#### First Pitch...

The Oklahoma baseball team begins a 13-game homestand by welcoming Alabama to L. Dale Mitchell Park this weekend. The Crimson and Cream take the field against the Crimson Tide for game one of the series Friday, March 2 at 6:30 p.m. The series continues Saturday at 4 p.m. and Sunday at noon.

#### About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is 4-5 on the year after a 5-2 loss at No. 24 Dallas Baptist on Tuesday night. The Sooners have started the same outfield for each of the last five games. Junior left fielder **Cade Harris** is hitting a team-high .412 with six doubles. Redshirt-sophomore **Kyler Murray** was inserted into center field last weekend and has hit two home runs in the last four games. Junior right fielder **Steele Walker** has hit third in eight of nine games and clean-up on Tuesday. He entered the season as a preseason All-American and was on the USA Baseball Golden Spikes Watch List. On the mound, the Sooners look to junior right-hander **Jake Irvin** in the Friday role. He is 2-0 with a 2.45 earned run average and coming off six-shutout innings and 11 strikeouts vs. Holy Cross (2/24).

#### On the Air...

All three games will be broadcast locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM. Veteran OU broadcaster **Chad McKee** will handle the play-by-play duties Friday before voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** jumps on the call for the final two. Former Sooners and MLB pitcher **George Frazier** will be in the booth all weekend long on color commentary. Friday's game will be streamed at SoonerSports.tv with the following games televised by Sooner Sports TV on FOX Sports Oklahoma and FOX Sports Oklahoma-Plus. Games two and three can be streamed on the FOXSportsGo mobile application. Audio of the games can also be streamed at Sportstalk1400.com and on mobile via the Sportstalk page on the TuneIn application.

#### Leading Off

• The Sooners won their 10th walk-off since the start of the 2016 season. Eight of those 10 wins have come on Sundays.

• Oklahoma defeated a ranked opponent on opening day for the second year in a row; beating No. 17 Long Beach State in 2017 and No. 20 Indiana last week.

• Cade Cavalli became the first Sooner freshman to homer on opening day since Cameron Seitzer (2009 vs. Western Illinois).

• Cade Harris ranks second in the nation with six doubles. Harris hit seven doubles in 2016 and three in 2017. He ranks seventh with two triples and 51st with 14 hits.

• OU last hosted a team from the SEC in 2012; a 4-0 win over Arkansas. The Sooners last home series against a SEC opponent was the Razorbacks in 1983.

• Sooner pitchers have combined for 10 or more strikeouts in five of nine games. The Sooners are third in the Big 12 with 9.60 strikeouts-per-nine innings.

• Steele Walker was one of only two Big 12 hitters to finish in the top six in BA (.333, 6th), RBI (51, t-5th) and SLG (.541, 5th) along with Tech's co-Big 12 Player of the Year Hunter Hargrove (.344, 4th - 51, t-5th, - .535, 8th).

### HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

### Scouting the Crimson Tide...

Alabama is 9-0 under first-year head coach **Brad Bohannon**. The Crimson Tide, which is ranked in the top-30 by the NCBWA and *Collegiate Baseball News*, swept Valparaiso opening week-end and Washington State last week. Alabama is hitting .344 as a team and averaging 10 runs per game. Left fielder **Keith Holcombe** is hitting a team-high .625 with 11 RBI. Right fielder **Chandler Taylor** has slugged a team-leading three home runs and designated hitter **Cody Henry** has driven in 13. Right-hander **Sam Finnerty** will throw game one for the Crimson Tide. He is 2-0 with a 3.86 ERA in 11.2 innings.

### Last Time They Met...

Oklahoma and Alabama met up for a single game in Oklahoma City on March 26, 2002. The Crimson Tide earned a 17-3 win on the day to run its all-time record against OU to 4-0. Future major leaguer Reggie Willits went 3-for-4 with a walk and a stolen base out of the leadoff spot for the Sooners.

