#### First Pitch... The Oklahoma baseball team plays its lone road game in the

month on Tuesday, March 20 at Wichita State. The Sooners and Shockers take the field at 6 p.m. for first pitch from Eck Stadium.

#### About the Sooners...

Oklahoma won its third series in a row to improve to 14-8 on the season. Sophomore right-hander Nathan Wiles gets the call for his fourth start of the season. He is 1-1 on the year with a 5.94 earned run average and 17 strikeouts in 16.2 innings pitched. The Sooners have five batters hitting .300 or better: led by sophomore catcher Brady Lindsly at .389. Senior second baseman Kyle Mendenhall is second on the team at .357 with a team-leading 23 RBI. Junior right fielder Steele Walker is hitting .326 with 16 RBI and 14 runs scored, while collecting a team-high 10 multi-hit games. The OU pitching staff has totaled double digit strikeouts in 12 of 22 games this season; averaging 10.0 strikeouts per nine innings, whick ranks 24th in the nation and tops in the Big 12. Offensively, the Sooners are third in the league averaging 6.0 runs per game. The OU lineup has produced double digit runs six times; scoring 12 or more runs on three occasions. Oklahoma has played just five games away from L. Dale Mitchell Park this season and is 0-2 in its only true road games of the year, while Wichita State is 9-1 in its home park.

#### On the Air...

Voice of the Sooners Toby Rowland will call the action across the Sooner Sports Network, which will air the game locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM. The game can also be streamed online at Sportstalk1400.com or on the Tuneln mobile app. Wichita State will broadcast the game on local television on COX Kansas. Shane Dennis and Denning Gerig will be on the call.

#### **HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON**

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

#### Scouting the Shockers...

Wichita State is 13-4 overall and ranked No. 26 by *Collegiate Baseball News*. The Shockers, whose Friday series opener was cancelled, split a two-game series against former Missouri Valley Conference rival Creighton in Omaha over the weekend. Wichita, which is playing its first season in the American Athletic Conference, owns quality series wins over Nebraska and UT Arlington. Third baseman **Alec Bohm** is hitting a team-high .344 with five home runs and 18 RBI. Center fielder **Greyson Jenista** is hitting .288 and matches Bohm for the team lead in homers at five to go with 14 RBI. Lefty **Alex Segal** gets the start for the Shockers on Tuesday. He sports a 5.68 ERA and has struck out 12 in 6.1 innings with no record.

#### Last Time They Met...

The Shockers came in to Norman and snapped No. 13 Oklahoma's 13-game win streak with a 4-2 decision on March 7, 2017. In a game that lasted over four hours, only six total runs were scored on 11 hits with Wichita State outhitting the Sooners, 6-4. OU pitchers totaled 18 strikeouts and WSU pitchers totaled 11. Despite leaving 13 runners on base, the Shockers took advantage of eight walks, three hit batsmen, three wild pitches and stole five bases. The key play came in the sixth as Wichita State had a 2-1 lead, the bases loaded and two down. A groundball to the right side should've ended the inning, but the call on the field was that OU lefty **Braidyn Fink** missed the bag at first attempting to get the force as two unearned runs came in to score.

#### All-Time vs. Wichita State...

Oklahoma leads the all-time series with Wichita State, 16-12, including an 8-4 win for the Sooners at the 1992 College World Series. Oklahoma had won seven straight over the Shockers prior to a 2015 meeting, where Wichita State overcame an early 6-0 deficit to earn the victory.

#### Sooner-Shocker Connection...

Wichita State's fifth-year head coach **Todd Butler** played at Oklahoma for two seasons, 1987-88. He was named an ABCA All-American in 1988 and set the Sooner record for stolen bases in a season with 46. He is tied for 14th all-time at OU with 53.

#### Senior Leader...

**Kyle Mendenhall** has the distinction of being the only four-year senior on the OU roster; a position that has been held by just one player in each of the last three seasons. **Hunter Haley** was the only four-year player in 2016 and **Austin O'Brien** the only one in 2017. Mendenhall is building on his junior campaign, which was his best offensive season through three years at OU. A .242 career hitter, he is currently hitting .357 and driven in 23 runs, the highest total of his career through just 22 games.

#### Deep Threat in Center or Under Center...

Sooner quarterback and outfielder **Kyler Murray** has made the adjustment to center field in his second year on the diamond. Murray, who threw three touchdown passes in only 21 attempts in 2017, has found his knack for the long ball this spring. He is tied for the team lead with three home runs. Murray hit his third of the season vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9) for his first career grand slam. The grand slam capped a five-run seventh, that was tied 6-6 when the Sooners came to bat, and stood as the difference in an 11-7 Oklahoma victory.

#### Up Next...

The Sooners open Big 12 play at home against West Virginia. Game on of the series is set for Friday, March 23 at 6:30 p.m. to start a seven-game homestand to finish the month.

