#### First Pitch...

The Oklahoma baseball team gets back on the road to visit Texas Tech for a weekend series beginning Friday, April 20 at 6:30 p.m. in Lubbock. The No. 14 Sooners play the No. 4 Red Raiders at Rip Griffin Mark in their second top-25 match-up in as many weeks.

#### About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is tied for first in the Big 12 with Oklahoma State at 9-3; a game ahead of 8-4 Texas Tech. The Sooners are 26-13 overall after their first series loss of the season to No. 17 Texas at home last weekend. Junior right fielder **Steele Walker** is hitting a team-high .338 and slugging .572 with nine home runs and 37 RBI. He has homered seven times in the last 10 games and became the first OU player since 2012 to go yard three games in a row; capped by a long ball against Texas (4/13). Sophomore catcher **Brady Lindsly** is second with a .333 average, 10 doubles and 21 RBI. Junior third baseman **Brylie Ware** is hitting .331 with 13 doubles and 29 RBI. Lindsly posted two three-hit games against the Longhorns and Ware totaled five hits and four RBI in the series. Junior right-handed pitcher **Jake Irvin** anchors the Sooner rotation with a 5-0 record out of the Friday night role. He owns a 2.96 earned run average, .190 batting average against and 10.04 strikeouts per nine innings.

#### On the Air...

Voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will call the series across the Sooner Sports Network and locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM. Former Sooner **Ross Hubbard** (color) joins Rowland in the broadcast booth. The games can also be streamed online at Sportstalk1400.com or on the TuneIn mobile app. Texas Tech will televise the games to FSSW+ and FSSW (Saturday). **Robert Giovannetti** (pbp) and **Mike Gustafson** (color) will call the game from the TV side.

#### Leading Off

- Oklahoma last won in Lubbock on March 25, 2012 to claim the series. The Sooners have lost six in a row on the road to the Red Raiders, but are 9-3 in games played in Oklahoma over that stretch.
- Steele Walker hit his ninth home run of the season vs. Texas (4/13) to mark a career-high and push his career total to 20.
- The Sooners won both of their road, Big 12 series against ranked opponents in 2017; at No. 25 West Virginia and No. 14 Baylor. OU's last series win at a top-10 Big 12 opponent was a sweep of No. 9 Baylor (2009).
- Kyle Mendenhall is a career .407 hitter against Texas Tech, including his first three-hit game as a freshman.
- OU matched its 2017 season total with its fourth shutout of the season vs. Texas (4/15). The Sooners have not recorded more than four shutouts in a season since seven in 2013.
- Cade Harris' 24-game reached base streak matches Brylie Ware's got the longest this season and as the longest by a Sooner since Ben Hollas reached safely in 29 straight in 2017.

#### HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

#### Scouting the Red Raiders...

Texas Tech enters the weekend series on a four-game winning streak, in which they have outscored their opponents, 76-25. Overall, the Red Raiders are 30-8 and 8-4 in conference action plus 19-1 at home. Left fielder **Grant Little** has a team-high .410 batting average, .729 slugging percentage, .508 on-base percentage and eight home runs. Third baseman **Josh Jung** enters the weekend hitting .403 with seven home runs and 52 RBI. On the mound for Tech, right-hander **Davis Martin** leads the way with a 6-2 record, 2.35 ERA and has struck out 56. RHP **Caleb Kilian** who has a 5-1 record, 1.27 ERA in 35.1 innings.

#### All-Time vs. Texas Tech...

Oklahoma leads the all-time series with Texas Tech, 47-36-1, including a 33-30-1 mark in Big 12 regular season games. Prior to the formation of the Big 12 in 1997, the two teams faced off nine times beginning in 1976 as OU led the series, 6-3.

#### Last Time They Met...

The No. 15 Sooners walked-off a 5-4 winner against No. 2 Texas Tech behind a ninth-inning home run from second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall**. Closer **JB Olson** tossed three-shutout innings in relief and earned the win. The victory clinched the series vs. the Red Raiders and marked the first time, prior to this season, since 2014 that the Sooners had won their first two Big 12 series. **Dylan Grove** struck out 11 in six innings as OU won the opener, 6-2. Lefty **Steven Gingery** pitched Tech to a series-evening, 9-4 win in game two with 10 strikeouts as the Red Raiders took advantage of five Oklahoma errors.

