First Pitch...

The Oklahoma baseball team is home for a four-game series against Texas A&M Corpus Christi this weekend. The Sooners and Island open their series Friday, March 9 at 6:30 p.m. The next two days begin at 1 p.m. from L. Dale Mitchell Park with a doubleheader slated for Saturday.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is 7-6 on the year after a 15-3 win over No. 25 Dallas Baptist (3/6), which concluded a 3-2 record against ranked opponents in an eight-day stretch. Junior right-hander Jake Irvin is 2-0 in three starts, all wins for the Sooners, with a 2.00 earned run average. He has totaled 29 strikeouts in 18 innings: posting 11 strikeouts in each of the last two games. Senior second baseman Kyle Mendenhall is hitting .611 (11-for-18) over the last four games to lift his average to .367, which ranks second on the team, to go with a team-leading 15 RBI. Junior left fielder and leadoff-hitter Cade Harris is hitting a team-high .380 with 13 runs and eight doubles. Sophomore shortstop Brandon Zaragoza has hit .346 (9-for-26) over the last seven games to bring his season batting average to .267. He has scored nine runs, driven in seven and totaled three doubles. In the back end of the OU bullpen, junior RHP Austin Hansen has made a team-high eight appearances with a 1.12 ERA and 1-1 record with 11 strikeouts in eight innings. Junior RHP Connor Berry has nailed down two saves and is 0-1 with a 1.42 ERA and 7 strikeouts in 6.1 innings.

Leading Off

- The Sooners won their 11th walk-off since the start of the 2016 season. Seven of those 11 wins have come on Sundays.
- Oklahoma previously played Texas A&M Corpus Christi in 2010 and 2013 and leads the all-time series, 2-0.
- Jake Irvin ranks second in the Big 12 with a 14.50 strikeouts per nine innings average. He has struck out 11 batters in back-to-back games.
- Kyle Mendenhall is hitting .611 (11-for-18) over the last four games and his 15 RBI matches his 2016 season total; tied for the second most in a season for his career.
- Sooner pitchers have combined for 10 or more strikeouts in eight of 13 games. The Sooners are second in the Big 12 with 10.16 strikeouts-per-nine innings.
- Cade Harris, Kyler Murray and Steele Walker have occupied the outfield together from left to right in eight games this season and all but one since opening weekend.
- Brady Lindsly had six productive (hit, walk, RBI, advanced runner, reach on error) plate appearances vs. Alabama (3/3) on a 2-for-2, three-walk, sac-fly day. Over his last seven games he has been productive 67% (14-for-21) of the time.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

Scouting the Islanders...

Texas A&M Corpus Christi is off to a 10-2 start, which includes a series win over UT Arlington plus a 6-3 win vs. No. 21 Mississippi State (2/25) at the Islanders' home Kleberg Bank College Classic. Third baseman **Jackson Owens** is hitting .469 and slugging .719 in nine games played with 12 runs and nine RBI. First baseman **Harrison Dinicola** is second on the team with a .404 average and slugging a team-best .745 with eight extra-base hits, including three home runs. In the Friday night starter role, right-hander **Dustin Lacaze** is 1-0 with a 2.55 ERA and 16 strikeouts in 17.2 innings.

Last Time They Met...

The No. 14 Sooners defeated the Islanders, 4-2, at Whataburger Field in Corpus Christi on Feb. 23, 2013. **Matt Oberste** drove in two runs in the first inning. **Jon Gray** picked up his second win of the season with seven innings of one-run ball with six strikeouts. **Jacob Evans** nailed down his second save of the season with a perfect 1.1 innings of relief.

All-Time vs. A&M Corpus Christi...

Oklahoma leads the all-time series, 2-0. Both previous matchups tok place in Corpus Christi. The first contest was the Sooners' second game at the Whataburger Classic. OU defeated Texas A&M Corpus Christi, 11-2; posting eight runs in the middle three innings. **Bobby Shore** pitched seven innings of one-run ball with five strikeouts to get the win. **Garrett Buechele** went 3-for-5 with three RBI and **Cameron Seitzer** homered.

