First Pitch...

The Oklahoma baseball team plays its second to last home series this weekend as Texas visits L. Dale Mitchell Park for the Red River Showdown. The No. 11 Sooners host the No. 17 Longhorns for game on Friday night at 6:30 p.m.

About the Sooners...

No. 11 Oklahoma has won 11 of 13 since the opening of conference play to improve to 25-11 overall and 8-1 in the Big 12. The Sooners stand atop the conference standings and lead the league with a .305 batting average and 2.44 earned run average. Junior right fielder Steele Walker is hitting a teamhigh .338 and slugging .571 with seven doubles, eight home runs and 33 RBI. Junior third baseman Brylie Ware is second on the team at .321 with 12 doubles and 25 RBI. On the mound, junior right-handed pitcher Jake Irvin anchors the rotation from the Friday role with a 5-0 record, 2.77 ERA and 55 strikeouts in 48.2 innings. Senior RHP Devon Perez starts on Saturday with a 4-0 mark and 2.61 ERA. Oklahoma is 21-5 at home this season with sweeps over Baylor and West Virginia. The Sooners went on the road last weekend to take two from TCU and get off to their best start all-time in Big 12 play.

On the Air...

Voice of the Sooners Toby Rowland will anchor the coverage, calling games two and three locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM with Wednesday's game airing across the Sooner Sports Network. The games can also be streamed online at Sportstalk1400.com or on the Tuneln mobile app. Ed Murray will fill in on the call Friday night. Veteran OU broadcaster **Chad** McKee (pbp) and former OU and MLB pitcher George Frazier (color) will be on the call Friday night on SoonerSports.tv. The remaining games will be televised nationally; Saturday on ESPNU and Sunday on ESPN2. Clay Matvick (pbp) and Kyle Peterson (color) will be in the booth. Both televised game can be streamed via the WatchESPN app and online.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

Scouting the Longhorns...

No. 17 Texas is 22-13 overall and 9-3 in the Big 12 following a sweep of Baylor. Second baseman **Kody Clemens** is hitting a team-best .367 with nine home runs, which is tied for the league lead. He is slugging .688 and driven in 35 runs. Shortstop **David Hamilton** is tied for the Big 12 lead in stolen bases with 18 on a .260 average and .414 on-base percentage. Right-hander **Nolan Kingham**, who went just two innings last Friday vs. the Bears, sit atop the Longhorn rotation. He is 4-2 with a 4.14 ERA. As a team, Texas, which is 4-7 on the road this year, owns a 4.38 ERA.

All-Time vs. Texas...

The Longhorns leads the Sooners in the all-time series, 130-52-2. Oklahoma had won back-to-back series against Texas until falling in two of three down in Austin last April. Oklahoma had won three of the last four series and its 2013 victory was the first over Texas in 15 years. OU's 2015 and 2016 series wins were the first in back-to-back years over UT since 1997 and 1998. The two sides have met in the College World Series six time; 1972, 1973, 1974, 1975 and 1992. Oklahoma twice defeated Texas in the NCAA Central Regional in Austin to advance to the CWS and win the 1994 National Championship. Ten of the last 16 meeting between the two sides have been decided by two runs or less with the Sooners holding a 6-4 advantage in those games.

Last Time They Met...

Texas scored three runs in the first and two in the third to race out to a 5-0 lead over the three-seeded Sooners in the 2017 Big 12 Championship opener at Bricktown Ballpark in OKC. The six-seed Longhorns moved on to the winner's bracket with an 8-4 victory. **Kacy Clemens** homered twice, drove in four and was 3-for-5. **Renae Martinez** hit a solo home run for Oklahoma.

2017 OU-Texas Series...

No. 9 Oklahoma salvaged its series at Texas (4/7-9/17) with a 2-1 win in the Sunday finale. The Longhorns struck for a run in the inning, but **Nathan Wiles** got a groundball and a strikeout to strand two runners in scoring position. The Sooners tied the game in the sixth on a **Renae Martinez** RBI-single and went in front in the seventh on a RBI-double from **Ben Hollas**. Right-hander **Connor Berry** earned the win in 3.1 innings of relief as he struck out five, including the final out to leave the potential tying run on base. OU was without closer **JB Olson** and starter **Devon Perez** in last year's series due to injuries.