#### By The Numbers: The Sooners vs. Tech...

**Dylan Grove:** Two wins, 3.46 ERA, 11.77 K/9 in two starts... seven-inning complete game to eliminate TTU (5/27/16) at 2016 Big 12 Championship... struck out a career-high 11 (3/31/17). **Jake Irvin:** Struck out the side on 13 pitches in a perfect inning of relief in his only career appearance vs. TTU (3/26/16). **Ryan Madden:** 3.00 ERA, nine innings in two relief appearances. **Kyle Mendenhall:** Career .407/.448/.593 hitter in eight games, all starts... two three-hit games (3/21/15 and 3/26/16)... walk-off home run (4/2/17). **Steele Walker:** Career .407/.467/.481 hitter in seven games... hits in all seven games with four multi-hit games.

#### OU-TTU Connection...

First-year Sooner head coach **Skip Johnson** and Texas Tech head coach **Tim Tadlock** grew up playing youth baseball together in Denton, Texas. Prior to returning to his alma mater on the coaching staff in 2012, Tadlock was an assistant coach at OU from 2006-11.

#### Spring Cleaning...

Oklahoma brought out the brooms on back-to-back weekends to start conference play with sweeps of West Virginia and Baylor. The Sooners swept back-to-back three-game conference series for the first time since beating Missouri and winning at Texas Tech in 2006. Overall, OU moved to 8-0 in the Big 12 for the first time in the 22-year history of the league and to start conference play since 1984 in the Big Eight following two wins at TCU. The Sooners last swept back-to-back three-game series to start conference play in 1974 with Big Eight wins over Kansas and at Nebraska.

#### Up Next...

The Sooners visit UT-Arlington for its final schedule midweek game of the season on Tuesday, April 24. Oklahoma then takes on Oklahoma State in the Bedlam Series that will be played in Stillwater (4/27) and Tulsa (4/28-29).

## Turn Down the Horns...

Oklahoma salvaged its series with Texas (4/15) behind sophomore right-hander **Nathan Wiles'** 7.2-scoreless innings. The Sooners' 6-0 win marked their first shutout of the Longhorns since March 16, 1957. Wiles was named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week (4/16) after scattering five hits and issuing just one walk, which came in his final inning of work. He did not allow a runner to reach third and saw only four runners in scoring position; all with two outs.

## Power Surge...

Oklahoma went 30 games between multi-home run games having gone yard three times opening day vs. Indiana (2/16) and **Kyler Murray's** two long balls at TCU (4/6). The Sooners then homered in six consecutive games; marking the first stretch of five or more games since 2010 and the first in the BBCOR (2011-present) era. **Steele Walker** hit two vs. TCU (4/8) and Little Rock (4/10) as the Sooners matched their season-high with three. Oklahoma added two more vs. Oral Roberts (4/11) and another Walker home run vs. Texas (4/13). The last 10 OU home runs have been hit by four OU outfielders.

## Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma, which was up to No. 11 by *CBN* (4/9), became ranked for the first time in 2018 peaking at No. 19 in the *Baseball America* and *Collegiate Baseball News* (4/2) polls. The Sooners were last ranked No. 23 by D1Baseball.com and No. 24 by BA on May 22, 2017 entering the Big 12 Championship. Oklahoma was ranked for 11 weeks, consecutively, in 2017, including five weeks in all five polls. OU is ranked in every poll for the second week in a row. Last season, the Sooners peaked at No. 9 by *Baseball America* (4/3/17) following a series win over No. 2 Texas Tech. Oklahoma went 22-19 as a ranked team last season.

## Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 11-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 19-6 win vs. West Virginia (3/23). Oklahoma swept the series over the Mountaineers to mark the fifth series win in the first Big 12 weekend in the last six seasons. It was the first sweep on opening weekend since welcoming TCU (2013) to the league OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

## MLB Opening Day Starters...

Brewers RHP **Chase Anderson** (2008-09), Rockies RHP **Jon Gray** (2012-13) and Angels RHP **Garrett Richards** (2007-09) represented the Sooners as MLB opening day starters for their respective teams. The University of Oklahoma is the first college to have three alumni start at pitcher on MLB's opening day in record-ed history. OU pitchers have combined for five opening day starts in the last three years, the longest in that period and tied for the most with Vanderbilt (David Price-3, Sonny Gray-2) since 2014.

