First Pitch...

The Oklahoma baseball team welcomes Holy Cross and Valparaiso to Norman for full weekend of baseball at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners take the field for their home opener Friday at 3:30 p.m. against Holy Cross. The weekend continues with a Saturday doubleheader beginning at noon and wraps Sunday vs. Valparaiso with a 2:30 p.m. first pitch.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma opened the **Skip Johnson** era with a 6-3 win over No. 20 Indiana (2/16). The Sooners are 1-3 after three straight losses, including two extra-inning walk-off defeats. Junior leadoff-hitting right fielder **Cade Harris** led the OU lineup with a .571 batting average in week one. He went 8-for-14 with four doubles and a triple to go with six walks. Junior center fielder **Steele Walker** hit .333 (6-for-18) opening weekend with two doubles and a home run. On the mound, junior RHP **Jake Irvin** gets the nod in game one. He picked up a five-inning win in the opening day start against the Hoosiers with seven strikeouts. The Sooner bullpen combined for 24 strikeouts in 22 innings of work last week with a 0.82 earned run average and .185 batting average against. Freshman lefty **Levi Prater** pitched 4.1-hitless innings in his collegiate debut with seven strikeouts. Sophomore lefty **Braidyn Fink** added four-hitless out of the pen; retiring all 11 batters faced.

On the Air...

Friday and Sunday's games will be broadcast locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM. Voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will handle the play-by-play for both games. All four games will be streamed at SoonerSports.tv and are available with a premium subscription. Audio of the games will be simulcast to the video stream and on Friday and Sunday can also be streamed at Sportstalk1400.com and on mobile via the Sportstalk page on the TuneIn application.

- The Sooners hit back-to-back home runs on opening day in back-to-back seasons. Renae Martinez and Blake Brewster accomplished the feat in 2017 before Kyle Mendenhall and Steele Walker did it last week against Indiana.

- Oklahoma defeated a ranked opponent on opening day for the second year in a row; beating No. 17 Long Beach State in 2017 and No. 20 Indiana last week.

- Cade Cavalli became the first Sooner freshman to homer on opening day since Cameron Seitzer (2009 vs. Western Illinois).

- The Sooners are 50-6 in home openers since 1962, including a 34-2 mark at L. Dale Mitchell Park. OU is seeking to win back-to-back home openers since the 2012 and 2013 seasons.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

New Skip in Town...

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach in OU history on June 19, 2017. He spent the 2017 season as the Sooners' pitching coach and originally arrived in Norman with 24 years of collegiate coaching experience in the state of Texas. Johnson started his career as an assistant at Navarro College for one season before taking the reins of the program in 1994 and winning 450 games between then and 2006. He then took on the role of pitching coach at Texas; a position he held from 2007-16.

Scouting Holy Cross...

The Crusaders come into the weekend matchup with a 1-2 record after facing the Houston on opening weekend. In the series opener, Holy Cross picked up a victory over the then No. 24 Cougars. **Thomas Russo** went 2-for-4 on the night and scored a run in the win. Holy Cross fell in the next two games, including an extra-innings loss in the finale. A staple of the Crusaders' offense, Russo, a 2017 Second Team All-Patriot League member, comes in hitting .400 with three runs scored and a .500 OBP. On the hill, the Crusaders are led by right-hander **Pat McGowan**. The junior has tossed four shutout innings and has struck out five.

Scouting Valparaiso...

A first-year member of the Missouri Valley Conference, Valparaiso squared off last weekend with Alabama in Tuscaloosa. The Crusaders were swept by the Crimson Tide and gave up double-digit run totals twice. A trio of players led the Valpo offense. Catcher **Zack Leone** leads the team in batting average at .545 and has an on-base percentage of .583. Leone is also tied with two others for the team lead in hits with six. **Blake Billinger** leads the team in slugging percentage with a .769 mark and has one home run. Billinger is tied with **Chase Dawson** for the team lead in RBI with four. Dawson comes into the matchup with the Sooners batting .462, six hits, three runs scored, and a .500 OBP.

Last Time vs. Valpo...