Big 12 Newcomer of the Week

#### Left to Right...

The Sooners have started Cade Harris, Kyler Murray and Steele Walker from left to right in the outfield in 17 games this season and all but one since opening weekend. The unit's total starts together surpassed the Walker-Ben Hollas-Blake Brewster unit's 15 from last year. In 2016, the Hunter Haley-Walker-Alex Wise outfield made 15 starts together. Beginning with opening day 2014 through the 2015 Big 12 Championship, Haley-Craig Aikin-Taylor Alspaugh patrolled the Sooner outfield together for 82 games. Walker, who has started all but two games in his entire career at OU, is the only true outfielder of the group. Harris moved to left field last season to solidify a position that had been started by six different players, including 14 starts by Murray, until Harris started the last 17 games of the season. Murray, a high school All-American middle infielder, did not play in the outfield until last season and had previously not played baseball in the spring of 2016.

#### Scoring Early...

OU scored in the first inning for the eighth time in 10 games against Texas Southern (3/14). The Sooners are 8-2 when scoring in the first inning this season; outscoring opponents 16-8 in the first. However, the opposition holds a 29-23 lead on runs scored in the second and third innings combined. OU is also 11-3 on the year when pushing across the first run of the game.

#### Crooked Numbers...

The OU lineup was hitting .220 following a 5-2 loss at Dallas Baptist (2/27). Since turning the calendar to March, the Sooners are hitting .319 and have collected 10 hits or more in nine of the last 12 games. Oklahoma is 10-3 in March and averaging 7.1 runs per game, including its two largest offensive outbursts of the season. In the first 10 games of the season, the Sooners scored more than one run in an inning only 10 times and have since scored two or more in an inning on 23 occasions in the last 12 games.

#### Two-Way Player...

Cade Cavalli has started eight games at first base, two at third, one as the designated hitter and vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/10) got his first start on the mound. He is hitting .241 at the plate with 12 runs and 10 RBI. He hit a home run on just the second pitch he saw in his career vs. Indiana (2/16). Cavalli earned his first win in relief against Valparaiso (2/25). He is the first OU player to homer and win a game in a season since All-American Sheldon Neuse hit 10 home runs and went 4-1 as the Sooner closer in 2016. Jacob Evans also won six games and hit one home run in 2015; having hit a walk-off jack as the winning pitcher vs. Kansas (4/2/15).

#### Behind the Dish...

Three catchers have started four games or more for the Sooners this season. Freshman **Justin Mitchell** and sophomore **Brady Lindsly** have each started nine games and junior **Domenic DeRenzo** four. Mitchell's nine starts are already the most by a freshman since DeRenzo started 33 in 2016. OU has not had three or more catchers start four games or more since **Mac James, Anthony Hermelyn** and **Dylan Neal** in 2014.

#### Winning Comparison...

In 33 games, including 27 starts, **Jake Irvin** owns a 15-5 record. His career 15 wins passed **Robert Tasin** for the fifth most by a Sooner pitcher to take the mound in the last 10 years. **Michael Rocha** (2008-11) won the most games over that period with 27 followed by **Dillon Overton** (2011-13) with 23. Overton won his 14th in the 44th game and 23rd start of his career, while Rocha's 14th win came in his 47th game as a Sooner.

#### MLB Opening Day Starter ...

The Milwaukee Brewers announced this week that former Sooner **Chase Anderson** (2008-09) will start opening day. This marks the third year in a row that a Sooner pitcher will start on MLB opening day. **Jon Gray** started for the Rockies in 2017 and **Garrett Richards** started for the Angels in 2016. Anderson went 12-4 with a 2.74 ERA in Milwaukee last season. As a Sooners, he owned an 8-5 record with two saves pitching in 50 games, primarily as a reliever, with 124 strikeouts in 115 career innings. Anderson, who debuted with Arizona in 2014, was a ninth round pick of the Diamondbacks in 2009.

#### Chase for the 100-100 Club...

Steele Walker sits at 99 RBI and 98 runs scored in his career. He is in the hunt to become the first OU player to reach 100 in each category since **Sheldon Neuse** (2014-16). Beginning with **Jackson Williams** (2005-07), seven Sooners reached the milestone over the next seven years. Walker would be just the second to do so playing his entire career in the BBCOR era. All-time, 39 players have reached the 100-run, 100-RBI mark as a Sooner. The first to do so was **Keith Drumright** (1974-76) with 147 runs and 114 RBI. Walker's former teammates **Austin O'Brien** (2014-17) and **Hunter Haley** (2013-16) were the most recent Sooners to approach the mark. O'Brien finished his career with 98 RBI and 95 runs, while Haley finished with 99 RBI and 98 runs. Both O'Brien (UCL) and Haley (wrist) suffered major injuries as seniors.

#### Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at 10th in the country with 13 sacrifice-flies. **Cade Harris** is the top individual as he is third in the nation with 24 walks and ninth with 10 doubles. **Levi Prater's** 13 pitching appearances rank fifth.

#### Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner 11 times; all at home. Seven of those 11 wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added their latest walk-off against Alabama (3/2), 2-1 in 11 innings. An error opened the inning and **Kyle Mendenhall** lined the game-winning single to center for his second career walk-off hit. OU's last Sunday walk-off was against Valparaiso (2/25), 3-2 in 10 innings. **Cade Cavalli** started as the DH before pitching the top of the 10th; striking out three and leaving a runner at second. He led off the home half and scored the game-winning run on a sacrifice-fly by **Brandon Zaragoza**.

#### New Skip in Town...

**Skip Johnson** was introduced as the 10th head coach in OU history on June 19, 2017. He spent the 2017 season as the Sooners' pitching coach and originally arrived in Norman with 24 years of collegiate coaching experience in the state of Texas. Johnson started his career as an assistant at Navarro College for one season before taking the reins of the program in 1994 and winning 450 games between then and 2006. He then took on the role of pitching coach at Texas; a position he held from 2007-16.

#### Pitching Adjustments...

During Johnson's first season as Oklahoma's pitching coach, Sooner pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. Oklahoma's 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions. Sooner pitchers combined for 17 starts of six innings of more, including the first two games of the Louisville Regional started by Perez and Irvin.

#### Preseason All-American...

**Steele Walker** earned preseason All-America honors from all four major media outlets prior to opening day. He was tabbed a second team selection by Baseball America and D1Baseball.com, while being named third team by Collegiate Baseball News and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. An All-Big 12 First Team pick a year ago, Walker has previously earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America and All-Big 12 Freshman in 2016.

#### A Stars and Stripes Summer...

Over the summer, **Steele Walker** split his time between the Team USA Collegiate National Team and the Brewster Whitecaps of the Cape Cod Baseball League. As a part of Team USA's 24-man roster, he hit .333 and slugged .514 in 20 games. Walker was named MVP of the teams' two series wins over Chinese Taipei and Cuba. He became the first Sooner to play for Team USA since **Brian Shackelford** pitched for the Team USA CNT in 1995. Teammate **Jake Irvin** was invited to tryouts with Walker and represented Team USA in an early exhibition game and later was recalled for a start prior the team's series vs. Japan.

#### Sooner Speedster...

**Kyler Murray** is the fastest Sooner on the baseball diamond and perhaps the football field as well. OU's back-up quarterback in 2017 stole a team-leading 12 bases in 13 attempts last season, including 12 in a row. He had a string of 14 consecutive successful stolen base attempts snapped against Kennesaw State (3/17). The Sooner record for consecutive stolen bases without getting caught is 30 by **Rick Gutierrez** (1993-94). On the gridiron, Murray played in seven games for the Big 12 Champions and made one start. He was 18-for-21 through the air with three touchdown passes and 359 passing yards. Murray added 142 yards on the ground; averaging 10.1 yards per carry.

- Cade Cavalli hit the first OU home run of the season. It came on the second pitch in his college career and marked the first by a Sooner freshman on opening day since Cameron Seitzer (2009).
- **Kyle Mendenhall** and **Steele Walker** went back-to-back on opening day. Oklahoma hitters have hit back-to-back home runs in consecutive seasons. **Renae Martinez** and **Blake Brewster** accomplished the feat in 2017.
- **Kyler Murray** hit his first career home run vs. Valparaiso (2/24) to become the second athlete at OU to hit a home run and throw a touchdown pass for the Sooners. **Cody Thomas** (2014-16) previously threw three touchdowns and hit six home runs in his career.
- Steele Walker has homered twice and ss OU's active career leader with 13; one ahead of **Domenic DeRenzo's** 12.
- **Kyler Murray** hit OU's first grand slam of the season vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9). It was the first Sooner grand slam since **Austin O'Brien** vs. Oral Roberts (4/4/17).

#### Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Jake Irvin** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day 2017 and 2018. Last year, he became the fourth sophomore to get the ball in game one in six seasons and third in four seasons. Irvin also became the third and fourth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

#### Leading Off 2018...

**Cade Harris** hit leadoff in all four games of the Baseball at the Beach hosted by Coastal Carolina. He reached base in his first seven plate appearances to start the season. Overall, Harris hit .571 (8-for-14) with six walks. He doubled four times, surpassing his 2017 total, and picked up the first three-hit game of his career; going 3-for-4 against Virginia Tech (2/18).

#### Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 16 players from within the state's borders and six from Texas. This season marks the most homegrown players on the roster since 2005; a roster that also had 16 players from Oklahoma. Prior to last season's roster, which featured 12 players from the Sooner State and seven from the Lone Star State, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.

#### The New Class...

For the second time in three years, OU welcomed a top-20 recruiting class as ranked by *Baseball America*. The Sooners brought in a 15-player class of 13 freshman and two transfers. Oklahoma's 2017 recruiting class was slated No. 20 by *Baseball America* and also earned the No. 12 slot at *Collegiate Baseball News*.


