to No. 1 UCLA in 2008. The Sooners' last win in a season opener away from home came against Texas State in 2006 in Edinburg, Texas.

Pitching Adjustments...

During Johnson's first season as Oklahoma's pitching coach, Sooner pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. Oklahoma's 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions. Sooner pitchers combined for 17 starts of six innings or more, including the first two games of the Louisville Regional started by Perez and Irvin.

On the Hill...

For the OU coaching staff, putting together a rotation and a bullpen has been a primary focus in the last five preseasons. In three of the last four seasons, the Sooners returned less than half of their innings pitched. However, this season Oklahoma returns all 59 starts on the mound from a year ago, including a five-year high 80% of innings pitched.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day 2017. He became the fourth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last six seasons and third in four seasons. Irvin also became the third consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

The Country's Top Conference...

The Big 12 rated as the number one RPI conference in 2017. Seven of the league's nine teams earned a spot in the postseason; tied with the 13-team ACC for the second most and trailing the 14-team SEC, which had eight teams selected. Oklahoma won five of eight series in the Big 12 for the third year in a row; the only Big 12 team to do so in the last three seasons. OU registered two series wins at home against national seeds Texas Tech and TCU and road series at two-seeds Baylor and West Virginia plus a series win at Kansas State.

Newcomer of the Year...

Brylie Ware was voted a Big 12 Co-Newcomer of the Year by the league's coaches as a sophomore in 2017. He went to Neosho County (Kan.) Community College in 2016 after receiving only one Division I offer (K-State). He was the first NJCAA Triple Crown Winner since 1988 and named the NJCAA Player of the Year with a .589 average, 29 home run and 122 RBI. As a Sooner, he primarily was used as the DH and also earned starts at both corner infield positions. Ware was a .298 hitter with five home runs and 31 RBI in his first season at OU. All five of his home runs came in the last 14 games. He joined **Greg Dobbs** (2001) and **Ole Sheldon** (2004) as the Sooners three Big 12 Newcomer of the Year recipients and was OU's first individual award winner since **Sheldon Neuse** was the 2014 Freshman of the Year.

Preseason All-American...

Steele Walker earned preseason All-America honors from all four major media outlets prior to opening day. He was tabbed a second team selection by Baseball America and D1Baseball.com, while being named third team by Collegiate Baseball News and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. An All-Big 12 First Team pick a year ago, Walker has previously earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America and All-Big 12 Freshman in 2016.

A Stars and Stripes Summer...

Over the summer, **Steele Walker** split his time between the Team USA Collegiate National Team and the Brewster Whitecaps of the Cape Cod Baseball League. As a part of Team USA's 24-man roster, he hit .333 and slugged .514 in 20 games. Walker was named MVP of the teams' two series wins over Chinese Taipei and Cuba. He became the first Sooner to play for Team USA since **Brian Shackelford** pitched for the Team USA CNT in 1995. Teammate **Jake Irvin** was invited to tryouts with Walker and represented Team USA in an early exhibition game and later was recalled for a start prior the team's series vs. Japan.

100 in Under 100...

Steele Walker collected two hits against Texas Tech (3/31/17) to reach 100 career hits. Doing so in his 86th career game, he tied for the eighth fastest to reach 100 hits at OU since 2003. Overall, Walker became the 14th Sooner with 100 career hits in less than 100 career games in the last 15 seasons.

Sooner Speedster...

Kyler Murray is the fastest Sooner on the baseball diamond and perhaps the football field as well. OU's back-up quarterback in 2017 stole a team-leading 12 bases in 13 attempts last season, including 12 in a row. On the gridiron, Murray played in seven games for the Big 12 Champions and made one start. He was 18-for-21 through the air with three touchdown passes and 359 passing yards. Murray added 142 yards on the ground; averaging 10.1 yards per carry.

Staff Built From Clay...

Skip Johnson's first two hires on his inaugural staff were assistant coaches **Clay Van Hook** and **Clay Overcash**. Van Hook comes to Norman after six seasons at Rice. As a player, he went to Navarro for one season before three years at Texas. Overcash returned to the coaching ranks after an 18-year career as a Midwest area scout for the Chicago White Sox. Johnson rounded out his staff with **Evan Mistich** as the team's volunteer coach. Mistich played at Oklahoma from 2011-12.

The New Class...

For the second time in the last three years, Oklahoma welcomed a top-20 recruiting class as ranked by *Baseball America*. The Sooners brought in a 15-player class consisting of 13 freshman and two junior college transfers. Oklahoma's 2017 recruiting class was slated No. 20 by *Baseball America* and also earned the No. 12 slot at *Collegiate Baseball News*.

Stephenson Commits Major Gift...

Sooner baseball alum **Robert L. "Bob" Stephenson** donated the lead gift for a planned \$10 million renovation to L. Dale Mitchell Park that was announced in May 2017. Stephenson graduated from OU in 1951 and played shortstop for head coach **Jack Baer** from 1948-50. He played one season in the majors for the St. Louis Cardinals in 1955 after a stint in the U.S. Army, which included 13 months in Japan during the Korean War. The stadium renovation's masterplan includes development of the berms, terraced seating, outdoor lounge seating, extended concourse and a second-level clubhouse, coaches office and team meeting space.

Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner nine times; all at home. Seven of those nine wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against No. 5 TCU (5/14/17) with an **Austin O'Brien** ninth-inning single to win, 10-9. It was the second consecutive walk-off win of the Horned Frogs as **Renae Martinez** blasted a three-run shot in the ninth to even the series with a 9-8 Sooner victory a day earlier.

Against the Ranked...

Since 2014, Oklahoma is 23-42-1 against teams ranked in the top-25. During that time, the Sooners are 9-21 against top-10 teams, including three wins over top-five Texas Tech (2016-No. 5, 2017-No. 2) teams. 2017 marked the first time OU played a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a doubleheader with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State. The last time OU played a ranked opponent on opening weekend in back-to-back seasons was 2004 and 2005 with games against No. 7 Arizona State and No. 12 Arizona State both in Surprise, Ariz.
