# First Pitch... The Oklahoma baseball team hits the road for a weekend for P

the first time since opening weekend. The Sooners' third Big 12 weekend of the season sends them to Fort Worth, Texas to take on TCU. Game on is set for Friday, April 6 at 6:30 p.m.

#### About the Sooners...

Oklahoma won its fifth series in a row, swept back-to-back Big 12 series for the first time since 2006 and is 21-10 on the season and a perfect 6-0 in league play. The Sooners are coming off a 5-2 win at Oral Roberts; their first over the Golden Eagles on the road since 2013. At the top of the OU rotation, junior right-hander **Jake Irvin** is 5-0 with a 2.27 earned run average and a .165 batting average against, Sophomore catcher **Brady Lindsly** is the Sooners' top hitter at .354 with 10 doubles and 20 RBI, Junior right fielder Steele Walker is hitting .321 with three home runs, 22 runs and 21 RBI, Junior left fielder Cade Harris is hitting .308 with a team-leading 33 runs and 13 doubles to go with five stolen bases. Oklahoma's bullpen has combined for nine saves, led by junior RHP Connor Berry's five. Sooner relievers are averaging 11.18 strikeouts per nine innings as a unit. Junior righty Austin Hansen has struck out 29 in 19.1 innings across 16 appearances with a 2-2 record, 0.93 ERA and two saves.

### On the Air...

Voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will call the series across the Sooner Sports Network, which will air locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM. He is joined on the broadcast by former Sooner **Ross Hubbard** (color analyst). The games can also be streamed online at Sportstalk1400.com or on the Tuneln mobile app. Saturday's game will be televised nationally on ESPNU and can be streamed on the WatchESPN app and website. **Richard Cross** (pbp) and **Kyle Peterson** (color) will have the call. Sunday's series finale will be broadcast locally on FOX Sports Southwest.

#### Leading Off

- The Sooners lead the all-time series with TCU, 59-33, but trail the Horned Frogs, 9-6, in Big 12 games.
- OU is 6-0 in Big 12 play for the first time in the 22-year history of the league. The Sooners last started 6-0 in conference play in 1984 as a member of the Big Eight and last swept back-to-back, three-game conference-opening series in 1974.
- Chase Anderson (2008-09), Jon Gray (2012-13) and Garrett Richards (2007-09) all started on the mound on MLB opening day; the first time in history that three pitchers from the same college will hold that distinction.
- OU posted its first multi-home run game since opening day vs. Indiana (2/16), when the Sooners hit three, with two vs. Baylor (3/31).
- The Sooners are ranked for the first time since May 22, 2017 and in all five polls for the first time since May 15.
- Oklahoma leads the Big 12 in doubles (70), sacrifice-bunts (13), sacrifice-flies (11), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.91), strikeouts-per-nine-innings (9.98) and WHIP (1.23).

#### **HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON**

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

## Scouting the Horned Frogs...

TCU enters the weekend on a four-game skid. The Horned Frogs currently hold a 14-11 record overall and own a 3-3 mark in conference action. **Michael Landestoy** leads the way for the Horned Frogs' lineup batting .337 with 18 RBI. **Luken Baker** owns a .279 batting average with six home runs, 17 RBI and a .512 slugging percentage. **A.J. Balta**, an Oregon transfer, has swiped a team-high 10 bags already this season, a mark that currently ranks fifth in the Big 12. On the hill, **Jared Janczak** is 1-1 overall with a 3.07 ERA in seven starts. The righty has struck out 41 batters in a team-high 41.0 innings, while holding opponents to a .238 batting average.

#### All-Time vs. TCU...

Overall, the Sooners lead the series 59-33 vs. the Horned Frogs, who have a 9-6 advantage in league games since joining the Big 12 in 2013. Since 2012, 13 of 20 games have been decided by two runs or less, including two extra-inning games. Oklahoma hosted TCU at the 2006 Norman Regional. The Horned Frogs opened with a 6-5 win over the Sooners before OU eliminated TCU, 15-6, on the way to advancing to the Houston Super Regional.

# Last Time They Met...

In their fourth meeting of the season, Oklahoma fell to TCU, 9-4. The loss eliminated the Sooners from the Big 12 Tournament. In the regular season, the Sooners took two of three from the Horned Frogs. The series included Sooner walk-offs on consecutive days. Both walk-offs came thanks to clutch hitting by seniors, **Renae Martinez** (walk-off HR) and **Austin O'Brien** who delivered the walk-off hit to clinch the series. The series victory, marked the first time since 2013 that Sooners had won a series against the Horned Frogs.