In the only prior match-up between the two programs, Oklahoma used a three-run bottom of the eighth to break a 9-9 tie and pick up a 12-9 win over Valparaiso in Jacksonville, Fla. on Feb. 26, 2010. The Crusaders put together a six-run top of the seventh to tie the game. In the eighth, **Ross Hubbard** knocked a pinch-hit single through the right side and plate the go-ahead run that stood as the game-winner. **Garrett Buechele** went 2-for-5 with a grand slam and **Jeremy Erben** got the win in 1.2 innings of relief, while **Ryan Duke** registered his third save as OU improved to 5-0.

Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 38-19 on opening day and 25-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 24-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 50-6 going back to 1962, including 34-2 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Pitching Adjustments...

During Johnson's first season as Oklahoma's pitching coach, Sooner pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. Oklahoma's 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions. Sooner pitchers combined for 17 starts of six innings or more, including the first two games of the Louisville Regional started by Perez and Irvin.

Up Next...

Oklahoma visits Dallas Baptist Tuesday, Feb. 27 for a 6 p.m. contest in the Sooners first of just two road games before April.

On the Hill...

For the OU coaching staff, putting together a rotation and a bullpen has been a primary focus in the last five preseasons. In three of the last four seasons, the Sooners returned less than half of their innings pitched. However, this season Oklahoma returns all 59 starts on the mound from a year ago, including a five-year high 80% of innings pitched.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day 2017 and 2018. Last year, he became the fourth sophomore to get the ball in game one in six seasons and third in four seasons. Irvin also became the third and fourth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

Winning Comparison...

In 29 games, including 23 starts, **Jake Irvin** has recorded a 13-5 record. His 13 wins are tied with **Bobby Shore** for the sixth most by a Sooner pitcher in the last 10 years. **Dillon Overton** and **Michael Rocha** won the most games over that period (2009-present). Overton won his 13th in the 35th game of his career, while Rocha's 13th win came in his 40th game as a Sooner.

The Country's Top Conference...

The Big 12 rated as the number one RPI conference in 2017. Seven of the league's nine teams earned a spot in the postseason; tied with the 13-team ACC for the second most and trailing the 14-team SEC, which had eight teams selected. Oklahoma won five of eight series in the Big 12 for the third year in a row; the only Big 12 team to do so in the last three seasons. OU registered two series wins at home against national seeds Texas Tech and TCU and road series at two-seeds Baylor and West Virginia plus a series win at Kansas State.

Newcomer of the Year...

Brylie Ware was voted a Big 12 Co-Newcomer of the Year by the league's coaches as a sophomore in 2017. He went to Neosho County (Kan.) Community College in 2016 after receiving only one Division I offer (K-State). He was the first NJCAA Triple Crown Winner since 1988 and named the NJCAA Player of the Year with a .589 average, 29 home run and 122 RBI. As a Sooner, he primarily was used as the DH and also earned starts at both corner infield positions. Ware was a .298 hitter with five home runs and 31 RBI in his first season at OU. All five of his home runs came in the last 14 games. He joined **Greg Dobbs** (2001) and **Ole Sheldon** (2004) as the Sooners three Big 12 Newcomer of the Year recipients and was OU's first individual award winner since **Sheldon Neuse** was the 2014 Freshman of the Year.

Preseason All-American...

Steele Walker earned preseason All-America honors from all four major media outlets prior to opening day. He was tabbed a second team selection by Baseball America and D1Baseball.com, while being named third team by Collegiate Baseball News and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. An All-Big 12 First Team pick a year ago, Walker has previously earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America and All-Big 12 Freshman in 2016.

A Stars and Stripes Summer...

Over the summer, **Steele Walker** split his time between the Team USA Collegiate National Team and the Brewster Whitecaps of the Cape Cod Baseball League. As a part of Team USA's 24-man roster, he hit .333 and slugged .514 in 20 games. Walker was named MVP of the teams' two series wins over Chinese Taipei and Cuba. He became the first Sooner to play for Team USA since **Brian Shackelford** pitched for the Team USA CNT in 1995. Teammate **Jake Irvin** was invited to tryouts with Walker and represented Team USA in an early exhibition game and later was recalled for a start prior the team's series vs. Japan.

100 in Under 100...