Crimson Over Orange in Norman...

On April 3, 2016, Oklahoma claimed its first series win over Texas at home since a sweep in 1998. OU won the game, 4-3. **Sheldon Neuse** hit his team-leading fifth home run of the season in the first inning. **Jake Elliott** matched his season-high with six strikeouts and **Ben Hollas** provided the walk-off hit, a RBI-single to right in the ninth. The Sooners won the first game of the series, 6-1, before the Longhorns evened things up with a 5-3 win on Saturday. **Chris Andritsos** pitched 7.2 innings on one-run ball in the opener and was backed by home runs from **Jack Flansburg**, **Austin O'Brien** and **Domenic DeRenzo**.

By The Numbers: The Sooners vs. UT...

Domenic DeRenzo: A .250 (4-for-16) hitter with three RBI, two doubles, a home run and one multi-hit game in four starts. **Dylan Grove:** Struck out 10 across 5.2 innings in a 5-3 loss (4/7/17). **Cade Harris:** Hitting .286 (4-for-14) in six games, including three starts, with a .412 OBP. **Jake Irvin:** No-decision in 3.2 innings with two runs, on earned, in first start back from injury (4/8/17). **Steele Walker:** Hit first home run in Austin (4/7/17) by a Sooner since Max White (5/1/11)...five RBI in seven games.

Big 12 Newcomer of the Week

OU-Texas Connection...

First-year Sooner head coach **Skip Johnson** arrived in Norman as the pitching coach for the 2017 season. He was promoted to head coach on June 19, 2017. Johnson spent the 10 prior seasons as the pitching coach at Texas under Augie Garrido. OU assistant coach **Clay Van Hook** played as an infielder at Texas from 2005-07. He then coached the 2008 season for the Longhorns as a student assistant.

Spring Cleaning...

Oklahoma brought out the brooms on back-to-back weekends to start conference play with sweeps of West Virginia and Baylor. The Sooners swept back-to-back three-game conference series for the first time since beating Missouri and winning at Texas Tech in 2006. Overall, OU moved to 8-0 in the Big 12 for the first time in the 22-year history of the league and to start conference play since 1984 in the Big Eight following two wins at TCU. The Sooners last swept back-to-back three-game series to start conference play in 1974 with Big Eight wins over Kansas and at Nebraska.

Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma, which is up to No. 11 by *CBN* (4/9), became ranked for the first time in 2018 peaking at No. 19 in the *Baseball America* and *Collegiate Baseball News* (4/2) polls. The Sooners were last ranked No. 23 by D1Baseball.com and No. 24 by BA on May 22, 2017 entering the Big 12 Championship. Oklahoma was ranked for 11 weeks, consecutively, in 2017, including five weeks in all five polls. OU is ranked in every poll for the second week in a row. Last season, the Sooners peaked at No. 9 by *Baseball America* (4/3/17) following a series win over No. 2 Texas Tech. Oklahoma went 22-19 as a ranked team last season.

Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 11-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 19-6 win vs. West Virginia (3/23). Oklahoma swept the series over the Mountaineers to mark the fifth series win in the first Big 12 weekend in the last six seasons. It was the first sweep on opening weekend since welcoming TCU (2013) to the league OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. lowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

MLB Opening Day Starters...

Brewers RHP **Chase Anderson** (2008-09), Rockies RHP **Jon Gray** (2012-13) and Angels RHP **Garrett Richards** (2007-09) represented the Sooners as MLB opening day starters for their respective teams. The University of Oklahoma is the first college to have three alumni start at pitcher on MLB's opening day in recorded history. OU pitchers have combined for five opening day starts in the last three years, the longest in that period and tied for the most with Vanderbilt (David Price-3, Sonny Gray-2) since 2014.

Double Take...