# Spring Cleaning...

Oklahoma brought out the brooms on back-to-back weekends to start conference play with sweeps of West Virginia and Baylor. The Sooners swept back-to-back three-game conference series since beating Missouri and winning at Texas Tech in 2006. OU moved to 6-0 in the Big 12 for the first time in the 22-year history of the league and 6-0 to start conference play since an 8-0 start in 1984 in the Big Eight. The Sooners last swept back-to-back three-game series to start conference play in 1974 with Big Eight wins over Kansas and at Nebraska.

### Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2018 peaking at No. 19 in the *Baseball America* and *Collegiate Baseball News* (4/2) polls. The Sooners were last ranked No. 23 by D1Baseball.com and No. 24 by BA on May 22, 2017 entering the Big 12 Championship. Oklahoma was ranked for 11 weeks, consecutively, in 2017, including five weeks in all five polls. OU is ranked in every poll entering this week for the first time since May 15, 2017. Last season, the Sooners peaked at No. 9 by *Baseball America* (4/3/17) following a series win over No. 2 Texas Tech. Oklahoma went 22-19 as a ranked team last season.

# Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 11-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 19-6 win vs. West Virginia (3/23). Oklahoma swept the series over the Mountaineers to mark the fifth series win in the first Big 12 weekend in the last six seasons. It was the first sweep on opening weekend since welcoming TCU (2013) to the league OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. lowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

#### Big 12 Newcomer of the Week

### MLB Opening Day Starters...

Brewers RHP **Chase Anderson** (2008-09), Rockies RHP **Jon Gray** (2012-13) and Angels RHP **Garrett Richards** (2007-09) represented the Sooners as MLB opening day starters for their respective teams. The University of Oklahoma is the first college to have three alumni start at pitcher on MLB's opening day in recorded history. OU pitchers have combined for five opening day starts in the last three years, the longest in that period and tied for the most with Vanderbilt (David Price-3, Sonny Gray-2) since 2014.

#### Double Take...

As a freshman, Steele Walker was one shy of the Sooner rookie record with 17 doubles. His six this season has pushed his career total to 39. Walker is one away from cracking that top-20 list in the OU record book, which would tie him with **Tommy Thompson** (1976-79). In the Big 12 era, he is tied with **Garrett Buechele** (2008-11) for the eighth most since 1997.

### Joining the 100-100 Club...

Steele Walker surpassed 100 RBI and runs for his career against West Virginia (3/23). He became the first OU player to reach 100 in each category since **Sheldon Neuse** (2014-16). Beginning with **Jackson Williams** (2005-07), seven Sooners reached the milestone over the next seven years. Walker isjust the second to do so playing his entire career in the BBCOR era. All-time, 40 players have reached the 100-run, 100-RBI mark as a Sooner. The first to do so was **Keith Drumright** (1974-76) with 147 runs and 114 RBI. Walker's former teammates **Austin O'Brien** (2014-17) and **Hunter Haley** (2013-16) were the most recent Sooners to approach the mark. O'Brien finished his career with 98 RBI and 95 runs, while Haley finished with 99 RBI and 98 runs. Both O'Brien (UCL) and Haley (wrist) suffered major injuries as seniors.

### Big 12 Pitcher of the Week...

**Jake Irvin** was named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week (4/2) after a career-high eight innings to beat Baylor (3/29). He faced the minimum through five; erasing the first two baserunners of the night on double plays Irvin id not allow a hit until there were two gone in the sixth. He allowed two runs on two hits and two walks to go with seven strikeouts. It was the second weekly Big 12 honor of his career; previously earning the same award following an opening day win over No. 17 Long Beach State (2/17/17).

### Big 12 Player of the Week...

**Brylie Ware** earned his second career weekly honor from the Big 12 as the conference Player of the Week (3/26). He hit a teamleading .562 (9-for-16), including .500 (6-for-12) with nine RBI in a series win over West Virginia. Ware went 3-for-4 in each of the first two games of the week, including a six-RBI game vs. the Mountaineers; the most by a Sooner since **Craig Aikin's** six vs. Little Rock (3/3/15).

#### Up Next...

The Sooners host a five-game home week at L. Dale Mitchell Park beginning Tuesday, April 10 vs. Little Rock. Oklahoma then takes on Oral Roberts (4/11) before its series vs. Texas (4/13-15).