Against the Southland...

The Southland ranked 12th in conference RPI last season. The Sooners are 52-19 all-time against the teams currently in the Southland. Oklahoma's most common opponents are Lamar and Sam Houston State, which the Sooners have played 14 times apiece. OU last took on a Southland team in 2016; a series sweep to Sam Houston State in Huntsville, Texas.

Sooner Juniors...

Among the 10 classes to arrive at 0U from 2007-16, this year's junior class, which ranked No. 10 among signing classes by Perfect Game ahead of the 2016 season, ranks fourth in games won. Led by 14 victories from **Jake Irvin**, the Sooners' 2016 incoming class has totaled 37 wins in a little over two full seasons. The 2011 incoming class, which includes **Dillon Overton's** 23 wins, won 46 games over the last decade. OU's current junior class ranks third in strikeouts (482) trailing the 2011 (595) and 2007 (555) newcomers. [Each class includes all players that played a minimum of two seasons between their freshman and junior year.]

Senior Leader...

Kyle Mendenhall has the distinction of being the only four-year senior on the OU roster; a position that has been held by just one player in each of the last three seasons. **Hunter Haley** was the only four-year player in 2016 and **Austin O'Brien** the only one in 2017. Mendenhall is building on his junior campaign, which was his best offensive season through three years at OU. A .233 career hitter, he is currently hitting .367 and driven in 15 runs, tied for the second highest total of his career through just 13 games.

Up Next...

The Sooners are home twice in the midweek against Texas Southern. Game one is Tuesday, March 13 at 6:30 p.m.

Crooked Numbers...

The OU lineup was hitting just .220 following a 5-2 loss at Dallas Baptist (2/27). Since turning the calendar to March, the Sooners are hitting a collective .336 (51-for-152) and have collected 10 hits or more in three of four games. Oklahoma is 3-1 over that stretch and averaging nine runs per game, including its two largest offensive outbursts of the season, which totaled seven multirun innings. In the first 10 games of the season, the Sooners scored more than one run in an inning only 10 times.

Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the beginning of the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner 11 times; all at home. Seven of those 11 wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against Alabama (3/2), 2-1 in 11 innings. An error opened the inning and **Kyle Mendenhall** lined the game-winning single to center for his second career walk-off hit. OU's last Sunday walk-off was against Valparaiso, 3-2 in 10 innings. Freshman **Cade Cavalli** started as the designated before pitching the top of the 10th; striking out three and leaving a runner at second. He led off the home half and scored the game-winning run from third on a sacrifice-fly by sophomore **Brandon Zaragoza**.

New Skip in Town...

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach in OU history on June 19, 2017. He spent the 2017 season as the Sooners' pitching coach and originally arrived in Norman with 24 years of collegiate coaching experience in the state of Texas. Johnson started his career as an assistant at Navarro College for one season before taking the reins of the program in 1994 and winning 450 games between then and 2006. He then took on the role of pitching coach at Texas; a position he held from 2007-16.

Pitching Adjustments...

During Johnson's first season as Oklahoma's pitching coach, Sooner pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. Oklahoma's 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions. Sooner pitchers combined for 17 starts of six innings of more, including the first two games of the Louisville Regional started by Perez and Irvin.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day 2017 and 2018. Last year, he became the fourth sophomore to get the ball in game one in six seasons and third in four seasons. Irvin also became the third and fourth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

Winning Comparison...

In 31 games, including 25 starts, **Jake Irvin** owns a 14-5 record. His career 14 wins are tied with **Robert Tasin** for the seventh most by a Sooner pitcher to take the mound in the last 10 years. **Michael Rocha** (2008-11) won the most games over that period with 27 followed by **Dillon Overton** (2011-13) with 23. Overton won his 14th in the 44th game and 23rd start of his career, while Rocha's 14th win came in his 47th game as a Sooner.

