First Pitch...

The Oklahoma baseball team takes on Oklahoma State in the 2018 Bedlam Series beginning Friday, April 27 at 7 p.m. in Stillwater. The series continues over the weekend at Tulsa's ONEOK Field.

About the Sooners...

No. 18 Oklahoma is 28-15 overall after an 11-5 win at UT Arlington on Tuesday night and third place in the Big 12 with a 10-5 record. The Sooners are hitting .291 as a team, including a .311 mark in conference games to rank second in the league. Junior right fielder **Steele Walker** leads the way with a .373 average, hitting a league-best .456 in 14 conference games. and slugging .633 with 11 home runs and 44 RBI. Senior second baseman Kyle Mendenhall and junior third baseman **Brylie Ware** are second and third on the team; both averaging .329. The OU pitching staff owns a 3.61 earned run average on the season, is tops in Big 12 play at 3.68 and second in conference contests with a 9.65 strikeouts-per-nine-innings average. Junior right-handed pitcher Jake Irvin, the Sooners' Friday night starter, is 5-0 with a 2.87 ERA and 68 strikeouts in 62.2 innings worked. He need just six strikeouts to reach 200 for his career. Sophomore right-hander Nathan Wiles is 4-2 with a 3.73 ERA, including a 2.61 mark in league games; ranking fourth in the Big 12. He has struck out 41 and walked only six in 50.2 innings.

Voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will call the series across the Sooner Sports Network and locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM. The games can also be streamed online at Sportstalk1400.com or on the TuneIn mobile app. OSU will televise the games to FSSW+ (Friday) and FSOK (Saturday-Sunday). **Dave Hunziker** (pbp) and **Tom Holliday** (color) will call the series from the TV side. All three games can be streamed online or on mobile through the FOXSportsGo app.

Leading Off

- Both OU and OSU enter the Bedlam series ranked for the first time since the No. 11 Cowboys took two of three from the No. 25 Sooners in 2015.
- The non-conference Bedlam match-up in Norman on March 27 was the first between the two schools as unranked opponents since the 2005 series; ending a string of 49 Bedlam games in a row with at least one team ranked in at least one top-25 poll.
- Oklahoma last won in Lubbock on March 25, 2012 to claim the series. The Sooners have lost six in a row on the road to the Red Raiders, but are 9-3 in games played in Oklahoma over that stretch.
- Steele Walker hit his 11th home run of the season at Texas Tech (4/22) to homer in back-to-back games and push his career total to 22.
- OU matched its 2017 season total with its fourth shutout of the season vs. Texas (4/15). The Sooners have not recorded more than four shutouts in a season since seven in 2013.
- Cade Harris' 28-game reached base streak is OU's longest this season and the longest by a Sooner since Ben Hollas reached safely in 29 straight in 2017.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

Scouting the Cowboys...

No. 17 Oklahoma State swept Kansas at home over the weekend and picked up a Tuesday win at Dallas Baptist to enter the series at 24-14-1 overall and 12-3, in first place, in the Big 12. Third baseman **Michael Neustifter** leads the Cowboys with a .298 batting average. Catcher **Colin Simpson** has bashed 12 home runs and driven in 40 with a .287 average. Shortstop **Matt Kroon** leads OSU with 35 runs scored and 12 stolen bases, while hitting .267. Lefty **Carson Teel** anchors the Cowboy rotation with a 5-2 record, 3.27 ERA and 60 strikeouts in 55 innings pitched.

All-Time vs. Oklahoma State...

Oklahoma trails Oklahoma State in the all-time series, 158-138. The Sooners hold the longest win streak of the series with an 11-game stretch from 1976-77. In the last five seasons, the Cowboys hold a 15-5 advantage. The longest game played between the two was a 12-9, 18-inning victory for OU on April 15, 2014; the Sooners' last win in Stillwater.

Last Time They Met...

Each team left two runners on base in the first, but most notably OU's Steele Walker was ejected after taking a called strike thre back on March 27. OSU gained all the momentum with a five-run second en route to a 7-1 win in Norman. C.J. Varela got the win in five innings of one-run ball. **Kyler Murray** went 2-for-3 with a double and drove in the only Sooner run of the night.

Campus Conference Clash...

Friday night's Bedlam contest mark the first time in the Big 12 era that Oklahoma and Oklahoma State will play an on-campus conference game. In the final year of the Big Eight, OU and OSU matched up for a five-game series. The series began with game one in Tulsa, followed by two in Oklahoma City before a game in Norman and the finale in Stillwater, which happened on April 17, 1996. Next season, the Sooners and Cowboys will play game one in Tulsa, game two in OKC and game three at L. Dale Mitchell Park in Norman.

Power Surge...