As a freshman, Steele Walker was one shy of the Sooner rookie record with 17 doubles. His seven this season has pushed his career total to 40. Walker is cracked the top-20 list in the OU record book vs. Oral Roberts (4/11), which tied him with **Tommy Thompson** (1976-79). In the Big 12 era, he passed **Garrett Buechele** (2008-11) for the eighth most since 1997.

Joining the 100-100 Club...

Steele Walker surpassed 100 RBI and runs for his career against West Virginia (3/23). He became the first OU player to reach 100 in each category since **Sheldon Neuse** (2014-16). Beginning with **Jackson Williams** (2005-07), seven Sooners reached the milestone over the next seven years. Walker is just the second to do so playing his entire career in the BBCOR era. All-time, 40 players have reached the 100-run, 100-RBI mark as a Sooner. The first to do so was **Keith Drumright** (1974-76) with 147 runs and 114 RBI. Walker's former teammates **Austin O'Brien** (2014-17) and **Hunter Haley** (2013-16) were the most recent Sooners to approach the mark. O'Brien finished his career with 98 RBI and 95 runs, while Haley finished with 99 RBI and 98 runs. Both O'Brien (UCL) and Haley (wrist) suffered major injuries as seniors.

Big 12 Pitcher of the Week...

Jake Irvin was named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week (4/2) after a career-high eight innings to beat Baylor (3/29). He faced the minimum through five; erasing the first two baserunners of the night on double plays Irvin did not allow a hit until there were two gone in the sixth. He allowed two runs on two hits and two walks to go with seven strikeouts. It was the second weekly Big 12 honor of his career; previously earning the same award following an opening day win over No. 17 Long Beach State (2/17/17).

Up Next...

The Sooners play 13 of their final 16 games away from home beginning at Texas Tech. After getting the midweek off, Oklahoma heads to Lubbock for a three-game set beginning Friday, April 20 at 6:30 p.m.

Deep Threat in Center or Under Center...

Sooner quarterback and outfielder **Kyler Murray** has made the adjustment to center field in his second year on the diamond. Murray, who threw three touchdown passes in only 21 attempts in 2017, has found his knack for the long ball this spring. He is tied for the team lead with three home runs. Murray hit his third of the season vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9) for his first career grand slam. The grand slam capped a five-run seventh, that was tied 6-6 when the Sooners came to bat, and stood as the difference in an 11-7 Oklahoma victory.

Left to Right ...

The Sooners have started **Cade Harris**, **Kyler Murray** and **Steele Walker** from left to right in the outfield in 29 games this season and all but three since opening weekend. The unit's total starts together surpassed the Walker-**Ben Hollas-Blake Brewster** unit's 15 from last year. Beginning with opening day 2014 through the 2015 Big 12 Championship, **Hunter Haley-Craig Aikin-Taylor Alspaugh** patrolled the Sooner outfield together for 82 games. Walker, who has started all but two games in his entire career at 0U, is the only true outfielder of the group. Harris moved to left field last season to solidify a position that had been started by six different players, including 14 starts by Murray, until Harris started the last 17 games of the season. Murray, a high school All-American middle infielder, did not play in the outfield until last season and had previously not played baseball in the spring of 2016.

Senior Leader...

Kyle Mendenhall has the distinction of being the only four-year senior on the OU roster; a position that has been held by just one player in each of the last three seasons. **Hunter Haley** was the only four-year player in 2016 and **Austin O'Brien** the only one in 2017. Mendenhall is building on his junior campaign, which was his best offensive season through three years at OU. A .237 career hitter, he is currently hitting .301 and driven in 30 runs, the highest total of his career.

Big 12 Player of the Week...

Brylie Ware earned his second career weekly honor from the Big 12 as the conference Player of the Week (3/26). He hit a teamleading .562 (9-for-16), including .500 (6-for-12) with nine RBI in a series win over West Virginia. Ware went 3-for-4 in each of the first two games of the week, including a six-RBI game vs. the Mountaineers; the most by a Sooner since **Craig Aikin's** six vs. Little Rock (3/3/15).

Scoring Early...