Preseason All-American...

Steele Walker earned preseason All-America honors from all four major media outlets prior to opening day. He was tabbed a second team selection by Baseball America and D1Baseball.com, while being named third team by Collegiate Baseball News and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. An All-Big 12 First Team pick a year ago, Walker has previously earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America and All-Big 12 Freshman in 2016.

A Stars and Stripes Summer...

Over the summer, **Steele Walker** split his time between the Team USA Collegiate National Team and the Brewster Whitecaps of the Cape Cod Baseball League. As a part of Team USA's 24-man roster, he hit .333 and slugged .514 in 20 games. Walker was named MVP of the teams' two series wins over Chinese Taipei and Cuba. He became the first Sooner to play for Team USA since **Brian Shackelford** pitched for the Team USA CNT in 1995. Teammate **Jake Irvin** was invited to tryouts with Walker and represented Team USA in an early exhibition game and later was recalled for a start prior the team's series vs. Japan.

Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at 15th in the country with eight sacrifice-flies. **Cade Harris** is the top individual as he ranks fifth in the nation with seventh doubles.

Reynolds Stadium on Friday, April 27 at 7 p.m. The remaining two games will be played in Tulsa as scheduled. In 2019, game one will be played in Tulsa, game two in OKC and game three in Norman.

#YardWork...

Sooner Home Run Notes:

- Oklahoma hit a season-high three home runs on opening day vs. Indiana (2/16).
- **Cade Cavalli** hit the first OU home run of the season. It came on the second pitch in his college career and marked the first by a Sooner freshman on opening day since **Cameron Seitzer** (2009).
- **Kyle Mendenhall** and **Steele Walker** went back-to-back on opening day. Oklahoma hitters have hit back-to-back home runs in consecutive seasons. **Renae Martinez** and **Blake Brewster** accomplished the feat in 2017.
- **Kyler Murray** hit his first career home run vs. Valparaiso (2/24) to become the second athlete at OU to hit a home run and throw a touchdown pass for the Sooners. **Cody Thomas** (2014-16) previously threw three touchdowns and hit six home runs in his career.
- **Domenic DeRenzo** and **Steele Walker** have each homered once and are tied as OU's active career leaders with 12 apiece.

Leading Off 2018...

Cade Harris hit leadoff in all four games of the Baseball at the Beach hosted by Coastal Carolina. He reached base in his first seven plate appearances to start the season. Overall, Harris hit .571 (8-for-14) with six walks. He doubled four times, surpassing his 2017 total, and picked up the first three-hit game of his career; going 3-for-4 against Virginia Tech (2/18).

Sooner Speedster...

Kyler Murray is the fastest Sooner on the baseball diamond and perhaps the football field as well. OU's back-up quarterback in 2017 stole a team-leading 12 bases in 13 attempts last season, including 12 in a row. He opened the 2018 baseball season with a stolen base in his first attempt to run his streak to 13 in a row. The Sooner record for consecutive stolen bases without getting caught is 30 by **Rick Gutierrez** (1993-94). On the gridiron, Murray played in seven games for the Big 12 Champions and made one start. He was 18-for-21 through the air with three touchdown passes and 359 passing yards. Murray added 142 yards on the ground; averaging 10.1 yards per carry.

Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 16 players from within the state's borders and six from Texas. This season marks the most homegrown players on the roster since 2005; a roster that also had 16 players from Oklahoma. Prior to last season's roster, which featured 12 players from the Sooner State and seven from the Lone Star State, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.

The New Class...

For the second time in three years, OU welcomed a top-20 recruiting class as ranked by *Baseball America*. The Sooners brought in a 15-player class of 13 freshman and two transfers. Oklahoma's 2017 recruiting class was slated No. 20 by *Baseball America* and also earned the No. 12 slot at *Collegiate Baseball News*.