Oklahoma went 30 games between multi-home run games having gone yard three times opening day vs. Indiana (2/16) and **Kyler Murray's** two long balls at TCU (4/6). The Sooners then homered in six consecutive games; marking the first stretch of five or more games since 2010 and the first in the BBCOR (2011-present) era. **Steele Walker** hit two vs. TCU (4/8) and Little Rock (4/10) as the Sooners matched their season-high with three. Oklahoma added two more vs. Oral Roberts (4/11) and another Walker home run vs. Texas (4/13). The Sooners have hit 18 of their 30 home runs in the last 13 games. Walker has homered nine times over that stretch, while Murray has homered three times.

Up Next...

The Sooners are done with midweek games this season and will turn their focus to Kansas State after Bedlam. Oklahoma hosts the Wildcats in its final home series of the regular season, May 4-6.

11-Hit Weekend...

Steele Walker hit .688 (11-for-16) at Texas Tech (4/20-22). He notched at least three hits in every game; matching his careerhigh with four twice. Walker is a career .512 (22-for-43) hitter against the Red Raiders. In game two, he homered and doubled in a 4-for-5, two-RBI performance. In the finale, Walker went 4-for-6 against a variety of Tech defensive shifts; twice beating the defensive alignment for singles to center and right and finally with all four infielders on the right side he blasted a two-run home run in the eighth. Walker owned a .706 on-base percentage and slugged 1.188 for an astounding 1.894 OPS.

Friday Ace...

Jake Irvin has started all 10 series openers for Oklahoma this season and 10 of 12 weekend game ones as a sophomore in 2017. He is 11-1 in those 20 starts with 13 starts of six innings or more. When Irvin won the series opener, the Sooners have won 10 of 11 series. When Irvin took a loss, no-decision or did not start game one, OU has won five of 11 series.

Free Bases...

Cade Harris drew the 100th base on balls on his career vs. Texas (4/15) to become the 14th player in program history to reach that mark, the first since **Casey Bookout** (1996-99). He currently ranks tied for sixth all-time at 0U with 106. Harris is tied with **Bill Severns** (1972-75). **Damon Minor** (1993-96) is the Sooners' all-time leader at 139.

Double Take...

As a freshman, **Steele Walker** was one shy of the Sooner rookie record with 17 doubles. His 10 this season has pushed his career total to 43. Walker cracked the top-20 list in the OU record book vs. Oral Roberts (4/11). He is tied for 15th all-time at Oklahoma with **Derek Wathan** (1996-98).

Spring Cleaning...

Oklahoma brought out the brooms on back-to-back weekends to start conference play with sweeps of West Virginia and Baylor. The Sooners swept back-to-back three-game conference series for the first time since beating Missouri and winning at Texas Tech in 2006. Overall, OU moved to 8-0 in the Big 12 for the first time in the 22-year history of the league and to start conference play since 1984 in the Big Eight following two wins at TCU. The Sooners last swept back-to-back three-game series to start conference play in 1974 with Big Eight wins over Kansas and at Nebraska.

Turn Down the Horns...

Oklahoma salvaged its series with Texas (4/15) behind sophomore right-hander **Nathan Wiles'** 7.2-scoreless innings. The Sooners' 6-0 win marked their first shutout of the Longhorns since March 16, 1957. Wiles was named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week (4/16) after scattering five hits and issuing just one walk, which came in his final inning of work. He did not allow a runner to reach third and saw only four runners in scoring position; all with two outs.

Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma, which was up to No. 11 by *CBN* (4/9), became ranked for the first time in 2018 peaking at No. 19 in the *Baseball America* and *Collegiate Baseball News* (4/2) polls. The Sooners were last ranked No. 23 by D1Baseball.com and No. 24 by BA on May 22, 2017 entering the Big 12 Championship. Oklahoma was ranked for 11 weeks, consecutively, in 2017, including five weeks in all five polls. OU is ranked in every poll for the second week in a row. Last season, the Sooners peaked at No. 9 by *Baseball America* (4/3/17) following a series win over No. 2 Texas Tech. Oklahoma went 22-19 as a ranked team last season.

MLB Opening Day Starters...

Brewers RHP **Chase Anderson** (2008-09), Rockies RHP **Jon Gray** (2012-13) and Angels RHP **Garrett Richards** (2007-09) represented the Sooners as MLB opening day starters for their respective teams. The University of Oklahoma is the first college to have three alumni start at pitcher on MLB's opening day in recorded history. OU pitchers have combined for five opening day starts in the last three years, the longest in that period and tied for the most with Vanderbilt (David Price-3, Sonny Gray-2) since 2014.

Joining the 100-100 Club...