#### Senior Leader...

**Kyle Mendenhall** has the distinction of being the only four-year senior on the OU roster; a position that has been held by just one player in each of the last three seasons. **Hunter Haley** was the only four-year player in 2016 and **Austin O'Brien** the only one in 2017. Mendenhall is building on his junior campaign, which was his best offensive season through three years at OU. A .237 career hitter, he is currently hitting .305 and driven in 27 runs, the highest total of his career.

#### Deep Threat in Center or Under Center...

Sooner quarterback and outfielder **Kyler Murray** has made the adjustment to center field in his second year on the diamond. Murray, who threw three touchdown passes in only 21 attempts in 2017, has found his knack for the long ball this spring. He is tied for the team lead with three home runs. Murray hit his third of the season vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9) for his first career grand slam. The grand slam capped a five-run seventh, that was tied 6-6 when the Sooners came to bat, and stood as the difference in an 11-7 Oklahoma victory.

### Left to Right...

The Sooners have started **Cade Harris**, **Kyler Murray** and **Steele Walker** from left to right in the outfield in 25 games this season and all but two since opening weekend. The unit's total starts together surpassed the Walker-**Ben Hollas-Blake Brewster** unit's 15 from last year. Beginning with opening day 2014 through the 2015 Big 12 Championship, **Hunter Haley-Craig Aikin-Taylor Alspaugh** patrolled the Sooner outfield together for 82 games. Walker, who has started all but two games in his entire career at OU, is the only true outfielder of the group. Harris moved to left field last season to solidify a position that had been started by six different players, including 14 starts by Murray, until Harris started the last 17 games of the season. Murray, a high school All-American middle infielder, did not play in the outfield until last season and had previously not played baseball in the spring of 2016.

#### Scoring Early...

OU scored in the first inning for the 13th and 14th times this season against Baylor. The Sooners are 12-2 when scoring in the first inning this season; outscoring opponents 22-8 in the first. However, the opposition holds a narrow 38-36 lead on runs scored in the second and third innings combined. OU is also 16-4 on the year when pushing across the first run of the game.

# Two-Way Player...

**Cade Cavalli** has started eight games at first base, two at third, one as the designated hitter and vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/10) got his first start on the mound. He is hitting .250 at the plate with 17 runs and 15 RBI. He hit a home run on just the second pitch he saw in his career vs. Indiana (2/16) and later blasted his second against Baylor (3/31). Cavalli earned his first win in relief against Valparaiso (2/25). He is the first OU player to homer and win a game in a season since All-American **Sheldon Neuse** hit 10 home runs and went 4-1 as the Sooner closer in 2016. **Jacob Evans** also won six games and hit one home run in 2015; having hit a walk-off jack as the winning pitcher vs. Kansas (4/2/15).

### Behind the Dish...

Three catchers have started four games or more for the Sooners this season. **Brady Lindsly** has started 17 and **Justin Mitchell** has started nine, while **Domenic DeRenzo** has started five. Mitchell's nine are the most by a freshman since DeRenzo started 33 in 2016. OU has not had three catchers start four games since **Mac James, Anthony Hermelyn** and **Dylan Neal** in 2014.

### Winning Comparison...

In 35 games, including 29 starts, **Jake Irvin** owns a 17-5 record. His career 17 wins tied **Andrew Doyle** (2008-09) for fourth most by a Sooner to take the mound in the last 10 years; surpassing **Jacob Evans** (2013-15). **Michael Rocha** (2008-11) won the most games over that period with 27 followed by **Dillon Overton** (2011-13) with 23. Overton won his 17th in his 48th game and 26th start, while Rocha's came in his 60th game and 24th start.

# Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner 12 times; all at home. Seven of those wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added to their list of recent walk-offs this season vs. Valparaiso (2/25), Alabama (3/2) and Baylor (3/30). The latest walk-off win started with a two-out single by **Kyler Murray**, who got into scoring position by swiping second. **Brady Lindsly** then delivered Murray home with a double to the track in right-center.

### Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at sixth with 70 doubles. Individually, **Cade Harris** is in the top-10 in two categories; ranking ninth with 33 walks and 10th with 13 doubles.

