#### First Pitch...

The Oklahoma baseball team wraps its 13-game homestand by welcoming Kennesaw State to L. Dale Mitchell Park this weekend. Game one is set for Friday, March 16 at 6:30 p.m. The series continues the following two days at 1 p.m.

#### About the Sooners...

Oklahoma has won eight of its last 10 games to improve to 12-7 overall entering the final weekend before Big 12 play begins. Junior right-handed pitcher **Jake Irvin** anchors the Sooner rotation with a 2-0 record and 3.63 earned run average. In 22.1 innings, he has struck out 29 and help opponents to a .175 average. As a team, the OU pitching staff is averaging 9.91 strikeouts-per-nine innings. Sophomore catcher/first baseman **Brady Lindsly** is hitting a team-high .409 and riding a seven-game hit streak. He has driven in 13 runs and totaled five extra-base hits. Junior left fielder and leadoff hitter **Cade Harris** is hitting .343 with a team-best .505 on-base percentage. He leads the country with 10 doubles and is third in the nation with 22 walks to go with a team-leading 24 runs scored. Senior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** is hitting .311 and is tied for the team lead in home runs with three to go with a team-high 21 RBI, including a team-best 11 of the Sooners' 47 two-out RBI.

#### On the Air...

This weekend's entire series will be broadcast by Sooner Sports TV. Game one will be a premium SoonerSports.tv feature followed by game two on FOX Sports Oklahoma and game three on FOX College Sports-Central. Former OU and MLB pitcher **George Frazier** (play-by-play) will call the games alongside former Sooner **Ross Hubbard** (color). The two televised games will also be stream on the FOXSportsGo mobile app. All three games will air locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM and will be streamed at Sportstalk1400.com and the Sportstalk page of the Tuneln app.

#### Leading Off

- Oklahoma swept a series at Kennesaw State last season; the first matc-up between the two schools. The Sooners came from behind to win each of the first two games.

- Cade Harris leads the nation with 10 doubles and ranks third with 12 walks.

- Oklahoma hit .382 (21-for-55) with tw outs over the weekend against Texas A&M Corpus Christi. The Sooners scored 19 of their 25 runs in the series with two outs and Kyler Murray led the team with six two-out RBI.

- Sooner pitchers have combined for 10 or more strikeouts in 10 of 19 games. Oklahoma is second in the Big 12 with 9.91 strikeouts-per-nine innings and third with a 2.43 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- Cade Harris, Kyler Murray and Steele Walker have occupied the outfield together from left to right in 14 games this season and all but one since opening weekend.

- Brady Lindsly had six productive (hit, walk, RBI, advanced runner, reach on error) plate appearances vs. Alabama (3/3) on a 2-for-2, three-walk, sac-fly day. Over his last 13 games he has been productive 62% (29-for-47) of the time.

#### HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

#### Scouting the Owls...

Kennesaw State is 8-10 on the season after taking a series from Sacred Heart at home last weekend and a 15-3 loss at Georgia on Tuesday evening. The Owls Friday starter, right-hander **AJ Moore**, is 1-0 with a 1.83 ERA in four starts. He has struck out 24 and help opponents to a .191 average. Second baseman **Grant Williams**, who went 6-for-13 against OU last season, has driven in a team-high 16 runs and slugged eight doubles and one home run. Left fielder **LaDonis Bryant** is hitting a team-leading .354 and stolen four bases, which is tied for the team lead.

#### 2017 vs. Kennesaw State...

Oklahoma finished its five-game, spring break trip through the Atlanta area by sweeping a series at Kennesaw State (3/17-19/17). The Sooners came from behind in game one, erasing a 2-0 deficit with a five-run sixth inning, which featured a leadoff-home run by **Ben Hollas** and a three-run jack by **Renae Martinez** that broke a 2-2 tie. In game two, OU overcame an early 6-0 deficit after the second, including a six-run sixth, on the way to a 17-9 win. Moore made the start and lasted five innings in a no-decision for the Owls. **Steele Walker** was 3-for-4 with five RBI and a grand slam in the sixth that gave OU its first lead at 8-7. Devon Perez pitched the Sooners to a 14-4 win in the Sunday finale. He struck out six in 6.1 innings; scattering nine hits. **Domenic DeRenzo** hit a two-run home run in the second and totaled three runs and three RBI on a 2-for-4 day.