## Free Bases...

**Cade Harris** drew the 100th base on balls on his career vs. Texas (4/15) to become the 14th player in program history to reach that mark, the first since **Casey Bookout** (1996-99) and tie **Baine Brooks** (1986-87) for 13th all-time.

## Double Take...

As a freshman, Steele Walker was one shy of the Sooner rookie record with 17 doubles. His seven this season has pushed his career total to 40. Walker cracked the top-20 list in the OU record book vs. Oral Roberts (4/11), which tied him with **Tommy Thompson** (1976-79). In the Big 12 era, he passed **Garrett Buechele** (2008-11) for the eighth most since 1997.

## Joining the 100-100 Club...

**Steele Walker** surpassed 100 RBI and runs for his career against West Virginia (3/23). He became the first OU player to reach 100 in each category since **Sheldon Neuse** (2014-16). Beginning with **Jackson Williams** (2005-07), seven Sooners reached the milestone over the next seven years. Walker is just the second to do so playing his entire career in the BBCOR era. All-time, 40 players have reached the 100-run, 100-RBI mark as a Sooner. The first to do so was **Keith Drumright** (1974-76) with 147 runs and 114 RBI. Walker's former teammates **Austin O'Brien** (2014-17) and **Hunter Haley** (2013-16) were the most recent Sooners to approach the mark. O'Brien finished his career with 98 RBI and 95 runs, while Haley finished with 99 RBI and 98 runs. Both O'Brien (JCL) and Haley (wrist) suffered major injuries as seniors.

## Big 12 Pitcher of the Week...

**Jake Irvin** was named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week (4/2) after a career-high eight innings to beat Baylor (3/29). He faced the minimum through five; erasing the first two baserunners of the night on double plays Irvin did not allow a hit until there were two gone in the sixth. He allowed two runs on two hits and two walks to go with seven strikeouts. It was the second weekly Big 12 honor of his career; previously earning the same award following an opening day win over No. 17 Long Beach State (2/17/17).

## Deep Threat in Center or Under Center...

Sooner quarterback and outfielder **Kyler Murray** has made the adjustment to center field in his second year on the diamond. Murray, who threw three touchdown passes in only 21 attempts in 2017, has found his knack for the long ball this spring. He is tied for the team lead with three home runs. Murray hit his third of the season vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9) for his first career grand slam. The grand slam capped a five-run seventh, that was tied 6-6 when the Sooners came to bat, and stood as the difference in an 11-7 Oklahoma victory.

## Left to Right...

The Sooners have started **Cade Harris**, **Kyler Murray** and **Steele Walker** from left to right in the outfield in 32 games this season and all but three since opening weekend. The unit's total starts together surpassed the Walker-**Ben Hollas-Blake Brewster** unit's 15 from last year. Beginning with opening day 2014 through the 2015 Big 12 Championship, **Hunter Haley-Craig Aikin-Taylor Alspaugh** patrolled the Sooner outfield together for 82 games. Walker, who has started all but two games in his entire career at OU, is the only true outfielder of the group. Harris moved to left field last season to solidify a position that had been started by six different players, including 14 starts by Murray, until Harris started the last 17 games of the season. Murray, a high school All-American middle infielder, did not play in the outfield until last season and had previously not played baseball in the spring of 2016.

## Senior Leader...

**Kyle Mendenhall** has the distinction of being the only four-year senior on the OU roster; a position that has been held by just one player in each of the last three seasons. **Hunter Haley** was the only four-year player in 2016 and **Austin O'Brien** the only one in 2017. Mendenhall is building on his junior campaign, which was his best offensive season through three years at OU. A .246 career hitter, he is currently hitting .321 and driven in 31 runs, the highest total of his career.