# #YardWork...

## **Sooner Home Run Notes:**

- Oklahoma hit a season-high three home runs on opening day vs. Indiana (2/16).
- Cade Cavalli hit the first OU home run of the season. It came on the second pitch in his college career and marked the first by a Sooner freshman on opening day since Cameron Seitzer (2009).
- **Kyle Mendenhall** and **Steele Walker** went back-to-back on opening day. Oklahoma hitters have hit back-to-back home runs in consecutive seasons. **Renae Martinez** and **Blake Brewster** accomplished the feat in 2017.
- **Kyler Murray** hit his first career home run vs. Valparaiso (2/24) to become the second athlete at OU to hit a home run and throw a touchdown pass for the Sooners. **Cody Thomas** (2014-16) previously threw three touchdowns and hit six home runs in his career.
- Steele Walker has homered three times and is OU's active career leader with 14; two ahead of **Domenic DeRenzo's** 12.
- **Kyler Murray** hit OU's first grand slam of the season vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9). It was the first Sooner grand slam since **Austin O'Brien** vs. Oral Roberts (4/4/17).

### New Skip in Town...

**Skip Johnson** was introduced as the 10th head coach in OU history on June 19, 2017. He spent the 2017 season as the Sooners' pitching coach and originally arrived in Norman with 24 years of collegiate coaching experience in the state of Texas. Johnson started his career as an assistant at Navarro College for one season before taking the reins of the program in 1994 and winning 450 games between then and 2006. He then took on the role of pitching coach at Texas; a position he held from 2007-16.

### Pitching Adjustments...

During Johnson's first season as Oklahoma's pitching coach, Sooner pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. Oklahoma's 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions. Sooner pitchers combined for 17 starts of six innings of more, including the first two games of the Louisville Regional started by Perez and Irvin.

### Preseason All-American...

**Steele Walker** earned preseason All-America honors from all four major media outlets prior to opening day. He was tabbed a second team selection by Baseball America and D1Baseball.com, while being named third team by Collegiate Baseball News and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. An All-Big 12 First Team pick a year ago, Walker has previously earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America and All-Big 12 Freshman in 2016.

# A Stars and Stripes Summer...

Over the summer, **Steele Walker** split his time between the Team USA Collegiate National Team and the Brewster Whitecaps of the Cape Cod Baseball League. As a part of Team USA's 24-man roster, he hit .333 and slugged .514 in 20 games. Walker was named MVP of the teams' two series wins over Chinese Taipei and Cuba. He became the first Sooner to play for Team USA since **Brian Shackelford** pitched for the Team USA CNT in 1995. Teammate **Jake Irvin** was invited to tryouts with Walker and represented Team USA in an early exhibition game and later was recalled for a start prior the team's series vs. Japan.

**Last Start:** Pitched a career-high eight innings to earn his fifth win of the season in a 4-2 decision over Baylor (3/29). Faced the minimum through five; erasing the first two baserunners of the night on double plays. Did not allow a hit until two outs in the sixth. Struck out seven and walked just two in the longest outing by a Sooner since 2015.

**2018 Big 12 Opener:** Matched his then career-high with seven innings to defeat West Virginia (3/23). Allowed only one baserunner through five innings. A sixth-inning error opened the door for four unearned runs to score. Totaled nine strikeouts and went a second start in a row without issuing a walk.

No-Strikeout Night: First career start without a strikeout. Lasted 4.1 innings against Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9). Allowed five runs on four hits and five walks. Walked and hit a batter before being pulled with one out in the fifth.

Vs. Bama: Racked up 11 strikeouts for the second start in a row. Kept Alabama (3/2) scoreless through five innings before a two-out double scored a runner from first in the sixth.

Home Opener: Tossed six-scoreless vs. Holy Cross (2/24) and struck out 11; surpassing double digits for the fourth time in his career. Scattered two hits and two walks; allowing only two runners to reach scoring position.

2018 Opening Day: Won on opening day for the second year in a row. Threw 86 pitches in five innings of work with seven strikeouts to beat No. 20 Indiana (2/16). Overcame an early deficit after allowing two first-inning runs.

Summer Ball: Invited to Team USA Collegiate National Team tryouts. Pitched three-scoreless with five strikeouts in an exhibition start. Invited back to Team USA roster for exhibition start against the Futures League All-Stars (7/11/17).

**Regional Recap:** Held Louisville (6/3/17) scoreless through five against National Player of the Year Brendan McKay and allowed just one run in the first seven innings. Gave up two runs in the eighth before being relieved and took the loss in a winner's bracket contest.

14-K Night: Irvin struck out 14 batters in a six-inning start to beat Central Connecticut (3/3), 3-0. It marked the most strikeouts by a Sooner since Michael Rocha's 13 vs. Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth innings.
