First Pitch...

A seven-game homestand closes out the month of march for the Oklahoma baseball team beginning with the Big 12 opener. The Sooners host West Virginia for a three-game series at L. Dale Mitchell Park this weekend. Game one is set for 6:30 p.m. on Friday, March 23.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma, which won its third series in a row last week, is coming off a 2-1 loss at No. 26 Wichita State on Tuesday. The Sooners are 14-9 overall entering the Big 12 season after finishing third in the conference last year. Sophomore catcher **Brady Lindsly** leads the team in hitting at .362 with 14 RBI. Senior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** has driven in a team-high 23 runs and is second on the team with a .345 average. Junior right fielder **Steele Walker** is third in hitting at .326 with 16 RBI. On the mound, OU turns to junior right-hander **Jake Irvin** as its Friday night starter for the sixth week in a row. Irvin is 3-0 with a 2.83 earned run average and 34 strikeouts in 28.2 innings of work. Sooner pitchers have combined to average a Big 12-leading 9.97 strikeouts-per-nine innings. Irvin ranks second in the league in total strikeouts and fourth in strikeouts per game. Senior RHP **Devon Perez** (2-0) gets the ball in game two and sophomore RHP **Nathan Wiles** (1-1) toes the rubber in Sunday's finale.

On the Air...

Voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will call the series across the Sooner Sports Network, which will air the game locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM. The games can also be streamed online at Sportstalk1400.com or on the TuneIn mobile app. Sooner Sports TV will broadcast all three games on the FOX Sports family of networks. Veteran OU broadcaster **Chad McKee** (play-by-play) and former Sooner **Ross Hubbard** (color analyst) will be in the booth on the TV side of the broadcast.

• Oklahoma is 10-9 all-time against West Virginia after taking two of three on the road in 2017.

• The Sooners are 10-11 in Big 12 openers. OU and WVU have never met in the first Big 12 series of the season.

• Steele Walker needs one RBI and two runs to become the 40th player in OU history with 100 career RBI and 100 career runs and the first since Sheldon Neuse (2014-16).

• Brylie Ware's career-best 20-game reached base streak is the longest by a Sooners since Ben Hollas's 29-game streak in 2017, which ended against Texas (5/24/17) at the Big 12 Championship.

• Sooner pitchers have combined for 10 or more strikeouts in 12 of 23 games. Oklahoma is first in the Big 12 with 9.97 strikeouts-per-nine innings and second with a 2.61 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

• Cade Harris, Kyler Murray and Steele Walker have occupied the outfield together from left to right in 18 games this season and all but one since opening weekend.

• OU has hit multiple home runs in a game only once this season; opening day vs. Indiana (2/16) the Sooners hit three.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

Scouting the Mountaineers...

West Virginia is 9-9 overall and coming off a series win over Canisius at home last weekend. The Mountaineers have mashed 25 home runs, including a team-high six by designated hitter **Kevin Brophy**. Shortstop **Jimmy Galusky** and second baseman **Kyle Gray** have each hit five home runs. Galusky has driven in a team-high 13 runs and stolen six bases. Leftfielder **Braden Zabransky** is hitting a team-high .405 with six stolen bases. WVU has totaled 27 steals as a team. RHP **BJ Myers** has no record in the Friday role. He sports a 5.55 ERA and has struck out 17 in 24.1 innings.

All-Time vs. West Virginia...

Oklahoma gained a one-game advantage in the all-time series vs. West Virginia, 10-9, by winning the 2017 series on the road. The Sooners lead the series, 8-7, in Big 12 conference games. The two sides met five times in 2016 as OU claimed the series, but the Mountaineers beat the Sooners twice in the Big 12 Championship. Oklahoma won the first-ever meeting on March 10, 2012 in Eugene, Ore. at the NIKE Showcase; a season before WVU joined the Big 12. No. 16 Oklahoma beat West Virginia, 6-2, behind a complete-game from **Dillon Overton**.