### All-Time vs. the SEC...

Oklahoma holds a 26-38 record against Southeastern Conference opponents, excluding former Big 12 rivals Missouri and Texas A&M. The Sooners, most common opponent from the SEC is Arkansas, which holds a 14-11 advantage in the all-time series. OU last hosted a SEC opponent in 2012; as 4-0 win over Arkansas to run its record to 11-10 in home games vs. SEC foes. The Sooners have hosted just two series all-time against a SEC team; last welcoming to Razorbacks to L. Dale Mitchell Park for three games in 1983.

### Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner 10 times; all at home. Eight of those 10 wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against Valparaiso, 3-2 in 10 innings. Freshman **Cade Cavalli** started as the designated before pitching the top of the 10th; striking out three and leaving a runner at second. He led off the home half and scored the game-winning run from third on a sacrifice-fly by sophomore **Brandon Zaragoza**.

### Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 38-19 on opening day and 25-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 24-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 50-6 going back to 1962, including 34-2 at L. Dale Mitchell.

### New Skip in Town...

**Skip Johnson** was introduced as the 10th head coach in OU history on June 19, 2017. He spent the 2017 season as the Sooners' pitching coach and originally arrived in Norman with 24 years of collegiate coaching experience in the state of Texas. Johnson started his career as an assistant at Navarro College for one season before taking the reins of the program in 1994 and winning 450 games between then and 2006. He then took on the role of pitching coach at Texas; a position he held from 2007-16.

### Pitching Adjustments...

During Johnson's first season as Oklahoma's pitching coach, Sooner pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. Oklahoma's 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions. Sooner pitchers combined for 17 starts of six innings or more, including the first two games of the Louisville Regional started by Perez and Irvin.

## On the Hill...

For the OU coaching staff, putting together a rotation and a bullpen has been a primary focus in the last five preseasons. In three of the last four seasons, the Sooners returned less than half of their innings pitched. However, this season Oklahoma returns all 59 starts on the mound from a year ago, including a five-year high 80% of innings pitched.

## Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day 2017 and 2018. Last year, he became the fourth sophomore to get the ball in game one in six seasons and third in four seasons. Irvin also became the third and fourth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

## Winning Comparison...

In 30 games, including 24 starts, **Jake Irvin** owns a 14-5 record. His career 14 wins are tied with **Robert Tasin** for the seventh most by a Sooner pitcher to take the mound in the last 10 years. **Michael Rocha** (2008-11) won the most games over that period with 27 followed by **Dillon Overton** (2011-13) with 23. Overton won his 14th in the 44th game and 23rd start of his career, while Rocha's 14th win came in his 47th game as a Sooner.

## The Country's Top Conference...

The Big 12 rated as the number one RPI conference in 2017. Seven of the league's nine teams earned a spot in the postseason; tied with the 13-team ACC for the second most and trailing the 14-team SEC, which had eight teams selected. Oklahoma won five of eight series in the Big 12 for the third year in a row; the only Big 12 team to do so in the last three seasons. OU registered two series wins at home against national seeds Texas Tech and TCU and road series at two-seeds Baylor and West Virginia plus a series win at Kansas State.

## Newcomer of the Year...

**Brylie Ware** was voted a Big 12 Co-Newcomer of the Year by the league's coaches as a sophomore in 2017. He went to Neosho County (Kan.) Community College in 2016 after receiving only one Division I offer (K-State). He was the first NJCAA Triple Crown Winner since 1988 and named the NJCAA Player of the Year with a .589 average, 29 home run and 122 RBI. As a Sooner, he primarily was used as the DH and also earned starts at both corner infield positions. Ware was a .298 hitter with five home runs and 31 RBI in his first season at OU. All five of his home runs came in the last 14 games. He joined **Greg Dobbs** (2001) and **Ole Sheldon** (2004) as the Sooners three Big 12 Newcomer of the Year recipients and was OU's first individual award winner since **Sheldon Neuse** was the 2014 Freshman of the Year.