#### Senior Leader...

**Kyle Mendenhall** has the distinction of being the only four-year senior on the OU roster; a position that has been held by just one player in each of the last three seasons. **Hunter Haley** was the only four-year player in 2016 and **Austin O'Brien** the only one in 2017. Mendenhall is building on his junior campaign, which was his best offensive season through three years at OU. A .232 career hitter, he is currently hitting .311 and driven in 21 runs, the highest total of his career through just 19 games.

#### Deep Threat in Center or Under Center...

Sooner quarterback and outfielder **Kyler Murray** has made the adjustment to center field in his second year on the diamond. Murray, who threw three touchdown passes in only 21 attempts in 2017, has found his knack for the long ball this spring. He is tied for the team lead with three home runs. Murray hit his third of the season vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9) for his first career grand slam. The grand slam capped a five-run seventh, that was tied 6-6 when the Sooners came to bat, and stood as the difference in an 11-7 Oklahoma victory.

#### Left to Right...

The Sooners have started **Cade Harris**, **Kyler Murray** and **Steele Walker** from left to right in the outfield in 14 games this season and all but one since opening weekend. The unit's total starts together trail the Walker-**Ben Hollas-Blake Brewster** unit's 15 from last year. In 2016, the **Hunter Haley-Walker-Alex Wise** outfield made 15 starts together. Beginning with opening day 2014 through the 2015 Big 12 Championship, Haley-**Craig Aikin-Taylor Alspaugh** patrolled the Sooner outfield together for 82 games. Walker, who has started all but two games in his entire career at OU, is the only true outfielder of the group. Harris moved to left field last season to solidify a position that had been started by six different players, including 14 starts by Murray, until Harris started the last 17 games of the season. Murray, a high school All-American middle infielder, did not play in the outfield until last season and had previously not played baseball in the spring of 2016.

## Up Next...

The Sooners play their only road game in the month of March next Tuesday at Wichita State on March 20.

## Scoring Early...

OU scored in the first inning for the eighth time in 10 games against Texas Southern (3/14). The Sooners are 8-2 when scoring in the first inning this season; outscoring opponents 16-8 in the first. However, the opposition holds a 26-23 lead on runs scored in the second and third innings combined. OU is also 910-3 on the year when pushing across the first run of the game.

## Crooked Numbers...

The OU lineup was hitting just .220 following a 5-2 loss at Dallas Baptist (2/27). Since turning the calendar to March, the Sooners are hitting a collective .323 and have collected 10 hits or more in seven of the last nine games. Oklahoma is 8-2 in March and averaging 8.1 runs per game, including its two largest offensive outbursts of the season. In the first 10 games of the season, the Sooners scored more than one run in an inning only 10 times and have since scored two or more in an inning on 21 occasions in the last nine games.

## Two-Way Player...

**Cade Cavalli** has started eight games at first base, two at third, one as the designated hitter and vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/10) got his first start on the mound. He is hitting .245 at the plate with 10 runs and eight RBI. He hit a home run on just the second pitch he saw in his career vs. Indiana (2/16). Cavalli earned his first win in relief against Valparaiso (2/25). He is the first OU player to homer and win a game in a season since All-American **Sheldon Neuse** hit 10 home runs and went 4-1 as the Sooner closer in 2016. **Jacob Evans** also won six games and hit one home run in 2015; having hit a walk-off jack as the winning pitcher vs. Kansas (4/2/15).

## Behind the Dish...

Three catchers have started four games or more for the Sooners this season. Freshman **Justin Mitchell** has started eight games, while sophomore **Brady Lindsly** has started seven and junior **Domenic DeRenzo** four. Mitchell's eight starts are already the most by a freshman since DeRenzo started 33 in 2016. OU has not had three or more catchers start four games or more since **Mac James**, **Anthony Hermelyn** and **Dylan Neal** in 2014.

## Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner 11 times; all at home. Seven of those 11 wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against Alabama (3/2), 2-1 in 11 innings. An error opened the inning and **Kyle Mendenhall** lined the game-winning single to center for his second career walk-off hit. OU's last Sunday walk-off was against Valparaiso (2/25), 3-2 in 10 innings. **Cade Cavalli** started as the DH before pitching the top of the 10th; striking out three and leaving a runner at second. He led off the home half and scored the game-winning run on a sacrifice-fly by **Brandon Zaragoza**.