Last Time They Met...

The Sooners escaped Morgantown with a series win over No. 25 West Virginia last season by claiming the finale, 7-4, in 10 innings on April 30, 2017. Due to a travel curfew, it was pre-determined that no inning could start after 2:45 p.m. local time. The bottom of the ninth came to a close at 2:44 with the game tied, 4-4. OU loaded the bases with one down before **Ben Hollas** fought off a 1-2 pitch into shallow left to score the go-ahead run. **Connor Berry** retired all five batters faced in the ninth and 10th to earn the win. West Virginia won the opener, 4-2, in a game that began on Friday and finished on Saturday due to rain. Oklahoma evened the series with a 3-1 win in game two; rallying for three runs in the seventh on a bases-clearing double from **Kyle Mendenhall**.

By the Numbers: The Sooners vs. WVU...

Domenic DeRenzo: Started all three games behind the plate in 2016; went 3-for-11 with two HR and five RBI. **Thomas Hughes**: Has played all four infield positions in three games off the bench. **Jake Irvin**: Two starts of 7.2 total innings; lost vs. WVU in 2016 and a no-decision in 2017; seven strikeouts and 7.04 ERA. **Kyle Mendenhall**: Nine starts at second base; five RBI all in 2017. **Kyler Murray**: Pinch-ran in all three games last year with two stolen bases. **Devon Perez**: 5.1 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 7 SO in 2017 no-decision. **Kyle Tyler**: 5.2 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO in 2017 no-decision. **Steele Walker**: .226/.250/.323 with five runs and three doubles in eight games.

Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 10-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-3 win at Baylor (3/24/17). Oklahoma won the series over the Bears to mark the fourth series win in the first Big 12 weekend in the last five seasons. OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

Senior Leader...

Kyle Mendenhall has the distinction of being the only four-year senior on the OU roster; a position that has been held by just one player in each of the last three seasons. **Hunter Haley** was the only four-year player in 2016 and **Austin O'Brien** the only one in 2017. Mendenhall is building on his junior campaign, which was his best offensive season through three years at OU. A .242 career hitter, he is currently hitting .357 and driven in 23 runs, the highest total of his career through just 22 games.

Up Next...

The Sooners host Oklahoma State for a non-conference Bedlam tilt on Tuesday, March 27 at 6:30 p.m. OU dives back into Big 12 play, remaining at home, to play Baylor beginning Thursday, March 29.

Deep Threat in Center or Under Center...

Sooner quarterback and outfielder **Kyler Murray** has made the adjustment to center field in his second year on the diamond. Murray, who threw three touchdown passes in only 21 attempts in 2017, has found his knack for the long ball this spring. He is tied for the team lead with three home runs. Murray hit his third of the season vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9) for his first career grand slam. The grand slam capped a five-run seventh, that was tied 6-6 when the Sooners came to bat, and stood as the difference in an 11-7 Oklahoma victory.

Left to Right...

The Sooners have started **Cade Harris**, **Kyler Murray** and **Steele Walker** from left to right in the outfield in 18 games this season and all but one since opening weekend. The unit's total starts together surpassed the Walker-**Ben Hollas-Blake Brewster** unit's 15 from last year. In 2016, the **Hunter Haley-Walker-Alex Wise** outfield made 15 starts together. Beginning with opening day 2014 through the 2015 Big 12 Championship, Haley-**Craig Aikin-Taylor Alspaugh** patrolled the Sooner outfield together for 82 games. Walker, who has started all but two games in his entire career at OU, is the only true outfielder of the group. Harris moved to left field last season to solidify a position that had been started by six different players, including 14 starts by Murray, until Harris started the last 17 games of the season. Murray, a high school All-American middle infielder, did not play in the outfield until last season and had previously not played baseball in the spring of 2016.

Scoring Early...