Steele Walker surpassed 100 RBI and runs for his career against West Virginia (3/23). He became the first OU player to reach 100 in each category since **Sheldon Neuse** (2014-16). Beginning with **Jackson Williams** (2005-07), seven Sooners reached the milestone over the next seven years. Walker is just the second to do so playing his entire career in the BBCOR era. All-time, 40 players have reached the 100-run, 100-RBI mark as a Sooner. The first to do so was **Keith Drumright** (1974-76) with 147 runs and 114 RBI. Walker's former teammates **Austin O'Brien** (2014-17) and **Hunter Haley** (2013-16) were the most recent Sooners to approach the mark. O'Brien finished his career with 98 RBI and 95 runs, while Haley finished with 99 RBI and 98 runs. Both O'Brien (UCL) and Haley (wrist) suffered major injuries as seniors.

Big 12 Pitcher of the Week...

Jake Irvin was named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week (4/2) after a career-high eight innings to beat Baylor (3/29). He faced the minimum through five; erasing the first two baserunners of the night on double plays Irvin did not allow a hit until there were two gone in the sixth. He allowed two runs on two hits and two walks to go with seven strikeouts. It was the second weekly Big 12 honor of his career; previously earning the same award following an opening day win over No. 17 Long Beach State (2/17/17).

Left to Right...

The Sooners have started **Cade Harris**, **Kyler Murray** and **Steele Walker** from left to right in the outfield in 35 games this season and all but three since opening weekend. The unit's total starts together surpassed the Walker-**Ben Hollas-Blake Brewster** unit's 15 from last year. Beginning with opening day 2014 through the 2015 Big 12 Championship, **Hunter Haley-Craig Aikin-Taylor Alspaugh** patrolled the Sooner outfield together for 82 games. Walker, who has started all but two games in his entire career at OU, is the only true outfielder of the group. Harris moved to left field last season to solidify a position that had been started by six different players, including 14 starts by Murray, until Harris started the last 17 games of the season. Murray, a high school All-American middle infielder, did not play in the outfield until last season and had previously not played baseball in the spring of 2016.

Deep Threat in Center or Under Center...

Sooner quarterback and outfielder **Kyler Murray** has made the adjustment to center field in his second year on the diamond. Murray, who threw three touchdown passes in only 21 attempts in 2017, has found his knack for the long ball this spring. He is tied for the team lead with three home runs. Murray hit his third of the season vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9) for his first career grand slam. The grand slam capped a five-run seventh, that was tied 6-6 when the Sooners came to bat, and stood as the difference in an 11-7 Oklahoma victory.

Senior Leader...

Kyle Mendenhall has the distinction of being the only four-year senior on the OU roster; a position that has been held by just one player in each of the last three seasons. **Hunter Haley** was the only four-year player in 2016 and **Austin O'Brien** the only one in 2017. Mendenhall is building on his junior campaign, which was his best offensive season through three years at OU. A .250 career hitter, he is currently hitting .329 and driven in 31 runs, the highest total of his career.

Big 12 Player of the Week...

Brylie Ware earned his second career weekly honor from the Big 12 as the Player of the Week (3/26). He hit a team-leading .562 (9-for-16), including .500 (6-for-12) with nine RBI in a series win over WVU. Ware went 3-for-4 in each of the first two games of the week, including a six-RBI game vs. the Mountaineers; the most by a Sooner since **Craig Aikin's** six vs. Little Rock (3/3/15).

Scoring Early...

OU scored in the first inning for the 19th time this season against UT Arlington (4/24). The Sooners are 16-3 when scoring in the first inning this season; outscoring opponents 38-13 in the first. OU took over the opposition for a 57-46 lead on runs scored in the second and third innings combined. OU is also 20-6 on the year when pushing across the first run of the game.

Two-Way Player ...

Cade Cavalli has started 36 games in the field or at DH and vs. TAMCC (3/10) got his first start on the mound. He is hitting .237 at the plate with 26 runs and 21 RBI. He hit a home run on just the second pitch he saw in his career vs. Indiana (2/16). Cavalli earned his first win in relief against Valparaiso (2/25). He is the first OU player to homer and win a game in a season since All-American **Sheldon Neuse** hit 10 home runs and went 4-1 as the Sooner closer in 2016. **Jacob Evans** also won six games and hit one home run in 2015; having hit a walk-off jack as the winning pitcher vs. Kansas (4/2/15).

Behind the Dish...

Three catchers have started four games or more for the Sooners this season. **Brady Lindsly** has started 27 and **Justin Mitchell** has started 10, while **Domenic DeRenzo** has started five. Mitchell's nine are the most by a freshman since DeRenzo started 33 in 2016. OU has not had three catchers start four games since **Mac James, Anthony Hermelyn** and **Dylan Neal** in 2014.

Winning Comparison...