## Preseason All-American...

**Steele Walker** earned preseason All-America honors from all four major media outlets prior to opening day. He was tabbed a second team selection by Baseball America and D1Baseball.com, while being named third team by Collegiate Baseball News and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. An All-Big 12 First Team pick a year ago, Walker has previously earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America and All-Big 12 Freshman in 2016.

## A Stars and Stripes Summer...

Over the summer, **Steele Walker** split his time between the Team USA Collegiate National Team and the Brewster Whitecaps of the Cape Cod Baseball League. As a part of Team USA's 24-man roster, he hit .333 and slugged .514 in 20 games. Walker was named MVP of the teams' two series wins over Chinese Taipei and Cuba. He became the first Sooner to play for Team USA since **Brian Shackelford** pitched for the Team USA CNT in 1995. Teammate **Jake Irvin** was invited to tryouts with Walker and represented Team USA in an early exhibition game and later was recalled for a start prior the team's series vs. Japan.

## Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at eighth in the country with six sacrifice-flies. **Cade Harris** is the top individual as he ranks second in the nation with six doubles.

#### Sooner Home Run Notes:

• Oklahoma hit a season-high three home runs on opening day vs. Indiana (2/16).

• **Cade Cavalli** hit the first OU home run of the season. It came on just the second pitch he saw in his college career and marked the first by a Sooner freshman on opening day since **Cameron Seitzer** (2009).

• **Kyle Mendenhall** and **Steele Walker** went back-to-back on opening day. Oklahoma hitters have hit back-to-back home runs in consecutive seasons. **Renee Martinez** and **Blake Brewster** accomplished the feat in 2017.

• **Kyler Murray** hit his first career home run vs. Valparaiso (2/24) to become the second athlete at OU to hit a home run and throw a touchdown pass for the Sooners. **Cody Thomas** (2014-16) previously threw three touchdowns and hit six home runs in his career.

• **Domenic DeRenzo** and **Steele Walker** have each homered once this season and are tied as OU's active career leaders with 12 apiece.

### Leading Off 2018...

**Cade Harris** hit leadoff in all four games of the Baseball at the Beach hosted by Coastal Carolina. He reached base in his first seven plate appearances to start the season. Overall, Harris hit .571 (8-for-14) with six walks. He doubled four times, surpassing his 2017 total, and picked up the first three-hit game of his career; going 3-for-4 against Virginia Tech (2/18).

### Sooner Speedster...

**Kyler Murray** is the fastest Sooner on the baseball diamond and perhaps the football field as well. OU's back-up quarterback in 2017 stole a team-leading 12 bases in 13 attempts last season, including 12 in a row. He opened the 2018 baseball season with a stolen base in his first attempt to run his streak to 13 in a row. The Sooner record for consecutive stolen bases without getting caught is 30 by **Rick Gutierrez** (1993-94). On the gridiron, Murray played in seven games for the Big 12 Champions and made one start. He was 18-for-21 through the air with three touchdown passes and 359 passing yards. Murray added 142 yards on the ground; averaging 10.1 yards per carry.

### Staff Built From Clay...

**Skip Johnson's** first two hires on his inaugural staff were assistant coaches **Clay Van Hook** and **Clay Overcash**. Van Hook comes to Norman after six seasons at Rice. As a player, he went to Navarro for one season before three years at Texas. Overcash returned to the coaching ranks after an 18-year career as a Midwest area scout for the Chicago White Sox. Johnson rounded out his staff with **Evan Mistich** as the team's volunteer coach. Mistich played at Oklahoma from 2011-12.

### The New Class...

For the second time in the last three years, Oklahoma welcomed a top-20 recruiting class as ranked by *Baseball America*. The Sooners brought in a 15-player class consisting of 13 freshman and two junior college transfers. Oklahoma's 2017 recruiting class was slated No. 20 by *Baseball America* and also earned the No. 12 slot at *Collegiate Baseball News*.