OU scored in the first inning for the eighth time in 10 games against Texas Southern (3/14). The Sooners are 8-2 when scoring in the first inning this season; outscoring opponents 16-8 in the first. However, the opposition holds a 30-24 lead on runs scored in the second and third innings combined. OU is also 11-4 on the year when pushing across the first run of the game.

Crooked Numbers...

The OU lineup was hitting .220 following a 5-2 loss at Dallas Baptist (2/27). Since turning the calendar to March, the Sooners are hitting .306 and have collected 10 hits or more in nine of the last 13 games. Oklahoma is 10-4 in March and averaging 6.6 runs per game, including its two largest offensive outbursts of the season. In the first 10 games of the season, the Sooners scored more than one run in an inning only 10 times and have since scored two or more in an inning on 23 occasions in the last 13 games.

Two-Way Player...

Cade Cavalli has started eight games at first base, two at third, one as the designated hitter and vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/10) got his first start on the mound. He is hitting .233 at the plate with 12 runs and 10 RBI. He hit a home run on just the second pitch he saw in his career vs. Indiana (2/16). Cavalli earned his first win in relief against Valparaiso (2/25). He is the first OU player to homer and win a game in a season since All-American **Sheldon Neuse** hit 10 home runs and went 4-1 as the Sooner closer in 2016. **Jacob Evans** also won six games and hit one home run in 2015; having hit a walk-off jack as the winning pitcher vs. Kansas (4/2/15).

Chase for the 100-100 Club...

Steele Walker sits at 99 RBI and 98 runs scored in his career. He is in the hunt to become the first OU player to reach 100 in each category since **Sheldon Neuse** (2014-16). Beginning with **Jack-son Williams** (2005-07), seven Sooners reached the milestone over the next seven years. Walker would be just the second to do so playing his entire career in the BBCOR era. All-time, 39 players have reached the 100-run, 100-RBI mark as a Sooner. The first to do so was **Keith Drumright** (1974-76) with 147 runs and 114 RBI. Walker's former teammates **Austin O'Brien** (2014-17) and **Hunter Haley** (2013-16) were the most recent Sooners to approach the mark. O'Brien finished his career with 98 RBI and 95 runs, while Haley finished with 99 RBI and 98 runs. Both O'Brien (UCL) and Haley (wrist) suffered major injuries as seniors.

Double Take...

As a freshman, Steele Walker was one shy of the Sooner rookie record with 17 doubles. His six this season has pushed his career total to 39. Walker is one away from cracking that top-20 list in the OU record book, which would tie him with **Tommy Thompson** (1976-79). In the Big 12 era, he is tied with **Garrett Buechle** (2008-11 for the eighth most since 1997.

Behind the Dish...

Three catchers have started four games or more for the Sooners this season. Sophomore **Brady Lindsly** has started 10 games and freshman **Justin Mitchell** has started nine, while junior **Domenic DeRenzo** has started four. Mitchell's nine starts are already the most by a freshman since DeRenzo started 33 in 2016. OU has not had three or more catchers start four games or more since **Mac James**, **Anthony Hermelyn** and **Dylan Neal** in 2014.

Winning Comparison...

In 33 games, including 27 starts, **Jake Irvin** owns a 15-5 record. His career 15 wins passed **Robert Tasin** for the fifth most by a Sooner pitcher to take the mound in the last 10 years. **Michael Rocha** (2008-11) won the most games over that period with 27 followed by **Dillon Overton** (2011-13) with 23. Overton won his 15th in the 46th game and 24th start of his career, while Rocha's 15th win came in his 50th game as a Sooner.

MLB Opening Day Starter...

The Milwaukee Brewers announced last week that former Sooner **Chase Anderson** (2008-09) will start opening day. This marks the third year in a row that a Sooner pitcher will start on MLB opening day. **Jon Gray** started for the Rockies in 2017 and **Garrett Richards** started for the Angels in 2016. Anderson went 12-4 with a 2.74 ERA in Milwaukee last season. As a Sooner, he owned an 8-5 record with two saves pitching in 50 games, primarily as a reliever, with 124 strikeouts in 115 career innings. Anderson, who debuted with Arizona in 2014, was a ninth round pick of the Diamondbacks in 2009.