In 38 games, including 32 starts, **Jake Irvin** owns a 17-5 record. His career 17 wins, the last of which came in his 29th start, tied **Andrew Doyle** (2008-09) for fourth most by a Sooner to take the mound in the last 10 years; surpassing **Jacob Evans** (2013-15). **Michael Rocha** (2008-11) won the most games over that period with 27 followed by **Dillon Overton** (2011-13) with 23. Overton won his 17th in his 48th game and 26th start, while Rocha's came in his 60th game and 24th start.

Midweek Summary...

The Sooners went 7-3 in the midweek this season; averaging 9.0 runs per game. Oklahoma was 1-2 against ranked opponents, 5-1 at home and 2-2 on the road. Following OU's 11-5 win at UT Arlington, its final midweek of the season, the average RPI of the Sooners' seven midweek opponents was 102. As a whole, Oklahoma's non-conference RPI is 61.

Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner 12 times; all at home. Seven of those wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added to their list of recent walk-offs this season vs. Valparaiso (2/25), Alabama (3/2) and Baylor (3/30). The latest walk-off win started with a two-out single by Kyler Murray, who got into scoring position by swiping second. Brady Lindsly then delivered Murray home with a double to the track in right-center.

Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at ninth with 25 sacrifice-flies. Individually, Cade Harris is in the top-10 in three categories: leading the country with 45 walks, ranking fourth with 50 runs and 10th with 17 doubles.

Last Start: Threw into the ninth for the first time in his career, but was lifted after a leadofferror and OU in front, 3-2. Wound up with a no-decision as an unearned run came in to score and force extras in an eventual 5-4 loss. Tossed 115 pitches; the second highest total of his career. Worked six perfect frames in eight innings with three runs, two earned, on five hits. Struck out seven and did not issue a walk.

No-Decision vs. Texas: Pitched six innings and left after a leadoff-triple in the top of the seventh with a 5-2 lead. Wound up with a no-decision as he allowed three runs on seven hits and no walks with six strikeouts.

Career Night: Pitched a career-high eight innings to earn his fifth win of the season in a 4-2 decision over Baylor (3/29). Faced the minimum through five; erasing the first two baserunners of the night on double plays. Did not allow a hit until two outs in the sixth. Struck out seven and walked just two in the longest outing by a Sooner since 2015.

2018 Big 12 Opener: Matched his then career-high with seven innings to defeat West Virginia (3/23). Allowed only one baserunner through five innings. A sixth-inning error opened the door for four unearned runs to score. Totaled nine strikeouts and went a second start in a row without issuing a walk.

No-Strikeout Night: First career start without a strikeout. Lasted 4.1 innings against Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9). Allowed five runs on four hits and five walks. Walked and hit a batter before being pulled with one out in the fifth.

Vs. Bama: Racked up 11 strikeouts for the second start in a row. Kept Alabama (3/2) scoreless through five innings before a two-out double scored a runner from first in the sixth.

Home Opener: Tossed six-scoreless vs. Holy Cross (2/24) and struck out 11; surpassing double digits for the fourth time in his career. Scattered two hits and two walks; allowing only two runners to reach scoring position.

2018 Opening Day: Won on opening day for the second year in a row. Threw 86 pitches in five innings of work with seven strikeouts to beat No. 20 Indiana (2/16). Overcame an early deficit after allowing two first-inning runs.

Summer Ball: Invited to Team USA Collegiate National Team tryouts. Pitched three-scoreless with five strikeouts in an exhibition start. Invited back to Team USA roster for exhibition start against the Futures League All-Stars (7/11/17).

Regional Recap: Held Louisville (6/3/17) scoreless through five against National Player of the Year Brendan McKay and allowed just one run in the first seven innings. Gave up two runs in the eighth before being relieved and took the loss in a winner's bracket contest.

Last Start: Worked three innings and took the loss at No. 4 Texas Tech (4/21). Fell behind in the first on a three-run home run. Surrendered a single run in the second and third; totaling five runs on five hits and a walk with four strikeouts.

Win at TCU: Posted his 10th career win in 5.2 innings at TCU (4/8) to clinch the series for the Sooners. Scattered six hits and you walks, which yielded three runs with two strikeouts. Pitched with a lead his entire start after OU plated two runs in the top of the first.

Series-Clincher: Earned his third win in a row, matching his career-high with a seveninning effort vs. West Virginia (3/24). Scattered four hits and one walk, yielding two runs, one earned, with six strikeouts.

Regional Win: Threw a season-high seven innings and 107 pitches to beat Xavier (6/2/17) in the Sooners' Louisville Region opener. Fell behind by giving up two runs in the second before the bats erupted for seven runs in the seventh after his final inning of work. Totaled seven strikeouts and walked just one.

First Career Start: Became the first non-sophomore to start on the mound for OU last season. Pitched six-shutout innings and got the win in an 11-0 run-rule win vs. Buffalo (3/10/17) in the nightcap of a doubleheader. Struck out nine and did not issue a walk.