## Big 12 Player of the Week...

**Brylie Ware** earned his second career weekly honor from the Big 12 as the conference Player of the Week (3/26). He hit a team-leading .562 (9-for-16), including .500 (6-for-12) with nine RBI in a series win over West Virginia. Ware went 3-for-4 in each of the first two games of the week, including a six-RBI game vs. the Mountaineers; the most by a Sooner since **Craig Aikin's** six vs. Little Rock (3/3/15).

## Scoring Early...

OU scored in the first inning for the 17th time this season against Texas (4/14). The Sooners are 14-3 when scoring in the first inning this season; outscoring opponents 32-9 in the first. OU took over the opposition for a 44-43 lead on runs scored in the second and third innings combined. OU is also 19-6 on the year when pushing across the first run of the game.

## Two-Way Player...

**Cade Cavalli** has started 29 games in the field or at DH and vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/10) got his first start on the mound. He is hitting .250 at the plate with 21 runs and 20 RBI. He hit a home run on just the second pitch he saw in his career vs. Indiana (2/16) and later blasted his second against Baylor (3/31). Cavalli earned his first win in relief against Valparaiso (2/25). He is the first OU player to homer and win a game in a season since All-American **Sheldon Neuse** hit 10 home runs and went 4-1 as the Sooner closer in 2016. **Jacob Evans** also won six games and hit one home run in 2015; having hit a walk-off jack as the winning pitcher vs. Kansas (4/2/15).

## Behind the Dish...

Three catchers have started four games or more for the Sooners this season. **Brady Lindsly** has started 24 and **Justin Mitchell** has started 10, while **Domenic DeRenzo** has started five. Mitchell's nine are the most by a freshman since DeRenzo started 33 in 2016. OU has not had three catchers start four games since **Mac James**, **Anthony Hermelyn** and **Dylan Neal** in 2014.

## Winning Comparison...

In 37 games, including 31 starts, **Jake Irvin** owns a 17-5 record. His career 17 wins, the last of which came in his 29th start, tied **Andrew Doyle** (2008-09) for fourth most by a Sooner to take the mound in the last 10 years; surpassing **Jacob Evans** (2013-15). **Michael Rocha** (2008-11) won the most games over that period with 27 followed by **Dillon Overton** (2011-13) with 23. Overton won his 17th in his 48th game and 26th start, while Rocha's came in his 60th game and 24th start.

## Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner 12 times; all at home. Seven of those wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added to their list of recent walk-offs this season vs. Valparaiso (2/25), Alabama (3/2) and Baylor (3/30). The latest walk-off win started with a two-out single by **Kyler Murray**, who got into scoring position by swiping second. **Brady Lindsly** then delivered Murray home with a double to the track in right-center.

**No-Strikeout Night:** First career start without a strikeout. Lasted 4.1 innings against Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9). Allowed five runs on four hits and five walks. Walked and hit a batter before being pulled with one out in the fifth.

**Vs. Bama:** Racked up 11 strikeouts for the second start in a row. Kept Alabama (3/2) scoreless through five innings before a two-out double scored a runner from first in the sixth.

**Home Opener:** Tossed six-scoreless vs. Holy Cross (2/24) and struck out 11; surpassing double digits for the fourth time in his career. Scattered two hits and two walks; allowing only two runners to reach scoring position.

**2018 Opening Day:** Won on opening day for the second year in a row. Threw 86 pitches in five innings of work with seven strikeouts to beat No. 20 Indiana (2/16). Overcame an early deficit after allowing two first-inning runs.

**Summer Ball:** Invited to Team USA Collegiate National Team tryouts. Pitched three-scoreless with five strikeouts in an exhibition start. Invited back to Team USA roster for exhibition start against the Futures League All-Stars (7/11/17).

**Regional Recap:** Held Louisville (6/3/17) scoreless through five against National Player of the Year Brendan McKay and allowed just one run in the first seven innings. Gave up two runs in the eighth before being relieved and took the loss in a winner's bracket contest.

**14-K Night:** Irvin struck out 14 batters in a six-inning start to beat Central Connecticut (3/3), 3-0. It marked the most strikeouts by a Sooner since Michael Rocha's 13 vs. Texas A&M in 2011.