OU's last Sunday walk-off was against Valparaiso (2/25), 3-2 in 10 innings. **Cade Cavalli** started as the DH before pitching the top of the 10th; striking out three and leaving a runner at second. He led off the home half and scored the game-winning run on a sacrifice-fly by **Brandon Zaragoza**.

New Skip in Town...

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach in OU history on June 19, 2017. He spent the 2017 season as the Sooners' pitching coach and originally arrived in Norman with 24 years of collegiate coaching experience in the state of Texas. Johnson started his career as an assistant at Navarro College for one season before taking the reins of the program in 1994 and winning 450 games between then and 2006. He then took on the role of pitching coach at Texas; a position he held from 2007-16.

Pitching Adjustments...

During Johnson's first season as Oklahoma's pitching coach, Sooner pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. Oklahoma's 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions. Sooner pitchers combined for 17 starts of six innings or more, including the first two games of the Louisville Regional started by Perez and Irvin.

Preseason All-American...

Steele Walker earned preseason All-America honors from all four major media outlets prior to opening day. He was tabbed a second team selection by Baseball America and D1Baseball.com, while being named third team by Collegiate Baseball News and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. An All-Big 12 First Team pick a year ago, Walker has previously earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America and All-Big 12 Freshman in 2016.

A Stars and Stripes Summer...

Over the summer, **Steele Walker** split his time between the Team USA Collegiate National Team and the Brewster Whitecaps of the Cape Cod Baseball League. As a part of Team USA's 24-man roster, he hit .333 and slugged .514 in 20 games. Walker was named MVP of the teams' two series wins over Chinese Taipei and Cuba. He became the first Sooner to play for Team USA since **Brian Shackelford** pitched for the Team USA CNT in 1995. Teammate **Jake Irvin** was invited to tryouts with Walker and represented Team USA in an early exhibition game and later was recalled for a start prior the team's series vs. Japan.

Sooner Speedster...

Kyler Murray is the fastest Sooner on the baseball diamond and perhaps the football field as well. OU's back-up quarterback in 2017 stole a team-leading 12 bases in 13 attempts last season, including 12 in a row. He had a string of 14 consecutive successful stolen base attempts snapped against Kennesaw State (3/17). The Sooner record for consecutive stolen bases without getting caught is 30 by **Rick Gutierrez** (1993-94). On the gridiron, Murray played in seven games for the Big 12 Champions and made one start. He was 18-for-21 through the air with three touchdown passes and 359 passing yards. Murray added 142 yards on the ground; averaging 10.1 yards per carry.

#YardWork...

Sooner Home Run Notes:

- Oklahoma hit a season-high three home runs on opening day vs. Indiana (2/16).
- **Cade Cavalli** hit the first OU home run of the season. It came on the second pitch in his college career and marked the first by a Sooner freshman on opening day since **Cameron Seitzer** (2009).
- **Kyle Mendenhall** and **Steele Walker** went back-to-back on opening day. Oklahoma hitters have hit back-to-back home runs in consecutive seasons. **Renae Martinez** and **Blake Brewster** accomplished the feat in 2017.
- **Kyler Murray** hit his first career home run vs. Valparaiso (2/24) to become the second athlete at OU to hit a home run and throw a touchdown pass for the Sooners. **Cody Thomas** (2014-16) previously threw three touchdowns and hit six home runs in his career.
- **Steele Walker** has homered twice and ss OU's active career leader with 13; one ahead of **Domenic DeRenzo's** 12.
- **Kyler Murray** hit OU's first grand slam of the season vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9). It was the first Sooner grand slam since **Austin O'Brien** vs. Oral Roberts (4/4/17).