Steele Walker collected two hits against Texas Tech (3/31/17) to reach 100 career hits. Doing so in his 86th career game, he tied for the eighth fastest to reach 100 hits at OU since 2003. Overall, Walker became the 14th Sooner with 100 career hits in less than 100 career games in the last 15 seasons.

#YardWork...

The Sooners went yard four times opening weekend, including three times vs. Indiana (2/16) on opening day. Freshman first baseman **Cade Cavalli** hit the first OU home run of the season. It came on just the second pitch he saw in his college career and marked the first by a Sooner freshman on opening day since **Cameron Seitzer** (2009). **Kyle Mendenhall** and **Steele Walker** went back-to-back on opening day. Oklahoma hitters have hit back-to-back home runs in consecutive seasons. **Renae Martinez** and **Blake Brewster** accomplished the feat in 2017.

Leading Off 2018...

Cade Harris hit leadoff in all four games of the Baseball at the Beach hosted by Coastal Carolina. He reached base in his first seven plate appearances to start the season. Overall, Harris hit .571 (8-for-14) with six walks. He doubled four times, surpassing his 2017 total, and picked up the first three-hit game of his career; going 3-for-4 against Virginia Tech (2/18).

Sooner Speedster...

Kyler Murray is the fastest Sooner on the baseball diamond and perhaps the football field as well. OU's back-up quarterback in 2017 stole a team-leading 12 bases in 13 attempts last season, including 12 in a row. On the gridiron, Murray played in seven games for the Big 12 Champions and made one start. He was 18-for-21 through the air with three touchdown passes and 359 passing yards. Murray added 142 yards on the ground; averaging 10.1 yards per carry.

Staff Built From Clay...

Skip Johnson's first two hires on his inaugural staff were assistant coaches **Clay Van Hook** and **Clay Overcash**. Van Hook comes to Norman after six seasons at Rice. As a player, he went to Navarro for one season before three years at Texas. Overcash returned to the coaching ranks after an 18-year career as a Midwest area scout for the Chicago White Sox. Johnson rounded out his staff with **Evan Mistich** as the team's volunteer coach. Mistich played at Oklahoma from 2011-12.

The New Class...

For the second time in the last three years, Oklahoma welcomed a top-20 recruiting class as ranked by *Baseball America*. The Sooners brought in a 15-player class consisting of 13 freshman and two junior college transfers. Oklahoma's 2017 recruiting class was slated No. 20 by *Baseball America* and also earned the No. 12 slot at *Collegiate Baseball News*.

Stephenson Commits Major Gift...

Sooner baseball alum **Robert L. "Bob" Stephenson** donated the lead gift for a planned \$10 million renovation to L. Dale Mitchell Park that was announced in May 2017. Stephenson graduated from OU in 1951 and played shortstop for head coach **Jack Baer** from 1948-50. He played one season in the majors for the St. Louis Cardinals in 1955 after a stint in the U.S. Army, which included 13 months in Japan during the Korean War. The stadium renovation's masterplan includes development of the berms, terraced seating, outdoor lounge seating, extended concourse and a second-level clubhouse, coaches office and team meeting space.

Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner nine times; all at home. Seven of those nine wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against No. 5 TCU (5/14/17) with an **Austin O'Brien** ninth-inning single to win, 10-9. It was the second consecutive walk-off win of the Horned Frogs as **Renae Martinez** blasted a three-run shot in the ninth to even the series with a 9-8 Sooner victory a day earlier.

Against the Ranked...

Since 2014, Oklahoma is 24-43-1 against top-25 teams. During that time, the Sooners are 9-21 against top-10 teams, including three wins over top-five Texas Tech (2016-No. 5, 2017-No. 2). 2017 marked the first time OU played a ranked opponent on opening weekend since visiting No. 1 UCLA in 2008 when the Sooners split a doubleheader with the Bruins. Oklahoma took two of three from visiting No. 17 (CBN) Long Beach State. The last time OU played a ranked opponent on opening weekend in back-to-back seasons was 2004 and 2005 with games against No. 7 Arizona State and No. 12 Arizona State both in Surprise, Ariz.

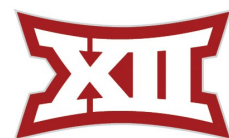