OU scored in the first inning for the 16th time this season against Oral Roberts (4/11). The Sooners are 14-2 when scoring in the first inning this season; outscoring opponents 29-9 in the first. OU took over the oppoistion for a 43-42 lead on runs scored in the second and third innings combined. OU is also 18-5 on the year when pushing across the first run of the game.

Two-Way Player...

Cade Cavalli has started 29 games in the field or at DH and vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/10) got his first start on the mound. He is hitting .238 at the plate with 20 runs and 18 RBI. He hit a home run on just the second pitch he saw in his career vs. Indiana (2/16) and later blasted his second against Baylor (3/31). Cavalli earned his first win in relief against Valparaiso (2/25). He is the first OU player to homer and win a game in a season since All-American Sheldon Neuse hit 10 home runs and went 4-1 as the Sooner closer in 2016. Jacob Evans also won six games and hit one home run in 2015; having hit a walk-off jack as the winning pitcher vs. Kansas (4/2/15).

Behind the Dish...

Three catchers have started four games or more for the Sooners this season. **Brady Lindsly** has started 20 and **Justin Mitchell** has started nine, while **Domenic DeRenzo** has started five. Mitchell's nine are the most by a freshman since DeRenzo started 33 in 2016. OU has not had three catchers start four games since **Mac James, Anthony Hermelyn** and **Dylan Neal** in 2014.

Winning Comparison...

In 36 games, including 30 starts, **Jake Irvin** owns a 17-5 record. His career 17 wins, the last of which came in his 29th start, tied **Andrew Doyle** (2008-09) for fourth most by a Sooner to take the mound in the last 10 years; surpassing **Jacob Evans** (2013-15). **Michael Rocha** (2008-11) won the most games over that period with 27 followed by **Dillon Overton** (2011-13) with 23. Overton won his 17th in his 48th game and 26th start, while Rocha's came in his 60th game and 24th start.

Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner 12 times; all at home. Seven of those wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added to their list of recent walk-offs this season vs. Valparaiso (2/25), Alabama (3/2) and Baylor (3/30). The latest walk-off win started with a two-out single by **Kyler Murray**, who got into scoring position by swiping second. **Brady Lindsly** then delivered Murray home with a double to the track in right-center.

2018 Big 12 Opener: Matched his then career-high with seven innings to defeat West Virginia (3/23). Allowed only one baserunner through five innings. A sixth-inning error opened the door for four unearned runs to score. Totaled nine strikeouts and went a second start in a row without issuing a walk.

No-Strikeout Night: First career start without a strikeout. Lasted 4.1 innings against Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9). Allowed five runs on four hits and five walks. Walked and hit a batter before being pulled with one out in the fifth.

Vs. Bama: Racked up 11 strikeouts for the second start in a row. Kept Alabama (3/2) scoreless through five innings before a two-out double scored a runner from first in the sixth.

Home Opener: Tossed six-scoreless vs. Holy Cross (2/24) and struck out 11; surpassing double digits for the fourth time in his career. Scattered two hits and two walks; allowing only two runners to reach scoring position.

2018 Opening Day: Won on opening day for the second year in a row. Threw 86 pitches in five innings of work with seven strikeouts to beat No. 20 Indiana (2/16). Overcame an early deficit after allowing two first-inning runs.

Summer Ball: Invited to Team USA Collegiate National Team tryouts. Pitched three-scoreless with five strikeouts in an exhibition start. Invited back to Team USA roster for exhibition start against the Futures League All-Stars (7/11/17).

Regional Recap: Held Louisville (6/3/17) scoreless through five against National Player of the Year Brendan McKay and allowed just one run in the first seven innings. Gave up two runs in the eighth before being relieved and took the loss in a winner's bracket contest.

14-K Night: Irvin struck out 14 batters in a six-inning start to beat Central Connecticut (3/3), 3-0. It marked the most strikeouts by a Sooner since Michael Rocha's 13 vs. Texas A&M in 2011. Opening Day 2017: Irvin started opening day for the Sooners and tossed seven-scoreless innings of one hit ball to beat Long Beach State (2/17). He matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts and did not allow a walk on the way to being named the Big 12 Pitcher of the Week.