## New Skip in Town...

**Skip Johnson** was introduced as the 10th head coach in OU history on June 19, 2017. He spent the 2017 season as the Sooners' pitching coach and originally arrived in Norman with 24 years of collegiate coaching experience in the state of Texas. Johnson started his career as an assistant at Navarro College for one season before taking the reins of the program in 1994 and winning 450 games between then and 2006. He then took on the role of pitching coach at Texas; a position he held from 2007-16.

## MLB Opening Day Starter...

The Milwaukee Brewers announced this week that former Sooner **Chase Anderson** (2008-09) will start opening day. This marks the third year in a row that a Sooner pitcher will start on MLB opening day. **Jon Gray** started for the Rockies in 2017 and **Garrett Richards** started for the Angels in 2016. Anderson went 12-4 with a 2.74 ERA in Milwaukee last season. As a Sooners, he owned an 8-5 record with two saves pitching in 50 games, primarily as a reliever, with 124 strikeouts in 115 career innings. Anderson, who debuted with Arizona in 2014, was a ninth round pick of the Diamondbacks in 2009.

## Winning Comparison...

In 32 games, including 26 starts, **Jake Irvin** owns a 14-5 record. His career 14 wins are tied with **Robert Tasin** for the seventh most by a Sooner pitcher to take the mound in the last 10 years. **Michael Rocha** (2008-11) won the most games over that period with 27 followed by **Dillon Overton** (2011-13) with 23. Overton won his 14th in the 44th game and 23rd start of his career, while Rocha's 14th win came in his 47th game as a Sooner.

## Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at sixth in the country with 12 sacrifice-flies. **Cade Harris** is the top individual as he leads the nation with 10 doubles and ranks third with 22 walks.

### Pitching Adjustments...

During Johnson's first season as Oklahoma's pitching coach, Sooner pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. Oklahoma's 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions. Sooner pitchers combined for 17 starts of six innings or more, including the first two games of the Louisville Regional started by Perez and Irvin.

### Preseason All-American...

**Steele Walker** earned preseason All-America honors from all four major media outlets prior to opening day. He was tabbed a second team selection by Baseball America and D1Baseball.com, while being named third team by Collegiate Baseball News and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. An All-Big 12 First Team pick a year ago, Walker has previously earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America and All-Big 12 Freshman in 2016.

### A Stars and Stripes Summer...

Over the summer, **Steele Walker** split his time between the Team USA Collegiate National Team and the Brewster Whitecaps of the Cape Cod Baseball League. As a part of Team USA's 24-man roster, he hit .333 and slugged .514 in 20 games. Walker was named MVP of the teams' two series wins over Chinese Taipei and Cuba. He became the first Sooner to play for Team USA since **Brian Shackelford** pitched for the Team USA CNT in 1995. Teammate **Jake Irvin** was invited to tryouts with Walker and represented Team USA in an early exhibition game and later was recalled for a start prior the team's series vs. Japan.

### #YardWork...

#### Sooner Home Run Notes:

- Oklahoma hit a season-high three home runs on opening day vs. Indiana (2/16).
- **Cade Cavalli** hit the first OU home run of the season. It came on the second pitch in his college career and marked the first by a Sooner freshman on opening day since **Cameron Seitzer** (2009).
- **Kyle Mendenhall** and **Steele Walker** went back-to-back on opening day. Oklahoma hitters have hit back-to-back home runs in consecutive seasons. **Renee Martinez** and **Blake Brewster** accomplished the feat in 2017.
- **Kyler Murray** hit his first career home run vs. Valparaiso (2/24) to become the second athlete at OU to hit a home run and throw a touchdown pass for the Sooners. **Cody Thomas** (2014-16) previously threw three touchdowns and hit six home runs in his career.
- **Steele Walker** has homered twice and ss OU's active career leader with 13; one ahead of **Domenic DeRenzo's** 12.
- **Kyler Murray** hit OU's first grand slam of the season vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9). It was the first Sooner grand slam since **Austin O'Brien** vs. Oral Roberts (4/4/17).

### Sooner Speedster...

**Kyler Murray** is the fastest Sooner on the baseball diamond and perhaps the football field as well. OU's back-up quarterback in 2017 stole a team-leading 12 bases in 13 attempts last season, including 12 in a row. He has stolen second on his first two attempts of 2018 to run his streak to 14 in a row. The Sooner record for consecutive stolen bases without getting caught is 30 by **Rick Gutierrez** (1993-94). On the gridiron, Murray played in seven games for the Big 12 Champions and made one start. He was 18-for-21 through the air with three touchdown passes and 359 passing yards. Murray added 142 yards on the ground; averaging 10.1 yards per carry.


